


Obituary





PIEDMONT PETS

Open-admission shelters are feeling the effects of "kitten season and puppy season". Thousands of unwanted litters are being born. Larger shelters, giving away kittens in "clear the shelter" events, and other programs cannot solve the problem; only spaying and neutering can.

This is a good time to remind all Danville and Pittsylvania County residents that we continue to offer spay/neuter rebates. Danville residents can receive up to \$75 and Pittsylvania County residents can receive up to \$50.

A rebate certificate must be picked up from the shelter at least the day before the animal is taken to the veterinary clinic for the surgery.

The general guidelines are:

The money is to be used for residents of Danville and Pittsylvania County. The pets must live with them.
 No money can be used

to facilitate the adoption of any animal from any other rescue group or shelter.

3. No money can be used for another.

for any animal being fostered for another group or for an animal that is going to be released to another group.

4. The money cannot

4. The money cannot be used for general trap/neuter/release programs. The exception would be if an individual will take legal responsibility of the feral cat's lifetime care, including providing food, water, shelter, and veterinary care and the cats are released on the person's personal property.

The real math is this: Every minute in the United States, 50 dogs, 50 cats, and 8 humans are born. That means that a family of four must have 25 pets in order for there to be no homeless dogs and cats.

The medical benefits for a spayed/ neutered dog or cat are numerous. Neutering males decreases and often eliminates diseases that intact male dogs are prone to later in life, including diseases of the prostate, testicles, and other tissues influenced by male hormones.

Spaying female dogs and cats entirely eliminates diseases of the ovaries and uterus, and if performed befOore the first heat, greatly reduces the chance of mammary cancer. Behavior is only positively affected by the sterilization surgery. A neutered male cat's territorial spraying is decreased. And spayed or neutered dogs and cats fight less and wander less

Spaying and neutering programs can benefit the animals and also humans. Through the courtesy of the E. Stuart James Grant Charitable Trust, we have spent almost \$1 million since 1993 on our spay/neuter programs. We invite all eligible residents to take advantage of this rebate program.







Petaluma, CA may be known as the Wrist Wrestling Capital of the World, but now has a relatively new boast, the home of the World's Ugliest Dog contest.



Mr. Disney's "Black Sunday" July 2019

July 17, 1955, was intended as an invited-guests-only, media-oriented day to celebrate the long-awaited opening of Disneyland. Technically it was called the "International Press Preview," but Disney employees—and even Disney himself-would afterwards come to label it "Black Sunday."

During the 1930s and 1940s, Walt Disney had visited several amusement parks with his wife and their two daughters. What he saw often tended to be rundown, trash-littered places that usually focused on scary "thrill rides."

Disney began to envision something better. In 1948, he sketched out a small place that he dubbed Mickey Mouse Park, its primary attraction to be a boat ride. Over the years, though, his once-simple plan morphed into a spectacular venue that would draw people from around the world.

To raise much-needed cash, Disney sold his vacation home and borrowed against a life-insurance policy. Then, in October of 1954, the fledgling ABC-TV network helped by offering priceless promotion for Walt's dream through an hour-long Wednesday-night show called Disneyland.

In 1953, Disney had purchased 160 acres of orange and walnut trees near the farming town of Anaheim, 22 miles southeast of downtown Los Angeles. With a crew of 1,200 workers, construction began the next year. By opening day in 1955, Disneyland's price tag had reached \$17 million (about \$125) million in today's money).

Disneyland officials expected 15,000 of their invited guests to show up for the opening, but over 28,000 excited folks, many wielding counterfeit tickets, jammed into the overcrowded park that day. One enterprising man charged \$5 to people who wanted to climb a back fence by using a ladder that he brought.

Much to Uncle Walt's chagrin, his troubles were just beginning that day. Around the park, workers frantically slathered on paint and hastily planted trees, and beds of weeds suddenly bore signs with Latin plant names. Many rides were still under construction, and those that operated sometimes broke down. Too many passengers aboard the Mark Twain Steamboat nearly caused it to capsize. Every park restaurant and concession stand ran out of food and beverages within hours. A small fire broke out in Sleeping Beauty's Castle. Adventureland, Frontierland and Fantasyland had to shut down for the afternoon due to a gas leak.

The temperature that afternoon reached a sweltering 101 degrees, with the now-sticky fresh asphalt seizing women's high-heeled shoes. While drinking fountains were available around the park, none worked on that fateful day. Plumbers had gone on strike, and Disney had to choose between working water fountains and working toilets. "Well, you know they could drink Coke and Pepsi," he grumbled, "but they can't pee in the streets. Finish the restrooms."

After opening day, adult park visitors paid a \$1 admission fee–kids were 50 cents—while the park's 35 rides each carried a separate cost of 25 to 35 cents each per adult, with children paying 10 to 25 cents each.

Two months after opening, the Magic Kingdom had welcomed its one millionth customer, the debacle of Black Sunday mercifully forgotten.



Social Security Matters

Ask Rusty - Should I claim benefits early and invest them?

