javalin, and shot put.


"We are so excited to participate in the Senior Olympics," said Rosalyn Fabianke.

the people of Alabama and working with the Coalition to build partnerships and strengthen public awareness about respite care."

The Alabama Lifespan Respite Coalition was created by the Alabama Legislature in 2012 and is comprised of members who are culturally, economically, and geographically diverse and representative of the state demographics. The coalition's responsibilities are three-fold: to build partnerships and coordinate respite care efforts statewide; to provide public awareness about respite to the citizens of Alabama; and to identify, coordinate, and develop community/ funding resources for respite services.

Abel's term will expire in June of 2021, and her appointment fills a

vacancy on the Coalition.

### **Trace Grant** for \$37 Million

TUPELO, MS – the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) has awarded \$35,757,000 to the National Park Service for improvements to the Natchez Trace Parkway. This funding will allow for the restoration of a section of the Natchez Trace Parkway from milepost 291-331 in Tishomingo county, MS, Colbert county, AL, and an area at the very southernmost point of Lauderdale county, AL. As part of the Nationally Significant Federal Lands and Tribal Projects (NSFLTP) program, it will involve heavy resurfacing, renovation, and rehabilitation to improve the pavement conditions of the parkway. Two National Park Service programs will augment the grant funds for a total of just over \$40 million.

# Trace Grant for \$37 Million

Chief Ranger, Sarah Davis, expressed her excitement about the project by stating that in addition to improving the pavement condition, this project will also address safety issues on the Parkway. "In recent years, more than 40% of injury crashes along the Parkway involved a lane departure," stated Davis. "A Road Safety Audit conducted by Department of Transportation recommended addressing these lane departure crashes with audible pavement markings to alert motorists when they leave their travel lane. This project will improve Parkway safety by adding raised profile stripes to both the fog line and the center striping.

The project will also apply Safety Edge to the edges of the asphalt where heavy 3R work is done. By providing a 30-degree angle between the Parkway and the unpaved shoulder, Safety Edge allows drivers to reenter the roadway safely, and drivers are less likely to lose control of their vehicle and cross into oncoming traffic.



seniors who may live or spend extended periods of time alone.

However, elder abuse can also be much closer Often, an to home. otherwise trusted family member with access to a checkbook, bank account, or social security check may abuse that privilege and trust.

World Elder Abuse Awareness Day is June 15. Therefore, this is a good time to become more aware and keep a few things in mind.

One in ten Americans 60 and older experiences abuse according to National Council on Aging estimates. However, they also report that only about 7% of cases are reported to authorities. In addition, those who are abused are three times as likely to die earlier than they would otherwise.

There are several types of elder abuse according the NCA, among those are theft, physical, sexual, emotional, confinement, neglect, withholding medication, food, etc.

"Primarily, the cases we do are financial exploitation," Lauderdale County District Attorney

hris Connolly said. "It's typically relative-related. relative gets into their bank account and they're left destitute.'

Officials with the Department of Human Resources confirmed that there are usually around 40 cases of elder abuse being investigated locally at any one time. Those do not include investigations of abuse when seniors are still considered to be of sound mind. Those cases would fall outside the area of responsibility for DHR.

If the elderly are alone with no close family members, there is usually not someone officially in charge of his or her finances. The elderly person may reach a point mentally where he or she can no longer make sound financial or health-related decisions. If they have not been legally designated incompetent by a court and someone designated conservator and/ as or guardian, that often leaves them vulnerable.

A guardianship gives one or more people the legal authority to make health-related decisions for another person. A conservatorship is a legal relationship that gives one or more individuals the authority to make financial décisions on behalf of an incompetent or incapacitated person.

