OST sets classics for 2019

It should be obvious now that when Stagerat Stan mentioned "a little bit of country and a little bit of Rock 'n' Roll" here last week, that he was talking about *Honky Tonk Angels* opening the Okoboji Summer Theatre's 2019 season on June 11th, with the music of Loretta Lynn, Tammy Wynette, and Dolly Parton – "a lot of fun and some dancing, too," executive director Ruth Ann Burke explained Saturday.

The three other musicals will be (The original) *Disney and Cameron Macintosh's Mary Poppins*; *Beethove*, *The 60's Musical*; and *Mamma Mia*, which will cap the season the first full week of August.

Burke said the decisions for this year's season – Stephens College's 62nd summer season in Okoboji – were to bring back some favorite classic shows along with a couple newer shows that haven't been staged by the OST.

While the four musicals alone would make a good season, five more great shows are planned, with Agatha Christie's *Murder on The Orient Express*; the Robert Harling comedy, *Steel Magnolias*; Tennessee Williams' classic *Cat On A Hot Tin Roof*; *Happily Ever After: A Wedding Comedy*; and Joe DiPietro's *Living on Love*.

Four musicals, three comedies, and one great classic – plus four Boji Bantam performances for the younger generation, that include *Treasure Island*, *Red Riding Hood*, *Miss Electricity*, and *The Ugly Duckling*, will provide opportunities for several outings to the Okoboji Summer Theatre this year. As always, the box office will open on the first Monday in June – the 3rd. The OST's money-saving discount ticket voucher books are available via email at OSTAssociation@GMail.Com

With June (and summer) just four months hence, this week will see a lighter than usual schedule on the music scene – probably due at least in part to advance knowledge of the forecast for snow and extremely cold temperatures. Terry Klein will be performing at Table 316, in Arnolds Park, Wednesday night, from 6 - 8:00 – on the same stage that will see *The Senders* at the top of the February roster next week...

And Emma Wicks, who was originally scheduled to be at the Little Swan Lake Winery this past weekend, will instead take the stage in the barn Sunday afternoon, from 4 - 6:00; with *Storm Rising* appearing the following Sunday afternoon on the same schedule...

Four "unsung" songwriters will be performing at the Jackson County Center for the Arts on Friday night, February 8th – following a song writing workshop presented by two of the four, the night before. David Stoddard, who performed at the JCCArts many years ago, will be joined for the 6:30 workshop on Thursday, the 7th, by Matt Fockler; then by Bruce Boldt and Dick Kimmel, as well, for Friday night's 7:30 performance. You will be suitably impressed if you Google any or all of the four. Following the workshop and show in Jackson, the four will work together, again, at the BARC in Windom, at 3:00, on Saturday, February 9th...

Research director RD wants to know if you think you will see your shadow on Saturday, which will be Ground Hog Day. That's the day she will be looking forward to hearing *The Shadow Of Your Smile*, written by Johnny Mandel and Paul Francis Webster for the 1965 motion picture *The Sandpiper*. The movie's theme included a trumpet solo by Jack Sheldon, and garnered a Grammy and an Oscar. Recordings that were issued almost simultaneously with the movie included efforts by Tony Bennett, Astrud Gilberto, and jazz guitarist Wes Montgomery, on his Verve album *Bumpin'...*

More immediately, today is National Corn Chip Day, which brought to the blonde's recall, "Munch, Munch, Munch a Bunch of Fritos Corn Chips," a line that was part of the promotional jingle used when Fritos were introduced in 1953. That's when The Frito Kid made his debut as the spokesman for the crunchy corn snack.

Fritos were invented by Charles Elmer Doolin, who eventually partnered with Herman Lay to form Frito-Lay, later a subsidiary of PepsiCo. The jingle was created by copywriter Jerry Abbs, who worked what became DDBO, a huge international ad agency in New York...

Today is also the day in 1950, that Ann Jillian was born Ann Jura Nauseda in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Jillian is best known for her role as Cassie Cranston, in the 1980's TV sitcom, *It's a Living*. It wasn't until 1994 that she recorded *In The Middle of Love* – a salute to the songs of Steve Allen, who was one of her biggest champions. Included on the CD were *Until I Left Chicago*, *I Depend On Me*, and the ballad, *I Love You Says It Very Well* – all composed and written by the very talented Allen, who is credited for music and/or lyrics for some 8,000 songs, including *This Could Be The Start of Something Big*, and *The Gravy Waltz*, which earned him a Grammy Award for the Best Original Jazz Composition in 1964...

