





The guest speaker will be Commander Denny Perry and the Parade Grand Marshall will be Clifford Phipps.

"Putting for Patriots" Event to be Held Mid-May Through Memorial Day Weekend

Pirate's Cove Adventure Golf, Arnolds Park, will host the Thirteenth Annual Putting for Patriots fundraiser from Friday, May 10 through Monday, May 27. Arnolds Park Amusement Park officially opened Saturday, May 18, for the 2019 season. The Iowa icon will be open Saturday

and Sunday, 10:00am to 7:00pm, and then open daily starting Friday, May 24. This weekend the park is offering a discounted rate of \$25 per park day pass.

The Park has seen

The Park has seen many changes over the past few years. Park goers this weekend will see a new ride being installed. The Wild Mouse



will make its return to the park in June. The maintenance staff is hard at work to get the ride, which was purchased from Joyland Park in Texas, put together and have it operational in the near future. Other ride renovations include the train which had a full renovation with a new motor, new paint design, and new wheels. Also refurbished in the off-season were the Apples ride and new paint and stickers on the Ferris Wheel gondolas.

Last year a new carousel from Chance Rides was donated to the park and enjoyed by many. Last year also saw the addition of the Arnolds Park Museum and in it the return of the Sugar Bowl, Barrel and Slide from the Fun House which was a part of the park over 30 years ago. The Slide can be ridden with a day pass or season membership or for just \$1 per ride.

Along with the new rides that have been acquired, park attendees can also partake in new food items. The Fun House Diner inside the park has added fried pickles, onion petals, and mini tacos. Benet's Confections has added Boji Snickers (a deep-fried Snickers bar) and a new twist on an Indian Taco. Of course, park goers can always get all of the regular park fare. Funnel cakes, hot dogs, hamburgers, French Fries, popcorn, caramel corn, philly cheesesteak, gyros, lemonade, and ice cream are all part of the regular menu at park food facilities.

Many of the changes over the past few years are due to the Restore the Park campaign. The park fund raising committee has been raising funds not only in the community but throughout the nation. Phase 1 of the campaign saw the addition of a new parking lot, new in park restrooms, new park administrative offices, and infrastructure work in 2017. Phase 2 in 2018, in addition to the park museum, included new office space for Okoboji Tourism and the Okoboji Foundation, the renovation of The Majestic Pavilion, a new ticket office, and new space for the Iowa Rock and Roll Museum.

Phase 3 going on now includes a much-anticipated new Roof Garden, new lakeside restrooms, and recently announced new parking lot to be completed by early July. Imagine Iowa Great Lakes is also working on a beautification project on Preservation Plaza which should be completed in June. "It is such an exciting time at the park. The improvements that have already been made are tremendous and the construction going on right now will only add to that." said park CEO Jeff Vierkant.

Day passes and season memberships to Arnolds Park can be purchased at arnoldspark.com. The \$25 discounted rate for this weekend can be made at the ticket office.





Now a standard, the song was written by Larry Shay, William Jerome, and Charles Tobias, and was more recently recorded by Nat 'King' Cole, the recently deceased

Doris Day, and Michael Feinstein, among others. It was also used in commercials for the American Apollo Program.

Those who have been saying through the winter months, 'There's nothing to do," will now have to change their tunes and Get Out... to recall some of the great big band melodies starting Monday night at the Pearson Lakes Art Center, where *The Dick Bauman Big Band* is scheduled to play from 7 - 9:00, every Monday night from Memorial Day through and

RAMBO-ling BOB RAMBO

According to research director RD, today is Memo Day — noting something that reminds us of something important, for which Burt Bacharach and Hal David get an "A" for their songwriting efforts on "There's always something there to remind me of you." R. B. Graves had the biggest hit with the song in 1970 — several years after Dionne Warwick struck gold with it in

Thursday is Lucky Penny Day, for which Rosemary Clooney gets the nod with her recording of *Pennies From Heaven*, a song written by Arthur Johnson and Johnny Burke, in 1936 — the year Bing Crosby recorded his version. Rosie's recording came in her 1978 Bing Crosby tribute album. 'Guess we should also note that May 23rd is the day Rosie was born in 1928..

Daniel Gabriel Fahrenheit was born on May 24, 1686, and noted to be the physicist who invented the thermometer — and the Fahrenheit scale. The song Too Darn Hot, written by Cole Porter for the musical Kiss Me Kate, has been recorded by many artists such as Sarah Vaughn (1949), Mel Tormé, (1960), and Stacey Kent in 2003 — the same year it was used as background music in an Adidas television commercial.

