## Common Sources of Indoor Air Pollution

**Carpet:** Some materials in carpet emit volatile organic compounds, or VOCs, which are emitted as gases and can have both short- and long-term adverse health effects. The concentration of many VOCs is as much as 10 times higher indoors than outdoors. When purchasing new carpet, homeowners can choose low-VOC adhesives that do not contain formaldehyde. It's also ideal to install new carpet in spring or early summer, when windows can be opened to air out the carpet for several hours without compromising comfort for those people inside the home.

**Glue:** Glue is widely considered a handy cure-all for minor problems around the house, but glue may also be compromising your health. Certain glues and adhesives like rubber cement emit VOCs, which can irritate the eyes and even the nervous system, and some may even emit toxic formaldehyde. When purchasing glues and other adhesives, opt for water-based products and avoid using glues and adhesives in smaller, poorly ventilated areas of your home.

Air fresheners: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency notes that many household air fresheners almost continuously release pollutants. While some air fresheners are safe, the best way to freshen air in a home is to open the windows and let fresh air inside. When possible, open the windows to let fresh air in rather than relying on potentially harmful store-bought air fresheners.

Older appliances: Old or malfunctioning stoves, furnaces and space heaters pose both safety and health risks around a home. Old or malfunctioning stoves increase the risk of fire around a home. But such products also intermittently release pollutants, putting residents' health in jeopardy. Homeowners should look into replacing especially old appliances, as today's newer products are both more efficient and liable to emit fewer pollutants than older products. Malfunctioning products should be fixed immediately or replaced if repairs are unlikely to significantly extend the life expectancy of the product. ■













## SIGNS OF A STROKE

Sometimes symptoms of a stroke are difficult to identify. The stroke victim may suffer severe brain damage when people nearby fail to recognize the symptoms of a stroke. Now doctors say a bystander can recognize a stroke by asking a few simple questions:

## Do you have HEEL pain or ARCH pain?

#### **HEEL SPUR SYNDROME/PLANTAR FASCITIS**

is a common problem among people who are active. It starts as a dull intermittent pain in the heel which may progress to a sharp persistent pain. Classically, it is worse in the morning with the first few steps, after sitting, after standing, or after walking.

• Plantar fasciitis often begins with irritation and tearing of the fibrous band of tissue on the bottom of the foot, which may eventually result in the formation of a heel spur.

• Contributing factors: flat pronated feet, high arched feet, poor shoe support, increased age, sudden weight increase, increased activity level, family tendency.

• Approximately 2-3 times your body weight of force is exerted on each foot with walking. Flexible, non-custom molded arch support found at those advertised shoe stores cannot support these forces and usually do not provide long-lasting relief, do not come with a lifetime warranty, and are typically more expensive than custommolded ones made by our office.

slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before betting help. Symptoms include:

**CHEST DISCOMFORT.** Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain.

#### DISCOMFORT IN OTHER AREAS OF THE UPPER BODY.





If your teenager was troubled and straying, you would want a man like Brett Sobieraski to sit and talk to him or her. If your sheriff's department was operating below potential, you would Brett Sobieraski to take its helm.

What I know of Brett Sobieraski I have read in the faces and stories of the officers he has led, trained, and served with for the last 20 years. They love him. They admire him. They strive to be like him. He is a legendary friend, a trusted leader, and an inspiration to all. That same spirit will be part of every interaction between Sheriff Brett Sobieraski and the noble men and women who wear the uniform of the Orleans County Sheriff's Office. He will always be leading, teaching and loving.

He will likewise bring the same spirit of servant leadership to the people, institutions and law enforcement agencies of Orleans County. This sheriff will be who he's supposed to be – the county's protector. And you can bank on that.

Brett Sobieraski will not let you down.

Brett Sobieraski doesn't let anybody down.

## The Sheriff's Office Divisions and Areas of Responsibilities

**CORRECTION DIVISION:** The Orleans County Correction Division is our largest Division with a Jail Supt and 50 full and part time employees and a 4.1 million dollar Budget. Our Correction Officers are responsible for the safe and secure operation of the O.C. Jail with a maximum capacity of 82 inmates. Correction Officers perform hundreds of Court transports per year.

