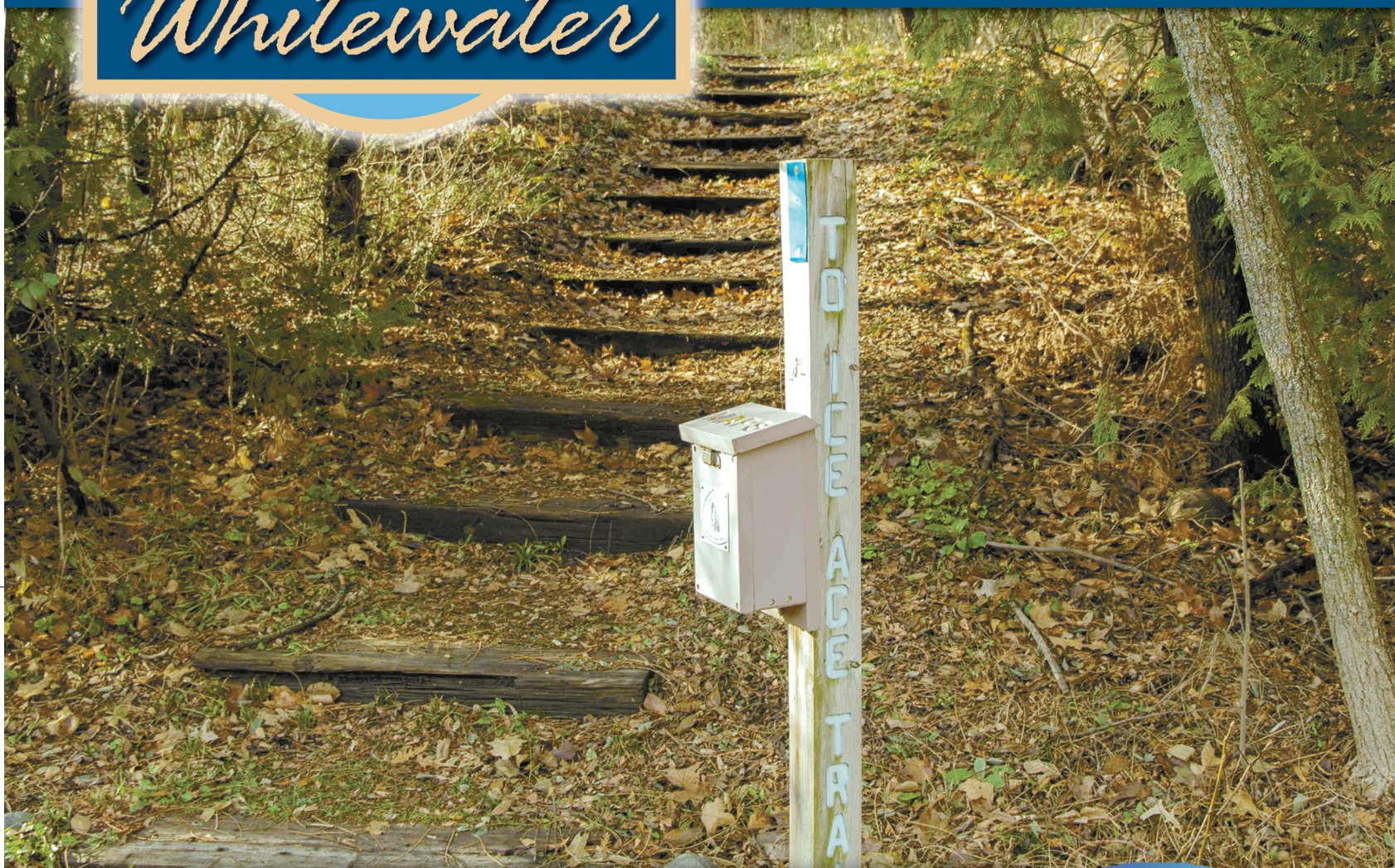

Hiking is a great way to stay active while getting some fresh air, and it's even better with friends! Put on your hiking boots and join Whitewater Tourism on one of the many guided Ice Age Trail hikes or venture out on your own as the trails are well maintained and easy to follow.

Wisconsin's Ice Age Trail is over 1,000 miles of footpaths that was sculpted by the glacial ices that covered our great state. Researchers, Tourists, and local residents visit the trail to look at one of the world's finest examples of glacier history and environmental sculpting. It's amazing to think that sections of the Ice Age trail are right in the backyard of Whitewater!

How do I get to the Ice Age Trail?

