THE OTHER ANIMAL IN OUR MARSHES

They haven't been in this area for a very long time, over 100 years. During the mid-1800s, this animal began to decline throughout the state. Deforestation, polluted water and unregulated trapping were responsible for eliminating them. Their last strong hold was in the Adirondacks, Catskills and the Hudson Valley. In 1936 the trapping season was closed on them and



The otter has been absent from this end of the state, but now he back!

wasn't resumed until 1945 with more restrictive seasons and bag limits. Still this animal was limited to the above mentioned areas. Then in 1994, the River Otter Project came to into being. It was a cooperative effort by both the NYS DEC and concerned citizens. The River Otter Project folks raised \$500,000 for expenses, and trappers volunteered to live trap otters in the above mentioned areas. Over the course of the project 279 otters were caught and then released at 16 sites in Western NY. None were released in our swamps as the trappers here voted against it. They use a large killer type trap for winter trapping of muskrat here and the trappers felt that they would be killing some of them if they were released here. The project was a huge success and we now have this unique animal well established in this end of the State. Does that include our local refuge areas? Yes, they eventually migrated into our local swamps and otter sign has been present here for a number of years now.

You would think that a guy like me who travels around this area with his camera a lot would have see one, but nope. No luck, but I do see the sign. In Western NY a few are accidentally taken each year by beaver trappers using killer type traps which is bound to happen as there is a close relationship between beavers and otters. When going to college in the Adirondacks I trapped, but never caught an otter and only seen one and that wasn't a very good observation. Maybe some day I'll lucky and get my camera on one in our local refuges.

The river otter is a very unique and interesting animal with a very short, dense and glossy fur. Running your hand over the fur reminds you of a fine piece of velvet. Their streamlined, but stout body, fully webbed feet on short legs, broad and flattened head and muscular tail all serve to assist in swimming and foraging. Their eyes, ears, and nose are located on the top of the head, so they can see, hear, and smell while most of their body remains in the water. That beautiful fur can range from black to light brown with the area under the neck and head being lighter. Males are larger than the ladies and range 35 to 50 inches long with weights of 10 to 30 pounds. River otters can stay underwater for up to eight minutes and can close their ears and nostrils to keep water out. They can also dive to a depth

They usually hunt at night and feed on whatever might be available. Fish are a favorite food, but they also eat amphibians, turtles, crayfish and even muskrats and waterfowl. They have a third eyelid, or nicitating membrane, that protects the eye and allows the him to see when swimming underwater. There are also long, stiff and highly sensitive facial whiskers that aid in locating and capturing prey.

Being that river otter is at the top of the food chain, they have a greater chance of being exposed to elevated levels of environmental contaminants such as PCB, DDT and heavy metals; such as cadmium and mercury. As contaminants accumulate in the organic materials and sediments on the bottom of a waterway, they become ingested by aquatic invertebrates such as snails, mussels, and insects. These are in turn consumed by fish, which may then be eaten by larger fish, all of which are consumed by river otter. This accumulating effect results in elevated levels of pollutants in river otter due to the ingestion of contaminated food items. At such high levels, some of these contaminants can have negative impacts on otter ranging from poor survival to sterility or infertility. By keeping a close eye on the otter we can tell if there could be a problem in the environment.

Gee, there are so many neat things about the river otter I will just have to continue about this marvelous animal into next week's column!



Signs of a **HEART ATTACK**





The Choice For Staying Put or Moving On

Many home improvement television series showcase people deciding whether to improve upon their current homes to make them into the houses of their dreams or to put "for sale" signs in their lawns and move on to something new.

The question of whether to move or stay put depends on various factors. Such factors may include emotional attachment to a home, the current economic climate and the cost of real estate. Current data points to a greater propensity for people to invest and improve upon their current properties rather than trading up for something new.

According to information collected by John Burns Real Estate Consulting, the percentage of homeowners moving up to their next home is the lowest in 25 years. Many are opting to make starter homes permanent by expanding them and repairing homes for the long haul.

