



Common Sense lost the will to live as the churches became businesses; and criminals received better treatment than their victims.


Common Sense took a beating when you couldn't defend yourself from a burglar in your own home and the burglar could sue you for assault.


Common Sense finally gave up the will to live, after a woman failed to realize that a steaming cup of coffee was hot. She spilled a little in her lap, and was promptly awarded a huge settlement.



A guy was just waking up from anesthesia after surgery and his wife was sitting by his side.


His eyes fluttered open, he said, "You're beautiful!" and then he fell asleep again.



### PIEDMONT PETS

We are thrilled to announce that we have received another grant from The E. Stuart James Grant Charitable Trust to continue our rebate program for helping residents of Danville and Pittsylvania County to spay and neuter their dogs and cats. We will continue the rebates of up to \$75 for City residents and up to \$50 for County residents. Since 1993, over 30,000 animals have been spayed/neutered through our various programs.

A rebate certificate must be picked up from the shelter at least the day before the animal is taken to the veterinary clinic for the surgery.

The general guidelines are:

1. The money is to be used for residents of Danville and Pittsylvania County. The pets must live with them.

2. Clients will not be able to use our rebate program if you have approved them for use of the grant money.

3. No money can be used to facilitate the adoption of any animal

from any other rescue group or shelter.

4 No money can be used for any animal being fostered for another group.

5. The money cannot be used for general trap/neuter/release programs. The exception would be if an individual will take legal responsibility of the feral cat's lifetime care, including providing food, water, shelter, and veterinary care and the cats are released on the person's personal property.

The real math is this: Every minute in the United States, 50 dogs, 50 cats, and 8 humans are born. That means

that a family of four must have 25 pets in order for there to be no homeless dogs and cats.

The medical benefits for a spayed/neutered dog or cat are numerous. Neutering males decreases and often eliminates diseases that intact male dogs are prone to later in life, including diseases of the prostate, testicles, and other tissues influenced by male hormones.

Spaying female dogs and cats entirely eliminates diseases of the ovaries and uterus, and if performed befOore the first heat, greatly reduces the chance of mammary cancer. Behavior is only positively affected by the sterilization surgery. A neutered male cat's territorial spraying is decreased. And spayed or neutered dogs and cats fight less and wander less.

The reality is that larger shelters and more adoptions cannot solve all of the problems with pet overpopulation. Ending the unwanted litters is the only solution; everything else just puts a bandage on the situation.

### Militaria

Military collectibles are more than swords and guns, although there are many antique and vintage weapons at auction. But there also are many other collectibles: uniforms, photographs or earlier daguerreotypes, scrimshaw, jewelry made from coins, vases made from brass bullet casings, stitchedwool pictures of boats, and many other

crafts that were made during free time on ships, land or in prison camps. The earliest ones found in sales and stores today probably are the intricate ship models and other crafts from the 1700s.

During the Napoleonic Wars (1793-1815), over 120,000 French prisoners were held in camps in England. There was nothing to do, so they began making all sorts of things from materials at hand, like straw, wood and bones from pigs and mutton eaten at dinner, and ivory from whales. The prisoners were not volunteers; they had been conscripted and left lives as carpenters, farmers and tradespeople with many skills. The British let the prisoners sell their handiwork and keep the money. Gifts for children were popular, and games like dominoes and cribbage were easy to make from square or rectangular pieces of bone. They were then given markings needed for the game.

One such set of dominoes seemed to be a collection of different nonmatching dominoes, perhaps using parts of other partial sets. The box holding the dominoes and a cribbage board had a

sliding top. The set sold at an Eldred's Marine auction for \$960. The box is 6 1/2 inches long by 1 1/4 inches wide.

• My family has a photograph of a female relative done by the Chicago Portrait Co. This is a photograph, not a painting or drawing. It's in a frame with a domed glass cover. How can I determine the date of the photograph?

A • The Chicago Portrait Co. was • in business from 1893 to at least 1940. The company was known for its portraits made from old photographs, which were sold by traveling salesmen. The photographs were enlarged and colored with pastels, watercolor, oil paint, crayon or India ink, or created with sepia tones and then printed on a curved piece of cardboard. The salesman brought the picture back in a domed wood frame, making it more expensive than buying the picture alone. Since the picture was on curved cardboard, it had to be displayed in a domed frame. The salesman made his money by getting the customer to buy the expensive frame. Domed glass frames were popular from about 1880 to 1920.