Hailey Killen, a social worker for the Adults Protective Services Unit of the Department of Human Resources, points out that







In case you do not know, "nose blind" is when you become so accustomed to certain odors that you don't notice them anymore.

officials from around the world. Her husband sold arms to the likes of Hitler and Mussolini. Hedwig listened closely to the conversations her husband had with these world leaders and was fascinated to learn about a new technology using radio

frequencies to control missiles. The life of a "kept woman" was not for Hedwig. She quickly tired of her overbearing, insecure husband and plotted her escape. With nothing more than a few pieces of jewelry and sheer determination, she drugged a servant, stole her uniform, crept

out of the prison-castle, made her way to London, and pursued her dreams of Hollywood stardom.

One of the M's in MGM studios, Louis Mayer, was scouting for talent in London at the time. Hedwig managed to track him down. Mr. Mayer offered her a job, then demanded she distance herself from that naughty movie by changing her name from Hedwig Kiesler to Hedy Lamarr. Hedy quickly became one of the most famous actresses of her time culminating in her role of Delilah in Cecil B. DeMille's Samson and Delilah in 1949.

That would be a pretty cool story in and of itself be we aren't done with Hedy. In her spare time, Hedy was an inventor. She dated and consulted with Howard Hughes on, among other things, streamlining his airplanes based on her studies of the fastest birds and fish she could find. Hughes set her up with a team of scientists and engineers that were ordered to make anything she asked for.

Hedy never forgot her conversations with the leaders of Nazi Germany during her brief marriage to the Devil. In the dark days of World War II, Hedy learned that the Germans were jamming our navy's radio-controlled torpedos. Hedy patented a way of rapidly changing radio frequencies that allowed for unjammable, secure, wireless communications. While the technology of the 1940s prevented the feasibility of her

idea at the time, the advent of the transistor introduced the world to her idea of "spread spectrum" technology.

Hedy was once known as a woman who was too beautiful to be taken seriously. But her "spread spectrum" idea is now the very backbone of cellular, Bluetooth, and Wi-Fi technology we use today. # **Medicare Minute**

### Part B & Preventive Services

When you go onto Medicare, the preventive services you receive will be filed under Medicare Part B. You will find that Medicare encourages you to have your preventive screenings completed. You can go to Medicare.gov to see a list of the screenings that are considered preventive services or feel free to contact our office and we can get you that list. Some of the most common preventive screenings are: bone density, mammograms, colonoscopy, diabetes screening, and flu shots.

The obvious question is "how much will these screenings cost me?" Your Medicare and You Handbook states, "You pay nothing for most preventive services if you get the service from a doctor or other qualified health care provider that accepts Medicare assignment." If you have employer insurance or a Medicare Advantage Plan your costs may be different so contact your benefit coordinator or plan for

If you have had Part B for less than 12 months you qualify for a "Welcome to Medicare" preventive visit or if you have had Part B for more than 12 months you qualify for a yearly "Wellness" visit. Both of these visits are designed to help you develop and follow a personalized plan to aid you in preventing illness and disability. If these visits are to a doctor or health care provider that accepts Medicare assignment there is no cost to you. 

We should take note that Florence made changes to the city's website in October of 2018.

Prior to these changes a citizen could go to city's website and go to a September 2010 council meeting agenda. Click on any resolution and the supporting documents for the resolution were available for citizen The current review. council has changed this. Now this information is not available for meeting agendas prior to the October 2, 2018 meeting agenda.

In addition, the city's website states, "The city council meeting minutes are added as they become available." The minutes for the April 16, 2019 meeting were approved at the May 9 meeting. The April 16 meeting was almost two months ago, yet as of this press time, had yet to be posted. Prior to the recent changes, minutes were posted in a more timely manner. Are these actions a violation of the spirit of the Freedom of Information laws?

Another action is the handling of the city's properties located at Cox Creek Park (CCP) and the city's vacant dog pound property downtown. The city gifted the property located within CCP to UNA for a new baseball facility. An article in the TimesDaily about the new dog pound dated May 14, 2019, stated, "The old center will be sold to the city's electricity department which is adjacent to it." I was not aware the electricity department had agreed to purchase the property. A purchase price was not included in the article. The property is owned by the city and the electricity department should have free use of the property. The electricity department gets their money from the citizens of Florence.



