New Debit Card Delays

MONTGOMERY – The Alabama Department of Labor is changing service providers for the Unemployment Compensation Debit Cards. Due to technical difficulties with this conversion, the release of the new cards has been delayed until April 10.

For recipients that do not already have a green card, any payments issued March 26 - April 10 will be sent via paper check. All recipients who have chosen the debit card will receive funds on the new tan card for all payments issued on or after April 10.

Recipients who are receiving benefits via direct deposit to a personal bank account will not be affected by this change. The new cards will be tan in color and will replace the existing green cards. Claimants should continue to use their green cards until the balance is zero.

Recipients are strongly encouraged to ensure that the Department of Labor has a valid, current address on file. Any updates should be made by calling 1-800-361-4524 or by visiting <https://labor.alabama.gov/uc/ICCS/default.aspx> and selecting "change personal information."

and Health Professions and Lauderdale County Radiology, will host the annual **Catherine Barnes Women's Health Fair** on April 11 from 9am-2pm at the clinic, located at 309-B Handy Homes in

Florence.

The fair will offer free cervical exams, breast exams, mammograms, and pap smears, for women age 50-64 who do not have health insurance or a primary health care provider, and for women 65 and over who do not have Medicare Part A. This is a part of the clinic's Well Woman Project supported by the Alabama Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program. There are some restrictions. This program is part of a nation-wide initiative launched by the Center for Disease Control (CDC). The program has offered over 9 million cancer screenings and provided follow-up treatment to over 200,000 women, thousands of Alabama women, who would not have had access to this preventative care otherwise. The lives of hundreds of women in Alabama are saved each year through this program.

Experts estimate that about one out of every eight women born today will be diagnosed with

breast cancer at some time during her life. Early detection is a key factor in treating and surviving a possible cancer diagnosis, so it is very important that everyone consult with their health care provider to schedule regular exams.



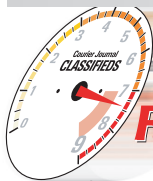

with a .378 average, beating out Babe Ruth for the title. Manush grew up on Third Street in Tuscomb. He died in Sarasota Florida in 1971.

"It's going to be big," said Annie Perry, an organizer of the celebration and member of the Tuscomb Bicentennial Committee. "Heinie Manush is a baseball legend. As I have called around the country to alert the teams he played for and others about Heinie Manush Days, everyone has been excited that we are honoring him. We have people coming from all over to join the celebration."

Manush, who was known as The Hitting Machine, was born in Tuscomb in 1901. He played professional baseball from 1920 to 1939 for the Detroit Tigers, St. Louis Browns, Washington Senators, Boston Red Sox, Brooklyn Dodgers, and Pittsburgh Pirates. Afterward he worked as a manager, scout, and coach. Manush was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame and the Michigan Sports Hall of Fame in 1964 and the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame in 1972.

D'Addona wrote, "Heinie's final career numbers are often overlooked, but he was one of the most dominating hitters of his time. He slapped 200 hits four times, 40 doubles five times, and finished his 2,008-game career with a .330 batting average, 2,524 hits, 491

doubles, 1,288 runs scored and 1,183 runs batted in."

The celebration begins Friday, April 5 with education day at Deshler Middle School. It will feature a general assembly with D'Addona as keynote speaker and a baseball clinic for the students.

Frank Manush will throw the first pitch. Organ grinder Ted Guillaum will entertain during the game. Fans can earn an honorary organ grinder certificate by cranking out a tune on the organ. Concessions will be available. Admission is free. Tailgating before the game is encouraged.

Matters of the Mouth

What is the difference in a deep cleaning and a regular cleaning?

Our teeth are surrounded by "gums" or gingiva. The gingiva is very important as it is the protective, outer covering of the bone that hold our teeth in place. If the gingiva is not healthy, it is very likely that the bone support of our teeth is not healthy.

The place where the gingiva and the teeth meet forms a small pocket. This pocket contains a fluid that helps clean and strengthen our teeth, however, bacteria can become trapped in the pocket. If we are not brushing our teeth regularly or properly, the bacteria are left to grow and multiply.

The body identifies the trapped bacteria as a threat and sends special immune cells to fight the bacteria. These cells flood the area and cause puffy, red gums. When this happens, the gums have gingivitis. These gums

bleed easily when touched and are usually sore.

