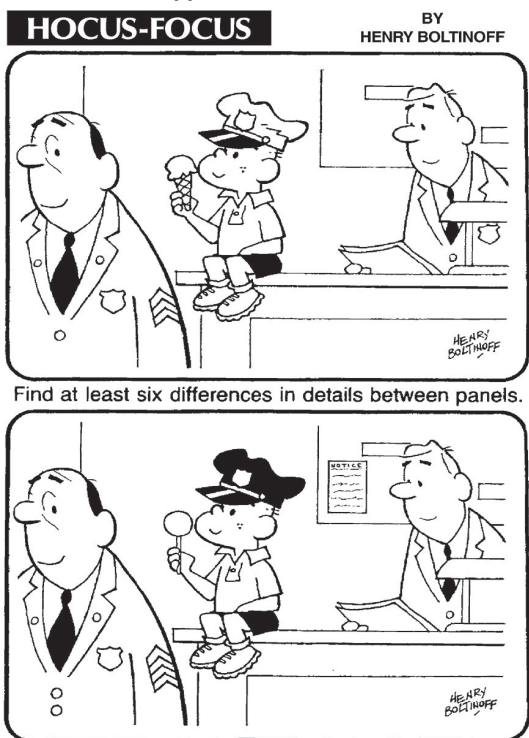

Social Media - Too Much? How Much?

Social media is just like mom's apple pie, it's not good to eat a whole pie every day.

Over three billion people are social media users worldwide. While social media helps keep the world connected, social media addiction is becoming a global problem that keeps growing. As of 2018, one third of the global population used social media.

Internet and social media addictions continue to grow as our dependence on technology increases. Over 210 million people suffer from internet and social media addictions worldwide.

A 2018 study found that teens who spend 5 hours per day using their phones were almost twice as likely to exhibit depressive symptoms than counterparts who dedicated only one hour on their phones. The relationship between excessive mobile use and depression appears to be strongly linked to gender with 58% more females than males experiencing depressive symptoms. A recent study containing over 23,500 participants between the ages of 16 and 88 found that being a young single female was most strongly associated with displaying addictive social media behavior. Addictive social media behavior was also strongly related to narcissistic personality traits and low self-esteem.

Social media addiction doesn't just affect behavior during the day; it even damages the ability to sleep. A study found that 71% of Americans sleep with or next to a mobile device. Some 47 million people in America do not get enough sleep and 55% more teens were sleep deprived in 2015 than in 1991. Exposure to screens before bed is a large factor in exacerbating sleep disorders. Thirty-five percent of people using phones less than average experienced sleep difficulty compared to 42% of those with average or above average phone usage. Forty-five percent of people check social media instead of sleeping and roughly 10% of teens check their phones more ten 10 times per night.

Fifty percent of people driving are checking social media. 90% of drivers admit to using smartphones behind the wheel. The Center for Disease Control and Prevention reports that each day nine people are killed and more than 1,000 are injured as a result of smartphone use while driving. According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, teens are the largest group reported for distracted driving.

Over 240 million Americans check Facebook daily or 74% of all Americans. The majority of Americans use Facebook and most users check the app daily. Approximately 68% of Americans have an account and 51% report checking Facebook several times daily.

Question - is it possible you might accomplish more of what you want and need to do if you would spend less time on social media? Another question - Is social media making you a better and happier person?

Is it possible you should cut back on your daily portion of social media?

Glass Pyramid

A 4 1/2-inch-high heavy glass pyramid was in a recent house sale. It was inexpensive, but no one knew what it was used for. It was almost too heavy to lift, so it wouldn't be a practical paperweight, but we bought it to display on a table with our obelisks. A long search of pictures online revealed what it is ... a "deck prism." It was used to give extra light to parts of an antique sailing ship that were below the waterline. The first deck prisms were used about 1840. Fire was the best source of light, but it also was very dangerous on a wooden ship, so oil, kerosene lamps and candles were avoided.