- Continue to seek funding and offer programs of intense comprehensive treatment for inmates in the jail seeking help with drug addiction.
- Continue to work with the Orleans County Legislature, the Orleans County Magistrates Association, the District Attorney's Office and Orleans County Probation on the implementation of several pieces of legislation that N.Y.S. has passed which mandates sweeping changes in the criminal justice system by 2020. Some examples are: "Raise the Age of Criminal Responsibility", "Right to Council at all Arraignments", "Bail Reform/No Cash Bail/Discovery Requirements"
- Work with the Orleans County Legislature in exploring long term plans for enhancing the current jail structure or an alternative site based on projected needs.
- Continue to scrub medical bills related to inmate medical care while in the facility and explore new ways of reducing the exorbitant medical bills for inmates which will reduce cost to the taxpayer.
- Continue to improve our training and equipment program for Correction Officers and expand our Jail Intelligence Unit.

**CML DMSION:** The Civil Division of the Sheriff's Office is comprised of 4 Civil Clerks and 1 Confidential Secretary. The Sheriff's Civil Division is responsible for preparing Civil Process for Service by the Deputies. Our Civil Division duties are one of the mandated duties of a Sheriff in New York State. We serve and enforce the legal process for legal community and general public.

- Sheriff's Civil Division performs the following duties; service of income and property executions, notices, summonses, subpoenas, and petitions.
- Serve Court Orders such as contempt of court, civil arrest warrants, orders of seizures and attachments. Serve evictions, notices, orders, writs and deliver property back to the owners following an eviction.
- Our Civil Division processes nearly a million dollars per year by collecting fees, poundage, bail money, pistol permit fees, and receipts related to civil process.

**PAR CENTER** Our Sheriff's Office 911 Center consists of 13 full and part time Public Safety Dispatchers. The Sheriff's Office 911 Center is a 24 hour operation handling all fire, ambulance, police (including NYSP) and animal control dispatching duties. All of our Public Safety Dispatchers are also Emergency Medical Dispatchers who may give life saving directions to callers while emergency crews are responding.

**ANIMAL CONTROLS** The Sheriff's Office Animal Control Division consists of 2 full time and 1 part time Animal Control Officers and the Orleans County Animal Shelter. Animal Control handles approximately 1400 calls for service per year.

- In 2018, due to increased caseload and taking on the Village of Medina animal calls, Sheriff Bower and our administration, working together with the Orleans County Legislature, added an additional full time Animal Control Officer to provide better service to the residents.
- Our Animal Control Officers are now on a 4 and 2 schedule with coverage from 7:00am to 8:00pm. This allows us to have an officer on every day of the week, some with two shifts a day. In the off times, Road Deputies shall respond to emergency animal calls and may call out an A.C. Officer when needed.

## **MARINE DIVISION:** Our Sheriff's Marine Division consists of 1 full time Sheriff's Marine Deputy and 10 Seasonal Deputies.

- Our Sheriff's Marine vessels consist of the following; M-1= 27ft SAFE Boat, M-2 = 24ft Boston Whaler Justice Center Console, M-3 = 19 ft Triton Center Console, M-4= 17ft Jet Boat.
- We also have a Patrol Tahoe and Pickup truck assigned to the Marine Division along with a Marine Office located in the County Marine Park.
- All of our Sheriff's Marine Division vessels and vehicles were obtained either at no direct cost to Orleans County taxpayers through our Partnership with NYS Parks, Recreation and Historical Preservation or 50% to 100% funded through the US Department of Homeland Security.
- The Sheriff's Office receives 50% reimbursement on expenditures from N.Y.S. related to Marine operations.
- The Sheriff's Office patrols 26 miles of border on Lake Ontario out to International water, the Erie Barge Canal, Lake Alice in Waterport, and other bodies of water.

**CRIMINAL DIVISION:** The Sheriff's Office Criminal Division consists of 23 Road Patrol Deputy Sheriffs. The Criminal Division is responsible for providing service and patrolling the 817 square miles of Orleans County.

- Deputy Sheriffs respond to calls for service, investigate crimes, investigate motor vehicle accidents including certified accident reconstruction personnel, provide security at the Orleans County Court House and County Office Building, maintain the Sex Offender registry, provides School Resource Officers in Kendall and Lyndonville School Districts, have three full time investigators in the C.I.D Unit, Certified Child Safety Seat inspectors, Service of
- We continue to upgrade operating systems and radio equipment to provide the best service possible to our residents.

Civil Process for the Civil Division, K-9 Unit, SWAT Team, along with attending many community events throughout the year.



