





Madison on April 10 marked 6 years of being cancer free. Madison was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia when she was 3 years old. The family received the diagnosis on Dec. 27, 2010. She endured 2 ¹/₂ years of chemo and treatment, including nine blood transfusions.

She just finished fifth grade and is active in dance classes and plays point guard in basketball. Her mother, Jaime Allport, said Madison has been a big fan of Rhett for more than a year. When she made the poster, Madison put the title of one of Rhett's most popular songs on top: "Look What God Gave Her."

Allport said several people helped Madison's dream come true on July 19. People at the concert cleared the way so she could get in the front pit, where Rhett was more likely to see her. A tall fan named Connor then put her on his shoulders. That's when Rhett saw Madison, read the poster and insisted she join him on stage. "Never in our wildest dreams did we think he would pull her up on stage," Allport said. "And he made such a big deal out of it."

Rhett posted photos and message on his social media on Saturday, a day after the concert: "Madison, it was such a pleasure meeting you!" he posted. "May God continue to bless you and your sweet family hope you had a great time at the show."

Allport said the family is gearing up for the ninth annual Madisonation golf tournament on Aug. 25 at Hickory Ridge Golf Resort in Holley. The tournament started in honor of Madison. Her father, Kevin Muckle, organizes the annual event, which goes to organizations and families fighting cancer.



WHERE'S THE HUMMERS?

By Douglas H. Domedion

Lately there has been quite a few of calls and emails asking "where are the hummingbirds". I'm down on the numbers here at home this year but many claim they only have one or two or none. So what is going on?

About a week ago or so several folks contacted me to ask what happened to their hummingbirds that they did have. When wild flowers are blooming like crazy some of our regular "customers" disappear to feed on this new bounty of nectar. I know when the Jewel Weed and phlox is blooming my hummer numbers go down. This not only makes for more and variable nectar available but increases the population of of insects that frequent these flowers. Hummers feed a lot on in tiny insects, much more then most people

realize. So they are probably feeding on nature's bounty out there and just not at your feeders as much.


As far as the overall numbers being down one reason could be that some bad weather conditions either, during the fall or spring migration, could have took some out of the population. Many of our hummers fly across the Gulf to South America which is a 500-mile day trip for them and they can run into some very adverse weather on that trip.

Still another possible reason could be that something could be going on the wintering grounds (environmental destruction that is depleting the population or worse chemical presence). Along with this thought we have what is going on in our country. The use of pesticides and herbicides is a way of life for big farming now days and just how many of those contaminated insects can they eat before they die or have low production rates? And with the habitat being changed by the reduction of insects through the large scale lost of vegetation and flowers it takes away a lot of what the hummers survive on. Thus, down the road we could be actually killing off many birds or driving them away from our location.

On an individual basics maybe hummers could be getting sick or driven away from particular feeders by folks not keeping their feeders clean and freshened. Feeders in the sun can turn bad in a few days in warm weather causing the hummers to abandon them or even get sick. This recent weather we have had causes your feeders to get bad real quick. Be smart and only fill your feeders enough to last a few days and keep them out of the sun if possible. When changing the food dump the old and do a good job of cleaning every part of that feeder before refilling. Now that many of us are getting "city water" maybe it would be a good idea to boil the water (then let cool) before mixing up a batch of food (1 part sugar to 4 parts water) and then keep the extra in the refrigerator. I also place a strip of masking tape on the side of each of my feeders where the date can be written with a magic marker to remind me when they were last cleaned and refilled.

If you have cats around outside they can be a problem as they can hide near a feeder and if it is low enough can spring from hiding and catch a hummer. I know of one place where the folks have a "dog house" outside for their outdoor cats and right next to the cat house and only 3 ½ feet from the ground is a hummingbird feeder. WHAT? The whole set up is right outside their window so I gather they enjoy watching the cats trying to catch hummers. Every time I see this set up I try to think what would be better, put a hole in the feeder or holes in the cats. An over abundance of bees visiting your feeders will discourage hummers, but by putting a couple more feeders up a ways from the ones the bees are visiting usually helps. Ants can also be a problem and to solve that problem I build little water moats from small plastic cups to hang my feeders on so the ants can't get to the feeders. Another possible cause of low numbers of hummers could be the poor decisions Governor Cuomo throws at us Western New York folks and they are just avoiding New York State! And as a final thought on the matter, all wildlife populations fluctuate and we may just be hitting one of those low years right now. So keep you feeders clean and fresh and once the nesting season is over you will probably see more hummers and you want those new guys to remember next year where they found a good, clean feeder after leaving the nest. Managing Cholesterol Starts with What you Eat

High cholesterol, particularly high levels of "bad" cholesterol, is a risk for heart disease. The Mayo Clinic says that high cholesterol also can increase risk for heart attack. Understanding cholesterol and how to control it can help people live longer, healthier lives. Cholesterol is a waxy substance that comes from two main sources. It is produced naturally by the liver and is obtained by eating certain foods, primarily animal products like meat, dairy and eggs. When these foods are consumed, the liver makes more cholesterol than it normally would, says the American Heart Association.

Harvard Medical School says that making certain food choices can help lower cholesterol levels. Some foods help prevent cholesterol from forming, while others lower low-density lipoprotein, also referred to as "LDL" or "bad" cholesterol. Some foods increase the amount of high-density lipoprotein, also known as "HDL" or "good" cholesterol. Still other foods block the body from absorbing cholesterol.

· Increase soluble fiber. Soluble fiber is found in oatmeal and other whole grains, flax, apples, legumes, and beans. Because soluble fiber can't be broken down, it goes through the body and bloodstream like a giant mop, collecting bile generated to digest fats. The fiber and the fat-soaked bile are then excreted in the stool. According to Healthline, bile is made from cholesterol, and when the liver needs to make more of it to digest fat, it does so by pulling cholesterol out of the bloodstream, naturally reducing cholesterol levels as a result.

· Eliminate trans fats. Trans fats, or those foods listed on labels primarily as hydrogenated oils, can raise overall cholesterol levels. The Food and Drug Administration has banned the use of partially hydrogenated vegetable oils by Jan. 1, 2021.

· Eat more fatty fish. Harvard Medical School says that eating fish two or three times a week can lower LDL by replacing meat and by delivering LDL-lowering omega-3 fats to the body. Omega-3s reduce triglycerides in the bloodstream and also protect the heart by helping to prevent the onset of abnormal heart rhythms.

· Use vegetable oils. Liquid vegetable oils, like canola or soybean, can be used in place of solid fats like butter or lard when cooking.

· Choose low-fat dairy. Substitute the low- or no-fat varieties of milk and cheeses instead of high-fat versions.
