



'Burning' Tattoo Forces Halt to MRI

DEAR DR. ROACH: Can you please explain how an MRI machine affects the pigment in a tattoo? My friend's MRI procedure was stopped because she was experiencing a burning sensation at her lower eyelids, which had previously been tattooed with black ink. Does this happen only with black ink? Which colors are safer? -- J.H.

ANSWER: Reactions between the ink in tattoos and MRI scanners are well-documented in the literature. Some inks -- mostly black, red and brown -- are made with iron or titanium oxides. Only 1.5 percent of people with tattoos have reported bad experiences in MRI machines.

Iron and titanium oxides conduct electricity, and the strong magnetic field in an MRI scanner can cause a current to travel between different tattoos or different portions of a tattoo -especially those with loops in the pattern. The electric current causes heat, and even can cause minor burns. Cold packs or ice placed on the area during MRI can minimize damage, but some MRI facilities will not perform an MRI on tattooed individuals, especially if the tattoo covers a large area.

If a magnet draws up the skin with a tattoo, then that area is at

DEAR DR. ROACH: I recently was diagnosed with transient global amnesia. I had never heard of this. My primary care doctor sent me for further testing, which included an MRI and MRA with contrast, and a CT scan. All were normal. Can you elaborate on this condition? -- M.T.M.

ANSWER: Transient global amnesia is a cause of retrograde amnesia ("retrograde" meaning you don't remember things from the past, usually the past day to a month, but sometimes longer; "anterograde" means memory loss forward from the time of the event). Its cause is unknown, but it occurs more frequently in men and women over 50. Your doctor ordered the appropriate tests to make sure it wasn't a transient ischemic attack or stroke. Epilepsy sometimes can look similar to TGA, so sometimes an EEG is obtained.

As scary as it sounds, TGA usually doesn't happen again and doesn't predict a higher risk of developing memory troubles, stroke or epilepsy in the future.

DEAR DR. ROACH: My wife has COPD. She is not coping very well. Her doctors are treating her with the standard medications. She has heard about an experimental treatment where they take her stem cells and make them into something that is inhaled. Have you heard about this treatment? Is it safe? Each treatment is \$7,000. -- J.W.

ANSWER: Stem cells are cells that can develop into many kinds of mature cells. In theory, they can grow and replace cells that have been damaged or destroyed due to a disease process. Stem cells hold great promise for many diseases, but there isn't enough information for me to make a recommendation for stem cells in COPD, for either safety or effectiveness.

If you are going to look into it further, I would recommend doing so only as part of a clinical trial. You can find out about clinical trials at www.clinicaltrials.gov. I was able to find some trials on the site that are recruiting subjects. I also would recommend www.closerlookatstemcells.org/ to anyone considering stem cell treatment.

Reworked Filing Cabinet

Decorating has once again become informal, like the "country furniture" era in the 1980s that led to rooms with "non-furniture furniture." An old cobbler's bench became a coffee table, a

cranberry scoop was a magazine rack, stacked orange crates were shelving and tin Grape Nuts signs were hung as art. A new "technology" style began about six years ago. A refinished workbench with a polished vice or gears is a dining table, and a church bench replaces three or four chairs. Refinished oak filing cabinets from an office or library provide storage for jewelry or folded shirts, and wall-towall carpeting is out, replaced by polished wood floors

The result is unique and childproof since the pieces have survived bumps and spills already. And the clever buyer can find solid wooden pieces for bargain prices. An Ohmer's Sons office filing cabinet with 48 drawers and the original brass hardware was auctioned in Maine for \$1,331. It

was made in Ohio before 1898, when Edwin Seibels tried to patent a way to file a flat letter in a lateral file folder instead of stacking mail inside its envelope in a drawer. Reworked factory and office furniture of the past has become more popular for the living room, and it is going up in price. There are even reproductions available.

. I have a piece of Niloak pot-• tery, which has some stains that look like drips, possibly from furniture polish. Is there a way to clean this?

Niloak Pottery was made at the A. Hyten Brothers Pottery in Benton, Arkansas, from 1910 to 1918, and again from 1921 to 1947. The pottery was made from Kaolin, a soft, white clay. The name "Niloak" is "kaolin" spelled backward. To clean Niloak pottery, use a soft cloth dampened with water. If the drips are furniture polish, they may be hard to remove since the polish probably contains oil, wax or another water-resistant ingredient. Some people recommend using a mild solution of water and dish detergent. Don't soak the pottery, avoid rubbing the surface too hard and be sure to blot it dry.







HOLLYWOOD — In 1985, a 59-year-old **Rock Hudson** was the first major movie star to die from AIDS, and his passing finally brought attention to the HIV disease. Rock starred in more than 60 major films, including "Magnificent Obsession" (1954); "All That Heaven Allows" (1955); "Giant" (1956), his only Oscar nomination; and "Pillow Talk" (1959), with **Doris** Day. It was while filming "Dynasty" (1984-85) that people realized he was deathly ill. Given the choice of filming "Dynasty" or going to France for treatment that could prolong his life, Rock chose "Dynasty." By the time he finally went to France, the disease had progressed beyond the point where the treatment could save him.

He began his career in 1949 at Universal Pictures playing indians and pirates, so it's only fitting that Universal will tell the story of his life and death in the upcoming "All That Heaven Allows," based on Mark Griffin's book of the same name. Marc Christian, one of Rock's past lovers, sued him and won a multimillion-dollar lawsuit because Rock didn't tell him he had AIDS. I met Rock through his mother, who was a friend of a friend, and he always treated me as a friend. At the beginning of his career, he hid his homosexuality, and at the end of his career, he hid his AIDS.