The National Association of Realtors said that, between 1987 and 2008, home buyers stayed in their homes an average of six years before selling. Since 2010, however, NAR says the average expected length of time people will stay in their homes before selling is now 15 years.

Part of what's fueling this permanency is that many home buyers were able to acquire rock-bottom mortgage interest rates shortly after the 2008 recession. As a result, they're not inclined to walk away from those rates, even if doing so means getting more house. Also, a low inventory of available houses has stymied repeat buying for many people.

Those factors and others have led many homeowners to invest in renovations instead. Very often a smarter layout and more efficient floor plan can make meaningful differences in spaces. Renovations and redesigns can make sense and often are less expensive and disruptive than moving.

How to Invest in Gold and Silver

Gold, silver and other precious metals have been used as currency throughout history. Paper money is a relatively recent method of payment, one that requires a certain level of faith among consumers. But that faith in paper currency has waned in recent years, and there are many people who are once again investing in gold and silver.

Gold and silver still have a position of great financial importance in today's market. With the value of a dollar fluctuating, precious metals may make a more stable investment. But investors who plan to investigate gold and silver should consider a few things before making their decision.

- Look into bullion. Gold and silver bullion are made from 99 percent of the total metal. - Sell scrap jewelry. While you may not get the full value of the jewelry, you can take advantage of the rising rates of gold and silver by selling off items you may not use. Selling extra jewelry requires little work on the part of the seller. ■



Soup & Sandwich Makes the Ideal Lunch Combo

Few things are better together than hot soup and a favorite sandwich for lunch or a light dinner. This combination is the ideal comfort food, and the variations are as endless as a person's imagination.

Mozzarella Sandwiches

Makes 4 servings

8 slices day-old bread, crusts removed

3 1/2 ounces mozzarella cheese, thickly sliced

8 canned anchovy fillets, drained and

chopped

16 fresh basil leaves

1/2 cup pitted black olives, chopped

4 eggs, beaten

2/3 cup milk

Oil for deep-frying

Salt and pepper

Cut each slice of bread into two triangles. Top eight of the bread triangles with the mozzarella slices and chopped anchovies. Place the basil leaves and olives on top and season with salt and pepper to taste. Lay the other eight triangles of bread over the top and press down around the edges to seal.

Mix the eggs and milk and pour into an ovenproof dish. Add the sandwiches and leave to soak for 5 minutes.

Heat the oil in a large pan until a cube of bread browns in 30 seconds — the oil will then be hot enough for deep-frying. Before cooking the sandwiches, squeeze the edges together again.

Carefully place the sandwiches in the oil and deep-fry for 2 minutes or until golden, turning once. Remove the sandwiches with a slotted spoon and drain on absorbent paper towels. Serve immediately while still hot.

Creamy Tomato Soup

Makes 4 servings

3 tablespoons butter

1 teaspoon sugar

Salt and pepper

1 pound, 9 ounces ripe tomatoes, preferably plum, roughly chopped 2 tablespoons shredded basil leaves

3 3/4 cups hot vegetable stock

2/3 cup milk or light cream 1/4 cup ground almonds

Melt the butter in a large saucepan. Add the tomatoes and cook for 5 minutes, until the skins start to wrinkle. Season to taste with salt and pepper. Add the stock to the pan, bring to a boil, cover and simmer for 10 minutes.

Meanwhile, under a preheated broiler, lightly toast the ground almonds until they are golden brown. This will only take 1-2 minutes, so watch them closely.

Remove the soup from the heat and place in a food processor. Blend the mixture to form a smooth consistency. Alternatively, mash the soup with a potato masher. Press the soup through a strainer to remove any tomato skin or seeds.

Place the soup in the pan and return to the heat. Stir in the milk or cream, ground almonds and sugar. Warm the soup through, and add the shredded basil just before serving.

Transfer the soup to warm bowls and serve hot.


