Community Blood Drive April 1

Blood donation is an important gift that helps nearly everyone at some point in their lives. Up to 90 percent of us will need blood at some point, and thanks to people across the country who donate their blood, those with cancer, those in automobile accidents, those undergoing heart surgery, and more are able to get the care needed.

Lakes Regional Healthcare is partnering with their blood supplier, LifeServe, to host a blood drive on Monday, April 1 from 10:00 am until 1:30 pm in the Big Spirit Conference Room in the hospital's lower level (enter the hospital's east entrance). Donating blood is safe, easy, and takes about an hour. Donors must weigh at least 120 pounds, be at least 16 years old (16 and 17-year-old donors must have a signed parental/guardian permission form), and be in general good health. There is no upper age limit for blood donations. Donors must bring a photo ID and should eat a good meal and drink plenty of fluids before giving blood.

Gerald Devore Cummins was born at Wolsey, South Dakota, on February 9, 1930. He attended public schools at Kimball, South Dakota, participating and excelling in several sports, especially basketball, graduating in 1948.

Gerald pursued a career he loved in education, studying at Northern State Teachers College in Aberdeen, South Dakota, and Wayne State College at Wayne, Nebraska. His first day as a teacher was in a one room school in Brule County, South Dakota. He later earned a bachelor's degree in Education from Dakota Wesleyan University at Mitchell, South Dakota, in 1956, and a master's degree in School Administration from the University of South Dakota at Vermillion, South Dakota, in 1959.

In 1951, he was drafted into the military service during the Korean Conflict. Following basic training at Ft. Leonard Wood, Missouri, he was assigned to the 508 Regimental Combat Team as an airborne paratrooper from Ft. Benning, Georgia.

Gerald Cummins and Grace Dey were united in marriage at St. Margaret's Catholic Church in Kimball, South Dakota, in 1956. The Cummins were blessed with three children, two sons Greg and Wayne Skip and a daughter they named Judith.

While serving in education as a coach and teacher, the family made their home in South Dakota, living at White River and Delmont. They later moved to Sanborn, Iowa, where he served 30 years as the Sanborn Public School Administrator. During that time, he was instrumental in the reorganization of the Hartley-Melvin-Sanborn School District.

Involved in community life, he served on the original board of directors during the development efforts and construction of the Sanborn Golf Course and Country Club. He was known as "Mr. C" by his students, school personnel, and the local and surrounding community. He was a member of the American Legion, St. Joseph Catholic Church and the Bedell Family YMCA.

Gerald retired in 1995 and he and Grace built their retirement home near one of his favorite golf courses, Emerald Hills, in Arnolds Park. Later in ill health, he was admitted to St. Luke Lutheran Home in Spencer, Iowa.

Gerald's family includes his wife of 62 years, Grace; son Skip of Las Vegas; daughter Judi (Mike) Luhrs of Okoboji and only grandchild, Michael Luhrs of Okoboji and Ames, Iowa.

Wills and Jones Vote to Extend School Infrastructure Tax (SAVE)

Representatives John Wills (R-Spirit Lake) and Megan Jones (R-Sioux Rapids) voted for House File 546, which extends the school infrastructure tax, known as SAVE, through 2050.

"This is one of the most important pieces of legislation that we will pass all session," said Wills and Jones. "Not only does this bill provide schools with resources to update aging facilities, improve security, and upgrade classroom technology, it also provides local residents with significant property tax relief. It is a win-win for both schools and taxpayers."

Funds for SAVE come from the statewide sales tax and are distributed among Iowa school districts to make improvements in infrastructure and technology as well as property tax relief. Since the implementation of SAVE in 2008, the number of local bond referendums to finance facility upgrades has dropped significantly.

Additional highlights of House File 546 include:

- School Safety:** Prioritizes school building security before using SAVE funds on athletic facilities
- Career Academies:** Establishes a yearly \$1 million fund to help schools develop and build career academies which provide students with first-hand job experiences that can be translated to a career after graduation
- Property Tax Relief:** The amount of funds devoted to property tax relief increases from \$10 million in FY2019 to \$174 million in FY2050.

An extension of SAVE was identified as a top priority for many education organizations this session including, the Iowa Association of School Boards, School Administrators of Iowa, Area Education Agencies of Iowa, Rural School Advocates of Iowa, and the Urban Education Network of Iowa.

