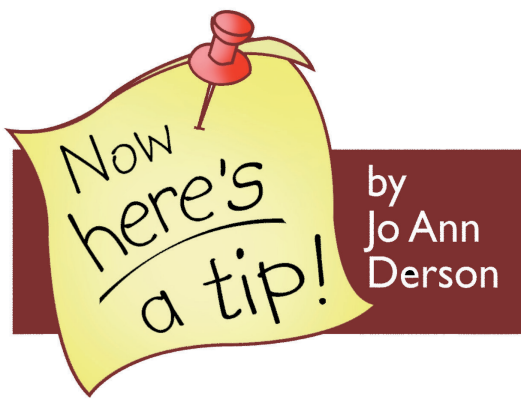

Finally, he was taken to the general manager's office. The manager rose from his chair, shook his hand and asked him to sit down.

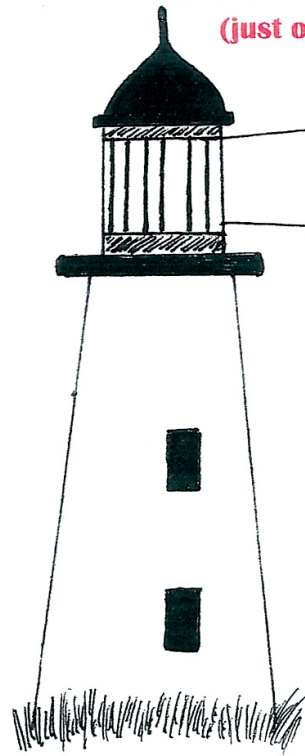

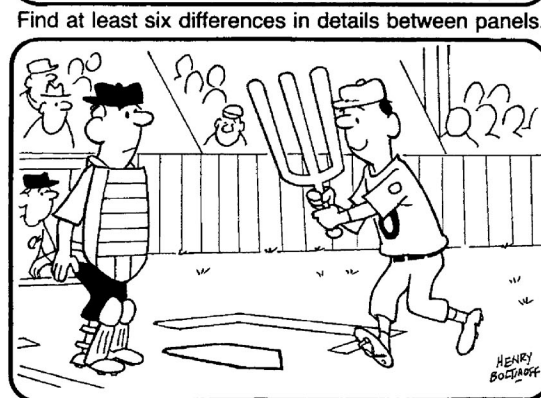

Some time ago, a woman met me at the front door early one morning. She was crying and was cradling a cat wrapped in a blanket. Her cat was elderly and sick and she wanted us to euthanize him for her.

Another memory I have is watching an entire family encircling their injured Great Dane as they grieved saying good-bye to him; they had brought him to us to euthanize.

Many times throughout the year, we are contacted by pet owners who are grieving because their pet is critically ill or injured. One of the hardest decisions that an animal guardian (or pet owner, as we used to say) will make is knowing when to euthanize your beloved friend. A veterinarian is the best person to speak with about your pet's condition. You will probably be asked if your pet is suffering from chronic pain, has frequent vomiting or diarrhea, or has stopped eating. Labored breathing or coughing can also indicate illness or injury.

Those symptoms may actually help make the decision to euthanize easier. The decision becomes tougher when the question is about the quality of life. If your pet is elderly, the quality of life will be considered, and your veterinarian will ask if the animal seems to have given up favorite activities (e.g. walking, playing, eating).

Hundreds of times throughout the years, people have sought our help in euthanizing their pets. It is a service that most shelters used to provide; now, shelters are criticized for their euthanasia numbers, so that free, vital service is one of the first services eliminated.

As more shelters stop offering to euthanize sick, elderly, or injured animals for owners, it will not have a positive outcome for the animals.

The woman who met me at the door kept saying she loved her cat, but did not want him to suffer anymore. People usually say that, and we tell them that making the difficult decision is actually the last act of kindness they can do for their beloved companion. It may sound rather emotional or simple, but sometimes being with grieving human companions as their animals go to heaven is like walking on the sacred ground of final, earthly good-byes.

Seashell Sofa

"I've never seen one before, so it must be valuable!" is a common comment made by collectors. But rarity doesn't always add to the price. Fame, beauty, workmanship, even usefulness



Not everyone would want this antique sofa from New Brunswick, Canada. It is a piece of unique and attractive folk art by a talented maker. It took time to collect and mount all the shells, and a bidder paid almost twice the estimate to buy it for \$4,613.

adds to the dollars paid for an unusual piece. A recent Skinner auction in Boston sold an 1840s-shaped sofa that was completely covered with shells — not fabric — as upholstery. The frame was made of wood and trimmed with rope. It probably was not a comfortable seat, but a unique conversation piece.

The sofa came from New Brunswick, Canada, likely from a seaside town. A talented original artist painted the wood red, then added mussel, clam, scallop, cockle, quahog, snail, starfish and other shells as well as pottery shards. The seat was covered in net. The sofa's price was estimated at under \$2,500, but it sold for \$4,613. No doubt the buyer liked the ocean and had an independent taste in furniture.