The segment of the trail closest to Whitewater can be accessed from highway 12 just before County Road O or plug 7206 us-12 into a GPS. Visit www.iceagetrail.org to locate other parts of the trail.

Milwaukee Street and Newcomb Street Construction Information for 2019

Start: March 2019

Complete: July 2019

Milwaukee St.: will be closed from the west side of the Esterly Street intersection to approx. 300 feet west of Taft Street.

Newcomb St.: Closed from Milwaukee St. to Main Street, including the intersection of Main St. Hwy 59 East traffic will be detoured from the round-about onto Bluff Rd. to Howard Rd. and then thru the Business Park back to Hwy 59.

Hwy 59 West traffic will use the same route in reverse.

Local traffic will be detoured onto Clay St. via Dann St.

Start: July 2019

Complete: November 2019

Milwaukee St. West of Taft St to

round-a-bout Milwaukee St. will be closed from approx. 300 feet west of Taft Street to the round-a-bout at Clay St. and Bluff Rd. The round-a-bout will remain open. Hwy 59 East traffic will be detoured from the round-about onto Bluff Rd. to Howard Rd. and then thru the Business Park back to Hwy 59. Hwy 59 West traffic will use the same route in reverse. Local traffic will be detoured onto Clay St. via Esterly St.

Start: April 2020

Complete: July 2020

Elkhorn Road will be closed from the round-a-bout to Highway 12. The round-a-bout will remain open. Hwy 59 traffic will be detoured using Janesville St., Main St., and Milwaukee St.

Lakes Drawdown and Dredging Project



At the March 5, 2019 City Council meeting, the Common Council

approved plans to move forward with a full drawdown and with the intent for the potential dredging of Cravath and Tripp Lakes. The project will start with the draw down soon after the 4th of July. The dredging phase of the project would take place the winter of 2020/2021. Both lakes would be drawn down through this entire process and would be refilled in the spring of 2021. The hope is to improve water quality and depth as well as reduce aquatic vegetation and eliminate presence of invasive aquatic plant species.

Whitewater Heritage Day

Supports Bassett House Preservation



The Whitewater Federation of Women's Clubs and its partners are delighted to announce that they will sponsor Whitewater Heritage Day on Sunday, June 23, 2019. This event will feature Whitewater's Main Street Historic District. The public is invited to help celebrate the District's 30th anniversary of being listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The district runs from the corner of West Main Street and Prairie Street, east to Fremont Street. It includes the Federation's Bassett House at 708 W. Main Street. This event is a fundraiser and all proceeds from the tour will go to the Federation for maintenance and preservation of the Bassett House. The district also includes Church Street from Main Street south to Center Street.

Whitewater Heritage Day's activities include indoor access to several buildings between 10 am and 4 pm. The Hamilton House will be open from noon until 4 pm. In addition, tour guides in period clothing on Main Street sidewalks within the district will share information between building tours. The 2nd Annual Food Truck Festival in the public library's parking lot will happen from 10 am to 2 pm, there will be a lemonade stand near the Birge Fountain, and an old-fashioned ice cream social at the Bassett House from 1 to 3 pm. Also at the Bassett House will be a silent auction, with funds raised benefiting the house.

Partners include Whitewater Landmarks Commission; Whitewater Historical Society; Whitewater Chamber of Commerce and Tourism Council; Downtown Whitewater, Inc., Whitewater Arts Alliance, Irvin L. Young Memorial Library, and the City of Whitewater's Neighborhood Service and Public Relations / Communications Departments. All proceeds from the Food Truck Festival will benefit the library.

Check out Whitewater Heritage Day on Facebook for more info on tour tickets. And to find out which buildings will be open for touring! At this writing, buildings include the Bassett House, the Engebretsen/Door House (Victoria on Main), the George Esterly House (Delta Zeta Sorority), the Hamilton House, the Smith-Allen House, and the Passenger Depot (Whitewater Historical Society Museum).

The Bassett House has been owned and operated by the Whitewater Federation of Women's Clubs since 1926, when the house was bequeathed to the Federation by member Florence Bassett. Her father, Thomas Bassett, had the home built in 1858, when his lot was described as located on the far western edge of the village of Whitewater. Bassett House is not only included in the Main Street Historic District, it is also a local Landmark protected by municipal ordinance.

