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




### SCRIPT UNGRATEFULNESS



I've never understood why women love cats. Cats are independent, they don't listen, they don't come in when you call, they like to stay out all night, and when they're home they like to be left alone and sleep.



### **Parmesan Spinach**

#### **Ingredients**

- 3 packages (9 ounces each) fresh baby spinach
- 1 small red onion, chopped
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 package (8 ounces) cream cheese, cubed
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1/2 cup half-and-half cream
- 1/3 cup plus 3 tablespoons grated Parmesan cheese, divided
- 3 garlic cloves, minced
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- 2 cans (14 ounces each) water-packed artichoke hearts, rinsed, drained & chopped
- 1 tablespoon snipped fresh dill
- 1/4 teaspoon seasoned salt
- 8 butter-flavored crackers, coarsely crushed

#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. Place half of the spinach in a steamer basket; place in a large saucepan over 1 in. of water. Bring to a boil; cover and steam for 3-4 minutes or just until wilted. Transfer to a large bowl. Repeat with remaining spinach; set aside.
- 2. In a large saucepan, saute onion in butter until tender. Reduce heat to low; stir in the cream cheese, sour cream, half-and-half, 1/3 cup Parmesan cheese, garlic and pepper. Cook and stir until cream cheese is melted. Stir in the artichokes, dill, seasoned salt and spinach.
- 3. Transfer to an ungreased 2-qt. baking dish. Sprinkle with cracker crumbs and remaining Parmesan cheese. Bake, uncovered, for 20-25 minutes or until edges are bubbly.

## Vegetarian Casseroles

### **Brussels Sprouts au Gratin**


#### **Ingredients**

- 2 pounds fresh Brussels sprouts, quartered
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1/2 teaspoon salt, divided
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper, divided
- 3/4 cup cubed sourdough or French bread
- 1 tablespoon butter
- 1 tablespoon minced fresh parsley
- 2 garlic cloves, coarsely chopped
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1/8 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes
- 1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1/2 cup shredded white sharp cheddar or Swiss cheese

### **Directions**

Ozark, Al.

- 1. Preheat oven to 450°. Place Brussels sprouts in a large bowl. Add oil, 1/4 teaspoon salt and 1/8 teaspoon pepper; toss to coat. Transfer to two ungreased 15x10x1-in. baking pans. Roast 8-10 minutes or until lightly browned and crisp-tender. Reduce oven setting to 400°.
- 2. Meanwhile, place bread, butter, parsley and garlic in a food processor; pulse until fine crumbs form.
- 3. Place roasted sprouts in a greased 8-in. square baking dish. In a small bowl, mix cream, pepper flakes, nutmeg, and remaining salt and pepper. Pour over Brussels sprouts; sprinkle with cheese. Top with crumb mixture. Bake, uncovered, 15-20 minutes or until bubbly and topping is lightly browned.





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### **Artichoke Egg Casserole**

### **Ingredients**

- 4 jars (6-1/2 ounces each) marinated artichoke hearts
- 1/2 cup chopped green onions
- 1 tablespoon canola oil
- 2 to 3 garlic cloves, minced
- 8 large eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 jar (4-1/2 ounces) sliced mushrooms, drained
- 3 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese
- 1 cup butter-flavored cracker crumbs (about 25 crackers)

#### **Directions**

- 1. Drain artichokes, reserving 1/2 cup marinade. Set aside. Cut artichokes into slices; set aside. In a small skillet, saute green onions in oil until tender. Add garlic; cook 1 minute longer. Remove from the heat.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine the eggs, artichokes, mushrooms, cheese, cracker crumbs, onion mixture and reserved marinade.
- 3. Transfer to a greased 13x9-in. baking dish. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 35-40 minutes or until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean. Let stand for 5 minutes before cutting.

### **Eggplant Parmesan**

### **Ingredients**

- 3 large eggs, beaten
- 2-1/2 cups panko bread crumbs
- 3 medium eggplants, cut into 1/4-in. slices
- 2 jars (4-1/2 oz.ea.) sliced mushrooms, drained
- 1/2 tsp dried basil
- 1/8 teaspoon dried oregano
- 2 cups shredded part-skim mozzarella cheese
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 jar (28 ounces) spaghetti sauce

### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°. Place eggs and bread crumbs in separate shallow bowls. Dip eggplant in eggs, then coat in crumbs. Place on baking sheets coated with cooking spray. Bake 15-20 minutes or until tender and golden brown, turning once.
- 2. In a small bowl, combine mushrooms, basil and oregano. In another small bowl, combine mozzarella and Parmesan cheeses.
- 3. Spread 1/2 cup sauce into a 13x9-in. baking dish coated with cooking spray. Layer with a third of the mushroom mixture, a third of the eggplant, 3/4 cup sauce and a third of the cheese mixture. Repeat layers twice.
- 4. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 25-30 minutes or until heated through and cheese is melted.

### Black Beans with Bell Peppers & Rice

### **Ingredients**

- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 ea. sweet yellow, orange and red pepper, chopped
- 1 large onion, chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 2 cans (15 ounces each)
   black beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 package (8.8 ounces) ready-to-serve brown rice
- 1-1/2 teaspoons ground cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1-1/2 cups shredded Mexican cheese blend, divided
- 3 tablespoons minced fresh cilantro

#### **Directions**

In a large skillet, heat oil over medium-high heat. Add peppers, onion and garlic; cook and stir 6-8 minutes or until tender. Add beans, rice, cumin and oregano; heat through.

Stir in 1 cup cheese; sprinkle with remaining cheese. Remove from heat. Let stand, covered, 5 minutes or until cheese is melted. Sprinkle with cilantro.


You may have lost your way but Jesus has started a search party for you. Today choose Jesus, He knows where you are.

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### Claybank Master Gardeners

At a recent herb cooking demonstration at the Dale County Extension Office by Linda Franzo, from The Passionate Platter store in Slidell, LA, we learned some things about using herbs that you can use.



 herbs to grow: rosemary, flat parsley,

thyme, fennel, dill, lavender, oregano. sage, basils: lemon, sweet Italian, Thai, Cardinal, Holy basil; lemon herbs: lemon verbena, lemon balm, lemon catmint, lemon grass

- herbs enhance flavors in cooked food, chemical free
- herbs add nutrients to food, especially if a bit of black pepper is added
- herbs do best with little watering
- cut back fully-grown herbs once a week to promote bushy leaves
- they should be harvested and dried upside down by their stems, or laying flat on a paper covered table under a fan
- keep the dried herbs in glass containers

- flavors are more intense when cooking with dried herbs rather than fresh cut herbs
- Petals from the Past in Jemison, AL offers Linda's cooking with herb demonstrations regularly.

#### What to plant this month:

asparagus (crowns, not peppers tomatoes seeds) lima beans cucumbers summer squash snap beans cantaloupe watermelon okra eggplant southern peas sweet potatoes corn winter squash

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


