



We have a great observation situation on the Iroquois National Wildlife Refuge at the Ringneck Marsh Overlook just off Route 63 on the Oak Orchard Ridge Road. Right out in front of the overlook there are two islands with the one on the east (left side) having an active eagle nest where two eaglets just recently hatched off. The nest is on the west edge of the island in a dead snag.

This has been an osprey nest for a number of years, but starting three years ago a pair of adult eagles took an interest in it and last year they chased the ospreys off. Ice fishing on the marsh has not helped to encourage the pair, but this year they went for it! Hopefully traffic down that dike will not disturb the nesting season. As a reminder, there is no boating allowed on this marsh and use of drones is strictly prohibited. Earlier this spring a couple of guys were running drones all around Ringneck Marsh and got caught and paid a good price.

With the popularly of drones now there will are going to be some idiots harassing wildlife with them to "get that shot." Flying drones near eagle's nests is highly illegal, but I'm sure someone is going to try it. The federal law officer shows up randomly and is a pretty sneaky guy. You probably won't see him until he is writing you ticket! If you see this kind of activity or anyone disturbing wildlife get their license number and drop it off at the INWR headquarters on Casey Road.

So how are our eagles doing? Well, good news and a little bad. The nest on the NY DEC Tonawanda WMA has failed. Just recently it was discovered that there were no eagles around the nest. She had been incubating since the middle of February and was due to hatch the third week of March, but that was when she disappeared. There are predator guards on the nest tree to prevent raccoon from getting to the nest and everything seemed to be going fine until the week of her due date and they disappeared. The theory is something happened to one of the adults and so of course the one left was unable to guard and take care of the nest. Another nest on the INWR also seems to be a failure. It was a new nest last year and they raised two eaglets, but it seems nothing is going on this year. It has no predator guard, so maybe a raccoon got up there early in the nesting season.

On the good side a new nest was found on the NYS DEC Oak Orchard WMA just recently which makes it the second eagle nest on that area. This makes nine eagle nests in our area now. All are on either the federal or state refuge areas except one north of Medina and another up by Lake Ontario.

At present, most have hatched out except for two late starts which are due this week. It is difficult to see the young until they are about two weeks old, but after that a good spotting scope will give you good views of the nesting activities for another eight weeks or so. The best place to do this is the above mentioned location at the Ringneck Marsh Overlook. And remember, you must stay 200 yards from an active eagle nest and NO DRONES. If you think you know of a eagle nest you can call our local DEC Office at 585-948-5182 or me.

Another thing has come to an end just recently too, hunting coyotes. There are a number of groups of sportsmen who run coyotes with hounds after deer season in our area. They do us a favor by keeping the coyote numbers down and more importantly keeping the coyote fearful of humans. Without this activity, coyotes get very bold and soon house pets and other domestic animals begin to disappear. They also begin to raise hell with other wildlife.

Recently, these houndsmen have been having problems with folks calling the law on them because their hounds may be on their property. There has even been talk of issuing tickets to these sportsmen for "not keeping their dogs under control." Most of these sportsmen are very respective of land owners, but sometimes these coyotes take the hound from one end of the county to the other and there is no way to control that. Sure, they are going to cross some land that the hunters may not have direct permission to go on, so being able to keep these hounds under complete control? Get real folks! Do you know where your kids are and have control them when they are out and about?





How to Tame Indoor Odors

A clean home interior can make a strong first impression on prospective buyers, but only if that home is accompanied by pleasant scents. Odors can make a strong impact on buyers' perceptions of a home, including its level of cleanliness and

Although dirt and other grime can contribute to the odor of a home, additional culprits can contribute to foul smells as well. Everything from pets to the foods cooked in the kitchen to the hidden presence of mold can impact air quality and odor inside a home. Fortunately, there are ways to remedy stinky problems and come away with sweet-smelling solutions.

It's important for homeowners to realize that foul air inside a home can be the result of poor indoor air quality — which can be a health hazard. The United States Environmental Protection Agency ranks indoor air quality as a top five environmental risk to public health. EPA studies found indoor air pollutants were generally two to five times greater than outdoor pollution levels. In some cases, indoor air pollution was 100 times greater. The United States Consumer Product Safety Commission says the following can contribute to poor indoor air quality and also to some interior odors: combustion sources; tobacco products; building materials and furnishings; wet or damp carpet; cabinetry or furniture made of certain pressed wood products; products for household cleaning and maintenance and even outdoor sources such as radon, pesticides and outdoor air pollution.

So how does one remedy poor indoor air quality and odors inside a home? These tips can improve conditions.

- Ensure adequate ventilation. Open windows and doors when weather permits to eliminate the concentration of pollutants and help air out odors. Use exhaust fans in kitchens and baths to pull indoor air to the outside.
- Invest in an air filter. A high-efficiency particulate air filter will force air through a fine mesh and trap harmful particles, such as pet dander, smoke, pollen, and dust mites, that can build up in a home. Remember to change the filter regularly.
- Increase the number of plants. Plants can brighten interior spaces, and they're also remarkable at cleaning indoor air. The Clean Air Study conducted by NASA set out to find out the best way to clean the air in space stations. The association found that the Boston fern, spider plant, Chinese evergreen, weeping fig, variegated snake plant, and English ivy, among many other plants, were ideal for filtering air and removing harmful contaminants.
- Ditch disposal odors. Food can become trapped and decompose in garbage disposals. Cut citrus fruit into chunks and drop them into a running disposal to remove many odors.
- Air out the washer. New washing machines have tight seals and gaskets that do not allow air to penetrate (or water to leak out). Mildew can grow as a result. Leave the washer door open after a round of laundry to let things dry and air out.
- Tame pet odors. Pets contribute heavily to odor in a home. Wet dog smells are prevalent on rainy days, while cat litter boxes can pack a pungent punch. Cleanliness can cut down on smells. Use activated charcoal in litter products to tame smells and empty the litter box frequently. Make sure dogs are dried off thoroughly when coming in from the rain, and use a deodorizing spray on pet fur. Regular grooming can help as

