Medina High School Students Learn to Make Better Decisions

As prom and graduation season approached, the students at Medina High School took part in a program about the impact on poor decision making.

Over 100 students were at the Ridgeway Fire Hall recently where a discussion on drugs and alcohol prevention was held by GCASA (Genesee/Orleans Council on Alcoholism and Substance Abuse). The prevention educator, Elizabeth Aldaco, talked to the students about the dangers of addictive substances and making healthier choices. She also informed the students that she is at the high school one day a week and her door is open to anyone who wants to talk to her.

The students were then brought outside where representatives from the New York State Troopers, the Orleans County Police, the Medina Police and the Ridgeway, Shelby and Medina Fire Companies had demonstrations set up that the students rotated through on the dangers of distracted and inexperienced driving.

The students went into a driving simulator booth, operated by the Orleans County Police, and attempted to drive while texting. They saw how easy it was to have an accident or a near accident by taking their eyes off the road for just seconds. The NYS Troopers showed what happens in a rollover crash when someone is not wearing their seatbelts. Their simulator ejected a crash dummy out the window as it spun without it being bucked in. The Medina Police Department had the students attempt to ride bicycles wearing goggles that mimic being impaired by drugs or alcohol. The final demonstration was given by local firefighters who showed off one of their fire trucks and then showed the aftermath of a car accident using vehicles donated by Lyons Collision.

The demonstrations had a very real and meaningful impact on the high schoolers as they saw the dangers of being a distractive driver. The school district is very grateful to the first responders that spent time with the students to show them how one bad choice and can have affect their lives and the lives of others.

