**Welcome to the City of Eastlake!
We are situated about 19 miles
northeast of Cleveland, Ohio,
along the shore of Lake Erie, and
are considered part of Greater
Cleveland.**

Over 300 years ago the Erie Indians had a village near what is now Lake Shore Boulevard and Reeves Road. In 1750 a French trading post, Charlton, was established at the mouth of the Chagrin River. In the 1830-40's settlers came from "York" State to purchase land from the Connecticut Land Co. for \$7 to \$10 per acre. The 1880's brought the wealthy people from Cleveland to build summer homes and in 1897, the C.P. & E. Shoreline Interurban Street Car Line brought many more people to enjoy the lake & country living. In 1923 Conrad & Jessie Albracht built a summer home on land that later became the city hall of Eastlake at a cost of \$22,043. The land extended from Erie Rd. along Lake Shore to Willowick Dr. In 1948 Eastlake incorporated as a village and by 1949 the city hall was at Roberts and Beachpark Rd. In 1951 Eastlake officially become a city with a population of 7,486. In 1956 Eastlake purchased the Albracht building & land for \$50,000 and in 1958 Eastlake & Willoughby became the first communities in the United States to form a sewer district. 1987 brought new shopping malls & business to Eastlake and in 1994 a new city hall was built with the old one being moved across the street as a private residence.

In 2019 we will see the completed construction of Longfellow Elementary and Eastlake North High school. This will be a tremendous asset for the education of our children.

We are home to the Boulevard of 500 Flags and the 9/11 Memorial on the grounds of City Hall. This amazing Memorial consists of a section of grass from doomed flight 93 that crashed in Shankland Pennsylvania, a piece of granite from the Pentagon, and an actual steel beam and light post from the Twin Towers in New York City. Visitors from all over the world come to pay tribute to the fallen at this site.

In 2002, a Memorial was built in Eastlake to honor all the dogs that served to protect our Service People during World War I, World War II, Korea and Vietnam. In building this memorial we found it to be the first in Ohio. Its location made it the first in the United States attached to a Dog Park, where residents can bring their dogs and let them run.

Eastlake has been the Home of the Lake County Captains since 2001 and The Miracle League of Lake County since the summer of 2018. The Miracle League is a baseball league designed for special needs children and adults. We are 1 of 6 cities in Ohio that have this special field and all-inclusive playground. The inaugural season was made up of 6 teams and we look forward to another great and more expanded season in 2019.

Eastlake is proud to have an ADA accessible Kayak and Paddleboard launch run by Chagrin River Kayak and Paddleboard at 201 Erie Road. For more information call (440)477-0864. The City also boasts 5 Yacht clubs, Chagrin Lagoons, Chagrin River, Lake County, West Channel, and South Shore. Each of these will accept new members at any time.

To sum it up, Eastlake is a city rich in history with an eye to the future.

Great Food

Recent accolades include Hook and Hoof New American Kitchen and Cocktail named as one of the Top 25 Restaurants in 2018 by Cleveland Magazine; THE BEST homemade hummus (and the best kept secret) from Sunoco on Lost Nation Blvd and bakeries that will cure your sweet tooth with crepes, mini donuts and cupcakes.

Historic Downtown

Willoughby's historic downtown is over 200 years old and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Some buildings in downtown have underground tunnels that once connected Speakeasies during Prohibition. The Willoughby Brewing Company was the former railcar depot and Sol was the powerhouse for the railway that ran through the city. Original buildings have been repurposed to house unique shops offering artist-made jewelry and gifts, on-trend clothing or shabby chic antiques. After strolling through the shops, there are over 20 restaurants and bars to grab a drink or a bite to eat.

Arts & Culture

The Fine Arts Association is a gathering place for those of all ages that want to explore, watch, and learn the arts. The newly established Willoughby Arts Collaborative has taken it to the streets, by painting the downtown crosswalks which is only the first of many public art projects on the list. Willoughby is also home various boutiques where you can purchase clothes, jewelry, original artwork and more.

