It appears that we skipped spring and went right to summer. This is a good time to remind people about how to make sure their dogs and cats can be protected during the heat.

Never leave your dog or cat in a parked car during warm or hot weather. The buildup of heat inside a car can kill a pet very quickly. Dogs and cats do not sweat as we humans do. Their lungs are their main cooling system. With nothing but overheated air to breathe, your pet cannot live very long. Heat stress, heat stroke, and permanent brain damage are the consequences, if your pet does survive. With the outside temperature in the low 80s, the temperature inside a car - with windows slightly opened - will reach 102 degrees in 10 minutes. In 30 minutes, the inside temperature reaches 120 degrees. Humidity increases the danger. Cars parked in the shade or cars that have just had the air conditioning turned off are just as dangerous. It is kinder to leave pets at home in warm weather, beginning when the temperatures reach 60.

If you see a dog in an unattended parked car, please call us immediately. We will need the location, make and color of the car, and the license plate number. Then, go into the store and ask the manager to announce over their public address system that the owners need to return to their car. However, when the spring and summer seasons arrive, either leave your pets at home, or take along a human who can remain in the parked car with the engine running and the air conditioning on.

Never put a dog where it is not protected from direct sunlight. Outside dogs cannot find relief in a doghouse that is not shaded. At temperatures over 80 degrees, the danger of heat stroke increases significantly. If the dog is confined to a pen on concrete, reflected heat makes the temperature even higher. A doghouse that is not in shade becomes nothing but a hot box. A source of shade must be provided in order for your dog to be comfortable.

Never expect your pet to be without cool, fresh water. Fresh water must be provided at all times. Even inside pets drink more during hot weather. The absolute legal minimum for adequate water is "access to clean fresh water of a drinkable temperature."

Cats must be provided the same level of care as dogs.

Blue Star Mother's Flag

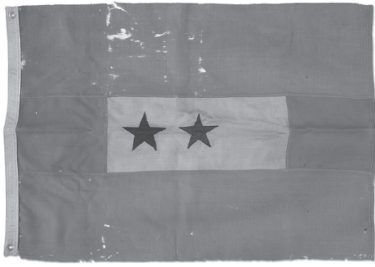
A reader asked, "What country uses a little flag with just a red border and a big blue star in the center?" It is a service flag designed in 1917 that identified a family that had someone in service during the war. It was entered into the Congressional Record in September 1917, and it can only be used according to strict guidelines.

The idea expanded to a Gold Star flag for a family that lost a son or daughter during any United States war, including World War II, the Gulf War and the Vietnam War. The flag size must be in the ratio of 10 to 19 like the United States flag, and it must be smaller and flown below, never above, the Stars and Stripes. In 2010, the Silver Star honoring those wounded in the wars was approved by the House of Representatives.

The Gold- and Blue-star mothers, wives and families have special clubs, lapel buttons, ribbons and meetings. In 1936, the last Sunday in September was declared Gold-Star Mother's Day. There are new flags flying in windows now, and the old ones are being saved and collected as interesting war memorabilia.

Q. I bought a poster of dogs playing poker about 30 years ago and would like to know if it has any value. It shows seven dogs sitting around a table playing poker. One dog is passing a card under the table to the dog next to him. There are no names on the poster. Is it worth anything?

A. The picture on your poster is called "A Friend in Need," part of a series of sixteen anthropomorphic dog paintings by Cassius Marcellus Coolidge (1844-1934) and published by Brown & Bigelow, a company in St. Paul, Minn. They were commissioned for a 1903 advertising campaign for cigars. Nine of the paintings pictured dogs in a poker game, and collectors often call the paintings "Dogs Play-

ing Poker." The paintings were reproduced on posters, prints, calendars and other items. This painting of the two dogs cheating at poker is the most popular in the series. An original painting would sell for a lot of money, but prints are common and can sell for \$10 or less. A pair of the paintings sold at auction for over \$590,000 a few years ago.

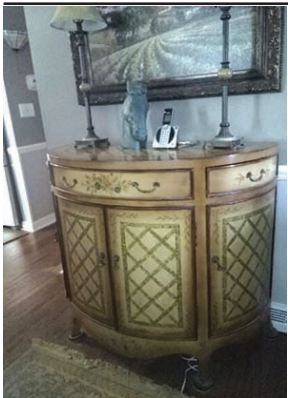

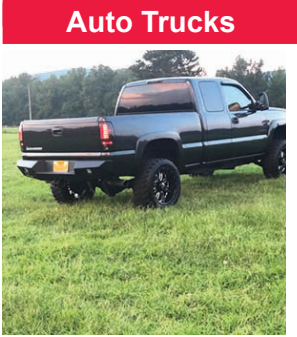

Grilled Pizza with Arugula Pesto, Corn and Ham

Recipe courtesy of Rachel Gurk of Rachel Cooks on behalf of Milk Means More
Prep time: 20 minutes
Cook time: 10 minutes
Servings: 6