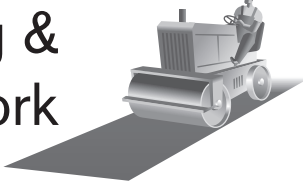

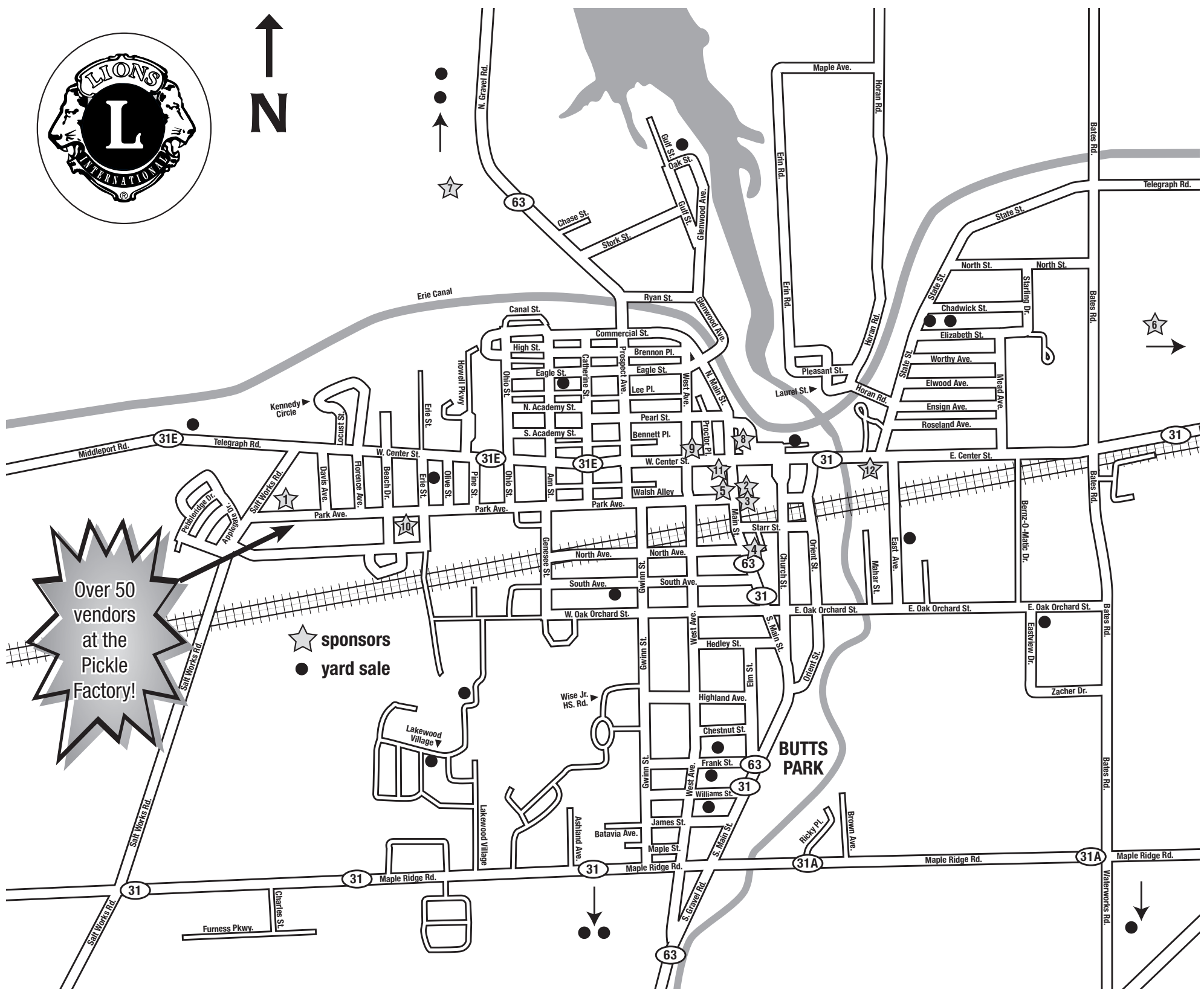

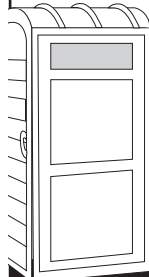

THINK OF YOUR CHILDREN

One of the most important
aspects of drawing up a will
for parents of young children
is appointing a “guardian”
to raise the children if both
parents were to die before the
children reach adult age. While
the chances of this scenario
taking place may seem to be
quite slim, failure to prepare
for the eventuality presents
possible ramifications that
are far too great to dismiss.
If a guardian is not named,
the judge would appoint a
guardian without knowing
whom the deceased parent(s)
would have preferred. While
naming a guardian in a will
does not necessarily ensure
that the person named to

RAVEN OR CROW?

I saw a pair of ravens around the swamp
this winter, but wasn’t able to get any good
shots of them. They are a bird that seems
to be absent from this area until recently.
Then I get a email from one of the readers
of this column, “we have a raven nesting in
our barn.” Of course I get over there as soon
as possible and the lady shows me the
nest right above our heads while we are
sitting on the UTV in the barn. As we sit
there looking, an adult raven flew in and
fed the young just like we weren’t there! I
love this lady! Naturally some time is being
spending with these birds as they are the
first I have heard of nesting in Orleans
County.

It is not always easy to tell the raven from
a crow. They are larger, but that is hard to
distinguish when they are high in the sky.

The tail of a raven is wedge-shaped where
as a crow’s looks more squared off. This
can be seen quite easily when they are
silhouetted against the sky.

A closer view will show that the raven has
a heavier bill that gives the appearance of
a “Roman nose.”

Probably the easiest way to tell a raven from
a crow when in the air is by its flight
pattern. A crow’s flight is usually a steady
flopping of the wings, but a raven will
routinely soar and glide like hawks. They
often engage in “barrel rolls” and tumbles
and even fold their wings and plummet like
a skydiver, playful characters!

The calls of these two birds is also quite
different and a high distant flying raven will
usually give away his ID with his loud,
guttural croak. The crow of course gives the
familiar “caw, caw” call in various versions.

The raven does have a larger variety of
calls that are much louder than crows.
Sometimes they sound like people talking
in the distance or have a metallic ring to
the call. One instance that stands out to me
was a fellow who was hunting bear up in
Canada at the same time I was. Ravens
back in the swamp near his bait pile were
making so many weird and scary sounds he
hunted with a rifle the next day instead of
his bow!

Ravens are mimics and can sometimes
imitate a human voice very well. They can
also mimic other birds or animals, like what
happened to that guy bow hunting bear in
Canada. Pet ravens have been known to
imitate a motorcycle being revved up,
flushing urinals, radio static and car horns.

They are intelligent birds that seem to
have the ability to reason. Bernd Heinrich
has done extensive research of both captive
and wild ravens. In his book, Mind of the
Raven, he tells of many experiments done
with these birds that show how they can
figure things out. In one instance he put out
donuts which a pet raven had never seen
before. The raven didn’t take just one
donut, but first pushed his bill through one
donut before picking up another with his
bill tip and flying off.

