Car Drop On Smith’s Bay West Lake Okoboji Tickets Now On Sale

The success of the annual car drop into West Lake Okoboji continues to grow each year raising funds for community needs. Watch for the car to be on the ice in Smith’s Bay very soon. You can purchase your ticket by visiting lowagratlakesrotary.org and clicking on the link in the left hand column. Tickets are \$10.00. They can also be purchased from any Iowa Great Lakes Rotarian or at The Hutt and the Dry Dock both in Arnolds Park. Or by calling 712-320-0192.

The winning time is awarded the prize of \$1,000. Proceeds from the event are used for local Rotary outreach projects.

720 tickets with a random time of day (good for both AM & PM) are sold giving each ticket two (2) chances to win.

A special clock is installed which is engineered to stop once the car falls through the ice and hits the water. The winning ticket will be determined once the car is retrieved and the time on the clock is verified by 2 Rotary board officials. If a winning ticket holder cannot be identified, the next closest ticket holder time will be chosen as the winner. If the car cannot be placed on the ice a winner will be chosen by random drawing on March 27th at the Noon Rotary meeting.”

Last year the car drop was the latest in history, dropping into the icy waters of Smith’s Bay at 3:17pm on April 26, 2018 . In 2017 the official date and time was February 23, at 4:44pm. In 2016 it dropped on March 9.

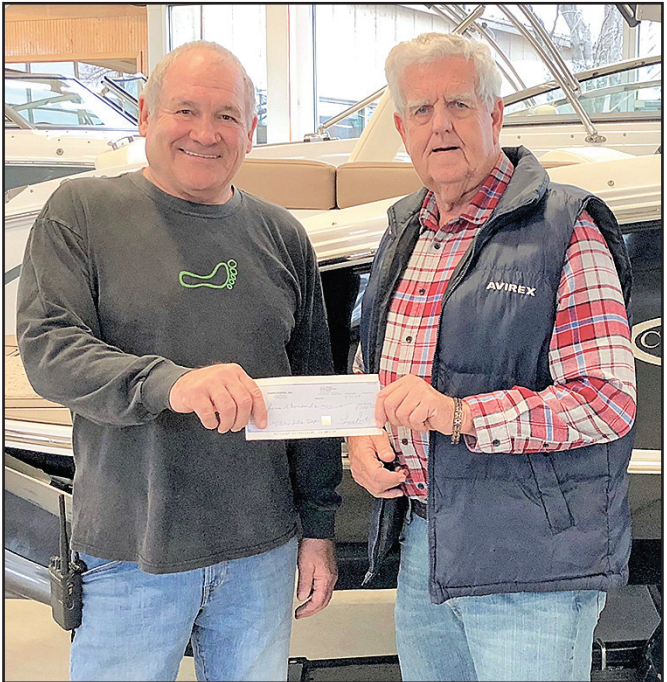

Hike the Wild Series Continues

Snow falling in winter, waterfowl migrating in spring, flowers blooming in summer, leaves changing colors in the fall.

Dickinson County Conservation's Hike the Wild series will move from monthly to seasonal hikes in 2019, starting with a snowshoe hike January 22.



Meet at 10:00am at the Dickinson County Nature Center in Okoboji, pick out the right size of snowshoes if you need to borrow a pair and then caravan to Horseshoe Bend Wildlife Area in Milford.

"I thought it would be fun to go to Horseshoe Bend in the winter, because we could see the wildlife down there," said Bryanna Kuhlman, Dickinson County Conservation environmental education coordinator.

The snowshoe excursion will last about an hour and is open to all skill levels, even newcomers to the activity.

"I think it's a fun way to introduce people who may be interested in taking up snowshoeing," Kuhlman said. "It's a fun way to explore places you otherwise may not be able to get to in the winter."

The snowshoeing aspect of the hike is weather dependent, and about 6 inches of snow cover is needed. Also, snowshoe sizes are limited through the conservation board, especially kids sizes, so please bring your own if you own snowshoes.

If there is not enough snow the day of the excursion, the January Hike the Wild will be a regular hike.

"We will just be going on a traditional hike, view the Little Sioux River, seeing some wildlife and enjoying the great outdoors," Kuhlman said. "I really enjoy Horseshoe Bend because you have a variety of habitats to go through --- river, forest and prairie."

The next hike will be held May 28. Meet at 10:00am at the Dickinson County Nature Center and then caravan to Kettleton Hogsback in Spirit Lake to experience spring, waterfowl migration and even warblers that are heading north.

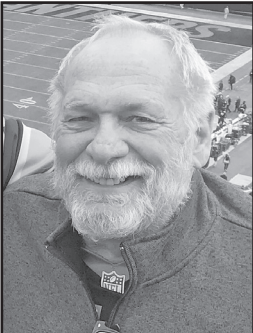

Henriksen uses new voices for Christmas in Dunnell

In his fifth or sixth annual concert celebrating the feast of St. Lucia at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Dunnell, Minnesota, on December 23rd, Armstrong's Glenn Henriksen reached out to Brookings, South Dakota, and Emily Marotz, the granddaughter of Elverna Knuth, the church's longtime organist; and Micah Perry, Emily's friend and fellow classmate at South Dakota State University, where the two are music education majors. Both have great voices. And the two sing well together. But it was Micah who took a standing ovation for his operatic tenor and stage presence, then later explained that while he intends to teach in the years ahead, he first wants to see the world — not in the Navy — but as an opera singer. Judging from the response of the 206 community members who literally squeezed into the tiny church two Sundays ago, Micah has a great career ahead of him.