To the Editor:

A recent piece written by a friend of mine brought up excellent questions about climate change and global warming. He asserted that 'global warming' was renamed to 'global climate change' because "when the climate did not heat fast enough ... any change in climate will provide proof we are in imminent danger".

As a science educator, I would like to point out the difference between 'global warming' and 'climate change'. Global warming refers to the long term trend of the earth's increase in average surface temperature (1.9 degree Fahrenheit since late 1800s) while climate change refers to changes in global climate systems as a result of the earth's increased surface temperature. The two terms are related and often used interchangeably, but they refer to two different physical phenomena and use of each term depends on the context. For example, the effects of global warming of the earth's surface is causing the retreat of glaciers worldwide, the loss of ice mass in polar regions, and the warming of oceans. This, in turn, is changing climate systems by introducing more moisture and energy into the atmosphere and magnifying naturally occurring weather events such as drought, hurricanes and precipitation. Locally, data show global warming is changing Iowa climate with more extreme storms and precipitation events.

If nothing is done to reverse carbon emissions, the earth may not be habitable for human life - perhaps within a generation.

However, I am an optimist and a patriotic believer in American ingenuity, entrepreneurship and democracy. From changes in our personal lifestyles to the development of more energy efficient buildings, appliances and technologies; to innovations in renewable energy and the harnessing of market forces to incentivize such changes (check out the Energy Innovation and Carbon Dividend Act recently introduced to Congress) I believe there is a path forward and exciting times ahead.

Remember, only a half century ago few imagined we could put a man on the moon.

Farmland transfer is a critical issue in agriculture today. In Iowa alone, over 65% of farmland is owned by those over 65.

It is also the subject of an original play coming to the Iowa Great Lakes region. Map of My Kingdom: Who is Going to Get the Farm? written by Iowa native and poet laureate Mary Swander. The play will be performed at the Pearson Lakes Art Center at 7:00pm on Thursday, April 11. On the following day, Friday, April 12, Swander will facilitate a farmland transfer workshop and luncheon at Iowa Lakeside Laboratory from 11:00am to 1:00pm. "The play generates lots of thought about this issue, but it isn't necessary to see it to attend the workshop," says Swander.

Both events are free and open to the public, thanks to a major sponsorship by Northwest Bank. ISU Extension will be sponsoring the luncheon workshop. Registration is not required for the play, but those attending the workshop and luncheon should register with ISU Extension before Wednesday, April 3 by contacting Katie Goodell at 712-336-3488. Additional collaborators for the performance and workshop include the Pearson Lakes Art Center, Iowa Lakeside Laboratory, the Friends of Lakeside Lab and the Practical Farmers of Iowa.

The play's sole character, Angela Martin, is a mediator in land disputes who shares stories of farmers and landowners she has worked with over the years, taking on the personality traits of each character as she tells their stories. The Practical Farmers of Iowa commissioned Swander to write a play about farm transfer after observing the widespread difficulty of this moment of transition for farm families. Swander said she hopes the play resonates with those who find themselves working through difficult land transfer and end-of-life issues.

