

- Won the most Section V titles in school history with a total of 9 individual titles and 5 more as a member of relay teams in track & field.
- Section V Class D champion in the 200m 4 straight years, 100m 3 times, long jump 2 straight years, and as a member of our 400m relay team 4 straight years.
- Helped lead our track & field team to 2 division titles and 4 consecutive Section V titles.
- Ranks 5th in school history in the triple jump.

*Inducted January 11, 2019*

On January 11, 2019, the Annual Hall of Fame Ceremony was held at Mount Morris Central School Gymnasium in between the girls varsity and the boys varsity basketball games. While the ceremony took place in 2019, it was actually honoring 2018 Inductees.

Here is Roberta Alessandra Finn, a graduate from the Class of 2002. Roberta was a 3-sport athlete in soccer, cheerleading and track & field. In the fall of 2000, she led our soccer team in goals and was one of the leading scorers in Livingston County Division 3. In cheerleading she was an LCAA All-Star and was also selected to the Ronald McDonald All-Star team in 2002.

In the spring, this inductee was one of the most dominant runners in Section V and is one of the best track & field performers in school history. No one in our school history has won more Section V titles in any sport than this inductee. All told, she won a total of 9 individual Section V titles in track & field and was a member of 5 relay teams that won Section V titles. She was the Section V Class D champion in the 200m for 4 straight years, the 100m 3 times, the long jump 2 straight years, and as a member of our 400m relay team 4 straight years. In 2000, she was the anchor of our 4x100m relay team that not only won the Section V title, they set the Section V Class D record for this event with a time of 51.1 seconds. This relay team still holds the Section V Class D girls record today. Her talents and hard work helped lead our track & field team to 2 consecutive division titles and 4 consecutive Section V titles. No other teams in Blue Devil history have won 4 consecutive Section V titles. She set many school records and still holds 3 school individual records and is also part of 2 relay teams that still hold school records in track & field. She also currently still ranks 5th in school history in the triple jump. After high school she served our country in the United States Air Force for 6 ½ years and was presented with a Combat Action medal.

The Mount Morris Athletic Hall of Fame was created in 2006 with the hope of accomplishing the following goals:

1. Recognize and celebrate the accomplishments of outstanding athletes, coaches, administrators, and anyone who made a significant contribution to Blue Devils Athletics program.
2. Reconnect or maintain a relationship with inductees, alumni, and their families with Mount Morris Central School.
3. Enhance the understanding and appreciation of the history of Blue Devils Athletics.
4. Provide role models for current students, coaches, and others to look up to.

In December 2007, when the very first induction ceremony was held, ten individuals were inducted into the MMCS Hall of Fame in a ceremony between a JV and Varsity basketball game in the gymnasium. This hugely successful event not only brought people back together who had not seen each other in a very long time but allowed others to meet and become friends for the very first time. The tradition continues today.