This glass prism with a slightly green tint is 4 1/2 inches high and very heavy. It was used like a window on vintage sailing ships to get light below the main deck. Just an ornament today, it is worth about \$50 in an online sale.

My prism was inserted upside down into a hole on the main deck. The glass pyramid point hung down and shed some light into the room below. The base of the prism, now at the top, was set flush into the wooden deck. After a while, the caulking that held the glass would leak and the glass would chip, so the prism was carefully remounted and caulked. In 1861 a patented threaded light that could be screwed into a metal frame was invented, so prisms lost favor. But reproductions in colored

glass still are made and used, and old ones are collected. They usually sell for less than \$50.

Q. I have my great-grandfather's accordion, a pre-1900 Hohner two-row button diatonic. It was appraised, and I was told it would fetch four figures. I'd love to keep it, but no one in my family wants it. It's normal fifth scalar organization, 20 plus treble buttons and 12 bass buttons in very good condition. Where should I start?

A. You probably will get the highest price by selling the accordion at an auction of other antique musical instruments. Expect to pay the auction gallery a commission, a percentage of the hammer price. Fees are negotiable. Find out in advance what costs are and what it includes. Will the instrument be pictured in a catalog? What is the cost of shipping it to the auction? Insurance? Do you want a minimum bid? What are costs to you if it doesn't sell? You also can try a music store in your area. They may know someone who collects vintage instruments.

No doubt about it, the temperatures we have experienced lately are brutal. We have received many dogs and cats suffering from the effects of it; we have received at least four that have died from heat-related problems

Within the past year, there have been two important changes in law regarding the adequate of animals during summer.

In the City of Danville, it is illegal to tether a companion animal when the temperatures reach 85 degrees or during weather advisories.

Statewide, the definition of "adequate shelter" is expanded to mean: "during hot weather, [the shelter] is properly shaded and does not readily conduct heat". This means that a doghouse is not adequate shelter; in fact, they become heat boxes. There must be shade provided at all times. One little dog that died was found tethered with his chain and collar tangled up in some underbrush. He choked to death, and it was probably from seeking respite from the sun.

Never expect your pet to be without cool, fresh water. Fresh water

must be provided at all times. Even inside pets drink more during hot weather. The absolute legal minimum for adequate water is "access to clean fresh water of a drinkable temperature." This, of course, will require extra effort by owners who leave their animals outside while they go to work.

Cats must be provided the same level of care as dogs. In fact, all companion animals in Virginia are afforded the same protections as dogs and cats.

Pet owners must be extra diligent during weather extremes to protect their companion animals.

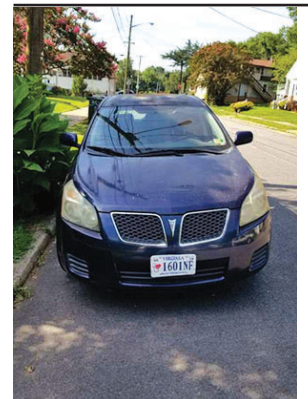

Is 'Beaver Fever' Cause of Digestive Trouble?

DEAR DR. ROACH: Last summer I went camping and ran out of clean water. I had to boil water and drink it without any treatment tablets. That evening, I had painful cramps in my stomach, and in my upper abdomen, under my ribcage. Since then, my digestion has been horrific. I have constant rank gas and bloating when eating foods I've never had a problem with before, even fruits and vegetables. I have been a big eater of probiotic foods, with no digestive disturbances. However, since this incident, any form of probiotic, whether from capsule or natural foods like sauerkraut or kimchi, gives me the worst gas and bloating I've ever had.

I had parasite and bacterial stool testing done with my doctor, and I came up clear. I feel like I need antibiotics or something to clear whatever is going on with my digestive system, but I'm hesitant because I have had four rounds of antibiotics in 2017 from surgeries. I am worried about "beaver fever." What do you recommend? -- A.L.

