



WOW IT'S BEEN A WHRILWIND OF **SPRING ACTIVITY!** By Douglas H. Domedion

Well I started getting excited last week when geese and tundra swans started piling into the area. The camera was point towards the sky most of the time and the swans especially were cooperating. Starting Lots of tundra swans in the area

this spring!

off on the Feeder Road on the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge the swans and geese offered some nice shots with a few sandhill cranes thrown in.

A pair of trumpeter swans were captured in flight and when the images were put in the computer and reviewed, it was discovered that it was the same pair that nested and raised young in the marshes here last year (a first). The male has yellow wing tags on him and some research found out "93" was from Canada and I have spotted in the area for a couple of years.

I have a soft spot in me for these birds not only because they are BIG, pure white and have a neat trumpet type call, but also because I was involved with trumpeters back when they were being taught to fly behind ultra light trike planes to teach them a migration route from here at the John White Game Farm in to Virginia. The project went two years and ended up being a failure not because of the birds, but the folks who were running the show. I had the job of monitoring the birds (they had radio transmitter collars) and handling them many times. It isn't until you handle one of these native North America birds that you realize just how big and beautiful they

The trumpeter is larger than the Arctic tundra swan that migrates through here in the spring and is just a tad bigger then the non-native mute swan. The mute swan is a undesirable bird that is not only very aggressive and nasty, but competes in a negative way with our native waterfowl. The DEC has been trying to eliminate or at least keep them under control for years, but "public opinion" has made this almost impossible and now they can be found on almost all of our larger water areas across the state. They are beautiful, but that is the only good thing about them and the public can not get past that.

Back to the tundra swans. A few days after I began photographing them here in the swamp I get a call from Jim S. and then one from Krys E. telling me that there is huge bunch of them staying on Lake Alice and feeding daily in a field nearby. So a scouting trip was taken to locate a good position to get flight shots of these beautiful white birds; one of my goals with the camera this year. The field they were going in was huge and they were too far out to get any good shots so the next morning I headed up again to try and catch them before they got to the field. Well, a "hot" spot was located right away and that adventure got me way too many great flight shots with a blue sky back ground. Of course I had to give it another "go" the next morning to see if I could improve on what I had learned and got the first day. That happened and I was tickled pink, but then figure maybe I could catch them coming back to the lake in the evening for those "cupped coming in shots."

I got permission to "hide" near a private boat house on the lake to wait their arrival that evening, but the type of lighting I needed was lost and it looked like they were not coming to the lake until much later. Leaving the lakeshore I headed up to watch the "show" going on in the field. There were originally about 500 swans and thousands of geese in that field, but this evening the field was much "whiter" and I figured more swans had moved in. When the spotting scope was put on them some snow geese were seen. Then just as evening rolled in, snow geese began to show up spirally down from high above like a tornado, by the hundreds! Lighting wasn't much good for photographing, but it was quite a show to witness! The roar of their calling and the constant spirally down to the field was awesome. Then something spooked them and everyone except a hundred swans "jumped." What a sight to see and the sound of calling and wings was just awesome. The whole bunch came back down farther out in the field and when I left just about dark the snow geese were still coming in. Snow geese travel in huge flocks and the Finger Lakes is more of their migration route, but every year we are seeing more of them this way. Their populations have skyrocketed and they are causing habitat destruction up in the Arctic tundra country. There is now a spring hunting season for them with allowances for lenient hunting methods and a daily bag limit of 30 a day. However, the areas they travel through on this spring migration is not widespread and they are much more difficult to hunt. When hunters do get an opportunity to shoot at them they educate a lot of them all at once because they travel and feed in such huge flocks. Did You Know?

Oxygen is essential for the roots of grass to breathe and grow strong enough to support healthy lawns. But according to the Center for Agriculture, Food and the Environment at the University of Massachusetts Amherst, compacted soil can produce a decrease in oxygen content that can make it hard for roots to thrive. Soil compaction can result from a number of activities, including walking on grass or driving or parking vehicles on grass. When soil is compacted, it breaks into small particles that reduce the amount of pore space in the soil. That makes it hard for water, oxygen and nutrients to get through, threatening the strength of the roots and putting the grass in jeopardy. Aerating a lawn can help homeowners foster strong root growth and healthy grass. When to aerate may be contingent upon local climate, so homeowners who suspect the soil in their yards is compact should consult with a local landscaping professional to determine the best time to aerate their lawns.

Did You Know?

