



Career and Technical Education Students Learn About Wildlife Rehabilitation



Recently, students at the Orleans Career and Technical Education Center were able to see some beautiful birds of prey up close.

Robert Humbert from Wolcottsville Wildlife brought in a red-tailed hawk and a snow owl that the organization is rehabilitating. Students who will be participating in the environthon and the landscaping and food service programs attended the demonstration.

Teacher Tracey Dahlhaus, who teaches the landscaping program, says it was fascinating and gave her students a lot of information. "We are studying bird culture at the moment and what plants you put in your yard to attract wildlife," she says. "I thought it was interesting for the students to think about how some of the bigger birds are drawn to the animals that will come to feed on the berries or the insects the plants draw. I love demonstrations and it was a real wow factor for the students to see the birds up close."

Mr. Humbert told the students he became involved in wildlife rehabilitation when he rescued two red-tailed hawks and brought them to a rehab center. The people who ran the center recruited him to work with them which he did for ten years. He then went on to start his own center. Its mission is to rescue and rehabilitate sick, injured or orphaned animals and release them back in the wild whenever possible.

Science teacher Peter Jablonski says he asked Mr. Humbert to talk to the students so they would have a better appreciation of nature and to maybe spark a new idea on a career choice. "I just thought that they are beautiful animals and it would be something fun for them to do. Maureen Bartlett, our Integration Specialist, and I have been working with our envirothon students and we just thought it was a great way to spark their interest. We had many students from other classes sneak out into the commons area to see the birds. It was really great."

Mr. Jablonski said Mr. Humbert talked to the students about the importance of not littering and picking up trash when they see it. "It is very harmful to animals," he said. He illustrated his point by showing photos of animals he had rescued that had gotten encased in plastic pop rings and old fishing nets. "75 percent of the stuff I see in rehab can be prevented. That is why I like to talk to the students. They are the next ambassadors to continue taking care of the planet."

As thanks and to help the animals, the SkillsUSA students at the center are planning a fundraiser for the Wolcottsville Wildlife Center. They will ask students to donate money, dog and cat food, paper towels and birdcages to aid the center. A LITTLE DIFFERENT COLUMN THIS WEEK

This week's column is a little different than usual. I love telling folks about nature and all it's marvels and beauty, but there are a couple related subjects that I feel need to be told. Back when I wrote a weekly column (The Great Outdoors) for the Medina paper before it went under, I used to regularly publish a list of "Bad Boys" those who got caught violating conservation laws. Most

thought this was great (except the "Bad Boys") as often times having those names and violation in the paper for everyone to see was more of a punishment than the fine. At that time the head of law enforcement in the Region 8 office in Avon would regularly send me these local violations along with the names of the individuals and addresses. However, things have changed today and for some reason that information cannot be given out now. Another of Albany's "great rules."

I don't understand why this information cannot be given out anymore as we still publish the names and violations of those who perform other crimes, even minor ones. Maybe the folks at Albany are afraid of getting their names in our papers.

Anyway, they have released a couple of big ones recently. Maybe because they get more attention for the DEC folks in Albany. Politics you know.

According to DEC, Carl J. Rivers, 49, of Albion was arrested Jan. 3 following a seven-month investigation into an illegal dump site (our Tonawanda Wildlife Management Area) on Klossen Road in the Town of Alabama, Genesee County. Rivers has been charged with third-degree endangering public health, safety and the environment, a felony, as well as a violation-level charge of unlawfully disposing of solid waste (asbestos). Mr. Rivers could face up to a \$150,000 fine and four years in prison for his abuse to our Tonawanda WMA. Apparently this is not the first dealings Mr. Rivers has had with the law. In fact, it seems to be a way of life for this moron as he was already in police custody for an unrelated crime. He will never be able to pay a fine like that so just put him on cleanup detail in prison for the rest of his life!

The DEC Spills Unit hired a contractor to clean up and remove the hazardous debris, which was taken to a registered facility. Mr. Rivers is due back in court on March 7 and here's to him getting the maximum sentence for such a reckless and dangerous crime to my playgrounds.