ANSWER: There are several infections one can get from drinking unprocessed water while camping. "Beaver fever" is a name for infection from the parasite Giardia lamblia, which is found in water where animals (especially beavers) are found. It's a reasonable thought -- it's one of the few waterborne infections that can persist for months. However, I think Giardia is unlikely. Symptoms from Giardia normally begin one to two weeks after exposure, and the parasites are killed very rapidly by boiling water.

Your symptoms are very much like irritable bowel syndrome, and I do wonder if it might have been triggered by some event that day you were camping. Usually, three sets of cultures for parasites are done to make sure there isn't an unwelcome guest in your intestine causing symptoms. A gastroenterologist would be a good choice to help you track down an identifiable cause and to get some symptomatic relief. Antibiotics are not recommended without knowing what you are treating.

DEAR DR. ROACH: Seven years ago, I had a stroke. I was immediately put on Lipitor and Plavix. The statin drugs made my arms and shoulders ache, and the doctor tested me and found no reason for it. He said anecdotally that he had many patients who complained of the same thing. He then put me on fenofibrate. The pain stopped immediately. Now he says new research shows that any cholesterol-lowering drug makes the blood tests show lowered cholesterol levels but it does not prevent heart attack or stroke. So he took me off it. I wonder if you know anything about this study that said there was no benefit to taking statins. I did not really understand what he said. -- G.C.

ANSWER: It sounds like the message got a bit confused. The evidence that statin drugs reduce the risk of heart attack and stroke in people at high risk, such as those who have had a previous event, is very strong. However, the evidence for fibrate drugs, such as fenofibrate, is much weaker. Statin drugs often cause some muscle aches. Pravastatin and fluvastatin are least likely to cause this problem, so it's worth a try switching, in my opinion. Some people get relief from muscle aches with a CoQ10 supplement.

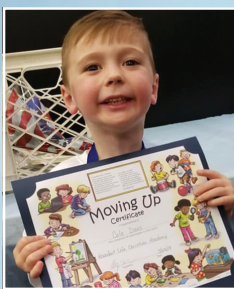

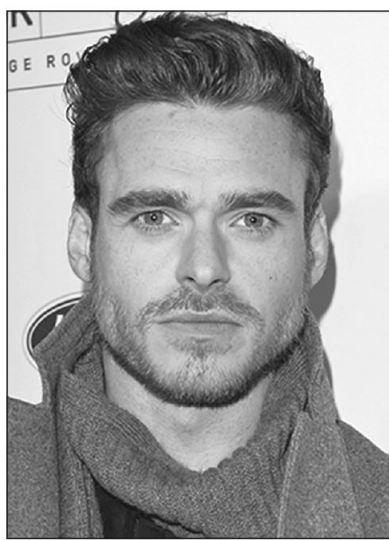

MAYOR DETAILS BIG STRIDES IN FIRST YEAR OF TERM

It has been a little more than a year since Alonzo Jones took over the reins of mayor in Danville. But that year has seen much progress, especially in the three focus areas that City Council established nearly three years ago.

The focus areas are violent crime, education, and growing Danville.

"A little more than one year ago, City Council gave me the honor of serving as mayor, and at that time, I promised to build upon the efforts underway in these areas," Jones said. "I also added 'partnerships' as a fourth area of focus. We are making big strides, and we have some real partners in making this happen."

Jones points to the following developments during his time as mayor:

Crime rates are down dramatically. Earlier this year, Danville Police reported that robberies, for example, have fallen 73 percent. Also, aggravated assaults involving the use of firearms have dropped 70 percent.

The vacancy rate for licensed teachers in Danville Public Schools decreased from 20 percent to 2 percent in the last school year, resulting in licensed teachers filling 98 percent of the classrooms and higher-quality instruction.

Aggressive industrial recruitment and workforce development programs led to the announcement of four new industries and one expansion that will bring hundreds of jobs and about \$100 million in new investment.

