STRANGE BUT BEAUTIFUL

I got an email from one of my readers last week in the Lyndonville area. They have been on my list of folks I email my nature photos to for a number of years so know my addiction to nature photography. She said they had a strange looking female cardinal coming to her feeder that had a white neck and head and wanted to know if I was interesting in photographing it. Gosh, yes!



White Head

Well there were three trips made to Beckie's home before this marvelous creature made it's appearance. Because of other commitments it

wasn't possible to watch for this bird at the times I would have like too and of course catching nature on camera can sometimes be difficult. One thing that is needed in this kind of endeavor is patience and I have a lot of that!

So on the third morning I was hiding in my "blind" for only a half hour when "White Head" showed up and like Beckie said, "You can't miss her!" Boy, what a beautiful bird and so unique. She was only there for about 10 minutes as I clicked away on the camera trying to catch her in flattering poses and then just disappeared. I remained, hoping she would return.

In the mean time, I entertained myself photographing the some 20 other cardinals coming to the feeders along with blue jays, chickadees, finches, a white-crowned sparrow, downy and red-bellied woodpeckers, some juncos and titmouses. Along with the birds was a red squirrel that was dominating the spilled sunflowers on the ground. When a gray squirrel came in and tried to join in, the red chased him right out of the area. A few times the gray sneaked up through the tree to the "squirrel proof" bird feeder and showed me how he "unproofed" it before red saw him and drove him away again.

As a side note: red squirrels are not disable creatures to have around your feeder or house or outbuildings. They are very aggressive to other creatures and have a great reputation for getting in houses and outbuildings to do serious damage. They are also very smart and hard to get rid of. Like rats, they are not a protected animal for a reason.

Then about an hour after her first appearance White Head showed up again and my excitement was again at it's peak. Another short visit and she was gone again. This time I called it quits and headed home reflecting back on how lucky I was to have photographed and experience this beautiful creature.

White Head is a regular female red cardinal who lacks color pigment in her neck and head feathers. The condition is rare of course and is called leucism or commonly, partial-albino. Coloration comes from different types of melanin pigments and if one of these types is not present in certain feathers then the feathers will be white. In the case of a true albino there is no melanin present and all feathers or hairs are white and the eyes are pink.

In my lifetime I have been fortunate enough to see various albino and leucistic creatures. I once was able to closely examine an albino 6-point buck I mounted for a hunter. I saw an albino mink one time while canoing and one of my past neighbors

had a baby albino robin in a nest.

Leucistic creatures have crossed my path more frequently, but are still very rare. Cornell's "Feeder Watch" project reported around 5.5 million birds each year from 2000 to 2006 and only 1,000 were leucistic. An example of this condition is the white deer at the Seneca Army Depot area that have been allowed to develop under controlled conditions. The "piebald" white-tailed deer, with various patches of white and brown, are also an example.

A few years back I had a litter of gray squirrels in a wood duck nesting box that were almost all white and have seen Canada geese with white heads and necks instead of the normal black. Back in the "pheasant days" I saw a hen that was a light, fainted brown over all color. A few years ago there was a partially white slatecolored junco at my feeder at camp. Back in 2008 there was the "Medina Ghost" who was a house sparrow that was almost all white. Then there was the part white male cardinal "Flash" in Lima, NY.

These unique creatures are something special to see and if you see something unique in nature like this give me a call, I would love a chance to photograph these rarities of nature. My contact information is 585-798-4022 or woodduck2020yahoo. com.







The Choice for Staying Put or Moving On

Many home improvement television series showcase people deciding whether to improve upon their current homes to make them into the houses of their dreams or to put "for sale" signs in their lawns and move on to something new.

The question of whether to move or stay put depends on various factors. Such factors may include emotional attachment to a home, the current economic climate and the cost of real estate. Current data points to a greater propensity for people to invest and improve upon their current properties rather than trading up for something new.

Makes 8. Serves 4.



1 3/4 cups smooth mashed potatoes (1 very large cooked potato or 2 medium)
3/4 cup self-rising flour
1/4 teaspoon powdered mustard
1/2 teaspoon sea salt
Several grinds of black pepper
1 tablespoon snipped chives or 2 tablespoons chopped parsley
1 extra-large egg, beaten
Butter for frying

Mix the mashed potatoes with the flour, mustard, salt,

pepper, and herbs. Do this with a wooden spoon, not a food processor (otherwise, you'll get a gluey mess).

Work in the beaten egg to make a firm dough. If it is very soft and sticky, work in a little more flour.

Turn out the dough onto a floured work surface, flour your hands, then knead the dough once or twice to make a smooth ball. Divide the dough into 8 equal portions and shape each one into a small cake, about 21/2 inches across.

When ready to cook, heat a little butter in a large heavy skillet, preferably nonstick, and cook the breads over medium heat for about 7 minutes on each side, until they turn good golden brown and are slightly puffed. Serve immediately.
