




#### **Bridal Shower for Winters**





## Crowd Sourcing at Lakeside's Science on the Menu You may have heard of "crowd sourcing" as a way to get a

big project done through small actions by many people. Did

you know that scientists are increasingly using crowd sourcing, called Citizen Science, to accomplish research? Dr. Lori Biederman, Associate Professor in the Department of Ecology, Evolution, and Organismal Biology at Iowa



State University, will share details behind Lakeside's "Bringing Dark Data to Light" Project at Science on the Menu at Lakeside Lab on Wednesday, April 17. Dr. Biederman will share her work and amazing discoveries such as the oldest bird discovered in the collections at Lakeside - a purple martin from 1879. In the years before mobile phones only a few folks would call "home" from a phone booth in a distant place like the Iowa Jazz Championships in Ames or Des Moines, then have friends and family spread the good word and get plans made for a welcome home party for the top bands on a local line. Today, mentioning anything about coins in a phone brings strange looks from anyone even of high school age who may never have seen a pay phone, or struggled to find a dime in an "emergency."

We're glad the news — especially good news — travels fast. Better communication is always good — especially when the communication is about things like winning sports contests or, even better, the Iowa Jazz Championships. Ryan Middleton and the Okoboji High School Jazz Band have much to be proud of with last Tuesday's victory in Class 2A, which by the numbers

makes it even more amazing.
While longtime OHS band director Greg Forney had to point us in the right direction (How were we supposed to know that list of top schools scrolled down, and down, and down and down... with all 43 years of high notes ever since the IJC began in 1976, with different classes then?)

that show, *There's a Small Hotel*, was recorded by Stan Getz (1950), Chet Baker (1955), and over 50 years later by jazz singer Jane Monheit — in addition to many others. What is arguably the most famous version was a collaboration between Frank Sinatra and Nelson Riddle for the soundtrack of the 1957 Columbia motion picture Pal Joey...

The third annual Grammy Awards, on April 12, 1961, saw Percy Faith win a Grammy for Record of the Year for Theme from A Summer Place. Interestingly, the song was the first movie theme and first instrumental to win that award. We missed Percy Faith's 111th natal day a week ago Sunday...

If you hear a lot hollering on Saturday, you'll know that the inveterate Scrabble Player in RD is winning somewhere against some unsuspecting opponent across the Scrabble board. "Scrabble Day" is worth 11 points on a Scrabble board — unless you get lucky and find premium squares. The word GLORIA refers to liturgical music. If you are having trouble spelling it, you







#### Auburn Handles Loss with Class

I will be the first to admit that I have not been a big Bruce Pearl fan, as the Auburn head coach has a very long history of NCAA rules violations that ultimately led to him being fired as Tennessee's head coach and banned from coaching college for three years. Pearl was hired at Auburn in 2014, and while he hasn't been charged with anything, he has had two assistant coaches dismissed for their involvement in the FBI bribery scheme that has rocked college basketball. I have a hard time getting past Pearl's long history of breaking NCAA rules, but have to give credit where credit is due, and that comes from this past weekend with how Pearl and his team handled their crushing defeat to Virginia in the Final Four.

I'm sure everyone has seen the foul call at the end of the game that allowed Virginia to hit three free throws with :00.6 remaining and pull out a 63-62 victory. The foul was a questionable call, although it did appear that Kyle Guy was bumped in the leg after he shot the ball; but what was so bad was that three officials missed Guy double dribble as he brought the ball up the court with :06 left in the game. That is not a judgement call and is normally an easy one to make, and all three refs blew it. Instead of complaining about the call after the game, Pearl gave Virginia credit for winning a great basketball game and said he told his team after the game that "this was God's plan, and we would be happier in victory, but God's blessed us all year long... and we all disappointed but we are all so very proud." That message resonated with his team, as Auburn's Samir Doughty, who was called for the foul on the play had this to say in the somber locker room about the officials, "They're gonna do their job the best they can. The referees don't try to tell me how to put a basketball in the hole, so I'm not gonna tell them how to make the right or wrong call.'