Ravens are basically meat eaters and
carrion is a large part of their diet. In fact
they seem to have a close relationship with
large predators such as wolves, bears and
cougars. They will keep tabs on these
predators and share in a kill. They are of
course unable to kill large prey and are not
equipped to tear through tough hide so they
stay close to these animals and clean up the
remains.

Like crows they will feed on garbage and
a large variety of smaller prey like frogs,
bird eggs and nestlings, mice, insects,
fruit, berries and seeds. Because of their
powerful bills they will also take small
mammals like squirrels and rabbits.

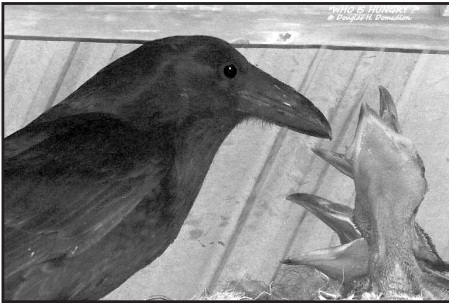
A unique feeding habitat they have is
caching food. They will dig a small hole in
the ground or snow and hide the food in it.
They will also make “false caches” which
seems to be designed to reduce pilferage
by other ravens.

Ravens are often solitary, commonly
traveling in pairs or small groups. In his
studies, Heinrich has proven that there are
strong relationships among siblings or
members of small groups.

This “large crow” is slow to reach sexual
maturity and although they may mate at the
age of three they may not do so until the
age of seven. They have a long live span
and have been known to live 50 years in
captivity.

In the mean time I’m having a ball
learning about and photographing this new
“nester” in Orleans County!

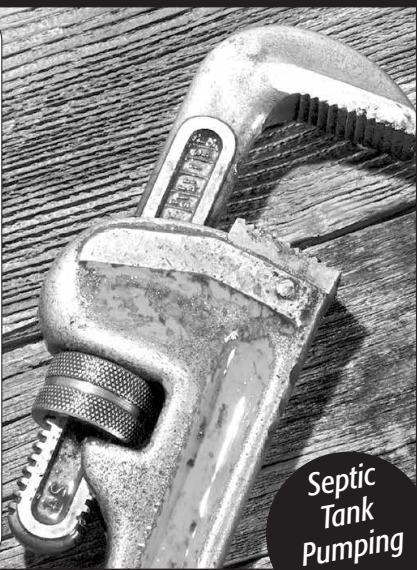

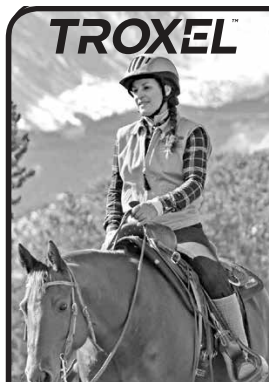

Did You Know?

Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before getting help. Symptoms include:

CHEST DISCOMFORT. Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain.

What Is Gluten?

Gluten-free foods are now more widely available than ever before, but unless they adhere to gluten-free diets, consumers may not know just what gluten is and why some people need to avoid it. According to the Celiac Disease Foundation, gluten is the general name for the proteins found in wheat, rye, barley, and the hybrid grain triticale, which is produced by crossing wheat and rye. Many foods and beverages, including breads, soups, beer, and cereals, contain gluten. However, the CDF notes that many foods also are naturally gluten-free. What's more, many naturally gluten-free foods are very nutritious. These foods include fruits, vegetables, fish and seafood, dairy, beans, legumes, and nuts. For example, rice, cassava, corn, soy, potato, quinoa, nut flours, and millet are just a handful of the naturally gluten-free grains and starches that people who must avoid gluten can eat without fear of aggravating their conditions. ■

SIGNS OF A STROKE

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

- 1 Ask the person to **SMILE**.
- 2 Ask the person to **TALK AND SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE**. i.e. It is sunny out today.
- 3 Ask the person to **RAISE BOTH ARMS**.
- 4 Ask the person to **STICK OUT HIS TONGUE**. If the tongue goes to one side or the other, that is a sign of a stroke.

- Sudden **numbness or weakness** of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body
- Sudden **confusion**, trouble speaking or understanding
- Sudden **trouble seeing** in one or both eyes
- Sudden **trouble walking, dizziness**, loss of balance or coordination
- Sudden, **severe headache** with no known cause
