


Hindsight Is 20-20




Summer Sun Bakes Mail-Order Meds

The medicine must cook all day in the mailbox -- way over 100 degrees here in Florida. I wonder how much the pills or liquids are deteriorating, and how the effectiveness is influenced. -- F.N.








SUMMER BEGINS

After eight days of backpacking with my wife Linda, we were looking pretty scruffy. One morning she came to breakfast in a baseball cap, her shoulder length hair sticking out at odd angles.

"Terry," she said, "does my hair make me look like a water buffalo?"

I thought for a moment, then said, "If I tell you the truth, do you promise not to charge?"



ANSWER: You are right to be concerned. All medicines should be stored in a cool and dark place, as direct sunlight and heat can damage their effectiveness. Hormones, such as oral contraceptive pills, thyroid hormone and insulin, are among the most sensitive. Nitroglycerine is as well. Although some are shipped in packaging with cold packs and insulation, that's not always the case.

I recommend using a local pharmacy, but many people have prescription plans that require them to use mail order. If that's the case for you, try to make sure the medicine will be delivered when you are available to receive it. If you have a temperature-sensitive medicine, such as the ones I mention above (ask your pharmacist about others), ask your mail-order pharmacy to send it in special packaging during warmweather months.

DEAR DR. ROACH: I am a 68-year-old male. I had triple bypass surgery two years ago. Post-surgery complications included diabetes, pneumonia and renal failure. I spent approximately three months in intensive care. After discharge I started physical therapy, as my arms and hands had atrophied. I am still doing therapy, but continue to have limited use of my arms and hands (I cannot curl my hands without force). Any insight you have as to why I am unable to use my hands would be appreciated. -- C.M.

ANSWER: Muscle weakness is common after an ICU stay (it's seen in more than 25 percent of patients), due to several separate causes. Prolonged immobility can lead to weakness, atrophy and even contractures (involuntary bending at certain joints, such as the elbow and ankle). Both critical illness myopathy (affecting muscles; it's common in people who received steroids, like prednisone) and critical illness polyneuropathy (affecting nerves; it's common in people with severe infection, like sepsis) can lead to weakness and atrophy.

Medications are sometimes needed to paralyze muscles in surgery or in critical illnesses, and these can have long-lasting side effects, including weakness. Malnutrition is common in ICU patients, not because ICU doctors and nurses don't know to or don't want to feed patients, but because the body may be unable to absorb necessary nutrients. Some or all of these may combine to leave lasting physical effects from a long ICU stav.

Physical and occupational rehabilitation services are the key to the recovery of function. Return of physical strength is slow and may be incomplete, so it may be necessary to use aids and to learn new ways to perform tasks. It has been my repeated experience that almost everyone can benefit from therapy, and patients who work harder, are more driven and are more optimistic tend to have the best results. Although most benefit is seen in the first year after loss of function, you still may continue to improve with therapy, perhaps utilizing different modalities. Definitely seek an occupational therapist if you haven't already.

PIEDMONT PETS

Many times, people bring dogs to us because they no longer have time for them. A couple of days ago, we received a cute German short-haired pointer mix puppy. The owner said the puppy was lonely and he did not have time to spend meeting her needs. I remembered what I had learned from the three dogs I have adopted since 1992. Dogs (and most companion animals, actually) need a friend.

The very first dog I adopted after beginning my employment with the Danville Area Humane Society was a young puppy with deceptively small paws. She was the only surviving puppy of a litter that had been thrown in a dumpster.

It seems as soon as I adopted her, Molly's paws grew and by the time they finished growing, she was an 80 pound, lovable, energetic dog that was a poor match for my level of energy and physical health.

What a wonderful dog she was! Then-shelter manager, Hilary, had a big lovable, energetic dog that she brought to the shelter for playdates with Molly. Shelby and Molly were best friends until Molly was tragically killed through an accident caused by a dear friend of mine.

A few weeks after Molly was killed, a one year-old dachshund mix came to the shelter. Sugar won my heart, I adopted her and re-named her Katey. By this time, Hilary had quit to take a job in the field she had a degree in and April became our shelter manager. April adopted a sweet little dog she named Bobo. Bobo and

Katey were best friends for over ten years. They were daily companions at the shelter and Bobo also hosted playdates with Katey at her house on Saturdays.

When Katey died at the age of 12, Bobo grieved for weeks and refused to leave my side during that time. I also grieved for her and did not want another dog. A few years after that, we grieved for Bobo when she died as a frail 17 year-old girl.

That changed eight years ago when a young wirehaired dachshund mix was picked up as a stray. April brought him to my office; I named him and adopted him.

Now, Wally is best friends with April's dogs. They have playdates and are always happy to see each other. In fact, when Wally spends the weekends there, he is exhausted for a couple of days!

The great lesson I have learned is that animals really do have emotional needs that we need to be aware of and do our very best to meet.



Rookwood Fountain

Flowers were an important part of the lives of Americans from the 1880s to 1950s. Technology had advanced to a time when pottery could be made in multiples in molds and large kilns. New types of plants had been introduced to the country, flower arrangements were a sign of wealth and good taste. Formal gardens were important.



This 32-inch-high Rookwood faience fountain featuring a child and a dolphin spouts water from the dolphin's mouth into a pond. The water recirculates thanks to a pump, and when the water evaporates either a hose or rain refills it. It cost \$2,300 at a Brunk auction in North Carolina a few years ago.