"Obviously, last week's announcement that Ikea plans to close its plant here was a setback, and my heart goes out to each of the workers there," Jones said. "But I want to point out that the decision to close had nothing to do with the workforce or the region."

Going forward, the mayor noted that the local economy remains strong and, as evident by the economic development announcements in the past year, the city is well-positioned with the strategies and programs in place.

"Our economic development team is working hard and in cooperation with our many local and state partners," Jones said. "I am optimistic that we will see more jobs and continued investments in the year ahead."

The mayor also is optimistic about the direction in public safety.

"The police chief (Scott Booth) has put in place a number of strategies that are making a difference," Jones said. "Danville is a safer community today."

Those strategies include a departmental restructuring, additional law enforcement partnerships, use of data-driven policing, and community engagement.

"I participated in the recent graduation ceremony for the second annual Youth Police Academy, and it was amazing to see the interaction between the youths and the police officers," Jones said. "This is what is taking place throughout the community. Our citizens are stepping forward and embracing the changes. There is greater trust, and that is key to having a safer community."

Also, the mayor believes there is a greater synergy between the City Council, City staff, and the Danville Public School Board and School staff.

Last month, the school division honored city officials with a Strategic Partnership Award. In announcing the award, school leaders pointed to the collaborative relationship that has developed and led to increased investments in public education and alignment of career and technical education programs with workforce and economic development priorities.

"We are investing in our most important citizens - the children in our community," Jones said.

Jones is serving his first two-year term as mayor, which is a position determined among sitting City Council members. Jones was vice mayor for a term before becoming mayor.

"We have worked as a team and in the best interests of this city, and we will continue to do that in the year ahead," Jones said.

