NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing/presentation of qualified voters of the Kendall Central School District, Orleans and Monroe Counties, Kendall, New York 14476 will be held at the David J. Doyle Kendall Junior-Senior High School, Library, 16887 Roosevelt Highway, Kendall, New York 14476 in said District on Monday, May 6, 2019 at 6:30 P.M. prevailing time, for the presentation of the budget document and introduction of Board of Education candidate(s).

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that said vote and election, will be held on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 9:00 P.M. prevailing time, in the <u>Town of Kendall, Kendall Town Hall, 1873 Kendall Road, New York 14476</u> in said District, at which time the polls will be opened to vote by voting machine upon the following items:

- 1. To adopt the annual budget of the Kendall Central School District for the fiscal year 2019 - 2020 and to authorize the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxable property of the District.
- 2. Transportation

RESOLVED, to authorize the purchase of motor vehicles for use in the transportation program of the District, including passenger buses, and expend therefore an aggregate sum not to exceed \$250,000 and be it further RESOLVED, that the sum of \$250,000 being the aggregate of the aforesaid maximum estimated amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the appropriation of the amount of \$250,000 from the School Bus Reserve Fund with the remainder to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property in the District and collected in annual installments as provided in Section 416 of the Education Law, and in anticipation of such tax, obligations of the District shall be issued: and be it further RESOLVED that the District shall be authorized to enter into one or more purchase contracts, installment purchase contracts or leases with a term of up to five years, and otherwise on terms satisfactory to the Board of Education, with respect to one or more of the vehicles hereby authorized to be acquired.

3. To elect one (1) member of the Board of Education, one for a term of five years commencing July 1, 2019, and expiring on June 30, 2024.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a copy of the statement of the amount of money which will be required to fund the School District's budget for 2019-2020, exclusive of public monies, and the tax exemption report may be obtained by any resident of the District during the fourteen (14) days immediately preceding the school vote and election except Saturday, Sunday or holidays, at the offices of each of the following schoolhouses in which school is maintained during the hours designated: Kendall Elementary School, 1932 Kendall Road, Kendall, New York 14476, 9:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M. prevailing time; Kendall Junior-Senior High School, 16887 Roosevelt Highway, Kendall, New York 14476, 9:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M. prevailing time; and Kendall Central School District Office, 1932 Kendall Road, Kendall, New York 14476, 9:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M. prevailing time.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education shall be filed with the Clerk of said School District at the Clerk's Office in the Kendall Elementary School Building, 1932 Kendall Road, Kendall, New York 14476, not later than April 22, 2019, between 9:00 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. prevailing time. Each petition shall be directed to the Clerk of said District and shall be signed by the greater of at least twenty-five (25) qualified voters of the District or at least 5% of the number of voters who voted in the previous annual election. This petition must state the name and residence of the candidate.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that applications for absentee ballots will be obtainable between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, Monday through Friday, except holidays, from the District Clerk in the District Office at 1932 Kendall Road, Kendall, New York 14476. The District Clerk must receive completed applications at least seven (7) days before the election if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or the day before the election, if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter. Absentee ballots must be received by the District Clerk not later than 5:00 P.M., prevailing time, on Tuesday, May 21, 2019 at the District Office, 1932 Kendall Road, Kendall, New York 14476.

A list of persons to whom absentee ballots are issued will be available for inspection to qualified voters of the District in the Office of the District Clerk at 1932 Kendall, New York 14476, on and after May 21, 2019 between the hours of 9:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, on weekdays prior to the day set for the annual election and on May 21, 2019, the day set for the election, and said list will be posted at the polling place at the election. Any qualified voter present in the polling place may object to the voting of the ballot upon appropriate grounds for making the challenge and the reasons therefore known to the Inspector of Election before the close of the polls.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that the qualified voters of the School District shall be entitled to vote at said annual vote and member election. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States of America, (2) eighteen years of age or older, and (3) resident within the School District for a period of thirty (30) days next preceding the annual vote and election. The School District may require all persons offering to vote at the budget vote and election to provide one form of proof of residency pursuant to Education Law 2018-c. Such forms may include picture identification, a driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill, or a voter registration card. Upon offer of proof of residency, the School District may also require all persons offering to vote to provide their signature, printed name and address.

