



Marple Newtown Community Band



The Marching Cobras Drumline and Danceline has taken New York and its neighboring states by storm. The program provides



opportunities that will promote leadership, teamwork, as well as physical fitness with a strong focus on character development. With a plethora of performances under our belt some of our most notable performances have been a part in the movie "The Birdman" the band also lead the Vince Lombardi Trophy into the stadium at the 2014 Super Bowl. The Marching Drumline and Danceline has opportunities for all young people. We create memorable events for the individual but also for the collective membership. These events provide realistic experiences that empower band members to contribute to common goals at practice. Team building and learning music benefit the participants in both their school work and personal life. The long term benefits include enhanced communication skills, concentration, decision making, stress minimization and self confidence.

The program also addresses the escalating violence, gang presence, dropout rate, lack of positive male role models for

and female role models and reduce the incidence of risk taking behaviors among this vulnerable population. The program also deals with a critical and often overlooked need in the minority community overweight and obesity. With a large minority population the need for intervention is critical to ensure the short-term and long-term of these youth. The Band program address this critical issue by a "Healthy Lifestyles and Transitions Program" as part of the Marching Cobra Program.

We pride ourselves on is the fact that there is no prerequisite for experience in our program. Many of our members were not drummers or dancers when they first entered. They heard about the program and their interest brought them to us. This is where we were able to really shape, mold, and work with anyone. Sure it is beneficial if an individual has the experience but it is not a requirement. If you show you will be dedicated and that you will put in the effort to learn your craft then it becomes easy. The best thing is watching an individual go from knowing very little to mastering their drum or their dance. Socially healthy and respectful bonds are formed. Shy individuals quickly come out of their shells and shine bright with the rest of the program. Every and anyone that is willing has a place in our program.

Fusion Core Drum Corps

Fusion Core is a non-profit performing arts organization providing music education, as well as dance, movement, and color

guard choreography instruction while competing and performing within the DCA Circuit. Formed in 2007, Fusion was successful in earning High Caption Awards in Brass, Visual and Guard at the 2008 Championships. Today the Core competes in the Open Class Division of DCA earning High Guard and top 5 placement with 3rd place in Brass at the World Championships in Williamsport. PA. During the Core's tenure the Core earned the Class A Championship title with High Caption Awards in Visual Effect, Music Effect, Brass & Color Guard. 2011 the Core placed in the top ten making history as one of the first Class A Corps to earn a voting right within the DCA Organization. We are excited to continue to expand upon the standards set and championship caliber instruction which has brought us to this juncture. Fusion is governed by an Administration and Board of Directors who volunteer their time, knowledge and experience in order to provide the best drum corps experience to all our members: no one on either the Board or Administration receive any form of compensation. Fusion Core brings young adults ages 14 and up together to accomplish a common goal. 

2019 Grand Marshal Tom Murray



Tom is married to his wife of 42 years Ellen and they have four grown children, Tom III, Katie, Patty, and Matt. Tom is a graduate of Cardinal O'Hara High School class of 1970 and attended St. Joseph's University. Tom has been active in the Marple Township Community since he was 17 years old when he joined the Broomall Fire Company as a volunteer fire fighter in 1969, following in the footsteps of his late father Tom Murray Sr. During his time with the Broomall Fire Company Tom rose thru the ranks and in 1980 Tom was elected to Chief of the Broomall Fire Company a position he held for over twenty years. Tom continues his service with the Broomall Fire Company to this day and currently serves as the Deputy Chief.

In September of 1979 Tom was sworn in as a Patrol Officer with the Marple Township Police Department. During the next 13 years Tom worked in patrol, before being promoted to Sergeant, a position he held for 10 years. During his time as a sergeant Tom had the opportunity to attend the FBI National Academy in Quantico, VA, only the second member of the Marple Township Police Department to attend this prestigious class. In July 2002, Tom was again promoted, this time to the rank of Lieutenant in charge of Police Operations. On January 10, 2005 Tom was promoted one final time to the rank of Chief of Police a position he has held since.

During his career with the Marple Township Police Department, Tom has received numerous commendations for his police work. Among them he has 6 Excellent Duty Citations and 1 Meritorious Duty Citation. He has seen many changes during his police career most notable was guiding the Marple Township Police Department through an Accreditation process, resulting in the Marple Township Police Department becoming only the second police department in Delaware County to achieve accredited status through the Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police Association in 2016.

Tom has also served on numerous committees with both the Fire Service as well as Law Enforcement. Tom currently chairs the Delaware County Emergency Services Advisory Committee and is a Board member for the Delaware County Domestic Abuse Project. He has served as the President of the Delaware County Police Chiefs Association in 2013 and is Past President of the Pennsylvania Association of Arson Investigators.

On January 10, 2020 fifteen years to the day when he was appointed Chief, Tom will officially retire from the Marple Township Police Department having served for just over 40 years.