Friday is the first day of February, and also Wear Red Day, bringing to mind the tunes *Red Garter*, *Red Shoes*, and *Red Carpet*, from the multi-part *Toot Suite*, on Duke Ellington's *Jazz Party* album, which saw singer Jimmy Rushing and trumpet player Clark Terry working with him. The Columbia LP was recorded in February 1959.

It will probably come as no surprise that RD has even found a song to celebrate the new month. *February Fiesta*, performed by Benny Carter, was written by Hal Schaefer, who was Carter's pianist when the album – like the Ellington LP noted above – was recorded in 1959. The jazz calendar album, *Aspects*, featured a song for each month of the year, but was recorded in the not very dynamic monophonic sound of the era. It was almost 40 years later, in 1997, that all 12 songs were re-recorded in stereo, and re-released (in Spain) as a two-LP CD. Featured musicians included Barney Kessel, Frank Rosolino, Joe Gordon, Pete Candoli, and Shelly Manne, among others...

Saturday is the day to celebrate composer and lyricist Burton Lane's natal day. Born Burton Levy, in New York, in 1912, Lane is recognized for the music heard in many Broadway shows, including *Finian's Rainbow* and *On a Clear Day You Can See Forever*.

Even earlier shows saw music introduced by Judy Garland in the 1941 motion picture *Babes on Broadway*. More recent recordings of Lane's music include those by Stan Getz, Bobby Darin, and Rosemary Clooney with Barry Manilow, who were backed by *The Count Basie Orchestra* on *At Long Last*.

Never one to skip a beat, RD also found that the aforementioned tenor man Stan Getz was born Stanley Gayetski, in Philadelphia, on February 2, 1927. In addition to his own compositions, Getz included a Burton Lane selection, *How About You*, on his critically acclaimed album, *The Steamer*, in 1958. The several versions of Lane's tune on the LP include an alternate that drew space in the liner notes as having, "some swinging hairpin turns that will make your head swivel!" Getz won five Grammy awards, including one for his most famous hit, *Girl From Ipanema*, with Astrud Gilberto, in 1964.

And, RD notes that Saturday is also the day Eva Cassidy was born in Maryland. The singer/guitarist was well known for her heartfelt interpretations of jazz and blues songs. One of her best-selling albums, *Songbird*, was released two years after her untimely passing in 1996, when she was just 33 years old. The CD included such classics as *Wade In The Water*, *Autumn Leaves*, and a haunting rendition of *Over The Rainbow*...

When the ice comes out at the arena in March, you'll continue to see lots of activity around the place. The Lakes Area Hockey Association is kicking off a 3-year, \$1M project to complete Phase 3 amenities, making the arena even better than it already is. It was a generous offer from the Goodenow Family to match up to \$300K in gifts that got the ball rolling. Steve Goodenow says, "The arena makes so much sense to me and is a great economic driver in our slower winter months. This group is doing great work in our community and I am more than happy to support them". Steve's right about the economic impact the association has on the community in the winter. The four youth hockey tournaments LAHA hosted this season brought teams from as far away as St. Louis, Missouri, and are estimated to have brought in over \$200K in visitor spending on hotels, restaurants, and shopping. Grant Secured For Spine Trail Maintenance
 In January, DCTB was awarded a Federal Recreational Trails grant for a significant maintenance project on the Spine Trail. The grant for \$313,300 will provide for a 2-inch asphalt overlay of the trail starting at 15th Street in Spirit Lake and going north to 125th Street in Orleans for a total of 2.75 miles. The project will be a major improvement to areas of the Spine Trail that are reaching 20 years old. DCTB is pleased to have the opportunity to provide a new surface to the trail with the project scheduled to be completed in 2020.
2019 Projects & Annual Planning Sessions
 Two new trail segments are planned for construction in 2019. The first is continuation of the rail trail, Tatonka Ska Trace, for another mile starting just north of Hy-Vee and heading west to Hudson Avenue. The second project is completion of the Jones Pasture Trail on the northeast side of Big Spirit Lake that will expand the Spine Trail for another mile. DCTB is also planning 1.35 miles of asphalt overlays on the Nature Center trail from Highway 71 to Kenue Park as well as the Spine Trail along Kiwanis Park and 20th Street in Spirit Lake. DCTB held planning sessions in November and December to prioritize future projects and maintenance needs. There are many great ideas about where we want to expand and improve