Odors in a home can be embarrassing and set a poor tone when inviting company over or showcasing a home for prospective buyers. Keep odors at bay by identifying the sources of smells and taking action. ■



Seven Steps to Leave a Job Gracefully



Deciding to leave a job is seldom an easy decision. However, it's a more common decision than many people may know, as the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics indicates the average worker holds 10 different jobs before age 40.

People change jobs for a variety of reasons. Some do so because of better opportunities elsewhere, while others simply need a change. Regardless of what's motivating a job change, leaving a place of employment can elicit various emotions, including some that may contribute to negative thoughts about a current employer. But it's always best to leave a job gracefully, which can pay dividends down the road. The following

days and overnights. Weekends are seven strategies people can employ as they leave their jobs to ensure those exits go as smoothly as possible.

- MAINTENANCE: Part-time. 8am- 1. Watch out for social media. It's best to keep resignation plans to yourself 4pm. Must have some knowledge and off of social media. You never know who is reading your posts, and badmouthing a soon-to-be-former employer can lead to hurt feelings and poor during the summer & winter references. Resist the urge to rant about what's making you unhappy at work or brag about a new position to your social network.
 - 2. Play by the rules. Your employer may have a plan in place for how the company prefers resignations to be handled. The standard two- to three-week's notice is a guideline. Visit with human resources if you need more information, such as whether or not a resignation letter or other documentation is required.
 - 3. Speak with your manager first. It's respectful for your immediate manager or supervisor to learn of your departure first. This gives him or her ample time to put a plan in place to fill your position. The more notice you can give, the more goodwill you're building on your way out the door. Schedule a meeting for this purpose; do not make it an informal chat by the water cooler. Resist the urge to quit via email or text. Resigning requires face-to-face communication. Present a concise letter of resignation as well. Don't call out colleagues or air your grievances in the letter.
 - 4. Announce your departure. Work collectively with your manager and other higher-ups to decide how to best handle the announcement to other employees.
 - 5. Train your replacement and prepare final assignments. Volunteer to train or assist with getting your replacement set up. If you have any outstanding projects or documents, be sure to tie up any loose ends before leaving. Leave behind instructions or a guidebook if you think it will help your replacement perform their duties more effectively.
 - 6. Keep the momentum. It can be tempting to phone it in as you near departure day, but this is inadvisable. Do your job to the best of your ability up until you say your goodbyes.
 - 7. Pack on your own time. Cause as little disruption as possible by packing belongings before or after office hours. Respect the working environment, recognizing that your coworkers still need to get their jobs done.

Quitting a job can be full of mixed emotions. Just be sure to time it correctly and leave in as positive a way as possible to maintain a strong professional network. ■



Orange Whole-Wheat Waffles with Yogurt & Fresh Berries

Makes about six 5- to 6-inch waffles. Serves 4 to 6.

Orange Whole-Wheat Waffles

- 2 1/4 cups white whole-wheat flour
- 3 tablespoons sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1 1/4 cups whole milk
- 1/2 cup freshly squeezed orange juice
- 2 eggs, separated
- 5 teaspoons packed, grated orange zest
- 6 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted and slightly cooled

Yogurt topping

- 1 cup Greek-style yogurt (see note)
- 4 teaspoons honey
- 1 teaspoon grated orange zest, packed
- Fresh raspberries, strawberries or blueberries, for garnish
- 1. For the Orange Whole-Wheat Waffles: Preheat a waffle iron (and, if you plan to hold the waffles until serving time, preheat the oven to 200 F).
- 2. In a large serving bowl, stir together the flour, sugar, baking powder, and salt. In another bowl, whisk together the milk, orange juice, egg yolks, and orange zest. In a third bowl, beat the egg whites until firm, but not stiff.
- 3. Make a well in the dry ingredients and pour in the milk mixture, blending gently only until the ingredients are combined. Add the butter in a slow stream, continuing to blend until the butter is incorporated. Gently fold in the egg whites.
- 4. For the yogurt topping: In a small serving bowl, whisk together the yogurt, honey and orange zest.
- 5. Pour 1/2 cup of the batter (or more, depending on the size of your waffle iron) onto the waffle iron and, using a metal spatula or table knife, spread the batter to within 1/2 inch of the edge. Close the cover and cook approximately 3 minutes, or until crisp and golden brown. (If your waffles aren't crisp, even after a "ready" signal has sounded, continue to cook them, watching carefully, until crisp and golden. If not serving immediately, place the waffles in a single layer on a baking sheet in the preheated oven while you finish with the remaining batter.)
- 6. Serve the waffles topped with a generous dollop of the yogurt mixture and garnish with some berries.

Note: Nonfat, as well as reduced- to whole-fat varieties of Greek yogurt work in this recipe.
