All swimming pools over 24 inches in depth require a permit and must also be equipped with a pool alarm and proper electric and fencing where applicable.

In addition please remember that under local zoning regulations and The NYS Property maintenance code the outdoor storage of junk and rubbish is prohibited in the town of Nunda and shall not be in view from public road or neighboring property. There shall be no more than one unlicensed, unregistered motor vehicle located on any property or stored in view from a highway or neighboring property within the Town of Nunda. There are random inspections of the Town throughout the year and should violations be found a notice of violation with an order to remedy will be issued to the property owner and to any tenant of record on the property.