Many people aspire to find a new job at the dawn of a new year. Job seekers should consider a host of factors before switching jobs to make sure they make the best decisions.



## Light Show draws 10,000, donates almost \$9,000 back to community

DANVILLE – Despite a snowy start to the 2018 Community Holiday Light Show, the 17-night event attracted an estimated 10,500 people to historic Ballou Park.

"After that first weekend, we didn't really know what to expect," said Danville Parks and Recreation's Taylor Roberts. "Once the show got rolling, we had nights where we had 3-400 cars. As always, the community support for this event is amazing."

On opening night, the Light Show got off to a record-breaking start with over 200 vehicles; however, an early December snowstorm forced staff to close the event for the next three days. Organizers were concerned opening later than usual, and an unprecedented rainy two weeks, attendance numbers would be down; however, after the final tally, 2,523 cars and 24 buses drove through the show.

"Our staff and team of volunteers worked incredibly hard to keep the show going this year," said Parks and Recreation Department Director Bill Sgrinia. "Unfortunately, clear and dry nights were few and far between this year, but the wet weather could not dampen the spirits of the Light Show crew or the community who helped make our fifth year another one for the books."

As a result, this year's Light Show reinvested almost \$9,000 back into the community, \$5,707.49 to the organizations that volunteered to work the gates and \$3,200 to the top five displays receiving best in show votes.

"This event's ability to give back to the community that supports it so well is what sets it apart as a true community event," said Special Recreation Division Director Lisa Ferguson. "Since we started in 2014, a grand total of \$39,396 has been donated either to organizations that have volunteered to work the gates or to organizations on behalf of displays built in their honor."

This year's winners included:

- · 1st Trophy & Sign Center decorating for God's Pit Crew; \$1,200
- · 2nd Old Dutch West Main Street decorating for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital \$900
- · 3rd Goodyear decorating for Danville United Way \$600
- 4th Riverbend Volunteer Fire Department Station decorating for Riverbend VFD -\$300
- 5th Danville Register and Bee decorating for God's Storehouse \$200

This year's show also drew visitors from Delaware, Maryland, Washington D.C., Illinois, Ohio, West Virginia, Tennessee, South Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Mississippi, Louisiana, Texas, New Mexico, and Colorado along with visitors from Danville, Pittsylvania County, Halifax, Henry County, Martinsville and right across the border in North Carolina.

"The Community Holiday Light Show continues to impact Danville in so many positive ways," Sgrinia said. "Words cannot express our sincerest gratitude to everyone involved, from the individuals who drive through with their families and children to the organizations that give their time and abilities to help us put it on every December."

### USDA Plan Provides for the Early Release of February Benefits for SNAP Recipients

Richmond, VA (January 14, 2019) - Virginia's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients will receive their February food benefits early due to the federal government shutdown. This change will affect all SNAP recipients in Virginia scheduled to receive benefits during the first week of February, regardless of case number or usual issuance date. The early issuance will occur on January 17, 2019.

"Families having access to food and children going to school without being hungry is a basic and critical need that transcends politics," said Virginia Department of Social Services (VDSS) Commissioner Duke Storen. "The SNAP program ensures food security for many of our nation's most vulnerable citizens, and we are pleased to be able to provide benefits to our clients for the month of February."

Individuals who have already been determined eligible for benefits do not have to take any action, as February's benefits will automatically be loaded to their SNAP Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) cards. Individuals who have filed new applications for benefits or are in the process of renewing their benefits are encouraged to submit all documents to their local department of social services as soon as possible.

"This early issuance of food benefits is still intended to sustain households throughout the month of February," said VDSS Director of Benefit Programs Toni Blue Washington. "SNAP recipients are encouraged to proactively plan their food shopping for the month of February using these early funds."

The status of future benefits beginning in March is unknown at this time, pending decisions by the United States Congress and the President. EBT cards remain active and unaffected by these changes.




with Danville Public Schools in maintenance until his retirement.