Arugula Pesto:

- 2 cups fresh arugula, tightly packed
- 1 clove garlic
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- pinch red pepper flakes, (optional)
- 1/3 cup shredded Parmesan cheese
- 1/2 cup extra-virgin olive oil
- salt, to taste
- pepper, to taste

Grilled Pizza:

- 2 tablespoons flour, divided
- 1 pound pizza crust dough (at room temperature if using refrigerated dough)
- vegetable oil, for grill
- 1/2 cup Arugula Pesto
- 1/2 cup part-skim ricotta cheese

- 1/2 cup diced deli ham
- 1/2-3/4 cup fresh corn kernels (about 1 cob)
- 1/4 cup thinly sliced red onion
- 1/4 cup shredded Parmesan cheese

Heat grill to medium heat (350-400 F).
To make Arugula Pesto: In food processor, combine arugula, garlic, lemon juice, red pepper flakes and Parmesan. Pulse until combined then, with food processor on, drizzle in olive oil until pesto forms, scraping down sides as needed. Taste and season with salt and pepper, to taste.
To make Grilled Pizza: Flour pizza dough lightly and stretch or roll to about 1/2-inch thickness (14-16-inch diameter).
Sprinkle remaining flour on large rimless baking sheet, pizza peel or pizza stone. Transfer dough to baking surface. Clean grill grate and grease with oil-soaked paper towel and tongs. Slide dough off baking surface onto grill. Cover and cook until dough is bubbling on top and golden brown on bottom, 2-3 minutes.
Carefully flip dough over using peel or tongs. Remove crust from grill to add toppings. Spread Arugula Pesto over dough. Top with ricotta, ham, corn kernels, onion and Parmesan. Return pizza to grill, cover and cook until toppings are heated through and bottom of crust is crispy, 5-7 minutes. Remove from grill, slice and serve.

HOLLYWOOD

HOLLYWOOD — **Will Smith** is reportedly being paid a whopping \$35 million by Netflix for “Bright 2” (the original “Bright,” with **Joel Edgerton**, cost \$90 million to make). That’s more than the busiest guy in movies, **Dwayne Johnson**, who makes \$20 million per film. Will has a cameo in “Student of the Year 2” (now in theaters), but goes big and wide as the Genie in the live-action “Aladdin” (out May 24), and the animated spy comedy “Spies in Disguise,” with **Tom Holland** (due Sept. 13). Next he’ll star in three-time Oscar-winning director **Ang Lee**’s sci-fi film “Gemini Man,” in which Smith plays the dual role of a man and his own clone (coming Oct. 11), followed by the action comedy “Bad Boys for Life,” with **Martin Lawrence** and **Vanessa Hudgens** (Jan. 17).

Ryan Reynolds, who starred in and co-produced “Deadpool” (which grossed \$783 million) and its sequel (\$785 million gross), has upped his price and star status. He is reportedly getting \$27 million from Netflix to star in “6 Underground,” about a billionaire-financed vigilante squad. Meanwhile, Reynold’s “The Hitman’s Bodyguard,” which earned \$176 million, has spawned a sequel, “The Hitman’s Wife’s Bodyguard,” with **Samuel L. Jackson** and **Salma Hayek** (due in 2020). His latest film, the just-released “Pokémon Detective Pikachu,” is a big hit.

When “Doctor Dolittle” opened in 1967 with Oscar-winner **Rex Harrison** (who was a big star), it was a flop that cost \$17 million and earned only \$9 million. Twentieth Century Fox was more successful in 2001 with **Eddie Murphy** (which cost \$70 million and earned \$176 million). Fox sold it to Universal Pictures for “The Voyage of Doctor Dolittle” (out Jan. 17) and paid **Robert Downey Jr.** \$20 million to play the man who can talk to animals.

Tom Cruise is getting \$14 million for “Top Gun: Maverick”; **Jason Statham**

\$13 million for “The Fast and The Furious” spin-off “Hobbs & Shaw” (while **Idris Elba** is making only \$8 million for the same film); and **Emily Blunt** reportedly is going to make \$13 million for the sequel to “A Quiet Place.” **Leonardo DiCaprio** and **Brad Pitt** are earning only \$10 million each for **Quentin Tarantino**’s “Once Upon a Time in Hollywood,” the same as **Gal Gadot**, who received a huge pay hike for “Wonder Woman 1984.”