The musical *Mame* opened for 1,508 performances on May 24, 1966. Jerry Herman wrote the music for the show, including the song, It's Today. A favorite for Marilyn Maye's audiences, the song was performed on Broadway by Angela Lansbury. Thirty years later it was covered by Ann Hampton Callaway and her sister Liz Callaway on their CD, Sibling Rivalry...

Friday is also Tiara Day. While she may never have worn a tiara, Ella Fitzgerald, the Queen of Jazz, received early recognition for her first single with the 1935, 78 RPM recording of I'll Chase The Blues Away, made with the Chick Webb Orchestra, on the Decca label..

Sing Out Day comes on Saturday. And RD is singing with a swing with Louis Prima's 1936 tune, Sing, Sing, Sing (With a Swing), and used by Benny Goodman in his 1938 Carnegie Hall jazz concert — the first jazz concert at Carnegie Hall. The King of Swing's recording lasted more than 8 minutes and required both sides of a 12-inch, 78 RPM disc!

The aforementioned lyricist Hal David was born on May 25th, 1921, and is best known for his collaborations with Burt Bacharach and his association with Dionne Warwick — especially on the song, *There's Always Something There to*

Weather permitting, you could have a lot of fun celebrating Paper Airplane Day on Sunday — while singing Straighten Up and Fly Right. Written by Nat 'King' Cole and Irving Mills, the song was first recorded by the *King Cole Trio* in 1944. Twenty-two years later, *Straighten Up...* was re-released on vinyl by another trio, featuring pianist Oscar Peterson.

Linda Ronstadt covered the song in 1986. And Diana Krall used it on her 1993 debut album, *Stepping Out*, which is what we're doing right now — to go make a paper plane...

Letter To The Editor:

Our agency was pleasantly surprised by a donation we received from the Good Neighbor Fund of the Okoboji and Spirit Lake Territories. We want to openly express our thanks to everyone who may have donated to such a cause. Centers Against Abuse & Sexual Assault (CAASA) provides services to sexual assault/ abuse survivors by offering 24 hour crisis intervention services, crisis counseling services, transportation services, information and referral services, legal and personal advocacy, mentoring, and other additional services for victims of abuse. All of the services we provide are free to victims of abuse. The funds CAASA received will go directly back to victim services.

Annually, April was Sexual Assault Awareness Month (SAAM). This year's theme, "I ASK" builds on the idea that consent is everything. Asking for consent is a healthy, normal, and necessary part of everyday interactions. Consent is always about choosing to respect the personal and emotional boundaries of others. It is important for individuals to think about how their actions might make others feel and ask questions if they don't know. When an individual wants to get close to someone. whether it is someone they are hooking up with for the first time or a partner in a committed relationship, it is important to know how to ask for consent. Nearly one in five women and one in 71 men are victims of sexual assault (Black et al., 2011), but all of us are impacted by sexual violence not only during the month of April, but throughout the year.

Everyone understands that sexual violence impacts victims and their families, but the effects of this violent crime on communities and society are less obvious. Sexual violence creates a climate of fear, anger, and/or disbelief in the workplace, campuses, and communities that it occurs in. Additionally sexual violence generates criminal justice, medical, and crisis and mental health service expenses. Perhaps most damaging are the lost contributions of survivors. All of us can practice consent in our lives by asking permission before assuming and showing respect for others' choices. When it comes to sex, it is important that everyone is on the same page, and the best way to do that is by directly asking for consent.

We can teach this culture of respect and asking in all facets of our lives. Communities and businesses can take action to implement policies that promote safety, respect, and equality. CAASA provides all of these services, presentations, and information to our local businesses free of charge. Please, join us in helping everyone see their role in preventing sexual violence the rest of the year as well. Once again, we are grateful to the donors of the Good Neighbor Fund. 35th Annual Flagfest Will Host Family Entertainment







Kiwanis Club Hosts Bumgarner





Gardner Sharp's memories of that place were tainted when tragedy occurred in March 1857. Misunderstandings between settlers and Native Americans sparked an atrocity that is still remembered today.

Individuals on both sides were killed. The lives of young and old were taken. But one little girl survived to tell the tale.

Abbie Gardner was 13 when she was kidnapped during the Spirit Lake Massacre and lived with the Wahpekute band for months before she was traded back for two horses, 12 blankets, two kegs of powder, 20 pounds of tobacco, 32 yards of cloth ribbon and other articles.

