SHERIFF'S REPORT

In the month of January, the Orleans County Sheriff's Department 911 Dispatch Center processed 1967 police incidents, including 747 events for Sheriff's Road Patrol, 172 for the New York State Police and 1048 calls for the Village police agencies of Lyndonville, Medina, Albion, and Holley. There were 626 Fire/EMS related calls dispatched countywide with 427 of those emergency medical in nature and a total of 6 drug overdoses.

Sheriff's Dept. Road Patrol Deputies handled 61 automobile accidents, including 13 with injury and 22 car-deer collisions. Road patrol, also made 60 service attempts and successfully served 22 subpoenas, civil, or court papers. wThe Orleans County Jail processed in 91 inmates and handled 48 prisoner transports to court appearances, etc.

The Sheriff's Animal Control Division handled 64 incidents including 26 stray dogs, 2 dog bite complaints, 6 neighbor dog problems, and several other miscellaneous animal calls. In addition, 5 animals were taken in to shelter on voluntary surrenders.





Wedding Dress Fitting Guide

The average person may be unfamiliar with custom-made or tailored items. In fact, a couples' wedding may be the only instance in their lives when they require the services of a seamstress or tailor. Fittings are a part of wedding planning, and here's how brides-to-be can navigate the process of finding and being fitted for a dress.

- Try on sample gowns. The first step is to make your rounds to various gown shops and try on the samples they have available. Most sample sizes will not be the size you wear every day, so expect them to be ill-fitting. Do not be discouraged. Once a gown is chosen, the dress shop will take your measurements and order the gown according to the manufacturer's sizing guide.
- •Schedule the first fitting. The first fitting should be anywhere from eight to 12 weeks before the wedding date, according to experts at WeddingWire, an online wedding information provider. This is the time it takes to complete most standard alterations. Complex customizations can take even longer. Brides should also budget a minimum of \$500 for alterations, which may or may not be included in the price of the dress.
- Bring shoes and undergarments. Remember to bring along the exact shoes and undergarments you will wear with your gown. A change in shoes or bra/corset can result in the alterations fitting poorly the next time.
- Speak up. Speak up at fittings if anything is uncomfortable or needs tweaking. Seamstresses are masters at their crafts, but only if they understand the desires of the bride.
- Check the details. The second fitting is designed to check that all issues from the first fitting have been addressed, the gown is comfortable and you can move freely. At the last fitting, ask the maid of honor to come along so that she understands how to bustle or help you handle complicated straps or closures.

Open communication with a seamstress and bridal shop can ensure brides-to-be get a dress that fits like a glove.



Making a Family Move Easier

Whether or not to relocate can be a difficult decision. Sometimes such decisions are borne out of necessity when a parent is relocated by his or her company. 

SINGLE-MINDED DETERMINATION

Unlike married people, unmarried partners cannot make medical and financial decisions for one another without signed authorization. Thus, it's very important that singles select someone they want to act for them and sign legal documents that give him or her "power of attorney." To ensure that singles will get the medical care they want, a health-care declaration or living will should be set up and a health-care proxy or agent named. A durable power of attorney for health care is also advised. The health-care directive should lay out the person's wishes if he or she is too ill to make decisions. The agent appointed the durable power of attorney for health care will see that the wishes are carried out.

If a person does become physically or mentally incapacitated and he or she has not made a valid power of attorney, it is often necessary to apply to the courts to have a guardian appointed to manage his or her affairs. 

THE OTHER ANIMAL IN OUR WATERWAYS (PART II)

Last week while writing on otters I realized there are just too many interesting things about this "clown" of the waterways to fit in one column so here "is the rest of the story."

A clown he often is, acting like he doesn't have a care in the world. Most of this clowning around consists of wrestling with

other otters, sliding down slopes or in the snow, chasing each other and play fighting. Most of this activity is done by immature animals, but adult will also engage in these things also. In fact sliding in the snow is often a means of travel. Their fur is very dense and short plus their bodies and limbs are very streamlined making them for an idea toboggan in the snow. When there is not enough slope to propel them they will use their hind feet to push them along; sometimes for great distances. This of course is more efficient than running and is an important energy conservative in the winter. Once I was holding a dead otter and it slipped from my arms and upon hitting the gentle snow-covered incline it started sliding away from me and I ended up having to chase him as he "slid" away!

In the water they use all four limbs (the feet are webbed enabling them to give very powerful strokes) and that big tail gives them stability while swimming and short bursts of rapid propulsion. On land they can slide not only on snow, but also grassy or muddy inclines. When running they bound along with a loping type movement.

Prey is captured with a quick lunge from ambush or after a sustained chase. Because he is well adapted to hunting in water, he eats aquatic and semi-aquatic animals. Fish of course are the main menu but he will take advantage of any prey when readily obtainable. Turtles, crayfish and even muskrats become a meal.

Otters are a social type animal with adult females often having their offspring with them which includes young of the year and maybe her yearlings. These groups hunt and travel together, use the same dens, resting sites, and latrines and perform social grooming. Even adult males will form bachelor groups and hang together. From mid-winter through the breeding season, adult females move and den alone.

River otters typically breed from December to April, but usually not until they are two years old. In early spring, expectant mothers begin to look for a den where they can give birth. The female otters do not dig their own dens; instead, they rely on other animals to provide suitable environments to raise their offspring. When the mothers have established their domains, they give birth to several kits. Litter size can reach five, but usually ranges from one to three. At birth they are fully furred, blind, and toothless. They start playing at 5-6 weeks, and begin consuming solid food at 9-10 weeks with weaning occurring around 12 weeks. The mothers raise their young without aid from adult males. When the pups are about two months old and their coats grow in, their mother introduces them to the water. They may leave the den by eight weeks and are capable of sustaining themselves upon the arrival of fall, but they usually stay with their families.

As far as noises they make a snarling growl or hissing bark when bothered and a shrill whistle when in pain. When at play or traveling, they sometimes give off low, purring grunts. The alarm call, given when shocked or distressed by potential danger, is an explosive snort, made by expelling air through the nostrils. They also may use a birdlike chirp, but the most common sound heard among a group of otters is low-frequency chuckling.

Otters will live in a den, constructed in the burrows of other animals, or in natural hollows, such as under a log or in river banks. An entrance, which may be under water or above ground, leads to a nest chamber lined with leaves, grass, moss, bark, and hair. Den sites include burrows dug by woodchucks, foxes and the use of beaver and muskrat houses is common. They also may use hollow trees or logs, undercut banks, rock formations and flood piled debris. The use of den and resting sites is chiefly opportunistic.

Although there is no trapping season in our area now they may be a limited season in the future as their numbers increase. As with all wildlife, because we have altered the environment, they need to be controlled to a certain extent to keep nature in balance.
