effective in December of 2019 according to a release from the city.

"Richard has been an outstanding Department leader. He made Florence a model for other cities as a leader who embraces technology and efficiency," said Mayor **Steve Holt**. "We appreciate his service to Florence and Lauderdale County and wish him God's blessings as he moves forward."

Morrissey began his career at the Florence Electricity Department in 1973 as an 18-year-old coop student from Auburn University. Morrissey earned his Electrical Engineering degree in 1977 and was then hired by the Electricity Department Manager, Howard McClanahan, as a full-time engineer. He achieved his Professional Engineering status in 1981.

Morrissey recalled, "In 1973, the dispatch center consisted of a 150-squarefoot room with one desk, a green pegboard covered with orange electrical tape representing high voltage lines, and white buttons to indicate the power switches. There were no roads shown on the maps. This was before 911 addresses were established and very few county roads were numbered. It is hard to imagine how we managed to dispatch crews to outages in a storm without mapping technology.'

levels are designated for conservation of waterfowl habitat.

The win makes Denney the only four-time contest winner, having previously won the 2016-17, 2012-13, and 2008-09 contests. Denney estimates the acrylic painting took him 25-30 hours over the course of a month to complete.

The year 2020-21 will be the last time Alabama produces a physical waterfowl stamp. "Since the state implemented a lifetime waterfowl stamp and added a waterfowl stamp privilege section to the regular hunting license, demands for a physical stamp have declined significantly," said **Seth Maddox**, Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries Migratory Game Bird Coordinator. Waterfowl hunters will still be required to have either an annual or lifetime state waterfowl hunting privilege designated on their license.

Nine artists entered the contest this year. **Bill Stem** of Huntsville was first runner-up with a pair of Blue-winged Teal. Tied for second runnerup were Barbara Keel **Lunsford** of Auburn (Mallards), and Eddie LeRoy of Eufaula (Bluewinged Teal).

Shoals Gets New Contract

FLORENCE-The Lauderdale County Commission recently approved a new contract with Shoals Ambulance to provide exclusive non-emergency and emergency 911 ambulance services. The Florence City Council approved the city's renewal on March 5.

Shoals Ambulance has responded to 9-1-1 calls in Lauderdale County and the city of Florence since 2013. The new agreement includes upgrades to equipment and continued investment in first responder partners and community events.

Shoals Ambulance will add new automated chest compression devices to every ambulance under the new contract. This is more than a \$100,000 investment. The automated compression devices ensure

Medicare Minute

"Mail, Calls and Door Knocking 2"

Last week we began discussing ways that agents and companies market Medicare plans to people turning 65. We discussed the phone calls you may receive and the possibility of someone showing up unannounced at your door. This week we will look at online marketing and direct mail.

Direct mail - This is the most common way companies market their plans. When you are within 6 months of turning 65 a company will purchase a mailing list with your name and address on it. Most companies will start sending mail 6 months prior to the month you turn 65. This is because you are eligible to purchase a Medicare supplement any time during that 6 month period. In most cases direct mail is designed to initiate a response on your part. That response is to call a toll free number. You may be calling to get information but usually are connected to a sales person. If you do respond to direct mail, our advice is to never give the agent on the line your social security number until you are ready to buy. This should protect you against unknowingly signing up for a plan.

Online marketing - Occasionally we will have someone stop by our office that has gone online to research Medicare plans. Most online marketing companies will ask you to provide your phone number and/or email address to get pricing information. Once you enter this information you will immediately begin getting phone calls. This is because when you hit "send" that information goes out to 10 or more agents who have bought that lead. All the agents will begin reaching out to you within minutes.

Phone calls, direct mail, door knocking and online marketing are perfectly legal and compliant under Medicare guidelines for some plans but not others. If you have any questions concerning any of these you can contact our office for more information.

increase in the tax to repair Alabama. This allowed local citizens time to share their opinion prior to their representatives leaving for Montgomery. Governor Ivey did not call for a vote on March 5! The vote was taken Tuesday, March 12 and the increase was approved. That increase will not take effect until October 1, 2019. Citizens have time to budget the increase. The increase at that date, will be 6¢, with additional 2¢ increases in 2020 and 2021, bringing the total tax to 28¢/gallon.