Gingivitis is reversible and can be treated with a regular dental cleaning. If left untreated, the bacteria begin to move deeper into the pocket to the bone. The immune cells chase the bacteria deeper into the pocket resulting in bone loss, also known as periodontal disease.

The average toothbrush cannot totally clean to the bottom of the pocket. As the bacteria migrates deeper, it makes hard deposits that cling to the tooth making it impossible for you to clean without intervention from a hygienist or dentist.

Once bone loss begins to occur, you will need "deep cleanings" or periodontal cleanings for life.

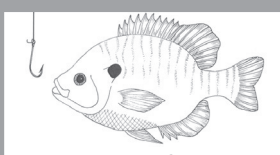

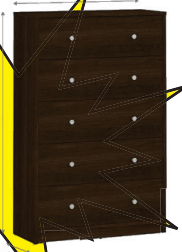

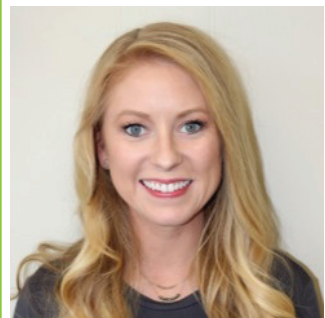
his veterans' only agent's management. From there Garrett went to work. Garrett has studied, worked, and networked better than I have ever seen up close.

I built a new house a few years ago and installed a few smart gadgets that I found useful at the time. Things such as a smart thermostat, internet-enabled security cameras, a Ring doorbell to thwart package thieves and annoying visitors, a Sonos music system, and a light or two that I can control remotely.

The primitive technology we had way back in 2015 was cool but times have changed. I recently took the plunge into fully automating my home with Samsung SmartThings. Up until recently, if I wanted to control my thermostat, I had to click on my thermostat app. I had to pull up a different app to look

for intruders on my security cameras, another app to turn on a light, and another to blast a Pink Floyd tune to annoy the neighbors. But now I'm able to control all these things with my voice from one app. Let's talk about how that's done.

A smart home starts with a dedicated smart home "hub." This hub is much like your wireless router but is dedicated to the gadgets in your home. The hub connects to your existing router then all your smart gadgets wirelessly connect to this hub. My

Samsung hub cost about \$70 bucks.

Once you have your hub connected, there are dozens of things you can add to it and more are being added all the time. I installed a few light switches (\$25 each) to control outdoor floodlights and a chandelier. I added some smart light bulbs (\$6) to automate lamps in the living and dining room. I added a water leak detector (\$20) to my "kegerator" to alert me if my precious home brew beer kegs sprout a leak. Most of

you would probably use that to monitor a pesky leak in the basement or under the kitchen sink but I have priorities. My existing stuff such as doorbell and cameras are all compatible with my hub.

You can add door and window sensors that will alert you when a door or window is opened, electrical outlets to control lamps or toasters (I don't know why you'd need to control a toaster but just knowing that you can is cool), smoke detectors that will alert you if your house burns down when you're not home, motion detectors, door locks, and even a pressure switch that will notify you if someone is sitting on your favorite chair. Seriously. All of this can be integrated with my Google Home account (or Amazon Alexa) giving me the ability to

speak to my home and it will obey.

For example, I can now be in my living room (or anywhere in the world), whip out my phone, and simply speak, "Turn on all lights," or "Activate security system," or "Play some jazz music," and my house will comply. I can program each gadget to turn on/off at certain times or when I leave the house or when I get home. How darn cool is that?

SUPPRESSING THE DISCUSSION DOESN'T SOLVE THE PROBLEM, It IS the Problem

The world today seems to be moving away from debate on contentious subjects and toward demands that those who have unpopular opinions -- or even just ask impertinent questions -- be forcibly silenced.

"You will never hear me mention his name," prime minister, Jacinda Ardern, said of Brenton Tarrant, the sole suspect in two deadly attacks on mosques in Christchurch. "He may have sought notoriety, but here in New Zealand we will give him nothing -- not even his name."

That's fine as a personal decision, but not as a top-down decision for her fellow New Zealanders. Even as Ardern spoke, police working for her government were arresting at least two people for sharing the shooter's live-streamed video of the attacks on social media.

Across the Tasman Sea, Australian prime minister, Scott Morrison, is calling on the governments of G20 countries to implement measures "including appropriate filtering, detecting and removing of content by actors who

Medicare Minute "Physician Charges"

There are three ways your doctor can be paid if you are on Medicare. The three ways are through Medicare assignment, Medicare excess charges or by not taking Medicare at all. Today we will discuss these three methods.

