A wedding was my reason to visit the Charleston Community in Delta County during the week between Christmas and New Year's. The couple was Dillon Lisle and Sara Hernandez, and they were married on December 28 at Charleston Sky. It's a lovely, large performance/event center located there, which is new enough that owners Kevin and Lisa Carter have scheduled a ribbon-cutting with the Hopkins County Chamber of Commerce at noon on January 9, 2019. Carol Lowrey, a talented Cooper-area retailer brings her creative touch to the venue's team. Carol assists with the wedding-planning services which are part of the offerings of Charleston Sky.

After the wedding, I drove around charming Charleston. It's a farming community with a water tower, a cemetery, a cafe called "The Hub", and at least one prominent church along it's main road, FM 895. According to the Handbook of Texas, Charleston was founded in 1854 by some settlers from Charleston, South Carolina who named their new home after their old one. The community was originally a part of Hopkins County, with a post office established in 1857 and a school district organized ten years later. Then in 1870, the large territory was divided up, and that's when Charleston became a part of the new Delta County whose county seat, Cooper, helped attract business and citizens to the outlying communities. By 1884, Charleston boasted 250 residents, three cotton gins, several stores, two wagonmaking enterprises, a flour mill, a sawmill, a gristmill, a church and a school. Population continued to grow until it peaked at 400 persons in 1892. An odd bit of history, on May 19, 1910 near Charleston, a 500-pound meteorite fell to earth during the passage of Halley's Comet, bringing some publicity to the community.



The Charleston United Methodist Church was formed in 1917, according to a wooden sign displayed in front of the church. The tall, white wooden church looks beautifully preserved with a welcoming porch and magnificent bell tower above a high peaked roof. According to a web search, an English speaking congregation of 83 members meets there with pastor Janita Lyn Phillips.



I did not have the chance to go inside The Hub or meet the owners, but it looked like the central gathering place for everyone. There's a small community park behind The Hub, consisting of playground equipment, a basketball goal and a volleyball sand court. The town Christmas decorations were still up, giving the feel of a proud little community happy to be just off the beaten path. The one thing about Charleston I could not explain, however, was the yellow sign below. I just never saw a roadway sign like it. Have you? But I'm sure our mutual friend, Eddie Trapp, will have the story next time I run into him. Til then, let's reflect on our blessings and try to bless others to the capacity we have been given, as this momentous year gets it's legs under it. I will be watching for you at the corral gate!

Geriatric Term Limits?...

Commentary by Dr. Don Newbury

For more than 15 years, I've attempted to write pieces to elicit smiles--however faint--and/or to inspire. I believe a great majority of them have been "upbeat."

Not so with this one, which may rank "down there" with the Grinch that stole Christmas. "Grinch," of course, is fictional; mine is backed up by cold, hard facts.

Many conversations among retirees in the year 2000 included pro's and con's of long-term care insurance coverage. "After all, we don't want to be burdens on our children," was a comment heard time and again....

My wife and I decided the pro's stacked up taller than the con's, and signed up in 2000 at a premium cost of \$422, to be paid each QUARTER. Ever-increasing premiums ruled, and billing was changed to monthly, probably because quarterly payments of \$3,000 seemed daunting. I'm not sure it makes much difference, however, since \$1,000 (or more) paid monthly seems challenging as well. And that's for the "here and now." Who knows what premiums will be exacted between now and the "sweet by and by"?

Anyway, that's the assessment of Continental Casualty Company, which perhaps provides pertinent "fine print" in the insurance policy. (Over the years, however, my tendency has been to read such "whereases" once over lightly.)

I admit this now, to my sorrow. Numerous letters informing us of "premium adjustments" (never "premium increases") are replete with full assurances that hikes are necessary to cover escalating health care costs.

There are many other "blah, blah, blahs," one of which should be in bold face type: "WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO INCREASE PREMIUMS." One might think the "powers that be" are peering skyward, wondering if the sky really is the limit....

It is with fear and trembling that Continental Casualty Company mailings are opened at our house. Granted, notices of premium increases arrive "60 days prior" to enforcement. So what?

The biggest bombshell came early in 2016. The letter announced a 95% "premium increase" for the upcoming two years. Particularly stinging was the second-year hike of 70%....

Each letter offers options, one of which I have recently exercised. I terminated my policy, but all is not lost. I still qualify for long-term care coverage as far as the \$60,000 I've paid in premiums will take me.

At current rates, this coverage might last for a year or so. My wife, a decade my junior, will retain her policy, for now, anyway. It is substantially less expensive, but another 95% "bump" in premiums will cause her to join the insurance cancellation list....

With luck, of course, one might do well NOT to worry about long-term care. Of people who reach age 65, only 40% are expected to enter a care facility. And once there, 44% stay less than one year; 30%, one-to-three

years, and 24% more than three years.