the trails system with priorities on building local connections throughout the Iowa Great Lakes and regional connections with Clay County to the south and Osceola County to the west. We have a great board with a variety of talents to contribute, and their service to the Iowa Great Lakes Trails is appreciated!
Winter Snowmobile & ATV Use On Trails
 Most of the Iowa Great Lakes Trails do not allow for snowmobile and ATV/UTV use, however, during the winter there are portions of the Spine Trail that are open to these vehicles. The trail is NOT open to these vehicles in key areas along Highway 71 where the trail is kept clear of snow for pedestrian use and access to businesses. The Spine Trail is also closed to these vehicles in Spirit Lake between 15th Street and Hill Avenue but there is a snowmobile route adjacent to the trail on the old railroad bed. The Dickinson County SnowHawks have an excellent map that shows where use is allowed on the trail on their website at www.dickinsoncountysnowhawks.com/trails. As a reminder, ATVs and UTVs are allowed on all public streets in the Iowa Great Lakes except for the state highways, so their use should be very limited on the trail. Please be mindful of other trail users and use caution while on the trail.

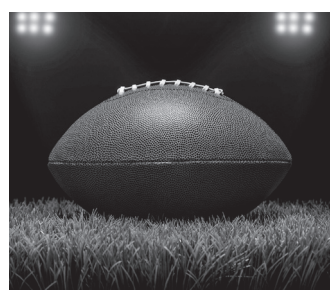

Spencer Hospital Prepares for Surgery Center Reopening

Patient care and cleaning were the top two priorities at Spencer Hospital on Tuesday following Monday evening's small equipment fire.

"Caring for our patients is always our number one priority and today we also had team members busy cleaning areas within the hospital which were impacted by smoke damage, sterilizing equipment and replacing linens," commented Spencer Hospital President Bill Bumgarner.

All hospital services were open on Tuesday with the exception of the surgical center, which was the location of the fire.

Bumgarner explained the surgery center will reopen once a deep-cleaning process is completed and approval is received from the state fire marshal's office and the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals, which oversees healthcare facilities in the state. He said representatives of both offices have been responsive and understanding of the importance of offering access to surgical services in the region.

Procedures scheduled for Tuesday were cancelled and the surgery center will also be closed for scheduled procedures on Wednesday. Bumgarner said the hospital will be ready to reopen the surgery center once state officials approve, with an anticipated time frame of later this week.

Shortly after 5:00pm, Monday, a hospital staff member in the surgical equipment sterilization area smelled smoke and noticed sparks escaping from one of the washer units. Immediately a fire alarm was pulled and the sparks were extinguished by the sprinkler system. The Spencer Fire Department quickly responded and assisted in clearing the smoke-filled room. Due to the spread of smoke in other areas of the hospital, 16 patients were transferred to neighboring facilities.

"We're grateful for the assistance of so many people, especially the local fire department, area ambulance services, law enforcement and neighboring hospitals Palo Alto County Health System, Lakes Regional Healthcare and Avera McKennan Hospital in Sioux Falls," Bumgarner said. "Of course, the Spencer Hospital team has responded to meet this challenge as it always does."

Bitter Cold Can Be Dangerous; Red Cross Offers Winter Safety Tips

- Frigid air has hit Iowa and is expected to get even colder later this week. To stay safe, the American Red Cross has steps people can take during this hazardous weather.
- "Forecasters predict this will be Iowa's coldest snap in more than 20 years. The extreme cold can be life-threatening as temperatures could dip between -10 and -30 degrees," said Leslie Schaffer, Executive Director of the Iowa Red Cross Region. "We at the Red Cross want to make sure everyone knows how to prepare and safely ride out these winter conditions."
- Here are ten ways to stay safe during this latest round of cold temperatures:
1. Wear layers of lightweight clothing to stay warm. Gloves and a hat will help prevent losing body heat.
 2. Know the signs of hypothermia - confusion, dizziness, exhaustion and severe shivering. If someone has these symptoms, they should get immediate medical attention.
 3. Watch for symptoms of frostbite including numbness, flushed gray, white, blue or yellow skin discoloration, numbness or waxy feeling skin.
 4. Bring the pets indoors. If that's not possible, make sure they have enough shelter to keep them warm and that they can get to unfrozen water.
 5. Avoid frozen pipes - run water, even at a trickle, to help prevent them from freezing. Keep the thermostat at the same temperature day and night to help avoid freezing pipes.
 6. Do not use a stove or oven to heat the home.
 7. Space heaters should sit on a level, hard surface and anything flammable should be kept at least three feet away.
 8. If using a fireplace, use a glass or metal fire screen large enough to catch sparks and rolling logs.
 9. Turn off space heaters and make sure fireplace embers are out before leaving the room or going to bed.
 10. Learn how to treat cold weather related emergencies by downloading the free Red Cross First Aid App at redcross.org/apps. More information about winter safety is available on redcross.org.