Former "Doctor Who" and "The Crown" star Matt Smith will become Charles Manson for the film "Charlie Says," which focuses on the women of the Manson family. It's a far cry from a space hero and a prince of England to a psychopathic killer.

Johnny Depp, who allegedly hid his assets to divorce Amber Heard, now is embroiled in two lawsuits. He's suing his former wife for \$50 million for defamation, because she claimed

he abused her, which he asserts was a hoax to further her career (it comes to trial Sept. 16). The second lawsuit, for \$30 million, is against his former business managers for malpractice. Insiders allege these problems have soured his chances to do the reboot of "The Pirates of the Caribbean," but that seems unlikely, since he was a key component in the original films.

The two men who allege in the documentary "Leaving Neverland" that they were sexually assaulted as kids by Michael Jackson have prompted the producers of the Michael Jackson musical "Don't Stop 'Til You Get Enough" to cancel their Broadway tryout. The Chicago Theater has replaced it with "Once Upon a One More Time," a musical comedy featuring songs by Britney Spears, set for Oct. 29-Dec. 1. Some of us have had enough and don't need one more time!

How to ace job interviews when switching careers

Millions of people change careers every year. Whereas professionals may have once worked for the same company for the majority, if not the entirety, of their careers, nowadays it's not uncommon for men and women to change jobs several times before reaching retirement.

Changing jobs and changing careers are not necessarily the same thing. - Use your contacts to your advantage. Even if much of your experience won't transfer to your new career, your professional network might still be valuable to a prospective employer. The longer you have been working the larger your professional network likely is, so highlight those contacts in your interview and illustrate how you can put them to good use should you be hired.
- Showcase how you have adapted in the past. Much of the business world moves at a breakneck pace. That pace has become even faster thanks to advancements in technology that routinely affect how businesses operate. Even if you have never before changed careers, that does not mean you have not adapted to change. Make a list of the changes your employers have instituted throughout your career, highlighting how you adapted to those changes and benefitted from them in their aftermath.
- Remain positive throughout the interview. Even if you are changing careers because you're unhappy and/or unfulfilled in your present line of work, avoid badmouthing that industry and your past employers. Doing so will only reflect negatively on you and raise a red flag with prospective employers. Instead, explain your reasons for pursuing a new career path in terms that excite potential employers about your candidate.

The decision to change careers can induce both excitement and anxiety. Maintaining a positive attitude and employing various strategies when interviewing with prospective employers can help make the transition to a new career go smoothly.

SHRIMP BOIL FOIL PACKS



INGREDIENTS

Easy, tasty shrimp boil dinners baked or grilled in foil with homemade seasoning, fresh lemon, and brown butter sauce.

Ingredients

1 pound shrimp, peeled and de-veined

2 ears of corn on the cob, husked

1/2 pound andouille sausage

1 pound baby red potatoes OR baby yellow pota-

3 tablespoons old bay seasoning OR homemade seasoning (see note)

salt and pepper, to taste

1 tablespoon minced garlic

juice of 1/2 lemon, plus lemon wedges for serving 3 tablespoons butter melted + 1/2 cup, divided chopped fresh parsley, for topping

INSTRUCTIONS

Chop corn into thirds, then chop each third in half lengthwise. Chop potatoes into 2 inch pieces. Boil corn and potatoes for 10 minutes. Drain and set

In a large bowl combine shrimp, sausage, corn, and potatoes. Stir together melted 3 tablespoons butter, Old Bay seasoning, garlic, juice from half a lemon, and salt and pepper to taste and pour over shrimp, sausage, and veggies. Stir to coat.

Divide between four 12x12 inch sheets of aluminum foil. Fold edges of foil up around the food to create a closed packet.

Cook on preheated grill over medium-high heat for 8-10 minutes on one side, then flip and cook another 5-6 minutes on the second side. Alternately, you can bake the packets at 400 degrees for 15-20 minutes until corn is tender and shrimp are pink and fully cooked.

While packets are cooking, melt remaining butter in a medium sauce pan over medium-high heat. Once melted, continue to stir gently over medium heat for 3-4 minutes longer until color changes from pale yellow to a golden amber (but be careful not to burn it).

Serve shrimp boil packs topped with chopped parsley, lemon wedges for squeezing, and browned butter for drizzling over the top or dipping.

VA Releases Ratings on 101 Nursing Homes

For the first time, the Department of Veterans Affairs has released health care inspection reports for 101 of its Community Living Centers, formerly known as nursing homes.

Facilities are surveyed in a number of ways, including having enough staff, managing medication, protecting residents from physical and mental abuse and properly storing and preparing food. Of those, staffing might be the most important: If there aren't enough registered nurses, vocational nurses and nursing aides, care doesn't happen at all. Per the reports, the VA has fewer low-performing facilities (17.2 percent versus 19.7 percent) and more high-performing facilities (17.2 percent versus 10.8 percent) than the private sector. These numbers aren't bad, they say, considering that the veterans at these facilities have more serious conditions than are generally seen in civilian facilities. Of the total, only eight VA facilities were rated one star. Reports for the remaining centers will be released by October.

However, one wonders why the VA is just now getting around to releasing the results of those reports. The General Accountability Office was asked to step in years ago to investigate complaints. Its report, titled "Actions Needed to Better Manage Risks to Veterans' Quality of Life and Care," outlined a lot of problems, with pain management being at the top of the list and a general failure to respond to and address

It's disheartening to see the ratings for the facility nearest to me. Percentages of short-term patients with moderate to severe pain are nearly four times higher than the national average. Long-term patients with moderate to severe pain see percentages nearly 10 times as high as the national average. The facility rates one star.