The most common way a physician gets paid is by Medicare assignment. These physicians are called "participating doctors". After the Part B deductible of \$185 is met, participating doctors will accept the Medicare approved amount for their services. These doctors charge Medicare 80% and the beneficiary 20% of the cost of the benefit. For example, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, and you would be responsible for the other 20%, or \$20.

A "non-participating doctor" can choose to accept or not accept Medicare assignment. If the doctor does not accept Medicare assignment you may have to pay an additional 15% of the cost of the service the doctor provided. This is called a Medicare excess charge. It means you would be responsible for 35% of the Medicare reduced amount instead of 20%. If we follow the example in the previous paragraph, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, but you would be responsible for 35%, or \$35.

Doctors who opt out of Medicare can charge whatever they want for their services and you are responsible of 100% of the cost. The majority of doctors in north Alabama accept Medicare, so you won't be faced with this situation very often.

Most people who have Medicare also have a supplemental policy that helps cover the 20% Medicare doesn't cover. If you are just entering Medicare and would like to know which policies cover what Medicare doesn't pay, you can contact our office for more information.

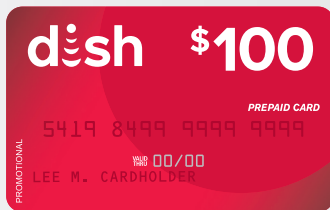

The Good, The Bad, The Ugly

Often the Bible has been referred to as "God's love letter to man." To a large degree this description carries a lot of merit. The most "famous" verse of the Bible contains the words, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life" (John 3:16).

From Genesis to Revelation there is the general theme of how man's sin has separated him from his Maker, yet God loved man so much that He redeemed him through the price of His own Son, Jesus. There is no doubt that God's plan of saving man as revealed in the Bible is truly "the greatest love letter" or any other letter ever written.

On the other hand, I would have to say that the Bible is more than merely a love letter. For example, it paints for us untainted pictures that reveal the good, bad and ugly of men and women throughout the ages.

To illustrate, consider the spiritual giant, Abraham. When spoken of today he is still given the honor of being the "father of the faithful." What Bible student does not know about Abraham's willingness to offer his son, Isaac, as a sacrifice simply because God told him to (Genesis 22:1f)? Even though the Lord stopped him, he demonstrated a faith that said, "As God directs, I am willing to follow." What a tremendous example of what our faith should be!

However, there were a few instances the Bible records that show a less-than-flattering view of Abraham's faith. Remember the occasion when he and his wife, Sarai, went down to Egypt and he was afraid the Egyptians would kill him in order to take her (Genesis 12:10f)? Even though God had just promised to make a great nation of his descendants, his weak faith (at that time) prompted him to tell Egyptians she was his sister.

So, what are we to make of this? Paul penned, "Whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have hope" (Romans 15:4). We are not given an unrealistic picture of man's perfection throughout Scripture. If so, we would probably become discouraged and quit.

Hence, we learn that in the bad and ugliness of our human frailty, we still can have hope - because God is always good! "But God demonstrates His love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 15:4).

encourage, normalise, recruit, facilitate or commit terrorist and violent atrocities.”

Let’s be clear about what Morrison, other world leaders, and significant segments of activist communities, and even the general public are demanding: internet censorship.

This isn’t really a new development. The mosque attacks are merely the latest incident weaponized by politicians and activists in service to a long-running campaign against public discussion and debate that requires them to make arguments and persuade instead of just bark orders and compel.

The fictional “memory hole” of the IngSoc regime in George Orwell’s 1984 stood for more than half a century as an oft-cited and wisely acknowledged warning. Now that hole is opening up beneath us for real and threatening to suck us down into a new Dark Age of “thoughtcrime” and “unpersons.”

The threat is content-independent. Renaming climate change skeptics “deniers” and demanding investigations of them, or pressuring media to ban discussions of policy on vaccines, is just as evil as suing Alex Jones for promulgating bizarre theories about the Sandy Hook massacre.

The only appropriate response to “bad” speech -- that is, speech one

disagrees with -- is “better” speech.

Attempting to shut down your opponents’ ability to participate in an argument isn’t itself a winning argument. Forbidding your opponents to speak to a problem doesn’t solve that problem.