If a contract has been breached or a dispute arises, please call the Law Office of MACK & PACE at (585)798compelled to clear up some of the disheartening false accusations that are being spread about its members. The OCDSA is comprised of 24 hardworking individuals, whose ultimate goals are to serve and protect the citizens of Orleans County. It has been implied that the OCDSA members are untrained, do not make vehicle and traffic stops, do not work with other

The OCDSA members receive required refresher trainings annually, along with opportunities to receive more specialized training. Despite having a small number of members and a tight training budget, the current administration strives to find creative ways to get our members into trainings that are free of charge. Many essential training seminars are hosted by the Department of Homeland Security at no cost to the department (including lodging for multi-day programs). Other examples also include a week long training that was put on by the New York State Office of Mental Health in which they traveled to our county to instruct our members on how to help people who are experiencing a mental health crisis and facilitate in getting them support. Additionally, our members have received training in basic first aid, CPR, and Stopping the Bleed (tourniquets). We've had specialized training in the civil process and the proper way to serve civil papers.

Due to the opioid epidemic members have also received more specialized training in handling drug overdoses and overdose deaths to include the proper way to administer Narcan and issued a Narcan kit. A critical tool in solving overdose deaths is the ability to access data in the deceased person's cell phone. Undersheriff Christopher Bourke was able to work with the DEA and have Cellebrite, a \$10,000 instrument, donated to the department. This piece of equipment is used in overdoses and numerous other types of investigations.

#### **DOING WHAT ROBINS DO!** By Douglas H. Domedion

It stood perfectly still and then took a quick dash of a few feet and then froze again. It continued to do this across the lawn until one time it tilted its head side ways when it stopped. Quickly reaching down in the grass it pulled an earthworm out and proceeded to eat it.



Doing what robins do!

We have all witnessed this "run, stop, listen" hunting method on our lawns. The first bird a child may notice and learn to call by name is the American Robin. They are the most widespread and best known birds in America. It is the largest of our North American thrushes and its bright orange breast and yellow beak makes it easy to identify. Males normally are darker with more intense color than the females while the juveniles will have large black spots on a pale orange breast.

It is one of our native birds that have increased its range because of man's "developments." As more areas were opened up by farming and homesteading better environments came into existence for the robin.

The average life span of a robin is less then one and a half years, but ones that survive to adulthood have a life expectancy of 10 years. In fact there are records of them living for up to 17 years.

They show amazing tolerance of human beings, even building their nests next to or on our homes. I have had them nest on the power line where it connects to my house, on an old fence post leaning against the barn, on the curve of a downspout on a rain gutter, in my firewood shelter (very popular spot), on window sills and in a bush right next to the house door that we use 95% of the time.

There are some really unique nest sites on record such as under the box of the running gear of a farmer's wagon. He made two trips a week to a village two miles away and the robins followed him with the female incubating while the farmer did his town errands. They would then follow him home again. The amazing thing was that they successfully raised their young during all of this travel!

In Michigan, robins built a nest on the arm of an active oil well pump and raised the young as the arm rose and fell with each stroke. In Iowa a pair built on a locomotive that went to and from Chicago. That nest was also successful because the female followed the train along its route to take care of the young.

The robin's song is a joyful and cheerful "cherrily, cheer-up, cheerio" song. They sing mostly at first light in the morning and last thing at night. They also sing a lot just before a rain and old folklore has it that they do this to make it rain.

The nest building takes about 3 to 10 days and incubation is 11 to 13 days. In 13 to 15 days the young will leave the nest. They like to use course grass to build the nest but will also add paper, cloth and string when it is available. They make an inter wall of mud and then line the inside with finer grass. A second brood maybe raised in the same nest after it is refurbished. One robin used a rafter on my barn to build one nest on top of another for several years in a row. Because many nest are built near to human dwellings house cats destroy many young robins. Young children and curious adults often get too close to a nest a few days before the young are ready to leave and this will cause them to leave prematurely. Unfortunately trying to put them back in the nest never works, as they will just keep jumping out. It is best to leave the area when this happens, making sure there are no cats or dogs around, and let the parents take care of them wherever they end up. The American Robin is so common that we often overlook its beauty and the trust it has for human beings. Take a few minutes the next time you see one in your backyard and watch it closely. Observe the beautiful orange breast and how skilled he is at finding and extracting a worm in your lawn.

 $1 \frac{1}{2}$  pounds new potatoes, about 15 Kosher salt and black pepper 4 slices bacon 3 tablespoons olive oil 2 tablespoons red wine vinegar 2 teaspoons Dijon mustard 1 cup fresh, flat-leaf parsley, roughly chopped

Meanwhile, cook the bacon in a medium skillet over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until crisp, 6 to 8 minutes. Transfer to a paper towel-lined plate. Let cool, then crumble.

In a large bowl, whisk together the oil, vinegar, mustard, 3/4 teaspoon salt, and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Add the potatoes, bacon and parsley and toss to combine.

Tip: The potatoes can be cooked and tossed with the dressing and parsley up to 1 day in advance; refrigerate, covered. Bring to room temperature and add the bacon just before serving.
