Come January, you can still continue to use Windows 7 just as you always have. Nothing will change regarding your experience. However, Microsoft will stop offering security and stability updates; you know,

those "Windows Updates" that bug the stew out of you from time to time. Without those updates, you computer will theoretically become more susceptible to security threats such as viruses.

After a year or so, major browser developers such as Firefox and Chrome will also stop issuing updates. This will eventually result in you not even being able to access your favorite websites.

It also means that manufacturers of peripherals such as printers and add-on

devices will stop providing software for those gadgets. For example, if your printer conks out after January 2020 and you have to purchase a new one, that printer may not come with software that makes it work with your old Windows 7.

So you may find yourself having to upgrade to Windows 10 or buying a new computer whether or not it's a convenient time to do so.

Come January more software vendors will stop offering support for anyone using Windows 7. They won't even talk to you unless you purchase new software. This kind of thing won't really kick into gear for at least another year or three but you need to be thinking ahead if you depend on one kind of software for your hobby or profession.

Business users will witness the biggest impact of this discontinuation. Businesses with 5, 10, or more computers need to start planning for the expense and downtime of upgrading or purchasing new computers.

Many of my clients who are "of a certain age" have been reluctant to adopt Windows 10. I get it. It's different. You'll have to learn a couple of new things for sure. But I'm afraid you're going to need to accept your fate and start learning a new trick in Windows 10.

Microsoft officially discontinued their "free" upgrade from Windows 7 to Windows 10 in 2017. However, tech-savvy readers can still upgrade for free if they know their way around a computer. Unfortunately, the details of how to do this are far too much for my little column, but it can be done. Windows 10 does generally run faster than Windows 7--even on old hardware--so upgrading can breath new life into your old computer. Plan ahead!



s of May 3, the Democratic Republic of Congo's Ministry of Health reported 1,510 cases of Ebola and 1,008 deaths in the country's current outbreak. Partial blame for the government's inability to contain the outbreak

oes to armed attackers who believe that international health workers are there to intentionally spread the disease, not treat it.

As of April 26, the US Centers for Disease Control reported 704 cases of measles and no known deaths in the country in 2019. Partial blame for the outbreak goes to Americans who fail to vaccinate themselves or their children.







According to my limited reading, many of those claims are not supported by science.

In fact, I've probably had more vaccines than you. I got the usual vaccinations as a child. Then more when I joined the Marine Corps, and still more when I deployed overseas. The only time I complained was when I was ordered (under threat of courtmartial for refusal) to accept an experimental anthrax vaccine from a tube marked DO NOT USE ON HUMANS in Saudi Arabia at the beginning of Desert Storm.

Vaccines as such don't bother me a bit. But, I believe that you are entitled to decide what may or may not be put into your own body. If you choose to forgo any or all vaccinations, that's your choice to make for yourself and for your children or wards.

It is an undisputed fact of that there ARE risks associated with vaccination. They are rare and usually minor, along the lines of allergic reactions, but they exist and they are occasionally fatal.

Who should get to decide whether those risks are acceptable is the person into whose arm the needle is to be injected, or that person's guardian.

Yes, it is an initiation of force and should be treated as a crime to knowingly or negligently transmit an infectious disease to others. If you are aware that you have the measles or some other infection, you should avoid contact with the public. And I have no real problem with *central Florida*. quarantine laws enforcing (Twitter: @thomaslknapp) that.

But the current hysteria over a small number of cases of a usually non-fatal disease is bringing out the worst in Americans. By "the worst," I mean calls for government to force vaccinations on the unwilling.

We mustn't let measles hysteria defeat freedom. Measles is bad. Tyranny is worse.





One thing that every attorney should do every time is put the client first. A lawyer should add value to the case and one of the things that personal injury lawyers do is find more money.

We almost always know who caused the accident and whether or not they are insured. 





Dear Dave,

I'll be retiring in the next couple of years. When I leave my job, we will have a yearly income of \$65,000 through my pension. I don't think we need an emergency fund with such a dependable, steady income stream like that, but my wife disagrees. She says she would feel safer if we had money set aside just for the unexpected. What do you think we should do?

Gary

Dear Gary,

A good pension can feel pretty solid, but nothing's perfect. Nothing lasts forever. There's always the possibility of lost income or large, unexpected expenses. What if one of you has a major medical event? Life can bite you at any time, and sometimes it will take a big financial chunk out of you. You absolutely need an emergency fund!

I recommend an emergency fund of three to six months of expenses. Put it in a good money market account with check writing privileges and a decent interest rate. That way, your money will work for you a little bit. With a solid pension like you're talking about, you could probably lean toward the three-month side, if you wanted. Honestly though,



I'd save up six months of expenses—just in case. Trust me, a fully funded

Trust me, a fully funded emergency fund will make you both feel better. Plus, it can turn a disaster into nothing more than an inconvenience! —Dave

ABOVE AND BEYOND

Dear Dave,

The school system I work for puts 12 percent of my pay into a public teacher retirement fund, and they match this amount. I've seen where you tell people to put 15 percent of their income toward retirement. If that's the case, should I put three percent into another retirement fund? I have no debt and very little in terms of expenses. Or, what would you think about the idea of opening another retirement

I wouldn't go as far as to pour an additional 15 percent into a different retirement plan, but I definitely would consider putting maybe eight to 10 percent into a Roth IRA. I want you to have some money that's separate from the school system account,

just in case things go south with their retirement fund. It sounds like you've got a pretty good pension plan, but you never know what

but you never know what might happen. I'm not predicting bad things, but at the same time there's no way I'd lean on the school system fund as my one and only source of retirement income. You should never put all your financial eggs in one basket!

There are three ways your doctor can be paid if you are on Medicare. The three ways are through Medicare assignment, Medicare excess charges or by not taking Medicare at all. Today we will discuss these three methods.

The most common way a physician gets paid is by Medicare assignment. These physicians are called "participating doctors". After the Part B deductible of \$185 is met, participating doctors will accept the Medicare approved amount for their services. These doctors charge Medicare 80% and the beneficiary 20% of the cost of the benefit. For example, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, and you would be responsible for the other 20%, or \$20.

A "non-participating doctor" can choose to accept or not accept Medicare assignment. If the doctor does not accept Medicare assignment you may have to pay an additional 15% of the cost of the service the doctor provided. This is call a Medicare excess charge. It means you would be responsible for 35% of the Medicare reduced amount instead of 20%. If we follow the example in the previous paragraph, if your doctor charges \$200 for a service and Medicare only approves \$100, Medicare would pay 80%, or \$80, but you would be responsible for 35%, or \$35.

Doctors who opt out of Medicare can charge whatever they want for their services and you are responsible of 100% of the cost. The majority of doctors in north Alabama accept Medicare, so you won't be faced with this situation very often.

Most people who have Medicare also have a supplemental policy that helps cover the 20% Medicare doesn't cover. If you are just entering Medicare and would like to know which policies cover what Medicare doesn't pay, you can contact our office for more information.