Hollywood is well-represented in nominations for this year’s Tony Awards (June 9 at Radio City Music Hall), with the musicals “Beetlejuice” (eight nominations) and “Tootsie” (11 nominations). Among acting nominations are **Bryan Cranston** (“Network”), **Jeff Daniels** (“To Kill a Mockingbird”), “Star Wars” **Adam Driver** (“Burn This”), **Annette Bening** (“All My Sons”) and **Laurie Metcalf** (“Hillary and Clinton”). As they say, “Everything old is new again” ... again!

Husband Refuses to Wash His Hands

DEAR DR. ROACH: My husband and I are both 74 and in general good health. He never washes his hands when he comes in from working as a public accountant. He doesn’t wash his hands when he sneezes, or after touching meat and poultry when he cooks. He smokes and is a functioning alcoholic. He says it’s not necessary to wash fruit before you eat it and tells me I don’t know what I am talking about. He has been on Lipitor for several years and eats steak almost every night. On the other hand, I wash my hands when I come in from work and before preparing meals, and have always washed fruit before eating it. What’s his secret? Does he have strong genes? -- T.M.

ANSWER: Eating well and taking good care of yourself don’t guarantee a long, healthy life. The converse is true as well. I have heard so many stories about Aunt Martha (or Gertrude or Helen), who drank, smoked and lived on bacon until she was 105, but your lifestyle does give you a better chance at living longer and healthier, and of feeling better right now.

Smoking increases the risk of dying from any cause. A 74-year-old man who has smoked all his life has about the same risk of dying as an 82-year-old nonsmoker. One can do a similar risk analysis with diet. But some people, through a combination of good genes and good luck, manage to live long, healthy lives despite poor lifestyle choices. Even though some individuals will not have the expected outcome, smoking is still bad. So is eating steak every night. Washing (or at least rinsing) produce is a good idea.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Last year, I started getting Raynaud’s. I can remember from my youth that my father had it, so it didn’t seem too terrible. It’s not just the fingertips that turn white, but also some of my toes are affected. I asked people who know of it or have it how one gets this. What is the cause? No one knows. So I asked my doctor. Even he said he did not know.

How do I get these episodes, and what can I do to prevent them? -- R.S.

ANSWER: Raynaud phenomenon is an exaggerated response to cold or stress, causing color changes in the skin of the fingers and toes. There is a long list of causes of Raynaud phenomenon. Often, no cause is ever found (in which case it is called primary Raynaud, which just means we don’t know what’s causing it). The most common known causes are the autoimmune rheumatic diseases, especially scleroderma, lupus and Sjogren’s syndrome. Hypothyroidism is an unusual cause, and some drugs can cause it as well. The current thinking is that primary RP is caused by abnormalities in the alpha receptors in blood vessels (alpha receptors respond to adrenaline and similar molecules).

Keeping the whole body -- and especially the hands -- warm is the first step. Sudden temperature changes can trigger the effect. Warming the hands in warm water at the onset of an attack can stop it. Anxiety makes it worse, so a positive attitude can really affect this condition. Medications, such as amlodipine, may be necessary for prevention in more severe cases.

NOW HERE'S A TIP

* "If you paint your kitchen cabinets, be sure that you label each door and drawer exactly where it goes. It can be really hard to figure it out, and the holes might not line up perfectly. Also, save hardware in baggies to keep it all together." -- R.U. in Montana
* To create a fun cake stand, glue a 10-inch terra cotta saucer to the bottom of a 4-inch terra cotta flowerpot. Paint and seal the whole thing. When you flip it over, the bottom of the saucer becomes the cake plate. So neat!
* "To clean the outsides of our windows, we mixed vinegar and hot water and added a couple drops of dish soap. Then I used a microfiber cloth to scrub the window and its surrounding casing. We rinsed them with the hose and used the squeegee I keep in my car to get the water drops off. They look great!" -- Y.D. in Arkansas
* Wash your reusable shopping bags from time to time, either in the washing machine on the delicate cycle or hand wash in the sink. Hang to dry.
* How much money should you have in an emergency cash fund? Experts say that at a minimum, you should have three months' worth of necessary expenses (home payment, utilities, food and gas, minimum debt payments, etc.) in an accessible form. This means you can't count the value of assets or stocks you own, nor any retirement funds. This sounds hard because it is, but it could make the difference between success or failure in an emergency.
* "I purchase a big pack of bottled water at my discount club. I keep it in the trunk, and it seems there are always opportunities for a bottle. I keep a few in a lunch tote, which actually keeps them cool in the hot car, even without an ice pack." -- C.L. in Maryland

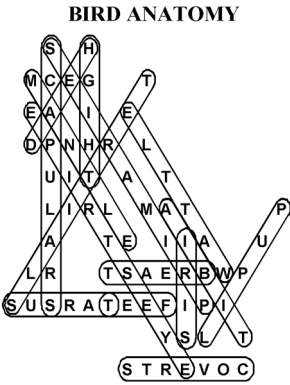