Q. I'm looking for information about a pair of salt and pepper shakers marked "Quaker Silver" and "506." There also is an emblem of a Quaker on the bottom. Can you give me an estimate of value?

A. The Quaker Silver Co. Inc. was in business in North Attleboro, Massachusetts, by 1926. It made ster-

ling silver, silver plate and pewter hollowware. The company was bought by Gorham in 1959. Salt and pepper shakers marked "506" are made of pewter. They usually sell for \$15 to \$20.

Q. We have a framed poster from the movie "Mr. Holland's Opus." It's signed "Best Wishes, Richard Dreyfuss." We also have the movie script signed the same way and the music "An American Symphony," written by Michael Kamen and signed by him and Richard Dreyfuss. We're wondering what the value of this collection is and if we should add it to one of our insurance policies.

A. You can find out the value of your collection by contacting an auction house that specializes in movie memorabilia. If the value is high, you will need to pay for a written proper legal appraisal in order to add it to your insurance policy. Condition, framing and proof of authenticity are needed to determine price. The movie "Mr. Holland's Opus" is of moderate interest but your collection should sell for \$1,000 or more.

"True Tales From Twenty-Two Years As A Pastor"

The first Sunday of June is always a very special day for Dana and me. June 1, 1997, was the day the Cornerstone Baptist Church was born. It was us and one old couple up in their seventies that just a few weeks before had been commissioned by our home church to start the new work.

Most new churches, sadly, do not make it. Just in my area I have seen at least fifty startups fail over the past twenty-two years. Of those that do make it, very few retain the founding pastor for more than a few years. So for God to have allowed me more than two decades thus far thrills me beyond measure.

My church has been so good to me. They allow me to maintain a fairly full schedule of revival and evangelistic meetings, youth rallies, and marriage conferences. They take very good care of us. They have been loving and kind to my wife and my children.

But twenty-two years in one place does not just produce "Hallmark moments;" it also produces a great many "Twilight Zone moments."

In our original building, an abandoned former fish camp, we had more renovation work to do than you could imagine. One project we undertook was the building and installation of a steeple. We used the large back room as our construction site, and labored over it for days. Just as we were finishing it, my dear wife came in, took one look at it and its 48" base, then looked at the 36" door it had to go through and said, "How do you intend to get it outside?"

Nope. We genius men had not even considered that.

Then there was the time she, in six inch high heels, went running through the parking lot to apprehend a woman who had walked in off the street, picked up the mission's change jug, and bolted with it. Dana is not one to mess with.

On one particular church work day, we had one group working on the roof, and other groups working inside. One inside group was trying to remove the hard-mounted fire extinguisher system that had been part of the fish camp kitchen. Tapping it "gently" with a hammer to try to loosen the top holding bracket, we heard a "BOOM!" as the top of the extinguisher exploded. It actually shot through the roof, the same roof the other crew was standing on to work.

A few seconds later, as the haze cleared, we saw bright sunlight streaming into the building through the large new hole in the roof. And then the light was blocked out as a face from on the roof looked down inside to see what had happened; but all we saw was two brown eyes blinking out from a face that looked like the Pillsbury Doughboy covered in new, fresh flour...

We had vandalism occurring in the men's restroom. Petty stuff like all of the toilet paper rolls being unwrapped and stuffed into toilets, air fresheners being thrown away, marks being made on the wall. And so, silently, our staff went into Sherlock Holmes mode. We keep an attendance list of every service. So each service that damage occurred, we made a list of everyone who was there. And after a few months, we had our suspects dead to rights. Two boys, thick as thieves, were the only ones there each and every time.

And so the very next service they were there I slipped up beside them with a pleasant look on my face and whispered (not at all pleasantly) "No more damage in the restroom. Ever. Understand?" Their eyes got as wide as saucers...and we never had any more damage in the restroom. Elementary, my dear Watson.

We once had a lady blow up at us over... wait for it... Kool-Aid. Some of our ladies dared to pour her pitcher out after it had sat in the refrigerator for more than six months and was growing unidentifiable new species of creatures down in its murky red depths.

We once accidentally set the entire front lawn on fire. We also, in the early days where every penny had to be stretched as if it were a full dollar, painted two dead decorative trees with green spray paint so we would not have to replace them. No one noticed for two solid years.

My favorite may just be the incomprehensibly troublesome lady in year two or three that left our church and vowed never to return. She went to another nearby church, and all of us honestly breathed a sigh of relief. And then a few weeks later she called and asked to come back. Dana and I went to pick her up, and she said, "If that man from your church had not come by to tell me how much you missed me, and begged me to come back to Cornerstone, I would have stayed gone!" I was flabbergasted. I asked who he was, and when she told me I nearly wrecked the car.

He was actually a deacon at the church she had left us for.