Lead is a naturally occurring element found in the earth's crust that can be toxic to both humans and animals. Lead can be found in air, soil and water, and human exposure to lead can often be traced to human activities, such as the onetime use of leaded gasolines and previous use of leadbased paints in homes. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency notes that lead also may have been used in ceramics, pipes, plumbing materials, and even some cosmetics. Perhaps the most troubling aspect of lead is its potential effect on children. The still-developing brains and nervous systems of children are more sensitive to the harmful effects of lead because their bodies absorb more of it than the bodies of adults. The U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention notes that the use of lead in house paint, on products marketed to children, including toys, and in dishes or cookware was banned in the United States in 1978. However, lead may still be found on toys imported from countries that have not yet banned lead. In addition, toys and collectibles that were produced prior to the ban in the United States may still contain lead that can be harmful to children and adults. Parents who suspect their children have been exposed to lead can speak with their youngsters' pediatricians, who may order blood tests to check for lead exposure.

Did You Know?

Brief breaks during the work day can dramatically improve one's ability to focus on a task. A 2011 study published in the journal Cognition found that brief mental breaks can improve focus on a prolonged task. The study's authors tested participants' ability to focus on a repetitive computerized task for 50 minutes under various conditions. The control group performed the task without breaks or diversions. The switch group and non-switch group memorized four digits before performing the task and were directed to respond if they saw one of the digits on the screen while performing the task. The switch group was the only group to be ${\scriptstyle \mbox{Responsible & reliable individual}}$ presented with the digits for full-time work available in for MAINTENANCE, days and & plumbing. Grounds twice during the experiment, and both groups were tested on their memory of the digits at the end of the task. Most participants' performance declined considerably over the course of the 50-minute task. However, the performance of those in the switch group did not decline at all, as the two brief breaks to respond to the digits allowed them to maintain their focus throughout the experiment. The researchers behind the study concluded that the switch group's performance was steady because the brain is built to detect and respond to change, and its performance will actually suffer if it must maintain prolonged attention on a single task without taking a break. Professionals with a lot on their plates may see their performance improve by taking frequent mental breaks throughout the workday.



Think Outside the Backyard Barbecue Box

While backyard barbecue menus are often dominated by hot dogs and hamburgers, hosts can expand that menu however they see fit. For example, fried chicken is a natural complement to popular backyard barbecue fare, such as potato salad and fresh watermelon.

Store-bought fried chicken can suffice in a pinch, but hosts who want to go the extra mile and offer a delicious homemade meal can prepare the following recipe for "Kansas City Fried Chicken" courtesy of Neal Corman's "Virgil's Barbecue Road Trip Cookbook" (St. Martin's Press).

Kansas City Fried Chicken

1/2 cup buttermilk 1/2 cup hot sauce 5 1/2 tablespoons Fried Chicken Spice Mix (see below), divided 2 tablespoons kosher salt 2 4-pound whole roaster chickens, cut into 10 pieces each 5 cups all-purpose flour 2 1/2 cups canola oil

1. In a large mixing bowl, thoroughly blend the buttermilk, hot sauce, 2 tablespoons of the Fried Chicken Spice Mix, salt, and 1 cup cold water.

2. Press the chicken pieces into the marinade. Place in a covered

container (ensuring that the chicken is covered with marinade), and refrigerate for 24 hours.

3. Thoroughly combine the flour with 31/2 tablespoons of the Fried Chicken Spice Mix in a medium bowl.

4. In a large and deep pan, or an electric skillet, add enough canola oil to fill the pan one-third full. Heat the oil to 350 F.

5. Set the marinated chicken next to the bowl of flour, close to the skillet. Remove a piece of chicken from the marinade, allow any excess to drain, then dredge in the flour mix. Shake off the excess flour and slide into the skillet.

6. Fry the chicken for 4 to 5 minutes on each side, or until the internal temperature reaches 165 F. Fry the chicken in batches, being careful not to crowd the skillet and to maintain the right temperature.

7. Remove the fried chicken to a sheet pan covered with three or four layers of paper towels. When all the chicken has been fried and dried on the paper towels, allow to cool slightly before serving.

Fried Chicken Spice Mix

Makes 2 cups, plus 2 tablespoons

6 tablespoons kosher salt 5 tablespoons onion powder 3 tablespoons dry mustard 1 tablespoon ground cumin 1 tablespoon poultry seasoning 1 tablespoon dried sage

6 tablespoons sweet paprika 5 tablespoons garlic powder 3 tablespoons cracked black pepper 1 tablespoon dried thyme 1 tablespoon dried oregano 1 tablespoon chili powder

Thoroughly blend all of the ingredients in a medium mixing bowl and transfer to a covered container. Keep in a cool, dry place until needed.

Serves 4 to 6
