SHADOW RENAISSANCE FESTIVAL 2019

Have you ever been to a Renaissance Festival? The big one in this corner of Texas is Scarborough Fair, which has been going on in Waxahachie, Texas for over 35 years. I proudly report that individuals connected with that successful event are reaching out to help local organizers of the new Shadow Renaissance Festival, scheduled in Hopkins County on July 26-28, 2019. What makes these fairs so interesting? Well, back during the Middle Ages, Scarborough Fair was a 45-day trading event that brought tradesmen from all over England and from countries beyond to the Yorkshire seaside town. Sailors brought fair visitors from Norway, Denmark, the Baltic States and the Byzantine Empire. In 1253, the annual fair had been granted privilege through a charter from Henry VIII, and it thrived for over a hundred years, but finally it's success became challenged when similarly-styled fairs began to crop up across England. The once monumental gathering was memorialized for a new generation within the 1968 soundtrack to The Graduate performed by Simon and Garfunkel. Today, there are numerous "Scarborough festivals" held in the United States which imitate the 'international trading fair' theme.

Kris Cobb is President of the Shadow Renaissance Festival. It will be held in Sulphur Springs on July 26-28 inside and on the grounds of the Hopkins County Civic Center. Elaborately dressed tradesmen, shopkeepers and 'royalty' will be in attendance most with goods to sell or photo opportunities. There will be many fun activities for children, games of chance and skill as well as exotic food and beverage. According to Kris "anytime you get to the Festival on any of the three days, you will probably be in time to catch one or more of the Knight Fights. These Knight Fights are full contact footed combat with swords and shields. 38 fighters and four referees have registered. The Unicorn Photos and even the Unicorn rides will be popular, and we even have the rare unicorn llamas. Fully costumed faeries will be plentiful around the petting zoo, and a Faery Garden will draw interested persons in for photos and just quiet time to meditate. The Knight Fights will draw crowds, with ongoing battles and chapter wars staged intermittently all three days. Rondini the Escape Artist will be one of the more popular attractions. Exotic food and beverage offerings like "Dragons Toes", Greek gyros and pitas and meade can be discovered.

Thirty nine fully costumed members make up the local cast of Shadow Renaissance Festival, and they will be joined by dozens more veteran festival performers and vendors. Cost to enter is \$15 for ages 11 and up, \$5 for ages 5-10 and free for ages 4 and under. Hours are Friday July 26 from 1 pm til 8 pm, on Saturday July 27 from 10 am til 7 pm and on Sunday July 28 from 11 am til 6 pm. Proceeds from the Festival are earmarked for Shadow Ranch Therapeutic Riding Center located in Hopkins County. "We'd like to raise enough money for Shadow Ranch to operate on for a full year, and to ensure a healthy start for the 2020 Shadow Renaissance Festival next year", said Kris. 

SPEND THE NIGHT IN A HARVEY HOUSE

Tumbleweed Smith



In the late 1800's Fred Harvey built restaurants all along the Santa Fe Railroad.

"There were no dining cars back then, so he saw a need for fine dining," says Lynn Melton of Slaton. She manages the Harvey House in Slaton. It's the only Harvey House in Texas where you can spend the night. "Mr. Harvey formed a company, partnered with Santa Tumbleweed Smith Fe. He was very meticulous about his service. He only

 used fine china and polished silver. He really did kind of tionize the industry. Walt Disney took his business model from Fred Harvey.'

Lynn says passengers' food orders were telegraphed to Harvey Houses so that when they got off the train their food was ready. They only had 20 minutes to eat, then get back on the train.

Harvey girls were efficient and lived at Harvey Houses.

"We had 6 Harvey girls that lived upstairs in this Harvey House. There was a full basement where Harvey girls roller-skated. There must not have been a lot to do in Slaton in the early nineteen hundreds." Fred Harvey died in 1901 but his sons continued the business. When dining cars became popular Harvey Houses became hotels. Brownwood and Slaton both have Harvey Houses. The one in Brownwood is now a museum. The one in Slaton is a bed and breakfast. It also has an event hall where weddings, meetings and other activities take place. It was built in 1912 and was used as a restaurant until after World War Two. Then it became the Santa Fe Depot and served in that capacity until 1980.

"This was vacant from 1980 to 1990 and they were about to tear it down. But when a local plumber came in to turn off the gas and water he thought we can't do this. He called a retired English teacher and she stood in front of the bulldozer that was going to raze the building. The loading dock had already been removed. The protests to save the depot grew and some citizens formed the Slaton Heritage Association. Funds were raised through grans and donations and the association bought the building for \$2,500 and started the renovations which were completed in 2007. That was when it opened to the public."

The facility has five bedrooms, all named for Indian tribes. Mr. Harvey was fascinated with Indian culture and the southwest. Slaton Harvey House is just a few feet from the railroad tracks and people love to hear the trains rumble by.