The Florence sales tax: The vote to increase the sales tax from 8.5% to 9.5% was approved by the Florence City Council at their January 15, 2019 meeting. The effective date of the increase was March 1. At the January 15 meeting Mayor Holt showed a video that described the needs for the increase. This was the first time citizens were aware of the video. The proper action by the Council should have been to delay their vote until the next Council meeting on February 5. Several citizens, who learned of the resolution to increase sales tax on the City's web site, asked the Council to delay their vote to give citizens more time to provide input. Those requests were



ignored. More information would have been provided on citizens comments at the meeting from Jan. 15, however the Council has not posted any minutes from ANY meetings since September 18, 2018! Council President Jordan stated that the reason for approving the sales tax with an effective date of March 1 was due to the pay increase, for police and firemen, beginning April
1. Jordan also stated, "to do that, a month's worth of the funding from the tax increase needs to be in

place." I disagree.
Using city estimates,
\$102,312 is the monthly amount needed for the pay increases. Certainly, the city could adjust their budget for a month or two in order to allow for citizens' input and have funds for the pay increases. Use reserves! The council, with support from the mayor, chose not to do this. The increase in the sales tax, again using city's estimates, will generate yearly revenue of \$10,546,860 with \$527,340 going to Board of Education. Therefore, \$10,019,520 will be available yearly for the city's needs, \$834,960/ monthly. In five years the increase will provide \$50,097,600 for needs of the city. This is too, too much. The increase should not be forever!!

It is recommended that the Florence City Council take immediate action to reduce the tax rate to 9.0% for a period that will end on December 31, 2019. Prior to this date the future needs of the City will be reviewed which will determine if the rate remains at 9.0% or returns to the 8.5% rate. The needs and cost must be shared with citizens prior to continuing with the 9.0% rate..

Our governor was aware of the action needed to ask for a tax increase in a proper manner.

Our mayor and our city council were not aware!



following your plan, and we're in the middle of saving up our emergency fund. When do you recommend buying a new car in the process? Do we have to wait until we've finished all the Baby Steps? Alanna

Dear Alanna.

I never advise buying a brand new car, unless you have a net worth of at least \$1 million. At that point, you've got enough assets that you won't get rocked by the ridiculous depreciation that comes with buying a new vehicle.

Now, you don't have to drive a beater until you pay

off your house or anything like that. I advise people to drive the minimum they can in terms of a car until they complete my first three steps. Baby Step 1 is a beginner emergency fund of \$1,000. Baby Step 2 is paying off all debt except for your home. Baby Step 3 is fully funding your emergency fund with three to six months of expenses.

After you've accomplished these first three steps, then you can move up to a nicer car. Notice that I didn't say move up to a new car. I want you to save up cash, and get a really nice used car. That's what the typical millionaire does, and I want you to model your financial behavior after people who are in the position you want to be in some day!



3 Prices For Your Home



CONTESTING A WILL

The most common reasons for contesting a Will are undue influence, lack of mental capacity to make a Will or the improper execution of a Will.

If one of these is proven the Will in question is set aside as if it never existed.

On March 15, 2019, the Alabama Supreme Court decided Jones v. Brewster which gives a checklist for Will contest cases. This is the "go to" case for lawyers who want to file a Will contest.

This case details and explains the applicable Alabama code sections and the procedure for filing a Will contest. One important point is the strict time limit. If the decision to contest a Will is made, there is a very strict time limit, potentially six months.

Undue influence occurs when someone with influence uses that influence to cause a person to make a Will different, if not influenced, than they would have made.

A properly executed Will is one signed in front of two witnesses, who then also sign the Will as witnesses. We don't often see these cases because all lawyers now provide what's known as a self-proving Will. That is a Will, signed by the "testator" in the presence of two witnesses and then notarized. That's not to say that a Will like that couldn't be invalid, but it is likely properly executed.

The mental capacity required to make a Will means that a person has sufficient mind and memory to know what property they are giving in the Will, the people to whom they are giving it, and that they are signing a Will

Will contests are odd and the rules are strict. Some contests are filed one way in some counties and differently in others. This is one of the few types of cases where the loser can end up responsible for the cost to defend the Will.
