





STARTING YOUR **OWN BUSINESS**

Those starting businesses should know that the simplest form of business is a "sole proprietorship," which is not a legal entity and simply refers to a person who owns a business and is personally responsible for its debts. While this popular business form is easy and inexpensive to set up, the owner of a sole proprietorship remains personally liable for all the business's debts. A "corporation" is separate from its owner, which means that, with some exceptions, it is shielded from personal liability. The "limited liability company" (LLC), which is also protected from personal liability, is not required to adhere to corporate formalities such as annual meetings, recording meeting minutes, electing directors, and issuing stock certificates.








MAKING A BIRD **PARADISE**

Last week I related to you how my little bird paradise was over come with new arriving birds next to my living room window. This didn't happen by chance, I have been feeding birds all year round for years and some definitely remember where the "free" stuff is from year to year.

So how can you have a enjoyable bird paradise by your house? Well, I will tell you what has worked for me for many years. I start by putting up a high "T" post of 1-inch pipe to hang the bird feeders on. The "T" is formed with a "T" coupling at the top of the pipe and a tight fitting sapling stuck through that coupling to hang out about a two feet from each end. The "T" ends being about 8 feet from the ground. In order not to bum up the threads on the top end of the pipe for the coupling I drive a

larger pipe into the ground first and then the 1-inch pipe can be placed in that pipe. A screw placed on each end of that sapling keeps the feeders from slipping off should the wind get them

Now where do you place that feeding pole? Well, it needs to be place far enough (10 or 12 feet) from any trees, bushes or buildings that a squirrel can leap to the feeder from them. These guys are very clever and will consume most of your bird food if you don't address them.

The final addition to the feeding pole is a good cone guard about half way up the 1-inch pipe that will prevent the squirrel from climbing to the feeders. The pole itself can be place close to the house (for close bird observation) as long as the squirrels can not use the house to gain access to the feeder (like diving off the roof).

Now that we have solved the squirrel problem. They will still come, but will be limited to what the birds spill off the feeder. What do we put in the feeders? I use only black flower sunflower seeds. Yes, the shells falling to the ground after the birds bust open the seeds, to get the hearts, do make a mess, but most birds really love them. I buy mine in 50-pound bags from a feed store usually waiting for a special sale. Avoid those "birdseed mixes" as there gets to be a lot of junk seed in them that does not attract the birds we want to see.

So one side of the "T" pole has the sunflower seed feeder hanging from it and on the other side I hang a whole peanut feeder or this time of the year a grape and hummer feeder. Some where up there a wire cage of suet is also hung for the woodpeckers.

Now when the orioles show up I hang a homemade grape jelly feeder (fruit cup in a hole in aa 8-inch square piece of plywood). Fine wire coming from each corner of the plywood is twisted together to form a loop will aid in hanging the feeder up. If you have enough over hang on your roof you can hang it from a hook under it right next to the window for really close observation!

The hummingbird feed can be hung from the over hang of the roof also or on one of those shepherd hooks you push in the ground. I prefer the over hanging roof as the squirrels like that sugar water so you will need a squirrel guard on the shepherd pole. Of course you could hang it on your "T" pole too, but I prefer to get those little guys really close to the window!

One other problem you will probably get is ants. They have a way of finding those oriole and hummingbird feeders. Solve this problem by making some "water moats" to hang between the feeder and whatever you hang the feeder from. I make these from those small plastic cups that the cocktail fruit comes in. I take a stiff piece of wire and stick it though a hole drilled in the bottom of the cup. A loop is made at the top to hang it from and a hook at the bottom to hang the feeder from. I use a silicon glue to seal around the wire and cup so it will not leak the water you will put in it. When the ants climb down the wire they can not get any farther because of the water moat!

Now those feeders are high so I use a pole with a hook on the end to raise and lower the feeders from the places they are hung from.

You are now set up to have a bird paradise right next to your window; just keep the feeders filled and I ensure you that you will enjoy their company year round like I do. One other thing, change the sugar water about every five days in the hummingbird feeder to ensure it is not going bad and hurting the hummers. Clean them thoroughly each time to you refill

How to Employ Staging to Impress Buyers



Brandied Baked Ham with Mustard Butter

(Serves 16 to 20; makes about 2 cups mustard butter)



For the ham:

1 1/2 cups packed dark brown sugar

1/4 cup brandy

2 tablespoons grainy mustard

15-pound bone-in, half ham, fully cooked

1 1/2 teaspoons whole cloves

In a small saucepan, stir to combine the brown sugar, brandy and mustard. Bring the mixture to a boil over medium-high heat and, stirring constantly, cook until the glaze is thick and syrupy, about 3 minutes. Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator for up to 2 days or use immediately

Preheat the oven to 325 F. Line a shallow roasting pan with heavy-duty aluminum foil and place a wire rack on top.

Score the fat on top of the ham by making diagonal cuts in a diamond pattern. Insert the cloves into the intersections of each diamond. Place the ham on the rack. Insert a meat thermometer, making sure it doesn't touch the bone. Bake the ham for about 1 hour, or until the thermometer registers 125 F.

Remove the ham and brush on the brandy glaze. Return the ham to the oven and cook for 20 to 30 minutes more, or until the thermometer registers 135 F. Let it stand for 15 minutes. (The meat temperature will rise to 140 F).

For the mustard butter:

2 cups butter, softened

1/4 cup grated sweet onion

1/4 cup Dijon or Creole mustard

In a medium bowl, stir to combine the butter, sweet onion and mustard. Scrape it into a serving bowl.

Cut the ham into thin slices and build your sandwiches (or serve slices on their own on a platter). Offer with accompanied bowl of mustard butter.


