



That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness." Think about these wonderful words and hold them close.

Have a wonderful Independence Day and remember what we really celebrate on this day in the United States of America.







As both a cultural and educational institution and stewards of local history, the Livingston County Museum is dedicated to promoting an appreciation of the present through a deeper understanding of the past.