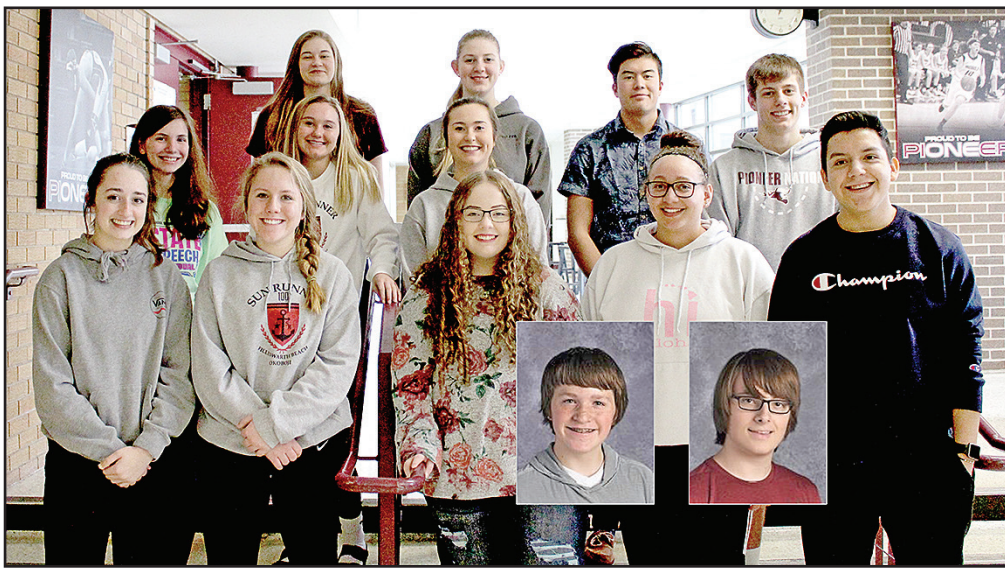

Cyclones Flip the Script

What a difference a week makes for the Iowa State Cyclones (I hope I'm not writing that same line after the NCAA Tournament), just last week I wrote about how they and Iowa (still trending down) were trending in the wrong direction and things didn't look very promising for their post-season run. I've never been so happy to be so wrong as ISU showed all of their doubters wrong by playing selfless basketball, hard-nosed defense, and played harder than they have all season while winning their fourth Big 12 Tournament Championship in the past six seasons.

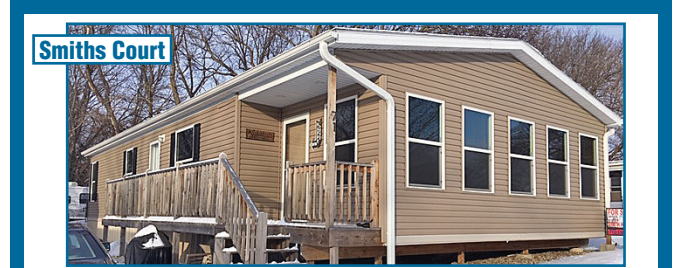
The nice thing for Iowa State was that in every game they had someone different step up and make big plays when they needed them. The Cyclones broke their three-game losing streak on Thursday afternoon with a nice 83-66 win over NCAA #9 seed Baylor, who had swept ISU earlier in the year. This game saw freshman Talen Horton-Tucker lead the way with 21 points while Marial Shayok chipped in with 18. On Friday night ISU drew #1 seed Kansas State (who was playing without one of their best players, Dean Wade). The Cyclones and Wildcats had split earlier this year, both winning on the road, and this was the battle that everyone thought it would be. ISU did jump out to a 10-point halftime lead but K-State quickly erased that deficit early in the second half, and held a five-point lead with just over 2:30 remaining. ISU cut the lead to three and then Marial Shayok stepped up big-time for the Cyclones. Shayok had just missed a three-pointer that was rebounded by teammate Mike Jacobson (16 rebounds) and then got a great pass from Tyrese Haliburton and screen from Nick Weiler-Babb while hitting a clutch three that hit the rim and bounced high before dropping and tying the game at 55. Shayok then hit a tough step-back three-pointer with the shot clock winding down to give ISU a 58-55 lead, and then the 'Clones hit free throws while getting stops down the stretch to win 63-59. On Saturday night ISU and Kansas met for the Big 12 title and this was a game that ISU controlled from start to finish. Iowa State missed a lot of open shots they normally hit, but unlike the regular season, they didn't let their misses affect their defensive effort as they held the Jayhawks to just 21 first half points while taking another 10-point halftime lead. This game that lead would not evaporate, as ISU kept the foot on the gas pedal and built the lead to 17 while never letting Kansas get closer than nine, on their way to a 78-66 victory. ISU again had a well-balanced attack in this game, with Lindell Wigginton leading way with 17 points, Shayok adding 15 and Jacobson chipping in with 14. Besides playing together better than they have since January, the Cyclones also guarded and rebounded at their highest level of the year while holding all three teams well below their season averages and also battling much tougher on the boards.

Now the challenge for Iowa State is how do they handle success, which has been a tough thing for them all season, as every time they would jump up in the rankings or the Big 12 standings they would start to play for the name on the back of the jersey and not the name on the front. Iowa State earned a #6 seed in the NCAA Tournament and will play #11 Ohio State in Tulsa on Friday. Ohio State enters the tournament on a bit of a slide, having lost four of five games, but for several of those games they had leading scorer Kaleb Wesson suspended; Wesson did play in the Big Ten Tournament, averaging 15.5 points in the Buckeyes two games, and will be playing in the NCAA Tournament. If the Cyclones do survive the first-round game, they will probably face #3 seed Houston with a trip to Hilton South in Kansas City and the Sweet 16 on the line. Let's hope the Cyclones from this past weekend and not from this past month show up in Tulsa, if that happens, they've got a very good chance to advance and enjoy March Madness even more, if they revert back to "Team B" as Coach Prohm calls them, they will have an early tournament exit and will wallow in some March Sadness.