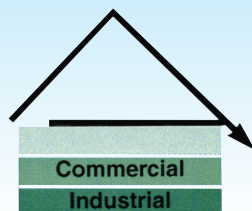

Biking

Love to bike recreationally? Discover the on and off-road bike trails nestled in the heart of the Kettle Moraine. Bikers are guaranteed a challenging yet exciting time while peddling along the Muir and Emma Carlin trails. For those who prefer a ride filled with leisure, check out the Glacial Drumlin trail.



Rotary Skate Park

Are you passionate about skateboarding, bike tricks, or rollerblading? Come enjoy our skatepark equipped with street spines, angled wall rides, and much more! Located at the Brewery Hill Park, the skate park offers a three ramp structure on a 62' x 145' concrete pad.



Fishing

Cast your line into one of our four lakes which range in size from just 68 acres to over 640 acres. The names of the four lakes are Cravath, Rice, Tripp, and Whitewater. These lakes are the perfect place to find small and large mouth bass, pan fish, northern pike and walleye. Charters and boat rentals are available through local boat shops.

Whitewater Aquatic and Fitness Center (580 S Elizabeth Street)

The Aquatic Center of Whitewater is 30,000 square feet of fun and adventure for the whole family. This center features a three store, 120 foot long water-slide, leisure pool, lap pool, lazy river, play structure, and whirlpool. The state-of-the-art fitness center has cardio equipment, free motion exercise equipment, weights, fitness classes and personal training services. 262-473-4900

Kettle Moraine State Forest

The Kettle Moraine State Forest features glacial topography and landmarks that make it one of a kind. Specifically, it has steep-sides ridges, conical hills, kettle-like depressions and flat out wash plains. The Southern unite of the state forest covers 21, 000 acres stretching through southern Wisconsin. It attracts thousands of visitors to bike, hunt, camp, swim, hike, horseback ride, and much more. Explore all of the outdoor wonders that the Kettle Moraine State Forest has to offer!

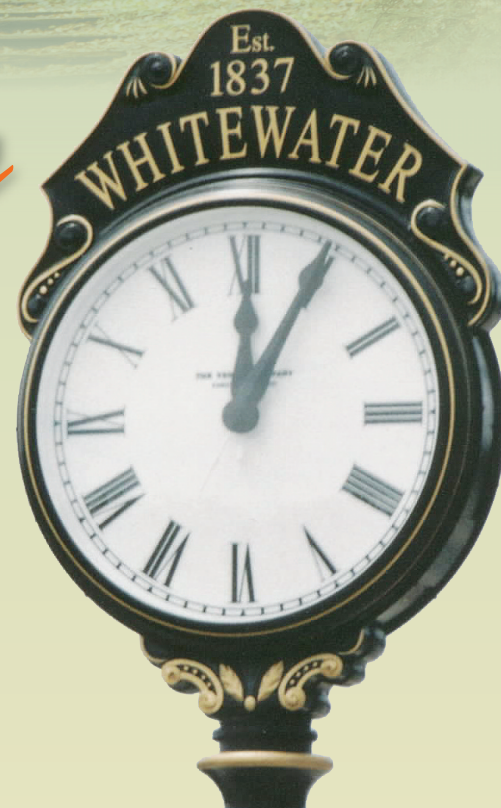


Whitewater Train Depot Museum

301 W Whitewater St

The Whitewater Passenger Depot is home to the Whitewater Historical Society and has been serving as a local history museum since 1974. The depot is a local Whitewater Landmark and is listed in the State and National Registers of Historic Places. The main gallery features Whitewater's history as told through artifacts dating all the way back to 1837. Artifacts are rotated in and out of exhibits, so no two visits are the same.

Whitewater Effigy Mounds Preserve

On the west side of town, there lies a preserve where 30 Native American huts once stood. These huts were constructed and standing between 200 AD and 1200 AD.

Prairie Tillers Mural

On the corner of Center and Whitewater St, you'll find our gorgeous Prairie Tillers Mural by artist Caryl Yasko. Caryl created the mural as a tribute to the Kettle Moraine in 1980. The mural showcases the courage and perseverance from Whitewater's founders as well as our beautiful rolling hills and prairies held sacred by native Americans. The figures on

the right represent people from the tribal era, early settlers, and the people of today. The figures on the left represent the future and how what we do today influences what is to come.



Flowing Well

Visitors come from miles around to quench their thirst at the refreshing Artesian well located two miles south on Clover Valley Road in the town of Whitewater. The water is free and has been flowing steadily since 1895.

Whitewater Historical Walking & Driving Tours

To explore the history of Whitewater, pick up a detailed map of the town at the Chamber office. With these self-tour maps, you can revel in the Whitewater architecture of the late 1800's and transport yourself back in time. Take in the scenery as you travel the Rustic Roads in our area.

