



Friends of Letchworth Scholarship Awarded



Public Information Meeting on Sheriff's Office Training Complex



Rabies Positive Fox in Mount Morris

According to the Livingston County Public Health Director, Jennifer Rodriguez, the New York State Health Department laboratory has confirmed that a fox in the Town of Mount Morris tested positive for rabies on May 6, 2019.

Rabies is a deadly virus that attacks the central nervous system in mammals. It is most frequently found in raccoons, skunks, and bats. All mammals, including unvaccinated dogs, cats, and farm animals, are at risk for getting rabies.

It is important to note that there is no way to tell if an animal is rabid just by looking at it. Wild and feral animals should always be avoided. Signs of rabies in wildlife include: inability to walk, appearance of "drunkenness," unwillingness to drink water or eat, drooling, aggressive behavior, or any significant change in temperament. All potential rabies exposures should be reported to the Livingston County Department of Health.

Below are important steps to prevent rabies.

- ••• Stay away from unfamiliar animals, either wild or domestic, even if they appear friendly.
- ••• Thoroughly wash any wound from an animal with soap and water and seek immediate medical attention.
- ••• Avoid wild and feral animals, especially if the animal is showing any sign of rabies.
- ••• Be a responsible pet owner by keeping your pet's vaccinations current. Getting your pets vaccinated can help stop the spread of rabies from wild animals to humans.

New York State Law requires that all dogs, cats and ferrets have current rabies vaccinations, beginning at 4 months of age. An unvaccinated pet that comes into contact with a rabid animal must be kept in strict confinement for six months or be euthanized. Free rabies clinics are offered for dogs, cats, and ferrets every year in Livingston County. The next rabies clinic is on May 15, 2019 in Caledonia. Pre-registration is available on the Environmental Health website listed below.

It is important to be aware of the facts and use caution to protect your family and your pets. Livingston County Department of Health Responds to Mumps Cases

Mount Morris, NY (May 29, 2019) - The Livingston County Department of Health continues to work closely with the New York State Department of Health and Livonia Central School to ensure the health and safety of our residents through active surveillance and investigation regarding mumps cases. As of May 29, 2019, there have been three confirmed mumps cases among Livingston County residents.

Mumps is a disease caused by a virus. You can catch mumps through the air from an infected person's cough or sneeze. You can also get it by direct contact with an infected surface. The virus usually makes you feel sick and causes a salivary gland between your jaw and ear to swell. Other symptoms include low-grade fever, fatigue, muscle aches and loss of appetite. After a person is exposed to mumps, symptoms usually appear 16 to 18 days after infection, but this period can range from 12 to 25 days after infection. Mumps cannot be treated.

While the mumps vaccine is not 100 percent effective, two doses of the vaccine provide the best protection against the disease. Individuals who have not previously been diagnosed with mumps or who are unsure of their vaccine history should contact their health care provider or local health department to inquire about receiving the measles, mumps and rubella vaccine, known as the MMR.

Here are some everyday preventive actions that can stop the spread of mumps:

- ••• Do not share food, drinks, utensils or other personal items that may contain saliva.
- ••• Wash your hands frequently with soap and water, or use an alcohol-based hand rub if soap and water are not available.
- ••• Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue if you sneeze or cough, and discard the tissue after you use it. If a tissue is not available, sneeze or cough into your upper sleeve or elbow, not your hands.
- ••• Clean and disinfect objects and surfaces that may be contaminated with germs.
- ••• People with the mumps should stay home, and away from public places for five days after the onset of symptoms and limit contact with others in their household.

"If you have questions or concerns about your level of vaccination, please contact your primary care provider. If you, your child or another family member has been exposed to mumps or have symptoms of mumps please stay home and call your local health department, doctor or clinic immediately for advice. If you never had mumps or were never vaccinated against it, you may need to stay home from work or school for a while", stated Jennifer Rodriguez, Public Health Director.