Collectors can find many flower vases by Rookwood, Weller, Roseville, Grueby, Fulper and many other important factories. And urns, flower vases, wall pockets, flower frogs and even chairs, benches, garden ornaments and fountains were popular. Life-sized frogs, rabbits, turtles, squirrels, even deer, dogs, elves and large mushrooms were created to display outdoors. Talented artists made the expensive garden fountains. Many were sculptures of groups of children with birds, fish, plants, shells and large rocks. The Rookwood Pottery started making architectural pottery fountains in 1902 that were groups about 3- to 5-feet high, with water pouring from rock crevices or mouths of large fish.

Today, a Rookwood fountain can sell for \$3,000 to \$8,000, depending on the artist, subject and condition. It is not unusual to have many chips, stains even firing cracks in a fountain after years outside, but it still sells for thousands of dollars. It also pays to get expert repairs that will raise the value and add to the life of the fountain. A Rookwood fountain sold by Brunk auctions a few years ago brought \$2,300 even though it was damaged. Wear and tear on a garden piece adds to the romance and aged look. Check the backyards of house sales or even houses for sale for overlooked fountains and birdbaths or ornaments. You might find a forgotten treasure.

Q.I have a print by Henry Aiken and wonder if you could tell me anything about it — the year and someplace besides eBay where I can sell it.

A. Henry Thomas Aiken (1785-1851) was a British artist known for his pictures of sporting scenes. Some of his oil paintings sell at auction for thousands of dollars, but many original works have been reproduced and are available online for as little as \$10 or less. Your print should be seen by an expert to determine if it is an original and what its value might be. If it's an original, it would sell for a satisfactory price at an auction.



American Airlines couldn't get us to grandmother's funeral -

now it's keeping our money

When American Airlines delays and then cancels Jeanette Franz's flight, she and her family miss her grandmother's funeral in Illinois. Are they entitled to a refund?

Q: My family of four was scheduled to fly from Austin, Texas, to Quad City International Airport for my grandmother's funeral in Moline, Illinois. The first leg of our American Airlines flight from Austin to Dallas was initially delayed because of a crew problem. Then, it was delayed even more because the plane had been mistakenly overfueled and they needed to drain some fuel. These delays made us miss our connection in Dallas.

After waiting eight hours for the next flight, American Airlines canceled that flight. We had to fly back home to Austin, and we missed the services. If it weren't for the delays, which were solely the responsibility of American Airlines, we would have made our connection with no problem. I was supposed to sing at the funeral and my husband was going to be a pallbearer.

I have contacted American Airlines and they are trying to give us vouchers that have to be used this year. I explained that we no longer have a reason to fly since we've missed an experience we can never get back. I believe we are entitled to a full refund. Can you help us? — Jeanette Franz, Austin, Texas

A: My condolences on the loss of your grandmother. American Airlines should have transported you and your family to Illinois as promised.

But wait. A closer look at American Airlines' conditions of carriage, the legal agreement between you and the airline, notes, "We do our best to be on time, but our flight schedule is not guaranteed and not part of this contract." So, American Airlines wasn't required to get you to your grandmother's funeral on time, unfortunately.

This is what's called a "trip in vain," and it's a gray area for airlines and other travel companies. And for good reason. They don't want to advertise that they will offer a refund or credit if you can't make it to your destination on time. But they do. That's because the airline's published schedule certainly implies some kind of guarantee, even if the contract says otherwise.

American Airlines offered you a voucher, but as you note, vouchers expire within a year of the initial purchase. For you, the funny money was worthless — and you're right, American Airlines could do better. After all, the crew problem and the mechanical issue were within the airline's control.

I list the names, numbers and email addresses of the American Airlines customer service executives on my website. A brief, polite email to one of them might have yielded a better outcome.

I contacted American Airlines on your behalf. A representative called you and offered the airline's condolences on your loss. American Airlines has issued a full refund.

In winning the award, the APPA cited projects by Danville Utilities that provide reliable energy and diversify its power supply portfolio. Last year, Danville Utilities celebrated the completion of the six-megawatt Kentuck solar project, and it has agreements in place for the purchase of up to 22 megawatts of solar power from projects planned in the Whitmell and Ringgold communities.

They have provided protection for us, but we are also gratified by the compassion exhibited by each one who serves in any capacity in that department. They are true heroes for the animals."

Sergeant Nicole Jeffries with the Community and Youth Engagement Unit said, "The Danville Police Department is excited to partner with the Danville Area Humane Society as we work together to protect all things, great and small."

The Danville Area Humane Society and Danville Police department have dealt with hundreds of cruelty cases and thousands of neglect cases through the years. Sadly, several have been because of the actions of children or youth. Although some children are born with a natural love for animals, they must be guided and taught appropriate behavior. Empathy is the ability to recognize and feel what another living creature (human or animal) is feeling and then act appropriately and compassionately.

Dean said, " Empathy for animals can be developed through positive interaction and it is our hope that through a Cops and Critters experience, children and youth can learn more about how to respect and care for animals."

Each participant in the Cops and Critters event will receive a t-shirt, provided through the generosity of The Community Foundation of the Dan River Region.

Cops and Critters will be a hands-on experience. There will be a mini-class on the care of companion animals, presented by Dr. Laura Luffman of Animal Medical Center. A turtle and rats will visit with their human, Dayne Scott. The children will help the police officers in bathing puppies, walking dogs, and playing with kittens and cats.

An hour before the event begins, we also invite the media to attend an announcement of another partnership between the two agencies that has the potential of saving both human and animal lives.