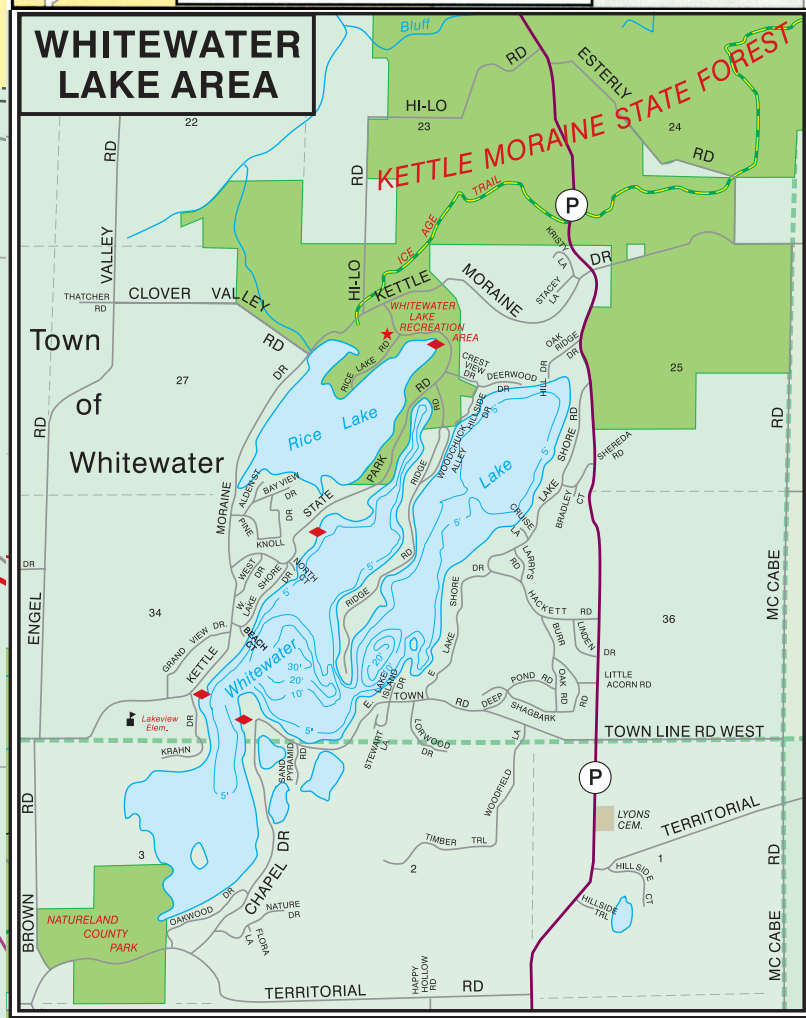

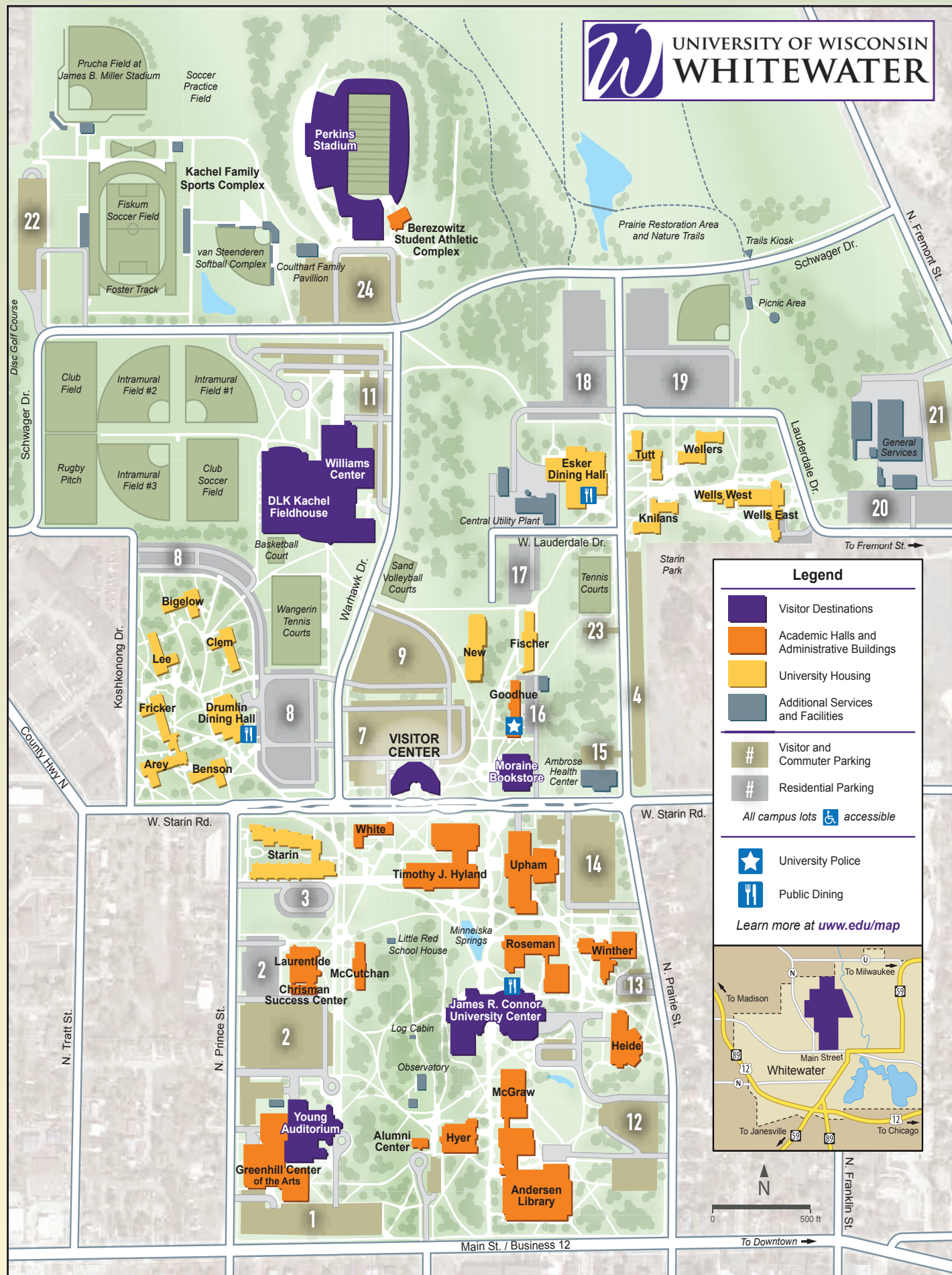

Historical Whitewater

A City Rich in History



When it Began

Whitewater was first established by the Potawatomi Native Americans who settled in the area due to the two streams that converged within the area; this created an area rich with resources and potential. These same natives were the great mound builders who created the burial ground that is now the Whitewater Effigy Mound Preserve (288 S. Indian Mound Parkway).

A City Was Born

Years later, men serving under General Atkinson, including Abraham Lincoln himself, pushed the natives west across the great Mississippi River. In the year 1837, Whitewater was flooded with colonists looking for plots of land to pursue their American dream. The city steadily grew until 1852 when the Milwaukee and Mississippi Railroads chose Whitewater as a stop between Milwaukee and Prairie Du Chien. This caused an explosion of people flooding the streets, bringing commerce and goods right into the city. Not only did it bring people in however, it allowed Whitewater's industries to sell to outside markets causing them to grow and in return hire more workers.

