which makes no distinction between consensual and forced sex. The state Senate approved it by a 25-6 vote with one abstention. The bill passed without exemptions in cases of rape and incest. The law will take effect in six months and includes very stiff prison sentences for medical professionals who violate provisions of the act.

Alabama is now the most pro-life state in the union. Some like that designation; some abhor it.

Republican Rep. Terri Collins from Decatur sponsored the bill which received national attention during the House deliberations. "This bill is about challenging Roe v. Wade and protecting the lives of the unborn, because an unborn baby is a person who deserves love and

protection," Collins said.
Since the bill includes the position that all unborn lives are sacred and created at conception, it can't arbitrarily exclude a life created through an act of violence.



Relatives of service members who were killed in American wars are especially invited to attend. Veterans are also encouraged to attend as a show of respect for their fallen comrades.

The ceremony include posting the colors, singing of the National Anthem, reciting the Pledge of Allegiance, laying of a wreath, the release of white-doves, a 21-gun salute, and the playing of Taps.

Heroes The ⁻ Fallen

Memorial will also be dedicated at the ceremony and two new memorial monuments will unveiled.

This memorial is located on the north side of the Veterans Memorial in a sunken-garden setting. Its purpose is to establish a permanent memorial for all the Lauderdale County citizens who gave their lives in defense of our Nation. The names of the 225 fallen heroes are listed on five permanently installed memorial markers, displayed by wars: WW I (46), WW II (131), Korean War (21), and Vietnam War (33). 

A Course In "Adulting"?

I was sitting in my recliner while reading the other day. My wife also had the TV on in the background tuned into the news. So while I was reading, I had one ear screening the news stories. Before long, one of those news stories captured my full attention.

Apparently there is a popular trend now for young adults (namely, "Millennials) to enroll in classes for "Adulting." So, what is "Adulting"? Well, the name is pretty self-explanatory- - it is learning how to be an adult. As the feature explained, "Adulting classes teach millennials basic

skills like sewing, cooking, how to handle their finances, how to deal with relationships,

I could not help but stop and give thought to this "Adulting" phenomenon. Of course, there is nothing wrong with the concept. If you do not know how to be an adult, and you are one, you have to learn somehow! But my thinking was more along the lines of wondering "Why is there such a growing need in our day for classes about being an

I doubt that this is the definitive answer, but if I had to sum it up in one word it would be "time." Most of the instruction for youngsters in learning how to be adults- - comes from adults- - primarily our parents. Some of it comes through verbal instruction, but a lot of it comes through osmosis. Both take a lot of time which is often lacking between parents and their kids in our day.

Several years ago, Cornell University did a study on contact time between parents and their children. In the study they wired average middle-income fathers for a couple of weeks to record how much actual interaction time they spent with their kids. Their study concluded that the average time was 37.7 seconds a day! I have seen other studies that were slightly better, but even so, the contact times were still astonishingly short.

To take this thought a step further, the lack of time between parents and children also takes its toll on spiritual maturity. Note God's words to Israel about spiritual training in the long ago: "These words which I command you today shall be in your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children, and you shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up..." (Deuteronomy 6:6ff). One key ingredient for fulfilling this command is once again, time.

May God help us as parents- - and may God help us as Christians to take the time to mentor those who follow in our footsteps (cf. Ephesians 5:15-17).

Not a Good **Decision**

Editor:

Recently, it was reported by the *TimesDaily* that over the next 22 months UNA will spend \$17 million to cut utilities by 20%. The article stated, "There are about 70 facilities campus-wide that will get improvements."

This spending will provide a 'guaranteed savings' of \$24 million over the next 20 years. The estimated net savings over the 20 years is \$7 million (24m-17m). I am assuming that future rate increases over the next 20 years will be factored into the 'guaranteed savings.' As work is completed work each facility a certain amount of the funds need to be retained by UNA as part of these guaranteed savings. A different light bulb may reduce costs but the extra cost of the bulbs must be considered.