AND FURTHER NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that pursuant to a rule adopted by the Board of Education in accordance with Sections 2035 and 2008 of the Education Law, any referenda or propositions to amend the budget, or otherwise, to be submitted for voting at said election, must be filed with the Kendall Central School Board of Education at the District Office on or before April 16, 2019 at 4:00 P.M. prevailing time; must be typed or printed in English; must be directed to the Clerk of the School District of the District of voters who voted in the previous annual election; and must state the name and residence of each signer. However, the Board of Education will not entertain any petition to place before voters any proposition the purpose of which is not within the powers of the voters to determine, or any proposition, which fails to include a specific appropriation where the expenditure of monies is required by the proposition.

PHOTOGRAPHING AND OBSERVING

By Douglas H. Domedion

The big migration is over and now nature is rejuvenating. The eagles are busy raising their young, geese are beginning to nest, leaves are starting to come out and many of our early flowers are in bloom. Amazement is all around



A slow approach with a vehicle gave me a nice photo with out disturbing the turkey.

With the arrival this outdoor wonder there

is also a great influx of folks who are eager to see and photograph it all. For many of these people it is a new experience and to make this "adventure" more meaningful and educational there are a few things I would like to pass on to you.

A lot of this observation will be along our roads and safety is the first consideration. Some places just don't have good road shoulders to pull off on and those areas just have to be avoided for your safety and that of others. Route 77 by the Iroquois NWR is one of the places that is extremely dangerous. There are marshes, usually with waterfowl on them, right nest to the road and there is also an osprey nest on a power line pole next to the road. The temptation is great to pull over here, but don't do it! There is not enough road shoulder to pull completely off the road and there are some "blind" spots in this area. Actually, it is illegal to pull off along this stretch of road as the area is saturated with "NO PARKING" signs because it is so dangerous. In fact, there have been a few tickets handed out for this area already. Besides safety the ospreys trying to nest there don't need harassment. Last year the nest was a failure and I suspect it was because people kept stopping "pushing" the birds off the nest.

Another helpful tip is to remain in your car when you spot wildlife and pull over where it is safe to do so. Getting out of your vehicle does several things, it usually scares the wildlife off and you have ruined the observation for someone else. What it does do is make wildlife more intolerant of vehicles, which will ruin future observations, and may cause a nesting failure As far as a good photograph, trying to get "a little closer" will not make much noticeable difference and most of the time you only get a lovely shot of a bird's butt going away. If you want closer shots invest in better photography equipment and LEARN HOW TO USE IT.

Another helpful thing is don't suddenly stop by some wildlife and expect it to remain there. Instead you should use a slow approach. I usually drive by some wildlife subject near the road and then turn around and come back slowly, some times taking 10 or 15 minutes to creep up to a good position, advancing only after the subject is comfortable with my last move. Before I start my "stalk" I have already adjusted my camera settings.

While you are out there be courteous to other nature watchers or photographers who may have already spent a great deal of time "stalking" the subject before you came along. How would you like it after you used a lot of caution and time getting closer to your subject just to have someone suddenly stop by you and scare off the wildlife?

By using a little caution, common sense and ethical action you will get to see nature more and learn more about it which in turn makes you a better naturalist and photographer.

If you really want to get into nature photography you really need to put you hands on some serious equipment (not a smart phone camera). Even more important is learning how to use it. All the automation in cameras today is amazing but in nature photography learning how to adjust your camera for each situation and subject is more important. When you do get a great picture shooting on manual it is much more rewarding then letting the camera make all the decisions, you are just a button pusher. I always shoot in the manual mode and find things come out better my way. It is difficult at first but eventually you will build up a database in your brain that can do better than the automation for all the different situations Mother Nature provides.

A little side bar here: The "immature kids" with vehicles have been tearing up the road sides and refuge overlooks. An effort has gone out recently for law enforcement to nail these asses. Well last week one of them was doing "donuts" in one of the refuge overlooks in broad daylight (not too bright either) and was nailed and it going cost him some big bucks. Two of the law enforcement fellows are pretty determined to catch some of these "brainless children" so I suspect they will be nailing some more in the near future. You can help by getting vehicle descriptions and license plate numbers if you see this activity.

A health care proxy lets you name a trusted person or persons to make health care decisions for you should you become temporarily or permanently unable to think for yourself. The person you empower with this responsibility is called your "agent." We recommend that you also name an "alternate agent" who can fulfill this responsibility if your primary agent is unavailable or cannot be contacted quickly enough in case of an emergency.

Mental side effects