Dear Rusty: I am 64 years old and my wife is 62. We both have good paying careers. Our original plan was to wait until we each turned 70 before drawing our Social Security benefits. But I was talking to a friend who is a very successful small business owner who told me that he started drawing his SS benefits at age 62. He puts the funds in a mutual fund every month. He has "run the numbers " and he is convinced that he will come out ahead rather than waiting to draw at age 70. I was shocked to hear this advice since I had never heard any expert advocate this option before. What say you, Sir? Signed: Questioning My Plan

Dear Questioning: I, too, have "run the numbers" many times. Although Social Security will say that it makes no difference when you apply (they say you get the same in total benefits no matter which age you claim) with average longevity today being in the mid-80's (84 for men; 87 for women) that may not be true. I have done numerous "break even analyses" and have found that if one claims at their full retirement age instead of at age 62, they will have collected the same amount of benefits at age 78 in either case. That means that by living longer than age 78, you will realize more in total cumulative lifetime Social Security benefits by waiting until your full retirement age to apply. Similarly, if you wait until age 70 to claim, you will break even (collect the same in total benefits) at age 82, and if you live beyond 82 you'll get more in cumulative benefits by waiting. If you live well beyond those ages, the extra benefits can be very substantial.

I wonder if your friend included in his analysis how the "earnings test" affected his early benefits. If you are still working and you claim benefits before you reach your full retirement age, you'll be subject to Social Security's "earnings limit" (\$17,640 for 2019) which, if you exceed it, will cause Social Security to withhold benefits equal to \$1 for every \$2 you are over the limit. This applies to both you and your wife. The earnings limit doesn't go away until your reach your full retirement age, so when contemplating whether to collect benefits before your full retirement age you should assess the amount of benefit loss you will incur if your earnings exceed the earnings limit. Although at your full retirement age (FRA) Social Security gives you time credit for any months you don't received benefits because you exceeded the earnings limit, it will take you years to recover any withheld benefits because they only slightly increase your benefit at your FRA to compensate for withheld benefits from over-earning (you need to live long enough to recover those lost benefits).

And did your friend consider this: your surviving spouse will receive 100% of the benefit you are receiving at your death. If you claim before your full retirement age, your surviving spouse will get the reduced amount; if you wait until after your full retirement age to claim, your surviving spouse will get the full amount of your benefit increased by delayed retirement credits. Benefits are about 76% more at age 70 than they are at age 62.

Of course, the question of when to apply must always take into account your current financial needs, your current health and lifestyle, and your expected longevity (considering your family history). Whether to claim early and invest those benefits or wait until later is a choice only you can make. But you should consider the above points and compare the guarantee of increasing your lifetime benefit amount by 6% to 8% for each year you wait to claim, against the interest or growth rate you might expect from investing in the securities market.

WVY Where to Get Help Paying **Your Medicare Costs**

Dear Savvy Senior,

Are there any sources you know of that can help me save on my Medicare coverage? I'm 65, and live primarily on my Social Security, and am having a hard time paying my Medicare out-of-pocket costs.

Need Some Help

Dear Need,

There are several financial assistance programs that can help lower-income Medicare beneficiaries who are having a difficult time paying their out-of-pocket health care costs. Here's what's available, along with the eligibility requirements and how to apply.

Medicare Savings Programs

Let's start with a program that helps pay premiums and out-of-pocket costs for Medicare Parts A and B. It's called the Medicare Savings Program (MSP), and it has several different benefit levels for people based on their income and asset level. At its most generous the program will pay your Part A and B premiums and pretty much all your Medicare deductibles, coinsurance and copayments. At its least generous the program will pay just your Part B premium.

To qualify for a MSP, the minimum standard set by Medicare, is an income under 135 percent of the federal poverty level, which at the moment works out to around \$1,426 a month for individuals (or \$1,923 for married couples). Everything counts towards income, including payouts from 401(k) plans, pensions, Social Security, and help from family members.

Medicare also allows states to impose an asset test, which can be as little as \$7,730 per individual (\$11,600 for married couples), not counting your house or car but counting retirement savings and bank

But some states have made their MSP programs a lot more generous, with much nigner income limits and in some cases no asset tests at all. And the program may be called something else in your state. To find out if you qualify or to apply, contact your state Medicaid program. Visit Medicare. gov/contacts or call all 800-633-4227 for contact information.

Medication Extra Help

For help with Medicare (Part D) prescription drug plan costs, there is another completely separate program called Extra Help. To get it, you'll need to apply through your local Social Security office.

Depending on how low your income is, this program will pay part or all of your Part D prescription drug plan's monthly premiums, annual deductibles and prescription copayments. In 2019, individuals with a yearly income below \$18,735 (\$25,365 for a married couple), and assets under \$14,390 (\$28,720 for a married couple) can qualify for Extra

If you're eligible to be in a Medicare Savings Program, you will automatically qualify for Extra Help. But because the requirements are slightly different, even if you don't qualify for a Medicare Savings Program for Part B you might be able to get Extra Help for Part D. For more information or to apply, visit SSA. gov/extrahelp or call Social Security at 800-772-1213.

Other Assistance Programs

Depending on your income level, needs and location there are many other financial assistance programs that can help like Medicaid, SSI (Supplemental Security Income), PACE (Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly), SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), (LIHEAP) Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program and many others.

To help you find out what types of assistance programs you may be eligible for, and learn how to apply for them, go to BenefitsCheckUp. org. This is a free, confidential Web tool designed for people age 55 and older that contains more than 2,500 programs.

It's also possible to get help in person at one of the 87 Benefits Enrollment Centers scattered across the U.S. Call 888-268-6706 or visit NCOA.org/ centerforbenefits/becs to locate a center in your area. Some centers also offer assistance over the phone.