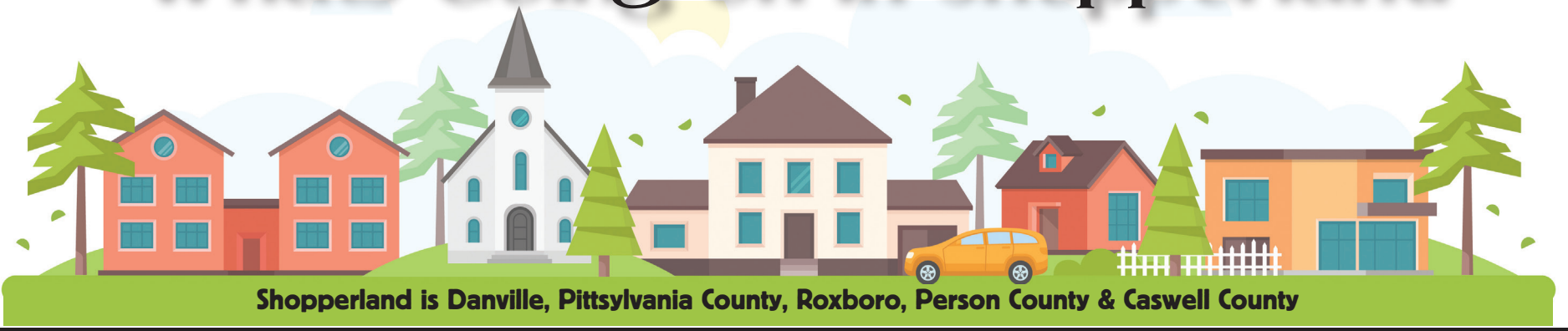

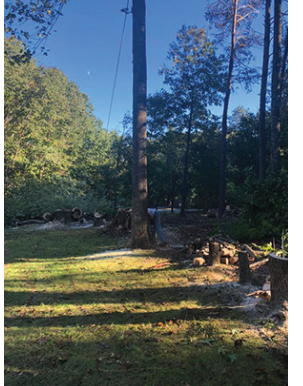

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 pound Bob Evans Original Roll Sausage

Barbecue Macaroni and Cheese Burger

Prep time: 5 minutes
Cook time: 25 minutes
Servings: 8

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 pound Bob Evans Original Roll Sausage
- 1 package (20 ounces) Bob Evans Macaroni and Cheese
- 8 hamburger buns

- 4 tablespoons barbecue sauce
- 1/2 cup French fried onion straws

In large mixing bowl, blend ground beef and sausage; divide into eight patties.

On grill over medium heat, cook burgers on each side until no longer pink in center and internal temperature reaches 160 F, about 15 minutes.

Crunchy Jalapeno Potato Poppers

Prep time: 25 minutes
Cook time: 15 minutes
Servings: 48

- 1 package (24 ounces) Bob Evans Original Mashed Potatoes
- 1 cup Monterey Jack cheese, shredded
- 1 cup sharp cheddar cheese, shredded
- 4 ounces diced jalapeno peppers, drained
- 8 ounces taco flavored tortilla chips
- 2 large eggs
- 6-8 tablespoons vegetable oil
- 1/3 cup all-purpose flour
- sour cream (optional)

Stir together cold mashed potatoes with Monterey Jack and cheddar cheeses and diced jalapenos.

Scoop 48 tablespoonfuls of potato mixture and place on parchment- or wax paper-lined baking sheet. Refrigerate 15-20 minutes.

In bowl of food processor, pulse tortilla chips to fine crumbs or place chips in large, zip-top bag and smash using rolling pin. Pour crumbs into shallow bowl. Beat eggs and pour into separate shallow bowl. Set aside.

In fryer or Dutch oven, heat oil to 350 F. Remove mashed potato scoops from refrigerator and roll into balls. Roll each mashed potato ball in flour, tapping off excess. Once potato balls are coated in flour, dip each into egg, allowing excess to drip off, then into tortilla chip crumbs, making sure to coat evenly. Set on clean baking sheet. Discard excess flour, egg and tortilla chip crumbs.

In hot oil, fry small batches of mashed potato poppers until golden brown, 30-40 seconds. Remove from fryer and place on paper towel to drain excess oil. Repeat until all poppers are cooked. Serve hot with sour cream, if desired.

Note: To reheat poppers, bake 6-8 minutes at 350 F.

Pulled Pork Mac and Cheese Sliders

Prep time: 15 minutes
Cook time: 10 minutes
Servings: 12

- 1 pound pre-packaged, fully cooked pulled pork in sauce
- 12 slider rolls
- 1 package (20 ounces) Bob Evans Macaroni and Cheese
- 2-3 tablespoons barbecue sauce
- 6 slices cheddar cheese
- 1 tablespoon barbecue dry rub
- 1/4 cup butter, melted

- 1 teaspoon dried parsley

Heat oven to 350 F.

In microwave, warm pulled pork according to package instructions.

Slice rolls in half. Place bottom halves of slider rolls in 9-by-13-inch baking dish and top each with pulled pork.

Microwave macaroni and cheese according to package directions and spoon evenly over pork on each sandwich roll.

Drizzle barbecue sauce over sandwiches. Lay cheese in two rows of three over sliders.

Top with top halves of slider rolls.

Stir dry rub into butter. Spoon evenly over tops of sandwiches. Sprinkle with parsley.

Bake, uncovered, 10 minutes.