One of the many great things about sports is that it teaches us so many life lessons. It would have been very easy for Auburn to complain about the calls and no-calls at the end of the game, but they chose to focus on the great season that they had while also giving credit to Virginia for winning the hard-fought game. Another great life lesson that sports can teach is that people deserve second chances, and it's great to see someone like Pearl taking advantage of his second (maybe third) chance to impact young people's lives in a positive way! This 2019 NCAA Tournament (Men's and Women's) continues to give us some great games and some moments that we all can learn from; I'll be sad when it's all over on Monday night.

## LRH to Participate with all Medicaid Contractors

Recent news about UnitedHealthcare's decision to discontinue providing Medicaid coverage in Iowa has caused some concern among Medicaid beneficiaries. According to Lakes Regional Healthcare Patient Financial Services Manager Pat Holdorf, several patients have been calling the hospital, concerned about their coverage at Lakes Regional Healthcare and the local Avera family physician clinics.

Lakes Regional Healthcare has and will continue to participate with all Medicaid contractors. Until July, there will continue to be two Medicaid contractors in Iowa: AmeriGroup and United-Healthcare. After July, a new Medicaid contractor called Iowa Total Care will enter the market, following UnitedHealthcare's exit.

'We understand UnitedHealthcare beneficiaries will receive letters advising them of their options," said Holdorf. "But we want our patients to know we - the hospital and family physician clinics - will continue to participate with all Medicaid contractors."





**Explore Iowa's Lost History on the Titanic** in Spirit Lake on April 15

What do an orphan train rider, a kidnapper, a betrayed wife, a church missionary, a wealthy businessman, a land baron's wife, a



maid, a farmer, a college student, an immigrant and a newspaper reporter have in common?

They all had ties to Iowa, and their stories would forever become intertwined with the saga of the opulent Titanic, which struck an iceberg and plunged to the bottom of the North Atlantic in 1912.

Iowa author Darcy Dougherty Maulsby will bring these stories to life on Monday, April 15, 2019, at the Spirit Lake Public Library for the free program and book signing featuring "Iowa's

Lost History on the Titanic," starting at 7:00pm.

"The humanity of these captivating stories conveys a drama more complex, intriguing and poignant than any work of fiction. These true tales also reflect the long reach of history," said Maulsby, Iowa's Storyteller, who has been featured in the Iowa History Journal, Our Iowa magazine, Iowa Public Radio and more. "Even though the Titanic sank more than a century ago, the aftershocks continue to reverberate more than a century later."

More than 20 men, women and children from all walks of life shared ties to Iowa and the Titanic. Some were wealthy firstclass passengers like Cedar Rapids natives Walter and Mahala Douglas returning home from an extended vacation in Europe. Others were second-class passengers, including the Caldwell family, church missionaries who were returning to the Midwest from Asia. Still others were third-class immigrants seeking a new start in America, lured by jobs in Iowa's farms and coal mines.

They had ties to communities small and large across Iowa, including Allerton, Boone, Burlington, Cedar Rapids, Central City, Cherokee, Council Bluffs, Davenport, Des Moines, Hamburg, Manchester, Mystic, Red Oak, Sanborn, Stanton and Story City.

Before dawn broke on April 15, 1912, some of these people of the Titanic would perish. Others would demonstrate the one thing they had in common—courage. Some survivors would manage to chart a new course for their future, while others would struggle with haunting questions and shattered dreams for the rest of their lives.

"As you explore these largely forgotten Iowa stories, you'll discover there's something endlessly spellbinding about the Titanic," Maulsby said. "Once it grabs ahold of you, there is no turning back."

Maulsby will take orders for signed copies of "Iowa's Lost History on the Titanic." Maulsby's other non-fiction, illustrated Iowa history books (including "A Culinary History of Iowa," "Calhoun County" and "Dallas County") and her postcard collections featuring rural Iowa images and postcards featuring favorite vintage photos from the Culinary History of Iowa book will also be available during the program.

## Performance and Workshop to Highlight Farmland Transfer

The public is invited to two free events on April 11 and 12 designed to bring awareness to a critical issue facing Iowa agriculture today:

farmland transfer. The play Map of My Kingdom: Who is Going to Get the Farm takes on the issue of farmland transfer, and the fact that the majority of farmland in Iowa is