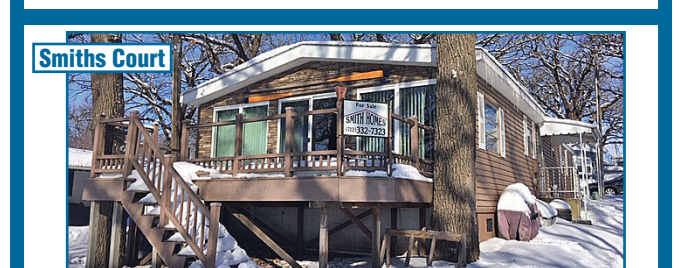

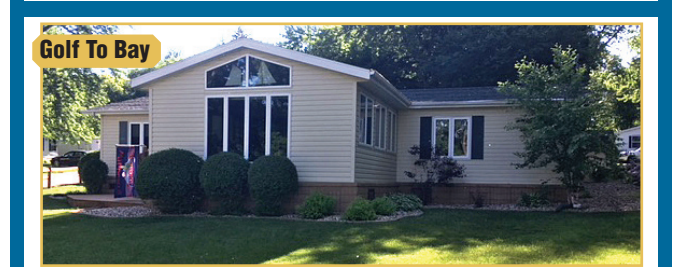

The Iowa Great Lakes is an incredible place to live, visit and enjoy. Much of our economy is tied to these area lakes. They are certainly the shining star for the state of Iowa. With these accolades come responsibility for us to protect these waters, to make sure we do all we can to continue to improve their health and water quality.

That's where our different lake protective associations, the Iowa Lakeside Lab, the Iowa DNR, the NRCS, the Dickinson County Clean Water Alliance and many other groups come in. Their goals are to protect and improve the water quality of our lakes.

Sometimes, difficult decisions come along, such as the Curlyleaf Pondweed issue on the north end of East Okoboji. It is an exotic that showed up in the 1950s, but in recent years has become a major recreational and navigational nuisance by growing to the surface in May and creating a dense mat that pretty much weed locks the north end of East Okoboji and on Lower Gar. It takes until the end of June until it dies off. As a result, a team of leaders from the county, local cities, lake associations, drinking water utilities, Iowa Lakeside Lab and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) have worked together the past two years to devise a plan to help open up navigational lanes and paths to help lake home owners, recreationists and anglers to at least be able to utilize areas of the affected areas.

A combination of mechanical harvesting and an aquatic herbicide was used in 2018 with plans to do this again in 2019. The herbicide is used about five miles from any drinking water intakes and testing showed the herbicide did not travel from the treated area and water tests showed no danger to fish, animals or humans.

There is a concern, however, that individuals will take matters into their own hands and use herbicides around their docks. This is definitely against the law.

Eric Stoll, a member of the committee and the director of the Milford Utilities, which gets its drinking water from West Okoboji, shared his concerns about individuals using herbicides on their own with the following quote published in the Dickinson County News just recently. "We can't tolerate lakeshore residents illegally applying herbicides. Iowa law restricts their use and only the DNR has the authority to treat plants in the lake with a herbicide. Everyone living or vacationing in this area gets their drinking water from our lakes. Not following the law endangers that precious resource."

I totally agree with Stoll. We can't have people dumping chemicals in our waters on a whim or simply because they can. There are lots of dangers in doing this. If we really think we need to remove weeds from around or behind our docks, there are professionals who can do this. One of them is Underwater Solutions, which is staffed with experienced divers that can provide aquatic weed removal by hand pulling the roots or cutting them with their mechanical harvester.

This is way bigger than just an individual. We need to all work together in a positive way to protect the waters of the Iowa Great Lakes. Let's do more than just say "I agree" and then drop the ball. Let's be proactive. I encourage you to become a member of one of our protective organizations. Strength in numbers can make a real difference.