When she later returned to Pillsbury Point as Abbie Gardner Sharp, she opened a museum to tell her story. Her legacy is still intact as the history of the Spirit Lake Massacre is recalled at the Abbie Gardner Cabin & Museum in Arnolds Park each year.

The State Historical Society of Iowa site opens for the season Friday, May 24, and is open noon-4:00pm, Tuesday-Sunday through Labor Day weekend.

Abbie Gardner Cabin Opening

of West Lake Okoboji.

'With inexpressible sadness I now recall some of the scenes and events that transpired in that humble but happy home..."Abbie Gardner Sharp wrote in "History of the Spirit

Lake Massacre." Her sister reading aloud to the family. Her father helping

the kids with schoolwork. Her mother crocheting.

Gardner Sharp's memories of that place were tainted when tragedy occurred in March 1857. Misunderstandings between settlers and Native Americans sparked an atrocity that is still remembered today.

Individuals on both sides were killed. The lives of young and old were taken. But one little girl survived to tell the tale.

Abbie Gardner was 13 when she was kidnapped during the Spirit Lake Massacre and lived with the Wahpekute band for months before she was traded back for two horses, 12 blankets, two kegs of powder, 20 pounds of tobacco, 32 yards of cloth, ribbon and other articles.

When she later returned to Pillsbury Point as Abbie Gardner Sharp, she opened a museum to tell her story. Her legacy is still intact as the history of the Spirit Lake Massacre is recalled at the Abbie Gardner Cabin & Museum in Arnolds Park each year.

The State Historical Society of Iowa site opens for the season Friday, May 24, and is open noon-4:00pm, Tuesday-Sunday through Labor Day weekend.

Seat Belt Myth Busters

Vehicle Type: There seems to be a misconception among those who drive and ride in pickup trucks that their large vehicles will protect them better than other vehicles would in a crash. Fiftynine percent of pickup truck occupants who were killed in 2017 were not buckled compared to 42 percent of car occupants.*

Seating Position: Too many people believe they are safe in the back seat unrestrained. Forty-six percent of all front-seat passengers killed in 2017 crashes were unbelted but 56 percent of those killed in the back seat were unbelted.*

Rural versus Urban: People who live in rural areas might believe that their chance of being in a crash is lower but in 2017 there were 12,786 passenger vehicle fatalities in rural locations compared to 10,316 fatalities in urban locations. Of those fatalities, 49 percent of those killed in rural locations were not wearing their seat belts compared to 44 percent in urban locations.* (*National data supplied by NHTSA)



The Death Boat, a new book by Lloyd B. Cunningham, tells the story of Miss Thriller, a 16-passenger launch known in the 1920s as the "fastest boat in the world carrying passage for hire." Launched on the St. Lawrence River in 1922, she was one of the most popular attractions at Alexandria Bay, New York. In 1925, Miss Thriller was moved to West Lake Okoboji, Iowa, and became the most sought-after attraction at Arnolds Park, a lakefront resort community in northwest Iowa.



Her popularity threatened the local Eagle Boat Line and an intense rivalry ensued. Sunday night July 28, 1929, Miss Thriller was hit in the dark and sunk by the Eagle Line launch, Zipper. Nine people lost their lives in the accident.

Over the next two years, men were charged with seconddegree murder, manslaughter and conspiracy. Four trials were conducted and a pilot was sentenced to prison. The governor banned passenger boats from operating after dark, and the state conservation board adopted stringent rules governing the operation of all motorboats on Iowa lakes.

In The Death Boat, Cunningham brings together dozens of newspaper stories, the accounts of survivors, the testimony of witnesses and the decisions of judges into the first detailed account of the famous launch. He quotes launch pilots, public letters, private correspondence, and government records as he sheds light on the many mysteries surrounding the sinking of Miss Thriller and her recovery from the bottom of the lake. And Cunningham reveals a new mystery about the launch as he writes about events that changed boating in Iowa forever.

Lloyd B. Cunningham is a retired news photographer who spent nearly forty years with the Argus Leader in Sioux Falls, South Dakota. He and his wife, Linda, now live in Lakeland, Florida, and spend their summers at West Lake Okoboji. A scuba diver since 1992, Lloyd has logged more than 350 dives in the lake where Miss Thriller sank in 1929. When not studying the history of the Iowa Great Lakes, he plays golf, kayaks and bicycles, and enjoys fishing and boating.