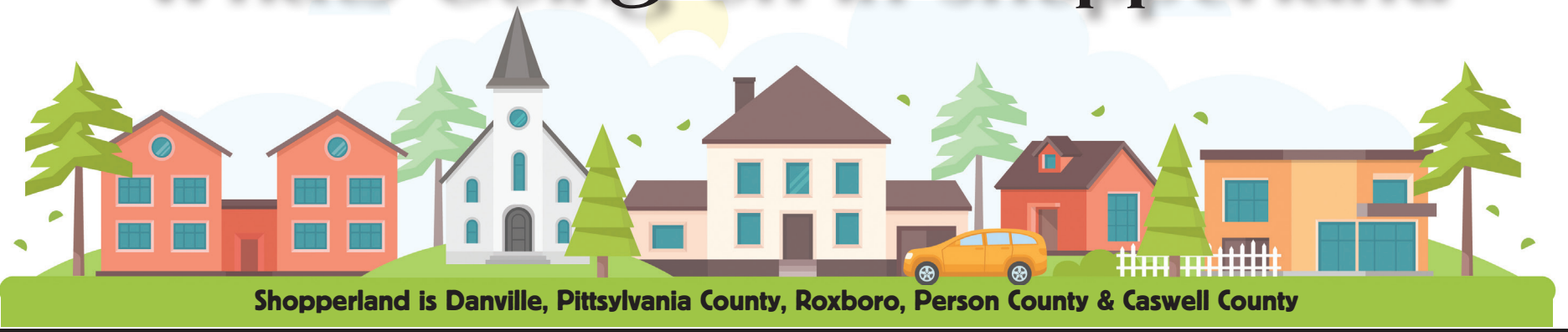

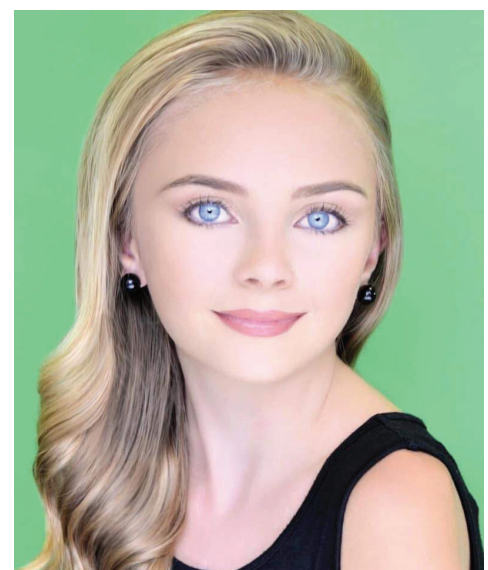

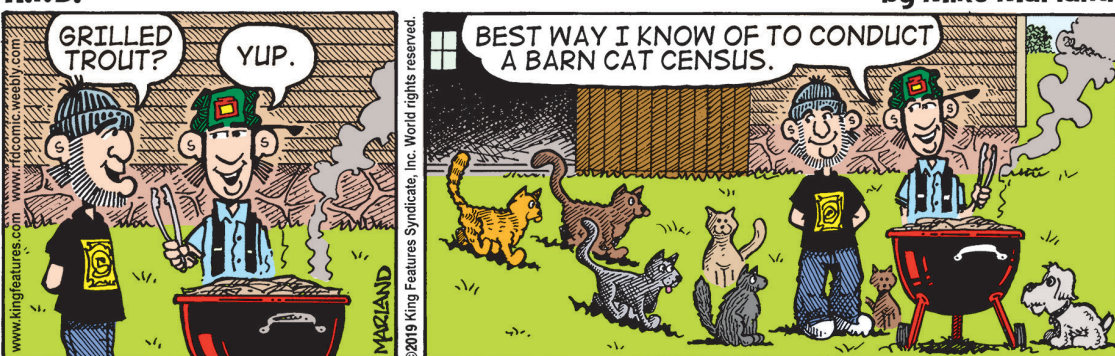

The family would like to extend their appreciation to Mrs. Huff's granddaughter-in-law, Samantha for her love and care for the past several years.

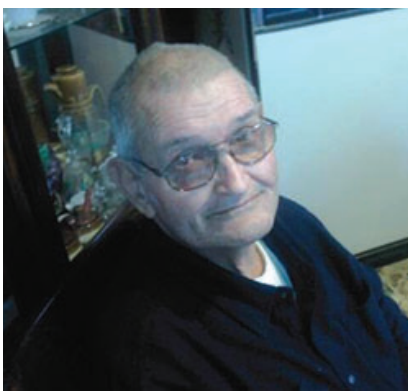

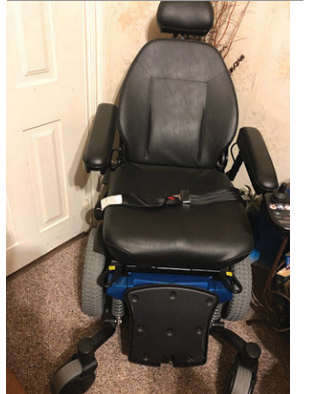

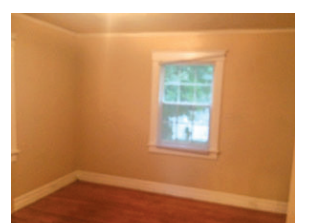

Peach and Pepper Honey Grilled Chicken

Ingredients

- 1 Ripe Peach, Sliced
- 2 Fresh Jalapenos
- 1/2 Cup Honey
- Grill Seasoning
- Salt and Pepper
- 2 lb. Boneless Skinless Chicken Breast

Directions

Thinly slice peaches. Quarter and deseed jalapenos length wise. Two options follow; either stuff the chicken breast with the peaches and peppers to cook them; or grill them alongside liberally seasoned chicken breast. Cook chicken to 165 degrees and remove from grill. For the stuffed chicken, slice into 1/2 medallions and drizzle with honey before serving. If not, simply top the chicken with the jalapeno and peaches before you drizzle with the honey. Pairs well with jasmine rice.