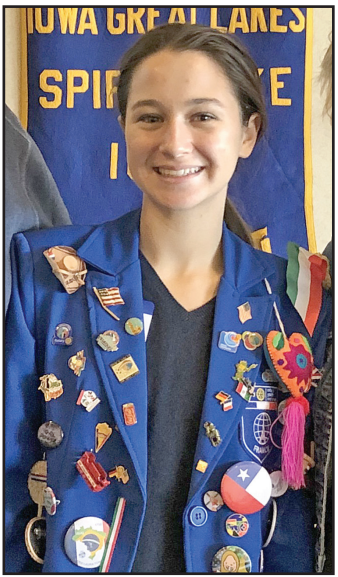

OHS JB does it again

When research director RD properly noted in her space here last week that Sunday would mark the centennial of Nat 'King' Cole's birth, we had hoped to include a photograph of Nat's brother Freddy in performance and later, at the Pearson Lakes Art Center. Freddy is the sole survivor of the four very musical Coles brothers. We ran out of time trying to find the digital images on deadline, as we lacked a date Freddy posed with the Frederick Brown acrylic of his brother.

Then, late last week, while thinning out some old tax files, we literally stumbled on a ticket stub from Friday, June 9, 2006, which was either Freddy's first of two, or second of three stops in Okoboji. Within minutes we found the backup files — but several days past deadline.

There are no easily available records at the PLAC. And none of Freddy's agents ever kept historical track of his appearances. Freddy's booking agent Suzi Reynolds, and his grandson Tracy Cole, both told us the record-keeping was a task Freddy's late wife performed, and no one maintained the list after Margaret's passing several years ago.

Today, Freddy travels in a world well beyond Okoboji, with performances in New York, Toronto, Palm Beach, and Portland (Oregon) last month; Beijing, Melbourne and San Francisco this month (after Sunday's centennial celebration in Montgomery, Alabama where Nat was born); and Boston, Belgravia (near Buckingham Palace), and London, in April. That's a lot of travel even for someone half of Freddy's 88 years. In addition to the miles, Freddy garnered a 2018 Grammy nod — his fourth! — for his CD, *My Mood Is You*, a great album!

It's kudos all around this week for the Okoboji High School Jazz Band. Not only did the aggregation take the top spot competing with 11 other bands in Class 2A at the USD Coyote Festival, but eight members, Lexi Duffy, Martha Stein, Samuel Heikens, William Alexander, John Alexander, Rikka Heimdal, Olin Myhre, and Carley Wells all received recognition as soloists.

Three of the above, Carley Wells, Samuel Heikens, and William Alexander, were also selected to the IA/2A Iowa High School All-State Jazz Band. As band director Ryan Middle noted, "This is a HUGE accomplishment!" The aggregation's final competitive appearance will be at the Iowa Jazz Championships, in Ames, on April 2nd.

Arnolds Park has now announced its August lineup for the Live at the Lake Saturday night shenanigans, including Samantha Fish (August 3rd), Filmore (17th), Hitchville (24th) and the Arch Allies tribute band (31st). August 10th is once again "TBA"...

Storm Rising is to be at the Little Swan Lake Winery, Sunday, from 4-6:00...

The Itty Bitty Boji Band, Jessie James Band, and Terry Klein will be playing for a fund raiser for Tandy Snodgrass, Saturday night, at Table 316 in Arnolds Park. Tandy is the daughter of Marilyn Wiltgen of Spirit Lake, and will soon be undergoing surgery for a double lung transplant. In addition to a special pulled pork meal before the dance, there will also be a silent auction. Funds raised will help to defray the many costs not covered by insurance...

A final advance reminder is also in order for the March 31st performance featuring John Moore and The Alexander Piano Trio at 4:30, in the St. Joseph Catholic Church in Milford.

Research director RD says the Rodgers and Hammerstein song *It Might As Well Be Spring*, should be the song of the day for the first day of Spring — especially since we should have sunshine and the warmest temperatures of the year — thus far at least.

The song is from the 1945 movie *State Fair*, which was reproduced in 1962, starring Pat Boone and Ann-Margret. It is the only R&H effort to be produced as a film before becoming a Broadway show — which didn't happen until 1969!

Curtis Stigers' *Crazy Moon* is also appropriate for the day, as the full moon begins Tuesday night and continues through the early morning hours on Wednesday. Stigers released the effort on his 2003 album, *You Inspire Me...*

And, Wednesday should also be a Day of Happiness, perhaps best noted by Peggy Lee and husband Dave Barbour, who recorded the song in 1946 — nearly 60 years ahead of Australia's very-own Nikki Parrot...

