



It was completed in 1965 after a 30 year effort by Howard Higbee, a former Penn State Professor.

Professor Higbee painstakingly plotted by hand, the location of 45,000 miles of streams onto the map. It sold extremely well - until the printer declared bankruptcy and hauled Higbee's work to the landfill.

But reprints were impossible because the maps were printed in non-photographic blue. Higbee was even offered \$400 for one of his last maps. And state agencies were forced to keep their copies under lock and key.

#### The Basics of Reducing and Reusing

As more and more people, businesses and governments have embraced ecofriendly lifestyles and practices, it's never been easier for men and women to make a positive impact on the planet.

One of the simplest yet most effective ways to make such an impact is to look for ways to reduce waste, which often involves reusing materials and products that otherwise might be discarded. #### How to reduce and reuse

Just like there are myriad benefits to reducing and reusing, there many different ways for consumers to reduce waste and reuse items.

• Shop for previously used items. Whether consumers are shopping for items for their homes or for new wardrobes, their options abound in regard to previously used items. Homeowners can work with contractors who have experience in working with reclaimed materials, while also visiting antique shops or used furniture stores when furnishing their homes. When clothes shopping, consumers can visit consignment shops that sell like-new items at reduced prices. • Pay attention to packaging. One of the biggest contributors to unnecessary consumer waste is packaging. Packaging is often made of raw materials, and heavily packaged items therefore require the use of more raw materials than items with less packaging. Packaging typically find its way into landfills, so consumers looking to reduce can favor items with less packaging when making their purchases and/or look for items packaged with reused or recycled materials. Maintain existing products. Reusing items does not always require repurposing them. By taking care of their existing products and possessions, consumers can get more mileage out of them, reusing them for far longer than they could if the products were not better maintained.





#### SOME HAVE ALREADY **SHOWED UP!**

They usually show up in our area in the winter about every three to five years, but not many of them. They are a beautiful bird and normally live way up north in the tundra country coming down to the U.S. during times when their normal food source is low. In their home range their diet consists of lemmings, ground squirrels and hares. When these species are down in their cycles, their diet will turn toward ground-

nesting feathered prey that will include ducks, ptarmigan and sometimes a goose. They are birds of open areas and in their normal range there are no trees.

Thus, when down here they are often seen perched on fence posts, telephone poles, on the ground or other exposed resting-places to take advantage of the higher perches for hunting and resting.

The snowy owl is big (24" tall with a five-foot wingspan) and are almost pure white with dark spotting. The female has more spots than the male and appears darker. Eventually older males will turn almost pure white. Their head is round without ear tufts and is set off with the typical yellow owl eyes.

These owls are daytime hunters, which is lucky for us because it makes them more visible when they are down here. They usually live 10 years or more in the wild and have been know to live 28 years in captivity. This owl lives on the tundra in the arctic and nest on the ground with the female doing all the incubation of the three to eleven eggs. The male does all the hunting to provide food for the family while the female tends the nest and young until they are able to move from the nest area. Both parents are very aggressive at defending the nest and have been known to drive wolves away.

Hunting is done by soaring in the tundra (a lack of trees and perches) looking for mostly small rodents. When they do migrate down this way they will use perches to watch for prey such as fence posts, telephone poles or other exposed resting places.

In the tundra the main food supply is the lemming, a small rodent that looks much like a large mouse with long fur and a short tail. When the lemming population is high, the owls remain in the tundra area all winter. However, every few years this rodent population hits a low and raising young is a problem for the owl. In fact, the adults may not even nest if the food supply is low.

In the years when the lemming population is low, the owls will migrate south into Canada and the northern areas of the United States including New York State. In 2014 there was a great influx of them and I had not only the opportunity to photograph a number of them but to also work with a friend who traps and bands



these owls.

This year may be a good year for them as a few have already showed up in our end of the state. One has been seen quite frequently at the Genesee Airport in Batavia. There was also one seen around the Oakfield area earlier and about the middle of December. I caught one sitting on a telephone pole on Route 77 by the old White Game Farm. Several have been seen up in Buffalo area by the Erie County Basin and one on a building at the Erie County Community College. There are several being seen around the Rochester area also.

There is a outfit called Project SNOWstorm that has been putting transmitters since 2014 on these owls that travel down into the USA as to learn more about them and their population status. So far a number of things have been discovered. One thing being that they are not as plentiful up north as once thought. It may be of interest to you to check out their website.

A request to anyone who may have a snowy owl hanging around their area rats that have been poisoned will travel out from the buildings and if eaten by the snowy, the owl will eventually die so please back off on the poison until the bird leaves the area.

### How Builders Can Keep Radon From Entering a Home

As the world has changed, so, too, have home buyers. The home buyers of today typically want homes that align with life in the 21st century. That means extra outlets for all of our devices and homes pre-wired for high speed internet access.

Housing starts, which refers to the number of new residential construction sites, reflect buyers' demand for newly built homes. According to the U.S. Census Bureau, there were slightly more than 1.2 million housing starts in September 2018, which marked a sizable increase from a year prior, when 1.158 million new residential constructions broke ground.

Though prospective buyers want a host of modern amenities, they also want something valued by homeowners since the dawn of time: safety. Security systems can safeguard homeowners and their families from criminals, but homeowners also must ensure steps are taken to protect a home's inhabitants from naturally occurring threats, including radon.

Radon is a radioactive gas that is produced from the natural breakdown of the uranium found in most rocks and soil. According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, exposure to radon gas is the second-leading cause of lung cancer in the United States.

Because it's naturally occurring, radon can infiltrate any home. However, the EPA, working alongside state and federal geologists, has developed maps that predict the potential indoor radon levels for every county in the country. (Note: Radon can pose a health risk when breathed in through outdoor air, but such instances are unusual because radon is typically diluted in open air.) Each county has been assigned a zone depending on its potential radon threat, and those that pose the biggest threat are designated as Zone 1, while those with the lowest threat are Zone 3. Homeowners building their homes can contact their state's radon office via www.epa.gov to determine which zone their property is in.

In addition to learning which radon zone they're in, homeowners building new homes can ask their builders to take the following measures so their homes' interiors are as resistant to radon as possible.

- · Install a layer of clean gravel or aggregate beneath the slab or flooring system.
- · Lay polyethylene sheeting on top of the gravel layer.
- · Include a gas-tight venting pipe from the gravel level through the building to the roof.
- · Seal and caulk the foundation thoroughly.






