

Local traffic will be detoured onto Clay St. via Esterly St.

Elkhorn Road will be closed from the round-a-bout to Highway 12. The round-a-bout will remain open. Hwy 59 traffic will be detoured using Janesville St., Main St., and Milwaukee St.

## Lakes Drawdown and Dredging Project



At the March 5, 2019 City Council meeting, WHITEWATER the Common Council

approved plans to move forward with a full drawdown and with the intent for the potential dredging of Cravath and Tripp Lakes. The proiect will start with the draw down soon after the 4th of July. The dredging phase of the project would take place the winter of 2020/2021. Both lakes would be drawn down through this entire process and would be refilled in the spring of 2021. The hope is to improve water quality and depth as well as reduce aquatic vegetation and eliminate presence of invasive aquatic plant species.

# Whitewater Heritage Day Supports Bassett House Preservation



The Whitewater Federation of Women's Clubs and its partners are delighted to announce that they will sponsor Whitewater Heritage Day on Sunday, June 23, 2019. This event will feature Whitewater's Main Street Historic District. The public is invited to help celebrate the District's 30th anniversary of being listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

The district runs from the corner of West Main Street and Prairie Street, east to Fremont Street. It includes the Federation's Bassett House at 708 W. Main Street. This event is a fundraiser and all proceeds from the tour will go to the Federation for maintenance and preservation of the Bassett House. The district also includes Church Street from Main Street south to Center Street.

Whitewater Heritage Day's activities include indoor access to several buildings between 10 am and 4 pm. The Hamilton House will be open from noon until 4 pm. In addition, tour guides in period clothing on Main Street sidewalks within the district will share information between building tours. The 2nd Annual Food Truck Festival in the public library's parking lot will happen from 10 am to 2 pm, there will be a lemonade stand near the Birge Fountain, and an oldfashioned ice cream social at the Bassett House from 1 to 3 pm. Also at the Bassett House will be a silent auction, with funds raised benefiting the house.

Partners include Whitewater Landmarks Commission; Whitewater Historical Society; Whitewater Chamber of Commerce and Tourism Council; Downtown Whitewater, Inc., Whitewater Arts Alliance, Irvin L. Young Memorial Library, and the City of Whitewater's Neighborhood Service and Public Relations / Communications Departments. All proceeds from the Food Truck Festival will benefit the library.

Check out Whitewater Heritage Day on Facebook for more info on tour tickets. And to find out which buildings will be open for touring! At this writing, buildings include the Bassett House, the Engebretsen/Door House (Victoria on Main), the George Esterly House (Delta Zeta Sorority), the Hamilton House, the Smith-Allen House, and the Passenger Depot (Whitewater Historical Society Museum).

The Bassett House has been owned and operated by the Whitewater Federation of Women's Clubs since 1926, when the house was bequeathed to the Federation by member Florence Bassett. Her father, Thomas Bassett, had the home built in 1858, when his lot was described as located on the far western edge of the village of Whitewater. Bassett House is not only included in the Main Street Historic District, it is also a local Landmark protected by municipal ordinance.

#### **Rotary Skate Park**

#### Fishing

Cast your line into one of our four lakes which range in size from just 68 acres to over 640 acres. The names of the four lakes are Cravath, Rice, Tripp, and Whitewater. These lakes are the perfect place to find small and large mouth bass, pan fish, northern pike and walleye. Charters and boat rentals are available through local boat shops.

#### Whitewater Aquatic and Fitness Center (580 S Elizabeth Street)

The Aquatic Center of Whitewater is 30,000 square feet of fun and adventure for the whole family. This center features a three store, 120 foot long waterslide, leisure pool, lap pool, lazy river, play structure, and whirlpool. The state-of-the-art fitness center has cardio equipment, free motion exercise equipment, weights, fitness classes and personal training services. 262-473-4900

#### **Kettle Moraine State Forest**

The Kettle Moraine State Forest features glacial topography and landmarks that make it one of a kind. Specifically, it has steep-sides ridges, conical hills, kettle-like depressions and flat out wash plains. The Southern unite of the state forest covers 21, 000 acres stretching through southern Wisconsin. It attracts thousands of visitors to bike, hunt, camp, swim, hike, horseback ride, and much more. Explore all of the outdoor wonders that the Kettle Moraine State Forest has to offer!

## SPIRIT' TOUR OCTOBER 11 & 12



## Historical Whitewater

## A City Rich in History



#### When it Began

Whitewater was first established by the Potawatomi Native Americans who settled in the area due to the two streams that converged within the area; this created an area rich with resources and potential. These same natives were the great mound builders who created the burial ground that is now the Whitewater Effigy Mound Preserve (288 S. Indian Mound Parkway).

#### A City Was Born

Years later, men serving under General Atkinson, including Abraham Lincoln himself, pushed the natives west across the great Mississippi River. In the year 1837, Whitewater was flooded with colonists looking for plots of land to pursue their American dream. The city steadily grew until 1852 when the Milwaukee and Mississippi Railroads chose Whitewater as a stop between Milwaukee and Prairie Du Chien. This caused an explosion of people flooding the streets, bringing commerce and goods right into the city. Not only did it bring people in however, it allowed Whitewater's industries to sell to outside markets causing them to grow and in return hire more workers.

#### The Year 1881

Whitewater was growing exponentially in the years prior to 1881, but, by the time the year began, a series of snowstorms had devastated the community, leaving the city in a state of peril. Horses and wagons couldn't get down the street and factories couldn't open their doors to their workers. One of the largest snowstorms during this time lasted over 40 hours! In the end, the snow wasn't the worst of it.

Because of the high amount of snow that accumulated during winter, when spring came around, the water flooded the area causing even more havoc and damage. If giant snowbanks and Main Street rivers weren't enough, a number of fires leveled multiple blocks of the downtown area. After building new dams, bridges and infrastructure, Whitewater rebounded and in the process, learned a lesson or two.