May is the annual **Rib Burn Off** where local and national chefs compete for the title of “Best Ribs” and bands play on 3 stages. **The Classic Car Cruise-In** in June offers a glimpse into our past as over 700 beautiful cars line the downtown streets for all to see. Come July, find that one-of-a-kind piece for your collection at **ArtsFest** as 140 juried artists, musicians and vendors line Erie Street. To close the summer, **Last Stop Willoughby** is a free, family friendly event. In honor of the Twilight Zone's episode of the same name, this event offers trolley rides, trains, a kid's zone and parade through downtown. Other summer staples including the Outdoor Market and a free summer concert series on Thursdays at Wes Point Park during July and August. Local bands, impromptu dancing and music under the stars is the perfect way to spend a summer night! And new for 2019, Second Saturdays on Second Street festivals.

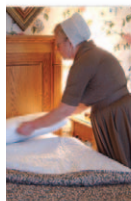

Perhaps you'll check out the 360-degree elevated view from **the observation tower at Lake Erie Bluffs**, where fantastic sunsets on the lake and bald eagle sightings are common. A popular birding location, trails also provide access to shoreline fishing along 9,000 feet of a sandy and cobble beach that is host to rare and common plants and animals.


Or maybe you'll consider visiting **the pier at Painesville Township Park**. An ADA-accessible walkway and stairs lead down to the pier, which extends 200 feet into the water and provides public access to our region's greatest natural resource: Lake Erie. The pier is a great place to marvel and stunning views of the lake and the setting sun as well as to witness bald eagles fly over the shoreline in search of a meal. The pier also provides excellent fishing access for a wide variety of fish including smallmouth bass, perch, walleye, and steelhead trout.

Nature Play at Penitentiary Glen Reservation is a unique "natural" play area that features interactive sites designed to engage children in creative and imaginative play. Kids can traverse through an acre of green landscape with logs to climb on, tunnels to crawl through and hillsides to roll down. Features include a play campsite, a shallow pond and natural objects to discover. There is no start or finish, nor map or suggested route. Kids are encouraged to chart their own course of adventure through this outdoor play maze. There are very few rules or limits and parents, although present, observe from a distance. Nature play spaces help children understand, appreciate and value nature's ecosystems.

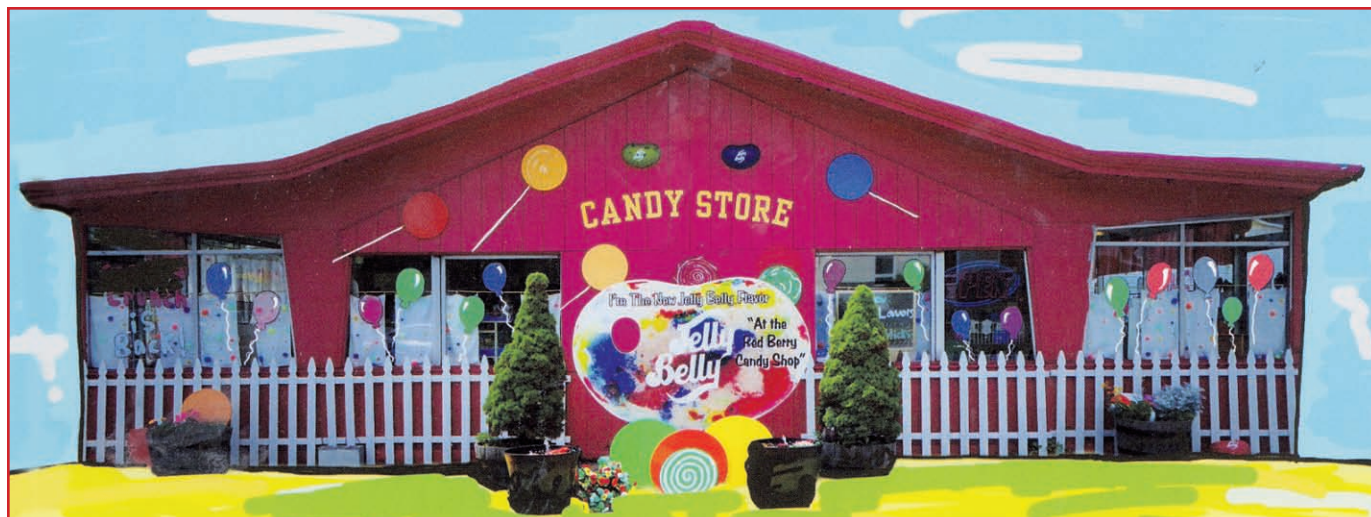
