Now that the New Year is here, you may BE face to face with your Resolutions! Most likely, you are plotting for a better YOU in 2019. So, while you might still have a stray Christmas ornament to put away and a final serving of our traditional Black Eyed peas to finish off, let's glance back before we get too far afield. From delicious to curious, here's some ways in which New Year's is welcomed in cultures around the world.

In Spain, it is customary to eat 12 grapes — one at each stroke of the clock at midnight on New Year's Eve. Each grape represents good luck for one month of the coming year. In bigger cities like Madrid and Barcelona, people gather in main squares to eat their grapes together and pass around bottles of Cava. What's Cava? A bubbly beverage,

the equivalent of champagne, served cold in white and rose. It's also used in another delightful Spanish drink, Agua De Valencia, an close relation of the American Mimosa.





Residents of Denmark greet the New Year by throwing old plates and glasses against the doors of family and friends to banish bad spirits. These Norsemen are fond of standing on chairs to jump off of them together at midnight to "leap" into January in hopes of good luck. In Denmark, they drink Mead, one of the world's oldest alcoholic beverages. It's made from water and fermented honey, with fruits, spices or other flavors added once it's ready to drink. It's sweet, and it's delicious warmed like a cider.

In Scotland, they pull out all the stops for the New Year's Eve celebration of Hogmanay, That's because there was no Christmas in Scotland for 400 years (due to Church of Scotland ban) and thus, the people made up for it on New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. Common are bonfire ceremonies where people parade while swinging giant fireballs on poles, supposedly symbols of the sun, to purify the coming In the Scottish countryside, "first-footing" practiced...the first person who crosses a threshold of a home in the New Year should carry a gift for luck.

Oh, they drink Scotch whiskey there, and eat Haggis, a spiced pudding composed of the liver, heart and lungs of a sheep.

You'll find round shapes all over the Philippines on New Year's Eve as representatives of coins to symbolize prosperity in the coming year. Many families display piles of fruit on their dining tables and some eat exactly 12 round fruits (grapes being the most common) at midnight. Many also wear polka dots for luck.

In Greece, an onion is traditionally hung on the front door of homes on New Year's Even (evening?) as a symbol of rebirth in the New Year. On New Year's Day, Greek children are awakened by parents tapping them on the head with the onion. The drink of choice in Greece and in Cyprus, it's neighbor, is Ouzo. Ouzo is an anise-flavored aperitif and a symbol of Greek culture. Oh, and don't forget to eat your Gyro!

Of course, common traditions throughout the United States include eating black-eved peas on New Year's Day for good luck. This totally American habit originated in Texas. You don't know how the culinary custom got it's start? If not, look up The Great Black Eyed Pea Hoax, an entertaining and (mostly) true tale as well as a savory part of our shared Texan heritage. Til then, I'll watch for you from my place at the corral gate.