As is too often the case, all I know is that I DON'T KNOW....

There are, of course, many folks who are far wiser in the "what-should-we-do" department. A strong suggestion is to contact a financial planning professional. He or she can decipher all the fine print, and convey pertinent information the average person can understand.

Consideration of insurance topics invariably causes me to think of my late parents, who were not introduced to insurance until obtaining basic home and vehicle coverage during the final 40 years of their lives. In the early going, of course, premiums were miniscule.

I also think of late storyteller Bob Murphey, who told about a fellow who signed on for employment with a company providing group health insurance....

Sure enough, the man fell ill, spending several days in the hospital. He smiled, confident that his "group insurance" would cover most of the charges.

He was stunned upon dismissal to learn that the policy covered nothing.

"They claimed the policy pays only if the whole group gets sick," the guy lamented....

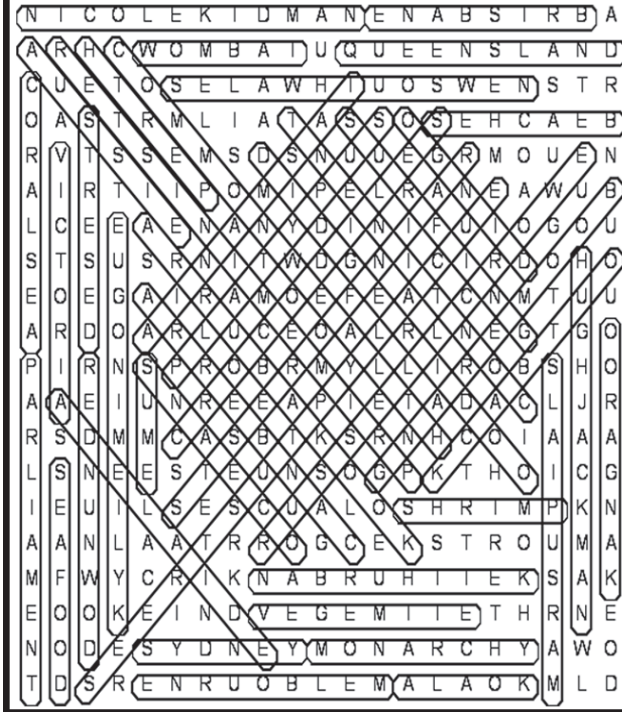

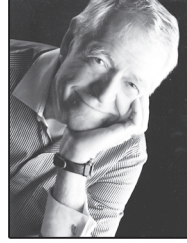

Harry Seurkamp of Whitney enjoys his hobby of woodcarving.

"It's very satisfying and very stress-relieving," he says. "I do enter competition and go to various shows. Some times people come up and say they'd love to learn how to do this. They ask me about tools. If they look like they're interested, I loan them 3 basic tools, a safety glove to keep from cutting themselves, and a leather strap like the old barbers used to use to sharpen their straight razors. I then give them a little book I wrote on how to carve various things."

He lets the people keep the tools, glove and strap for 6 months. "If they enjoy carving, I'll tell them where they can buy the tools. If they don't enjoy the carving or can't handle it, they give the tools back to me and they're not out any money."

Harry's house is in a planned community on the outskirts of Whitney. "The house is designed around my shop. I drew the plans and gave them to the architect and he pretty well followed them. It works great. I can enter the workshop from my office. I have air ducts and blowers to get the dust outside so it never gets in the house. I spend a lot of time in my workshop and have some wonderful equipment I've bought over the years. When I'm not carving I'm reading about carving. I have a large library of wood carving books and magazines."

He is a member of the Texas Woodcarvers Guild that has a two-day show in Cleburne every April. There are also 5 days of teaching woodcarving to anyone who wants to learn. Most of them are older. He wishes more young people would find the hobby interesting but says most of them are electronic minded.

He carves manger scenes. "I have 15 students that I teach in our community. We have a church here called White Bluff Chapel. We had a Christmas Eve service one evening and there was no manger scene. So the following Christmas Eve I presented the congregation with a manger scene with Mary, Joseph, baby Jesus and promised them that I would give them a piece every year to add to this. At his point we have two shepherds, a cow, a donkey, the 3 Kings, the 3 gifts and 3 large camels. The camels were challenging. I have one that's standing, one that's semi-reclining and one fully reclining. I gave each of my students the opportunity to carve a sheep, so they have a hand in this, too. There's probably about 52 pieces in there right now."

The manger scene is on a 6-foot table. He made a stable with Velcro so all he has to do to put it up is snap the pieces together. Harry is a retired druggist who was at a crafts show and saw some woodcarvers.

"They looked so contented, just carving some really beautiful pieces that looked like they belonged in a museum or gallery. I stood there a long time admiring their work and asking questions."
