Spring ushers in golf and bunny yoga at Ruttger's Bay Lake

Another season of golf at Jack's 18 at Ruttger's Bay Lake Lodge kicks off on Friday, April 26, when the course opens to the public, Ruttger's PGA Golf Professional Dave Sadlowsky announced. Alec's 9 will open later in the spring.

The start date is subject to change in the event of more inclement weather, but the extended forecasts look promising, Sadlowsky said.

"Spring is one of the best times of year to golf," he said "It's not hot, there are no bugs and spring rates are very affordable. I can't wait."

New to the Ruttger's golf in 2019 is the Thursday Game Day and Open League. This is a casual 9-hole game day that is open to both men and women. Golfers can play anytime during the day—morning, afternoon or evening. It's a chance to meet new people, or play with friends. Fees are only collect-

ed on the days golfers play.

Bunny yoga

Hoppy Hour Yoga is coming to the second annual Lakes Area Yoga Festival - a celebration of the innovative, life-affirming yoga and wellness available in the Brainerd Lakes Area, April 26-28 at Ruttger's Bay Lake Lodge.

Area yoga studios will conduct six yoga sessions for yogis of all skill levels over the three-day event, including Hoppy Hour Yoga - a session featuring more than 30 therapy bunnies. The bunnies are provided by the Minnesota Companion Bunny Society (MCBS), a volunteer-based, non-profit organization dedicated to improving the lives of companion rabbits.

The Lakes Area Yoga Festival begins on Friday with an "Unpack Your Bags" yoga session and welcome gathering on Friday evening. The bulk of the festival takes place

on Saturday, however, with four sessions, lunch, snacks and a vendor expo for the latest gear and yoga merchandise. The yoga festival ends on Sunday, April 28 with a "Leave it at the Lake" yoga session. Classes will be led by instructors from Karmady Yoga of Aitkin, Lakes Area Yoga Association of Brainerd and Uplifted Wellness Studio of Crosby.



Highway 169 south of Garrison single lane beginning April 29

Sewer District votes against paying for relocation in tunnel project

Serpent Lake Sewer District votes against paying for force main relocation in conjunction with MNDOT Highway 6 Tunnel Project north of Crosby at the April 11 meeting of the Serpent Lake Sewer District Board.

WSN Engineer Mark Hallan talked about the bidding process for the force main relocation. Only one bid from Landwehr Construction was submitted. Landwehr Construction is also the apparent low bidder for the estimated \$1.4 million Hwy. 6 Tunnel project. There was other interest in the force main relocation, but no other bids were submitted by deadline. A unanimous vote to reject the bid, that was slightly over \$242,000. The bid was more than \$70,000 over the engineer's estimate.

Board Chairman Lloyd Brix, Cuyuna, relayed the Sewer District's Attorney Pat Kruger's opinion that the current MNDOT permit with the

district, issued in 1987, does not say if a highway project requires the force main be moved who pays for it.

Furthermore, a proposed new permit submitted by MNDOT has not been signed and would include the language making the sewer district responsible for the cost for moving the force main.

Board Member Dave Zontelli, Cuyuna, said "I represent the sewer users in Cuyuna. And I don't think it is fair or just to expect them to pay for this."

After some discussion, Board Member Lou Dirkes, Ironton made the motion to follow Attorney Kruger's advice to not pay for moving the force main. The resulting vote was seven in favor of the motion to one opposed. Board Member Robyn Wolfe, Crosby, voted no and said, "My reason for voting against that part was simply because I would have liked to have our attorney for the district

have the opportunity to talk with MNDOT."

City of Crosby Engineer Phil Martin will be notified of the sewer district's decision. The City of Crosby should then notify MNDOT and MNDNR.

WSN Engineer Mark Hallan said he would continue to follow up on IRRRB grant request to pay for the force main relocation.

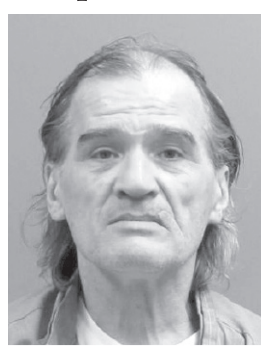
The Board also voted not to sign the new permit with MNDOT at this time.

Sheriff Goddard. "I want to assure the public that we are extremely vigilant on monitoring and checking on Mr. Lindmark and other predatory offenders in the community".

Sheriff Goddard reminds citizens that they can always visit the predatory offender search via the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension website.

The Crow Wing County Sheriff's Office believes that the release of this information will enhance public safety and protection. This notification is not intended to increase fear, but rather raise awareness. Abuse of this information to threaten, harass or intimidate is unacceptable and such acts could be charged as a crime.

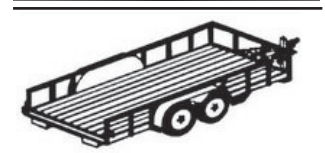

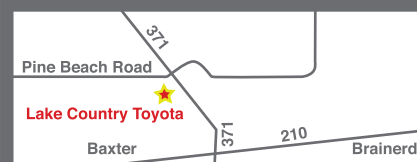