This \$17 million contract is not a good business decision on UNA's part. The contract should have been for two or three facilities. After the work is completed, wait three or four months and determine if the savings are there. If yes, then follow the same procedure for another two or three facilities.

The article stated that UNA and the contractor are 'partnering' in the project. Does this mean bids were not received? The contractor is located in Huntsville. Were local contractors allowed the opportunity to become partners with UNA on this project? The city of Florence recently gifted UNA with land for a proposed new baseball facility. Helping each other should not be one way!

UNA's administration wants a new baseball facility, a new football facility, and they have entered into a contract for \$17 million that will be paid over the next 22 months. This is an awful lot to be taken on by UNA.

Medicare Minute "Medicare Supplements"

Medicare supplements, also known as Medigap policies, are designed to help cover some or all of the deductibles, copays and coinsurance that Original Medicare does not cover. Medigap policies are sold through private insurance companies.

In Alabama these insurance companies can sell you only a "standardized" policy identified by a letter, such as Plan F. The most common supplemental plans in Alabama are Plans A, B, F, G and N. The term "standardized" means that Medicare requires all plans with a particular letter to have the same basic benefits regardless of the company selling it. For example, a Plan G with one company has to have the exact basic benefits as Plan G with every other company selling it.

Two things to keep in mind when shopping for a Medigap policy. First is the premium. Different insurance companies can charge different premiums for the exact same policy. This means you could pay more for your Medigap policy from one company than you would from other companies offering the same basic benefits. It's a good idea to check with someone who can show you the premiums from several companies to be sure you're getting the best premium for you coverage.

The second thing to keep in mind is the type of Medigap policy you are looking at. Some companies offer a Medicare SELECT policy. SELECT policies may require you to use a defined network of providers to receive full coverage, meaning you may not have full coverage from a provider even though the provider accepts Medicare. A standard Medigap policy will allow you to go to any provider that accepts Medicare. If you are not sure about the type of Medigap policy you are looking at, or its premium, you can contact or come by our office for help.

My fiancé and I just started your class, but we're having trouble getting our beginner emergency fund together. We both work full-time, and I make \$59,000 a year while he has worked in read one several years and makes \$22,000 to \$25,000. I'm trying to manage a couple of side jobs, but we just can't seem to get our budget to work in a way that will allow us to save anything. Can you help us?

First of all, your finances remain separate until you're married. There's shouldn't be a "we" in terms of money at this point. You can always run a single budget that vou both look at and prepare for after you're married, but right now he shouldn't be

paying your bills and you shouldn't be paying his bills. The biggest problem I see is that he's making no money. He needs to get a better job. He can't pay his bills, and in the process, he's sucking you dry. I'm sure your fiancé is a good, hard-working man, but he needs to make a serious career shift soon—like now!

In the meantime, this guy needs to take on a part-time job or two until he gets that career shifted. It's not really a budgeting problem you're looking at. It's an income issue.

DIVERSIFY ADVISORS?

Dear Dave,

We're wondering if we should diversify our investments by hiring multiple advisors with different companies, so we won't have all our eggs in one basket. Your thoughts would be appreciated.

Dear Marya, I would get one advisor, and I wouldn't invest all my mutual funds in one fund category. Virtually all mutual fund advisors can sell pretty much any mutual fund, and you can buy an array of different mutual funds from different companies through one advisor. That gives you diversification. So, there's really no advantage in having multiple advisors, unless you don't trust someone's advice. And if you don't trust someone's advice, why are you working with them in the first place?

I personally have one financial advisor, and I trust that person. Still, I ask lots of questions and make sure I understand everything that's going on with my money and the investment before making a decision. Why are you recommending this? What is it about them you like? Show me the fund and how it compares to the S&P and other

funds in the same category. If you approach it this way, and again, you have one advisor, it's a learning process and you become a more educated investor. Plus, after a while you can create your own diversification. *Never* put money into something you don't fully understand!

