Top 5 weight loss secrets

ises fabulous new ways to slim and trim up. Well, I'm not going to give you the new "Apricot and Mustard Diet" (I don't know if it really exists but it sounded terrible!). Instead, I'm going to touch on some lesser known things that can be standing in your way of successful weight loss.

• Pain can stand in your way for weight loss. There are three hormone that are considered fat-storing hormones: cortisol, insulin and estrogen. Pain causes the adrenal gland, which makes cortisol, to increase cortisol in your body. It does this to decrease the pain in acute conditions but longer chronic conditions can contribute to unhealthy levels. This causes fat storage and you're fighting an uphill battle.

• You can sleep your fat off. Really. I've touched on this before but getting a good night's sleep is important for loosing weight. Growth hormone is a fat burning hormone. This becomes active in a deep sleep state. Get good sleep and get good fat burning if other things are right.

 Choosing the right exercise matters. Depending on your individual body chemistry, you can help or hinder weight loss. For example, if you have been under high stress for any extended period of time, the adrenal gland we mentioned may be compromised. If so, lifting heavy weights and strenuous work outs can stress this gland and make your problem worse.

• In the presence of insulin, all fat burning stops. Remember, Insulin is fat storing. Having carbohydrates, like bread and chips, will

Okay. So everybody prom- cause an insulin response. We have been teaching this in our practice for almost 20 years. It's just as true now as it was when we started. The Keto diet is largely based on managing this. It, incidentally, is also anti-inflammatory.

> • Fats don't make you fat. I can hear the screaming but it's true. The wrong fats, such as hydrogenated fats, will. However, the Keto diet, I mentioned is a high fat diet. These are generally from plant-based sources, such as avocados, and organic meats. Keeping carbohydrates (breads, chips, etc.) very low, with some proteins, and mostly fats can eventually help growth hormone when you sleep.



Last [Saturday] night, Governor Walz, Senate Leader Gazelka and House Speaker Hortman finally announced a tentative global agreement on a new two-year state budget. While that is a step forward in most areas, details are not out yet. Here are some big picture items that are in the agreement:

I am relieved to see the governor and House DFL majority finally gave up their demand to hike the gas tax by 20 cents per gallon and increase tab fees.

Just as important to stopping the unwarranted gas tax hike was preventing the "highway robbery" of the statutorily dedicated road and bridge funding that comes from the sales tax on auto parts and repairs that we already pay.

Every year we produce cars that get better gas mileage, with

However, reinstating the health care provider tax despite a longstanding bipartisan agreement to end that tax remains problematic. That action will add about \$2 billion in health care costs for Minneso-
