

Spaghetti Dinner & Silent Auction




"Going once, Going twice... and more than 30 campers are going to Camp Cherith this summer from the proceeds of the annual Spaghetti Dinner and Silent Auction.

Severe Heat Warning – Residents Advised to Prepare



Experts warn that this a dangerous long period of hot temperatures which is expected from early Friday until late Saturday. The combination of hot temperatures and high humidlity is expected to rise to 105-108 degrees in the next few days, which can cause serious heat-related illnesses if preventative measures are not taken. The Livingston County Department of Health urges residents to keep themselves and their loved ones safe by doing the following:

- Find places in your community where you can go to get cool
- Keep your home cool by doing the following:
- Install air-conditioning units in windows. Make sure they fit snuggl —insulate if necessary.
- Create a temporary heat reflector by placing a sheet of cardboard covered in tin foil between your windows and your drapes. This will cause light (and heat) to be reflected back outside.
- Weather strip doors and windows to keep cool air in.
- Cover windows that receive direct sunlight with drapes or shades.

This can reduce the amount of heat that enters a house by up to 80%. o Use attic fans to clear hot air.

Remember, young children, the elderly, and pets are at the greatest risk of heat-related illness. Never leave children or pets in a parked car, as temperatures can rise to over 135°F in less than 10 minutes. Residents are also advised to limit physical activity and stay hydrated. If you have elderly neighbors, check on them to see if they are coping well and determine if they need any additional assistance.