Road Work Ahead, **Expect Delays**

There you are... just be-bopping down the interstate and all of a sudden you see brake lights for miles. The worst part of a traffic delay is when you can't see what has you stopped and you have no idea how long

you're going to be there.

In the real estate world, we deal with time frames on most everything. From the number of days allowed for the home inspection to the actual number of days until the deal has to close, time is always counting. Unfortunately, we sometimes face delays that we have no control over. Whether it's a loan problem or a title issue, sometimes problems arise that just couldn't have been prevented.

Often times however, the delay could have been expected. Similar to the roadside sign on the interstate, there are usually red flags that tell you when you might need to be looking out for possible delays.

For example: If a buyer is doing a VA or Rural Housing loan, it's best to allow a little extra time for the closing to take place. Most agents will allow 45 to 60 days to close instead of the customary 30-day period when such a loan is being used. This is not a negative jab at those loan programs; it's merely a fact that certain loan programs take longer to close. If everyone is aware of this on the front end, everyone is still happy on the back end.

Scheduling a real estate closing, coordinating moving in/ moving out, transferring utilities and all of the other things involved are sometimes tricky enough. Trying to do those things without knowing when you're going to close is even tougher.

It's much better to agree to close in 60 days and then find out you can close in 40 days than it is to think you're closing in 30 days and find out it's going to be 60. The tough part of the latter is that you don't find out on day 30 that you need 30 more days. Usually, you are asked to extend for a week or a few days, then another week, and another week, and so on... It's a logistical nightmare.

Look for red flags up front that you feel might cause you an issue or delay down the road. It's like the old saying goes, "Pay me now or pay me later"... This is most certainly true with time as well as money. -mr



I was hit in a parking lot by a teenager who was on her cell phone and not looking at all when she backed into me. She was still on her cell phone when she got out of the car. The police would not make a report because it was on private property and I only have liability insurance. The whole situation makes me very angry. Is there anything I can do to prove that she was on her cell phone and not paying attention? Johnny, Florence, AL

Parking lot accidents really cause problems for people who don't have full coverage insurance. I am not suggesting that everyone should have full coverage insurance. In fact, I spoke to a young lady who had bought a 12 year old Jaguar and was paying \$200 a month for full coverage insurance. Those cars can be bought for \$5000 and I don't

know that the math works out to pay full coverage for a car that can be replaced relatively inexpensively.

Property damage only cases that have less than \$5000 in

damage to the car should go to small claims court. It is not economically feasible to hire me to go to small claims court for a \$2000 or \$3000 case. By the time you pay the attorney's fee, your net result isn't enough to pay for the repairs for your vehicle. Small claims court is designed for non-lawyers to prepare reasonably well with common sense evidence and witnesses and present their case to a judge who makes a decision, in writing, typically after the parties leave.

Small claims court does not automatically allow "discovery". Discovery in the legal sense means or includes depositions, written questions that are to be answered under oath and subpoenas. In a regular automobile accident case that we would handle, a case involving a person who was hurt, we would be very interested in obtaining the cell phone number and the carrier (AT&T, Verizon, Sprint) so that we could issue for a subpoena to find out whether or not the person at fault was either talking or texting at the time of the accident.

That brings up a point that should be made. We use repair bills, medical bills and the other side's phone records to prove our case. We photograph skid or scuff marks from the accident scene and we use the physical evidence from the damage to the vehicle for the jury to consider. The problem is people that are really hurt aren't out snapping pictures of the car that hit them and writing down the exact time of the accident.

You will be able to testify that you saw the person on the phone. You will be able to describe or show photographic evidence of where the impact on your car was. You will be able to testify as to your version of how the accident happened. You will need to know the value of your car before the accident and after the accident and you should have a person who regularly repairs cars to testify as to how it will cost to repair your car present in court. Unfortunately, I do not believe that you will be able to prove, other than through your testimony, that the person that hit you was a distracted driver.