Lemon Pepper Fried Zucchini and Squash Sriracha Ranch

Ingredients

- 1 Medium Yellow Squash
- 1 Medium Zucchini
- 2 Cups Vegetable Oil
- 2 Cups Breader-House Autry or Similar
- 2 Eggs, Beaten
- 50/50 Mix of Sriracha and Ranch Dressing
- 3 Tablespoons Lemon Pepper Seasoning

Directions

Heat oil in a frying pan to 350 degrees, or until oil begins to appear wavy. Skipping the oil and using an air fryer is also an option! Slice the squash and zucchini into 1/4 inch slices. Split the breader into two small mixing bowls. Beat the eggs and also reserve in a small bowl. Mix seasoning into the breading before dredging. To sufficiently bread the squash and zucchini, dredge the slices in the first bowl of breader, then the egg and finally the last breading bowl. This will provide an evenly coated slice. Fry in oil for 3 to 4 minutes or until golden brown. Serve with Sriracha Ranch dipping sauce.

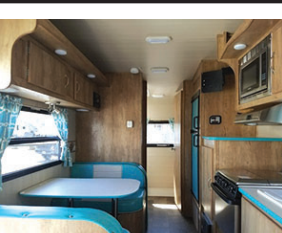

Building a Balanced Diet with a **Better Sandwich**

FAMILY FEATURES

Fast diets come and go, and as many Americans find, so do the pounds they lose. Most experts agree that eliminating, or drastically reducing, any of the major food groups from your diet can be detrimental to your health and prevent you from achieving long-term healthy eating goals.

Each of the food groups plays a distinct role in fueling your body and providing it with the vitamins and nutrients it needs. Attempt a well-rounded approach to eating, such as one that includes more nutritious choices for popular dishes like sandwiches. In general, pay attention to the variety, amount and nutrition of the foods you consume.

Consider these ideas for creating a balanced diet and a nutritious sandwich to help ensure you get enough of each food group:

Start from the Outside

There are two groups of grains: whole grains and refined grains. Whole grains contain the entire grain kernel, while refined grains have been milled for a finer texture and are required to be enriched per government mandate to help the population make up for nutrient shortfalls. Grains should account for about one quarter of each meal, but at least half of them should be whole grains – a fact that may surprise some people.

“Many health professionals mistakenly encourage consumers to skip the bread when trying to improve diets,” said Yanni Papanikolaou from Nutrition Strategies Inc., who completed a study to assess the energy and nutrients contributed from sandwiches in diets of children and adolescents. “Americans need to think twice before cutting bread from their diets. In fact, bread packs more of a nutrient punch than a caloric one.”

The ingredients inside a sandwich, not the bread itself, are the most significant drivers of calories, fat and sodium, according to Papanikolaou’s research. A separate study published in the journal “Nutrients” shows grain foods contribute less than 15 percent of all calories in the total diet,

while delivering greater than 20 percent of three shortfall nutrients – dietary fiber, folate and iron – and greater than 10 percent of calcium, magnesium and vitamin A.

Consumers can significantly and positively impact their caloric, fat and sodium intake by making more deliberate decisions about sandwich ingredients, including choosing either whole-grain or enriched-grain bread. Find more information about the role of grains in a healthy diet at GrainFoodsFoundation.org.

Rethink the Ingredients

Making more nutritious choices with sandwiches and positively impacting your consumption of calories, fat and sodium is oftentimes a matter of changing the way you stack ingredients between the bread. Consider this sample sandwich: two slices of whole-grain or enriched bread, 2-3 slices of lunchmeat, two slices of cheese, a few spinach or lettuce leaves and a slice of tomato.

Contrary to popular belief, research shows that sandwich eaters who choose either whole- or enriched-grain bread can consume less calories, fat and sodium compared to the typical sandwich consumed in the American diet. This demonstrates the need to focus on the ingredients between the bread for a better (more healthful) sandwich.

According to the USDA, most Americans get about the right amount of protein in their diets, but could do better at choosing leaner options and adding more variety to their menus.

Incorporating more variety doesn’t have to mean sacrificing convenience.