The Year 1881

Whitewater was growing exponentially in the years prior to 1881, but, by the time the year began, a series of snowstorms had devastated the community, leaving the city in a state of peril. Horses and wagons couldn't get down the street and factories couldn't open their doors to their workers. One of the largest snowstorms during this time lasted over 40 hours! In the end, the snow wasn't the worst of it.

Because of the high amount of snow that accumulated during winter, when spring came around, the water flooded the area causing even more havoc and damage. If giant snowbanks and Main Street rivers weren't enough, a number of fires leveled multiple blocks of the downtown area. After building new dams, bridges and infrastructure, Whitewater rebounded and in the process, learned a lesson or two.

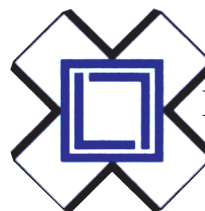

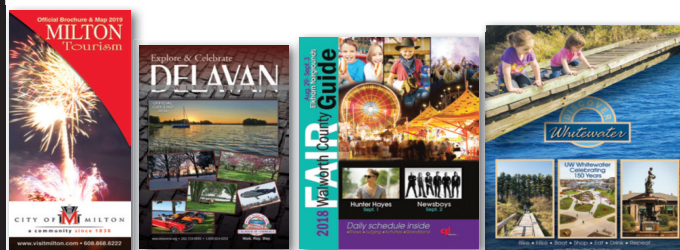
