Dear Speakout:

Thursday, July 4th is Independence Day in 2019.

Our founding fathers placed their lives on the line when they signed the Declaration of Independence in 1776. They knew if they were captured that they would be executed as traitors. We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness. That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed, That whenever any Form of Government becomes destructive of these ends, it is the Right of the People to alter or to abolish it, and to institute new Government, laying its foundation on such principles and organizing its powers in such form, as to them shall seem most likely to effect their Safety and Happiness." Think about these wonderful words and hold them close.

Have a wonderful Independence Day and remember what we really celebrate on this day in the United States of America.

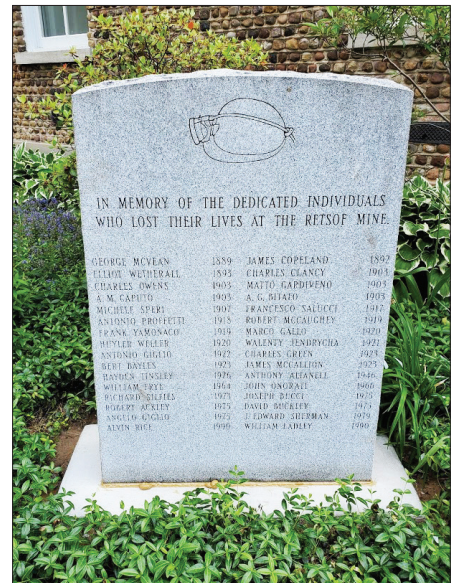


Historical Society Receives Generous Donation

As both a cultural and educational institution and stewards of local history, the Livingston County Museum is dedicated to promoting an appreciation of the present through a deeper understanding of the past.

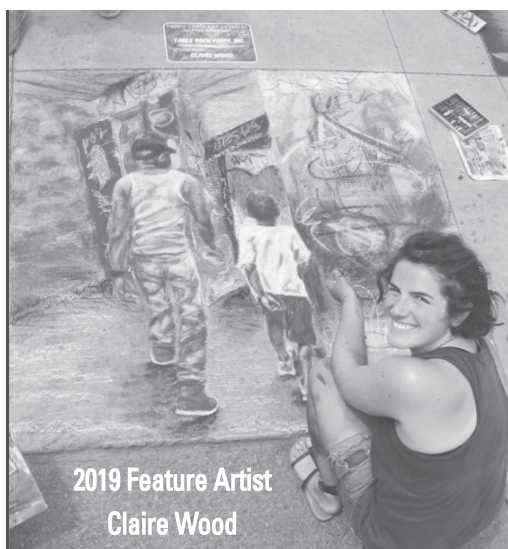

Working in collaboration with representatives of American Rock Salt and SUNY Geneseo, we look forward to improving exhibitions that feature the stories and artifacts relating to Salt Mining in the Genesee Valley. This is not only a story of the past, but also of the present, and future."

Additionally, the Museum is now home to a memorial stone dedicated to the miners who lost their lives at the seven local area mines. Formerly at the site of the closed Retsof shaft, the stone can now be seen in the front gardens of the Livingston County Museum.
