April is Sexual Assault Awareness Month 2019
RESTORE Sexual Assault Services is widening its reach for the program's fifth annual region-wide campaign for Sexual Assault Awareness Month. Because of the substantial shift in national conversations about supporting survivors, more attention is focused on agencies serving those impacted by sexual violence, including RESTORE—a program of Planned Parenthood of Central and Western New York. In the past year RESTORE has added staff positions, office space, and ways to raise awareness.

One example is the unique partnership with community libraries and other agencies to host 'Mailboxes of Hope,' wherein RESTORE places card boxes for anonymous submission of 'Letters of Hope' for survivors, collecting for an April display of words of solidarity and support from each and every community. While 2017 and 2018 hosted 9 and 17 respective 'Mailboxes of Hope,' in 2019 there are more than 50, highlighting the passion so many have to offer support for survivors.

Present for the fifth consecutive year are the symbolic displays of hundreds of tiny flags. Each of the five counties that RE-STORE serves (Monroe, Genesee, Orleans, Wyoming and Livingston) host a display for the month of April emphasizing the role communities play in standing against sexual violence.

This year, the displays features 720 small orange flags, representing a stark statistic: every two minutes, someone in the United States is sexually assaulted. That's 720 every day. The display supports survivors, challenges "locker room talk" and helps raise awareness of resources available to become educated, help survivors and prevent sexual assault.

RESTORE is partnering with multiple agencies across the region on this project.

- In Wyoming County, the flags will be hosted at the Government Center in Warsaw through collaboration with the Wyoming County District Attorney's Office.
- In Orleans County, signage will be posted at the Pullman Memorial Universalist Church in Albion.
- In Genesee County, the flags will be displayed on the lawn of the County Courthouse in Batavia.
- In Livingston County, RESTORE's display will be coordinated with the Town of Geneseo, at the intersection of 20A and Volunteer Road in Lakeville.
- In Monroe County, flags will be planted at the Planned Parenthood health center on University Avenue in Rochester.

The flags will be set up on Monday April 1, and remain on display throughout the month. Additional flag displays will travel across the region, hosted by the colleges with whom RESTORE partners for advocacy, education and support.