Thursday is Common Courtesy Day, calling for *What The World Needs Now*, a selection written by Burt Bacharach and Hal David about half a century ago. Jackie DeShannon's hit version was recorded March 23, 1965. Four years later Sergio Mendes and Brasil 66 gave the song a Latin flavor on their album *Ye-Me-Le*. More recently the song has been heard on the soundtracks for the motion pictures *Happy Gilmore*, *Forrest Gump*, and *Austin Powers: International Man of Mystery...*

Thursday is also French Bread Day, calling for a song from the 1964 French musical romantic drama, *The Umbrellas of Cherbourg*, *I Will Wait For You*, the main theme from the movie, was composed by Michel Legrand and Jacques Demy, with English lyrics by Norman Gimbel. Legrand's *Chanson d'amour* has been made popular by a wide variety of artists such as Astrud Gilberto, *The King Sisters*, Tony Bennett, and Oscar Peterson on the studio album, *Exclusively For My Friends: Lost Tapes*, that was recorded in 1967 and 1968, but not released until 1995...

Forrest Mars, Sr. was born on March 21st, 1904, the son of candy company founder Frank C. Mars. In 1940, in partnership with Bruce Murrie (whose father was making Hershey's bars), Forrest Mars produced m&M's. And in 1954, he created peanut m&M's — even though he had been allergic to peanuts all of his life! In 2004, when the company added new colors for m&M's, their ads featured the 1967 Petula Clark hit, *Color My World...*


George Benson turns 76 on Friday. The Pittsburgh-born jazz guitarist, singer, and songwriter's well-received 1964 debut studio album, *The New Boss Guitar of George Benson*, was set for success from the beginning. It was released on the Prestige label, with backing by 'Brother' Jack McDuff's quartet and a track listing that included jazz standards like *Will You Still Be Mine*, written by Matt Dennis and Tom Adair, and *Easy Living*, by Leo Robin and Ralph Rainger...

Joseph Barbera, the Manhattan-born animator, director, producer, and cartoon artist, was born on March 24, 1911. In a bit of a twist, here, RD is conducting a pop quiz...

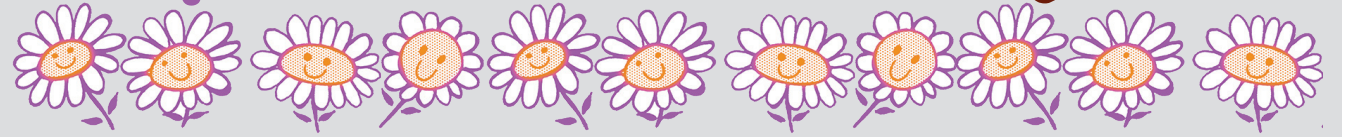

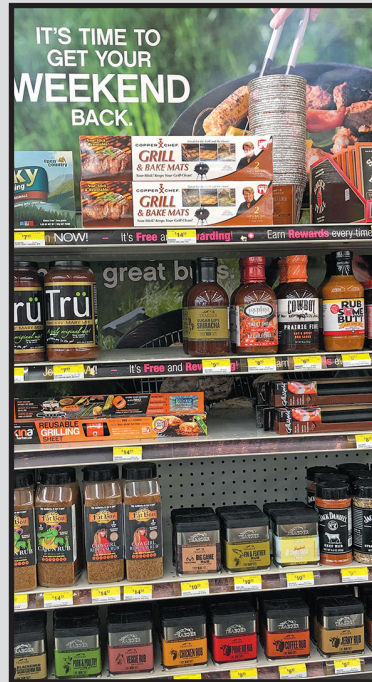

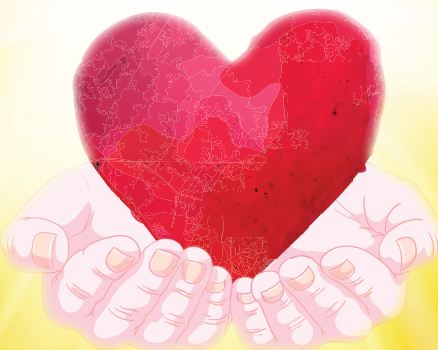
