MATADOR, TEXAS

This July Fourth week, let's explore a little more of the great American West's ranching heritage with a further stroll through Matador, Texas. The town was consolidated by the founders of the Matador Ranch, a Scottish syndicate of investors, in the year of 1882, and a post office was established in 1886. The town and the ranch were run by their representatives. The townspeople later "broke free" from the dominion of the Matador ranch when the city was incorporated around 1899, they did this by by relocating nonranch families there and electing their own slate of officials. The community was incorporated in 1912 and made the county seat. The state required that a town have at least 20 businesses. Local ranch hands hence established fraudulent, temporary businesses using ranch supplies. The only real business in Matador at the time was a saloon but there was a hotel in place by 1914. Originally the Carter Hotel, built in 1914 by Roy Carter and his wife, the former Jessie Simpson which would later become the Hotel Matador. For a rural area, the Carter hotel had luxurious rooms with a bell hop, a full-time gardener, and laundry service. It had 15 rooms, a dining room, and a large 9-foot, oak-rimmed tub as the

only bathroom in the facility. An ice cream parlor, which ran the length of the lobby, operated until the 1920s.

The name "Hotel Matador" was coined during that same decade. The hotel changed owners several times. It was a community gathering place for meetings, parties, and dances for young people. In 1941, hotelier and barber Warren





Clements purchased the Matador Hotel property. He turned the ice cream parlor into a barber shop. He also established living quarters for himself and his wife, Faye, with an apartment behind the hotel. Mrs. Clements maintained an English garden known for her prize irises, and under her tutelage, the hotel was Matador formal dining room Matador registry desk known for its entertainment.

In 1980, Johnny (Sonny) and Evelyn Jackson purchased the hotel and restyled it into apartments. It later became a single residence, but had been abandoned for five years when the current owners took possession and began reclaiming and restoring the historic facility. In recent years, three sisters, Marilyn Hicks, Linda Roy, and Caron Perkins, have operated the Matador as an eight-unit bed and breakfast. I met one of the sisters, and although she declined to pose for a photo, she told me that this is the siblings' "retirement business" and that they love putting on events and catering to the needs of visitors. Back in 1980, the barber shop had been converted to the Circle Cross Heritage suite, and today



retains the original tin ceiling and elaborate bathroom fixtures. If you stop in at the Matador Hotel, whether you plan to book a stay or just want to view the luxury from a time past, you will receive a warm welcome and a friendly lesson on it's history.

Noel Wiley of San Benito is a prominent Rio Grande businessman who has always had a big interest in horses. He grew to love them while growing up on his family's farm near Ballinger. When I interviewed Mr. Wiley early this year he was in the process of getting his Mare's Milk business going.

"In 2005 I was reading Draft Horse Journal and there was an article in it about the benefits of mare's milk," says Mr. Wiley.

"I was intrigued. The article mentioned that in Europe milk from pregnant horses was being used for medicines and cosmetics. In 2006 we took a trip to Europe and discovered that in the Brussels, Belgium phone book there were 32 listings for horse milking farms. We went to one and became friends and eventually business partners with the owners and founded the first ever equine dairy in the United States. It's located in Jamesport, Missouri, an Amish community.

"After a couple of trips to Europe and having European horse farmers come over here, our main concern was finding out just who and where these pregnant mares would be milked. We heard that the Amish have big horses in Missouri and are superb farmers and dairymen who take pride in what they do. We determined they could supply us with clean and sanitary pregnant mare's milk (PMM). So farmers from Europe came over and taught the Amish how to milk horses, something they had never done before."

After the milk is obtained from the Amish dairies it is spray dried to powder form and formulated into products. It is being produced and sold under the product name of Ooh La Leche. I have read letters from pharmacists and others who say capsules made from mare's milk help with diarrhea and hot flashes. There is also a cream for skin disorders.

There are some mentions about pregnant mare's milk in history. Literature claims that Cleopatra used it to maintain her youthful complexion. In Europe PMM treatments are available in health clubs and spas. PMM is found in specialized massage oils. Mr. Wiley lists several PMM products including hand creams, shampoo gel and conditioner, body lotion, yogurt, baby formula, ice cream, energy drinks and horse milk liquor. He says the pregnant mare's milk capsules help with irritable bowel syndrome, Crohn's disease, colitis, vaginal dryness and menopause.

Mr. Wiley was amazed at what his research had told him about PMM. did not rush into his new enterprise. He went to the FDA and got specific instructions as to what is necessary to produce a certified dairy. Since he had developed a couple of gated communities in the valley he was familiar with building codes and governmental requirements. "It hasn't been easy, but I think it'll be worth it," he says.