### THE DIFFERENCE **BETWEEN "FOR** CAUSE" AND "RETALIATORY" DISCHARGE

**A**TTORNEY

Employment generally in the United States is considered to be "at will". That means that employment may be ended by the employer or the employee at any time.

There are certain restrictions, the most common of which is probably employment through a contract. An employment contract will specify the terms under which a person is employed and under what terms they may be terminated and what happens if the contract is not

followed (breach of contract).

Generally the law is that an employer may fire an employee for good cause, bad cause or no cause at all. If an employee is fired for no reason, generally they can draw unemployment for a period of time or until they find employment elsewhere. If an employee fails to show up for work or otherwise violates the rules then they are not able to draw unemployment compensation.

There are federal rules that pertain to firing a person because of their race, age, sex or religion. In those cases if a person believes they were fired for those reasons, they must contact EEOC (Equal Employment Opportunity Commission) within 180 days and get a "right to sue" letter after giving the EEOC an opportunity to investigate and resolve the situation.

In Alabama, we recognize that employers have an incentive to fire a worker following an injury. If an employee is injured and then terminated, this creates a situation where a claim for "retaliatory discharge" could be made. Employers are prohibited from firing an employee for seeking to recover workers compensation benefits following an on-the-job injury.

When an employee notifies the employer of an injury and is then fired, the facts are then such that a retaliatory discharge claim could be made. The injured employee does not have to file a lawsuit or do anything other than notify the employer that they were injured on the job. If, after notice of an injury, the employee is terminated, the employer may be asked to come forward with proof of a legitimate reason for terminating the employee.

These can be good cases, but become difficult or unclear when the employee is placed in an "inactive" status or claims that the employer made the working conditions "intolerable". Typically a jury determines the outcome of a retaliatory discharge claim after hearing both sides. They decide whether or not the employer's reason is true or if the employee was fired for claiming an injury. People in general and juries specifically look at an employer's past history for evidence that this type of termination is a pattern. If the employer has a pattern and practice of terminating employees after an injury, juries can award punitive damages to prohibit this type of conduct in the future.







memories for many of us. My dad perfected a piercing whistle that echoed through the evening air, signaling the end to the day's recreation and effectively breakingup any bike-riding or neighborhood game of kickthe-can. He made it to every school and sporting event, and many practices. I may not have seen him there, but I knew that familiar whistle of approval. That meant more to me than he knew.

Dad took care of the finances. He also sacrificed personal and professional gain for his children. After rebuilding a struggling local plant into profitability as its GM, corporate restructuring left him with a choice: step aside or accept a significant promotion - one that would require a move to Chicago. He'd had his fill of cities, so he chose to lean on his other skills and kept his young family in the Shoals.

When times were tense or financially tight, the kids didn't really know. We had what we needed. Dad absorbed the stress. He was very smart in that we only spent what he could pay for in full when the credit card bill came. There were no monthly payments dragging us down. My brother, sister, and I knew little economic adversity.

Dad was also a firm but fair disciplinarian when he needed to be. There are more than a handful of situations still fresh in my mind where the belt came out followed by the phrase, "This is going to hurt me more than it hurts you." My young person's interpretation still has him wrong every time on that. However, his methods seemed to work. Once the belt corrected a matter, that issue rarely had to be "discussed" again.

Ironically, as a current

advocate of corporal punishment, the penalty I remember most was being grounded in the seventh grade... for three months.

With \$3 in my pocket, I made the mistake of taking a friend's dare one Saturday to steal a 20¢ beef jerky from a convenience store about a mile from home. The cashier busted me at the register and gave me two unappealing options. He could call the police or call my father. Either way, dad was going to find out. He would much rather hear of my stupidity from an 18-year-old clerk at the Com-Pac than from City Hall. Nevertheless, that was a long ride home on my 5-speed Sears Spider. Dad was working in the garage and he was

amazingly calm when I got home. Just as I started

to relax, he said, "Let's go. Get in the car." "Where are we going?" I asked. "We're going to get a haircut." My confident response, "I just got one last week." Dad's response, which clearly set the tope for what was to the tone for what was to follow.... "You're getting another one."

