- 2011 soccer co-captain, team MVP, Section V Exceptional Senior All-Star game Offensive Player of the Game, and made the Section V All-Tournament team.
- Point guard and co-captain who helped lead the 2010-11 basketball team to a 17-4 record, the #1 seed in Class D2, a trip to the Section V finals, and was named to the Section V All-Tournament team.
- 2011-12 basketball co-captain and Exceptional Senior who scored 15 ppg including a 35 point game and had 15 assists in another game.
- 2012 baseball LCAA Division 3 All-Star, Exceptional Senior, and team MVP. Led the team in hits, runs, stolen bases, and batting average at .455.

Inducted January 11, 2019

On January 11, 2019, the Annual Hall of Fame Ceremony was held at Mount Morris Central School Gymnasium in between the girls varsity and the boys varsity basketball games. While the ceremony took place in 2019, it was actually honoring 2018 Inductees.

Here is Bradley Ferraro, a 2012 graduate who was a multi-talented 3-sport athlete in soccer, basketball and baseball.

On the soccer field he was a 2-time LCAA All-Star as a left wing. As a co-captain in his senior year, he scored 20 goals which was 2nd highest in Livingston County and a school record at that time. He scored four goals in a single game three times,

including once in a sectional game. Four goals in a sectional game is a school record for most goals in one sectional game. This performance led him to be named to the Section V All-Tournament team. He was also named the team's MVP, and was selected to play in the Section V All-Star game. Not only did he play in this game, he was named the Offensive Player of the Game. He is likely the only person in school history to have accomplished this.

On the basketball court he was amongst the league leaders in points, assists, and steals in both his junior and senior years. As our point guard and co-captain, he helped lead our 2010-11 basketball team to a 17-4 record, the #1 seed in Class D2, and a trip to the Section V finals. His talents and leadership led him to being named to the Section V All-Tournament team, and also to the Livingston County Super 18 team. In the 2011-12 basketball season, he was again a co-captain who scored 15 points per game including a 35 point game and had 15 assists in another game. He received several accolades including being named an LCAA Exceptional Senior. He culminated his high school career on the baseball field where he was also an LCAA Division 3 All-Star, was named an Exceptional Senior, and was named the team's MVP. During this season, he led the team in hits, runs, stolen bases, and batting average at .455. He also went on to play basketball at Alfred State.

The Mount Morris Athletic Hall of Fame was created in 2006 with the hope of accomplishing the following goals:

1. Recognize and celebrate the accomplishments of outstanding athletes, coaches, administrators, and anyone who made a significant contribution to Blue Devils Athletics program.
2. Reconnect or maintain a relationship with inductees, alumni, and their families with Mount Morris Central School.
3. Enhance the understanding and appreciation of the history of Blue Devils Athletics.
4. Provide role models for current students, coaches, and others to look up to.

In December 2007, when the very first induction ceremony was held, ten individuals were inducted into the MMCS Hall of Fame in a ceremony between a JV and Varsity basketball game in the gymnasium. This hugely successful event not only brought people back together who had not seen each other in a very long time but allowed others to meet and become friends for the very first time. The tradition continues today.