In fact, those tactics are tantamount to admitting that your arguments are less persuasive and that your solutions can’t withstand scrutiny.

Freedom of thought and expression are foundational rights. They make it possible for us to hash out issues and solve problems peaceably instead of by force. Any attempt to suppress them is a call for totalitarianism and the alternative to those liberties is social and political death.

The tour of the Florence City Cemetery, on April 20 features unique headstones and monuments adorned with burial and religious symbolism. The cemetery established in 1818 contains graves belonging to early settlers, two former governors in the O'Neal family, along with other prominent community leaders and families.

The tour begins at Florence City Cemetery entrance at 705 E. College Street next to the Animal Shelter or entrances on Tennessee Street. Tour Guide: Harry Wallace

"Governing of a Town and County" Historic Tuscumbia Walking Tour.

The free tour begins outside Coldwater Books, 101 W. 6th St. The tour includes a visit to the Colbert County Courthouse and other buildings that played a role in the early governance of Tuscumbia and Colbert County.

Historic Sheffield Walking Tour begins at Sheffield City Hall, 600 N. Montgomery Ave. The 2-hour tour will focus on historic commercial buildings along Montgomery.

Historic Florence - University of North Alabama Campus - The history of the University of North Alabama contains both direct and indirect ties to institutions such as LaGrange College and Locust Dell Academy. Dear Kendall,
Marriage counselors say you have a good chance of having a successful marriage if you're in agreement on four things—religion, money, children, and in-laws. So, first things first. I'd strongly suggest you and your fiancé go through pre-marital counseling to make sure you're on the same page when it comes to handling this and other issues.

If you and her mom really want to show her you love her, you'll make sure she starts learning some character and discipline. And it's very important that both of you are on the same page and in agreement every step of the way. You might also want to read a book together by Dr. Henry Cloud called "Boundaries." This is a great book, and it will give you both several ideas for creating a reasonable timeline aimed at teaching her more responsibility.

I would advise letting her mom present any changes to her initially. Neither of you wants to create a scenario where you're viewed as the bad guy. Let her mom start the process by explaining that she made a few mistakes in terms of teaching her more about personal responsibility and self-reliance when she was younger. Then, she can begin to lay out the first few rules and expectations.

In my mind, there's nothing wrong with requiring her to get a job within 30 days if she doesn't already have one. If she needs to go job hunting, make sure she's out of bed and on the road no later than 8:00 a.m. every morning. During

this first phase, looking for work every day should be her job. It wouldn't be a bad idea to start teaching her about budgeting, saving, and everything else that goes into handling money responsibly during this time, too.

Next, phase two might consist of requiring her to help around the house doing chores on her days off, or whenever mom needs a hand. Then, after a month or two of this, phase three might consist of her paying a small amount in rent.

Do you see what I'm doing? By stepping up the expectations gradually you're build-

ing a foundation so she'll have the tools and knowledge to where, in the sixth or seventh month, she's moving out and taking care of her own responsibilities.

Like an adult!

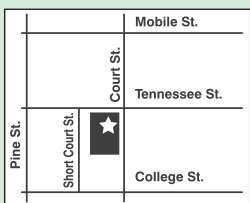

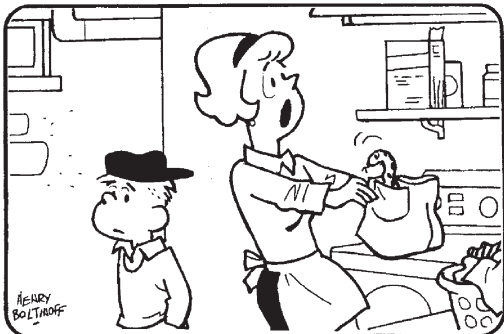

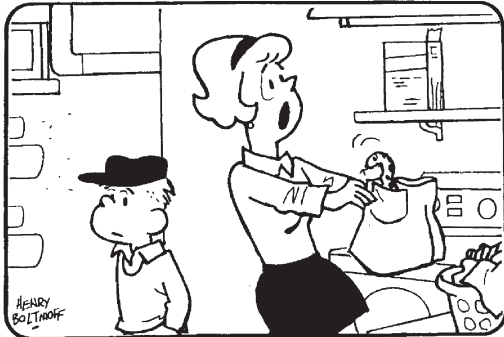