Groundings at my house were simple: Straight to school-straight home, no TV, no sports (unless school related), no friends over, no leaving the yard.

He did tell me I could do some extra work around the house this one time, and he would consider knocking some time off the grounding. Years later he told me that neighbors marveled at how impressive our property looked over those next few months. There wasn't a weed in the yard, a blade of grass out of place, or a smudge on any window.

For my efforts, I got a week taken off the back-end of the sentence and I learned a life lesson.

Every child needs and responsible deserves and loving parents (a mother and a father) in the household. That is the arrangement God planned. Not coincidentally, this plan allows children the greatest chance of "being kids" and growing up healthy and happy with a strong foundation.

I am not claiming better results than anyone else, because I certainly pushed the youth envelope for many years. However, I count myself blessed that my parents were always around, we had a spiritual foundation, I knew right from wrong, my father was the family leader and disciplinarian, and my traditional family remained intact.



### Why Did God Make A Hell?-

A young man of 17 asked me this question today as I was discussing the subjects of salvation, sin and judgment and eternity with him at Crestwood hospital. I told him that hell wasn't prepared for man, but for the devil and his angels. Read: Matthew 25:41 "Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:" I then had him read: Revelation 20:14-15 "And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." Another man I talked to at the hospital told me that death and eternity contained just darkness and a kind of semiconscious state of some unassured oblivion. I then referred him to the story of the rich man in Luke 16:19-31, and to read that tonight before bedtime. Luke 16:22-25 "And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. And he cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. But Abraham said, Son, remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy good things, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted. and thou art tormented.'

My friends, your never dying soul has to spend eternity somewhere. We only spend seconds on this planet compared to eternity. Acts 4:12 "Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved." You must be saved to be prepared for eternity. Romans 10:9-10 "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation." Romans 10:13 "For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." Now it's up to you. Call on Christ.





### **Annual Drinking Water Quality Report GREENHILL WATER & FIRE PROTECTION AUTHORITY January - December 2018**

We're pleased to present to you this year's Annual Quality Water Report. This report is designed to inform you about the quality water and services we deliver to you every day. Our constant goal is to provide you with a safe and dependable supply of drinking water. We want you to understand the efforts we make to continually improve the water treatment process and protect our water resources. We are committed to ensuring the quality of your water. Greenhill's water sources are two groundwater wells which draw from the Tuscumbia/Fort Payne Aquifer and purchased water from Florence Water & Sewer Department (50%). Florence water is supplied by surface water from the Tennessee River and the Cypress Creek. In addition, Florence Water Department pumps ground water from two wells in the Killen and Center Star areas in Lauderdale County, which is blended with the treated surface water sources. In the water provided to our customers (from Greenhill), Chlorine is added for disinfection purposes, Caustic Soda is added to raise pH levels of the water that will prevent it from being corrosive and Aqua Gold to produce a desirable water quality by raising the pH level to reduce corrosion and acidic conditions. In the water provided to our customers (from Florence), Chlorine is added for disinfection purposes, Fluoride for the prevention of tooth decay, **lime** to produce a desirable water quality by raising the pH level to reduce corrosion and acidic conditions, **Potassium Permanganate** to oxidize iron, and aid in taste and odor control, **Poly Aluminum Chloride** for turbidity removal and Alum for coagulation. Also Florence has added a new treatment process called the MIEX system as a simple solution for meeting U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) disinfection by-product (DBP) removal by employing a continuous ion exchange process. The Process removes dissolved organic carbon (DOC) allowing for improved drinking water quality and regulatory compliance. Greenhill Water & FPA and Florence Water & Sewer Department have implemented a Source Water Protection Plans. These plans provide more information such as potential sources of contaminations, which may affect our water source. 