This incident is a good reminder to keep your eyes open to illegal activities on our three local wildlife areas. Sometimes that black garbage bag disregarded along the road may contain more than just household trash and may not only hurt wildlife and other humans, but trash the reputations of other outdoor folks using an area. We are very short on conservation officers and so it is important that we report any suspected violations that we may observe while out there enjoying our refuge areas.

The second story is quite sad from both ends. On Nov. 22, 2017 a 34-year-old deer hunter from the small town of Sherman in Chautaugua County fired a round from his pistol after legal closing time and killed his neighbor who was walking her dogs about 100 yards from her home. This tragedy could have been prevented if the hunter had obeyed the NYS DEC law of no deer hunting after sunset and the basic hunter rule of knowing your target and what is behind it. Apparently the shooter was shooting under poor light conditions and had not correctly identified his target. Supposedly the woman was walking 200 yards away from the hunter. Two-hundred yards is a long piece even with a rifle being shot offhand yet alone a hand gun.

The woman later died from the shot in the hip. The shooter was charged with second-degree manslaughter at the time. Now the woman's family has to live with her loss and the shooter has to live with the stupid mistake he made.

Recently a judge sentenced the shooter, who pleaded guilty in October 2018, to criminally negligent homicide and hunting after sunset, to an "indeterminate sentence" of one to three years in state prison.

I hope this is a wake up call to those of you out there that occasionally "bend" the law and rules of safe gun handling.

Six Options for **Funding Your Next Home Improvement Project**



Before starting a home improvement project, either on one's own or with the assistance of a professional contractor, homeowners must first consider the costs involved. According to the home improvement resource HomeAdvisor, more than one-third of homeowners do not understand what hiring a professional will cost, and then cannot successfully budget and secure financing once they have set their sights on a renovation project.

- 1. - 2. Home equity line of credit: The financial experts at Bankrate indicate that a HELOC works like a credit card, with the house as collateral. There is a credit limit, and borrowers can spend up to that limit. The interest rate may or may not be fixed. However, the interest may be tax-deductible if the financing is used to improve, buy or build a home.
- 3. Home equity loan: Individuals also can borrow against equity in their homes with a fixed interest rate through a home equity loan. Most lenders will calculate 80 percent of the home value and subtract a homeowner's mortgage balance to figure out how much can be borrowed, according to the financial advisory site The Simple Dollar.
- 4. Personal loan: Homeowners can shop around at various financial institutions for competitive personal loans to be used for home improvement purposes. Funds may be approved within one business day, which can be ideal for those who want to begin their improvements soon.
- 5. Personal line of credit: A personal line of credit allows borrowers to borrow only the money needed at the time, and offers a variable interest rate that is generally lower than fixed loan rates. Again, like a credit card, PLOC gives a person a maximum borrowing amount and is ideal for ongoing purchases.
- 6. Credit cards: In a pinch, credit cards can be used to finance improvements, but they do come with the cost of very high interest rates if the balance is not paid in full by the time the bill comes due. However, for funding smaller projects and maximizing rewards points through home improvement retailers or specific credit card company promotions, credit cards can be a way to earn various perks in addition to the benefit of improving a home.

Homeowners looking to finance their next improvements should speak to a financial advisor and shop around for the best types of funding for them. \blacksquare



Croissant French Toast with



1/2 cup orange marmalade

2 cups pitted fresh California Bing cherries

4 Croissants (Tip: Day-old are fine)

3 eggs

1/2 cup milk

1/4 cup heavy cream

1 tablespoon vegetable oil

2 cups fresh whipped cream

1/2 cup chocolate sauce

Heat orange marmalade in a small saucepan over medium-low heat. Add the cherries and cook for 5 minutes, stirring frequently. Remove from the flame.

Slice the croissants in half lengthwise, as if to make a sandwich. Whisk eggs, milk, and cream together in a flat-bottomed baking dish. Lay the croissant pieces in the egg mixture, turning several times as the liquid is absorbed.

Add the oil to griddle and heat on medium flame. Cook the croissant slices until golden brown on each

Place the bottom croissant slices on serving plates. Top with 1/2 cup cherry mixture. Top with the croissant tops, then add a dollop of whipped cream and finish with a pour of chocolate sauce.