We wish both Emily and Micah well in their endeavors.

Editor's note: Originally known as the Blooming Prairie congregation, Immanuel Lutheran Church in Dunnell was dedicated in May of 1905, after nine months of construction, at a cost of just \$13,000 — which included the first church pipe organ in Martin County, Minnesota. This year's concert celebrating the Feast of St. Lucia is already planned for Sunday, December 22nd, at 2:00...

Jessie James and The Outlaws will be returning to the stage at Table 316, Wednesday night, from 6 - 8:00, for your dancing and listening pleasure. *The Senders* will take the same stage next Wednesday night...

Friday night and Saturday afternoon will see Sarah Morris & Nigel Egg in shows in Jackson and Windom. Sarah is a 2018 Kerrville Folk Festival song-writing winner from Shoreview, Minnesota, not far from where Nigel lives in Minneapolis — though he is from Ramsgate, England. You will find samples of Sarah's work on *You Tube*...

Friday night's performance at the Jackson Center for the Arts begins at 7:30. Saturday's show at The BARC, in Windom, starts at 3:00...

And, Mark Lair and the Service Bay Band will be at the Little Swan Lake Winery, Sunday, from 4 - 6:00

This week, research director RD asks the musical question, "Who had hit songs with three James Bond movie themes?" The answer is: Dame Shirley Veronica Bassey, who turns 81 today. The Welsh singer is most famous for singing the themes to *Goldfinger*, 1964; *Diamonds Are Forever*, 1971; and *Moonraker*, 1979...

Wednesday is the day RD wants us to recall a Brooklyn-born composer of television and motion picture music. Victor 'Vic' Mizzy was born in January 9, 1916, and gets credit for themes for *The Addams Family* and *Green Acres*, among others. But his earlier fame came for co-writing one of Doris Day's first hits, 1945's *My Dreams Are Getting Better All The Time*.

Louis Prima and Perry Como are just two of the many others who later recorded the song...

It was January 10th, 1947, that Finian's Rainbow opened for 725 performances in the Big Apple. All of the songs for the show were written by E. Y. 'Yip' Harburg and Burton Lane. One of the most popular was *Old Devil Moon*, which has been revisited by many artists, including Margaret Whiting (1947), Sonny Rollins (1957), Mel Torme (1960), and more recently, Jamie Cullum, with the 2003 release of his second album, *Twenty-something* -- when he was 24 years old...

Morse Code Day will be celebrated Friday, which leads RD to the *Morse Code of Love*, originally performed by *The Capris*, a "one-hit wonder" group from the early sixties. It was later made more popular by *The Manhattan Transfer* under the alternate title, *Baby Come Back To Me*, on their 1985 album *Bop Doo Wopp*...

Sunday is Skeptics Day, which RD says calls for the song, *I Can't Believe That You're In Love With Me*, co-written by Jimmy McHugh in 1926. Since then it has been recorded by just about every popular singer recognizable by just his or her first name — Ella, Tony, Mel, Bing, Frank, and Dean, who used it on his 1960 album, *This Time I'm Swingin'*!

And finally, it was January 13th, 1962, that the Jule Styne, Betty Comden, Adolph Green musical *Do Re Mi* closed after 400 performances. The production introduced the popular songs *Cry Like the Wind* and *Make Someone Happy*, which was a top song for Perry Como and was later covered by Tierney Sutton on her 2007 CD, *On The Other Side*, and in 2014 by the aforementioned birthday boy Jamie Cullum, on his *Interlude* album. RD also suggests that the song might be a favorite of cake bakers everywhere, after being used in a cake mix commercial on TV 40 years ago...

Lab, Imaging Patients To Enter Hospital On East Side

Lakes Regional Healthcare (LRH) has been preparing for the anticipated construction of a new medical office building for Avera Medical Group-Lakes Family Practice and Avera Medical Group-Spirit Lake Medical Center physician clinics. Bids for the construction project will be reviewed by the Board of Trustees soon, and the project will result in demolition of the current Avera Medical Group-Spirit Lake Medical Center clinic and a remodel in the area previously used by Surgery within the hospital which includes the current west lobby area. LRH has identified temporary spaces for affected departments and staff to be located during construction, and those moves have already taken place.
At this point LRH is preparing for the close of the west entrance except to ER, Dickinson County Public Health, Avera Medical Group - Lakes Family Practice, and Outpatient Center patients. Beginning Wednesday, January 2, 2019, those coming to the hospital for lab or imaging appointments are encouraged to park in the hospital's east parking lot off of 23rd Street and Zenith Avenue and enter the hospital's east entrance. Volunteers inside the door will be able to direct or escort patients. In addition, a map will be available upon entrance to the hospital. Wheelchairs will also be available and volunteers will be able to transport patients in them if needed.
This new medical office building will allow care to be provided much more efficiently and privately and help even more with physician recruitment efforts. Construction is expected to begin in the next month or two and is anticipated to be completed in Spring of 2020.
