



HOLLYWOOD - We now know why Netflix has been concentrating on making original movies that it can show in theaters and make available exclusively for streaming. In the beginning we had HBO, Showtime, Cinemax and the Movie Channel for watching current films. Netflix backed its streaming with TV series content such as "Friends," "The Simpsons" and "The Office," which was immensely popular. Last year Disney pulled its product from Netflix because Disney is starting its own streaming service.

Now WarnerMedia has created HBO-Max as their streaming service, and as of November, "Friends" will no longer be available to Netflix. As contracts run out, Netflix also will lose "The Fresh Prince of Bel Air," "Pretty Little Liars" and Reese Witherspoon products. Thanks to Disney's acquisition of 20th Century Fox, Netflix also will be losing 30 years of "The Simpsons." Disney's streaming service likely will cost \$7, while HBOMax will be \$15 or more.

Among the top 100 celebrity moneymakers is Celine Dion (at No. 100) with \$37.6 million, Ryan Seacrest (No. 27) with \$71.5 million, Chris Hemsworth (No. 24) with \$76.4 million, Ellen DeGeneres (22) with \$80.5 million, Beyonce and Jay Z (20) with \$81 million, Elton John (19) with \$84 million, Dwayne Johnson (15) with \$89 million and Phil McGraw (9) with \$95 million. Kim Kardashian came in at No. 26 with \$72 million and husband Kanye West is No. 4 with \$80 million, but Kylie Jenner beat them combined at No. 2 with \$170 million. The top grosser of the year? Taylor Swift, with \$185 million

for Tommy Lee Jones. Now Warner is developing a series reboot for the small screen. No cast been named yet.

Vanity Fair is predicting the Emmys will go hostless like this year's Academy Awards show. When Kevin Hart bowed out of emceeing, it was too late to find another host. 

PIEDMONT PETS

IThe first time I saw newborn guinea pigs, I was amazed. They are born with eyes open, all of their hair, and a full set of teeth. In fact, within hours of being born, they can eat solid food.

Guinea pigs readily interact and bond with humans. They may the ideal companion for someone who lives in a apartment, but still wants to have a companion. Be aware, though, they still require attention and play time outside of the cage.

Guinea pigs originally came from South America and are considered a source of protein. I tried not to be too appalled when I learned that a friend of mine who had served a mission to Argentina had actually eaten them.

Although parents must realize that they will be the ones ultimately responsible for the care of any companion animal in the home, guinea pigs may be a good choice of a first pet for older children. They have very specific needs that should be carefully monitored.

Guinea pigs can live to be about eight years old in a home where their dietary needs are fulfilled. They must have constant access to a high-quality guinea pig food, Timothy hay, and some fruits and vegetables (especially those high in vitamin C). Any fresh food not eaten within 24 hours should be discarded.

Guinea pigs needs to have fresh, clean, chlorine-free water every day in a bottle that is kept clean and sanitary.

The biggest concern we see is the size of a cage. If your guinea pig spends most of the time in a cage, then it needs

to be a large one. If a store employee suggests the minimum size, increase that! There must be a solid floor and paper bedding should be used. Cedar shavings are a huge no-no. The cage will quickly smell if not kept clean every day; solid waste should be removed every day and wet spots should also be removed daily.

Guinea pigs love time outside their cage; however, they should never be taken outside and left there. In fact, a hawk would not be bothered by a human standing nearby and can snatch guinea pigs before the owner has time to react. In addition, guinea pigs can also get infested with fleas and other small creatures. There are plenty of ways to let guinea pigs get exercise inside.

If you believe a guinea pig may be a good first pet for your older child, there is a lot of information online. And don't forget - animal shelters also have guinea pigs for adoption. We currently have six young ones and three adult ones for adoption. There is no need to buy one; a homeless guinea pig may be waiting for you at the shelter!



BOOK DETAILS SPIRITUAL BATTLE FOR GANG-AFFILIATED YOUTH

The City of Danville's coordinator for youth services and gang violence prevention has written a book that provides churches and faith-based organizations with an under-

standing of the motives and origins of gangs from a Christian perspective.

In his book, "Gangs vs. Kingdom: Battle for the Next Generation," Robert David also provides evidence-based strategies for these groups to make a change in the lives of youths affiliated with gangs.

"Over time, I realized that gangs operate under a trinity just as Christians operate under a Trinity," David said. "For gang members, their God is money. Their Jesus or their Messiah is their OG (Original Gangster) because whatever instruction they receive comes from their OG or leader.

"Their Holy Spirit - which will comfort them or come to their aid - is other gang members."

David said organizations must understand

that violent and deviant behaviors are the outward expression of a gang's commitment to their Trinity.

"I use this concept of the Trinity so that faith-based organizations can see that it's going to take more than a hot dog supper during which you tell them to get out of their gang," David said. "To tell a young person entrenched in a gang to get out of the gang is the same as trying to tell you or me to stop worshipping God and stop believing in Jesus as your Lord and Savior."

He continued, saying, "For these youths to make a change in their lives there has to be a conversion like you would convert from another religion."

Faith-based organizations must first develop a relationship with these youths, and they must understand the history of urban gangs and how they became glamorized. David details this history in the book.

"If faith-based organizations don't give young people a place to operate in their purpose, then gangs will," David said. "That's the battle. If we don't find a relevant way for young to manifest who they are – and to be able to look past some of their indiscretions because they don't look like us or act like us – then these young people are going to go to the street. The gangs facilitate that."

David, who is available for seminars and training sessions, said OGs make their god – money – tangible when they come through neighborhoods in big cars and with lots of money.

The 90-page book is available on Amazon as a paperback and Kindle eBook.

David joined the City on June 11, 2018, as its first youth services and gang violence prevention coordinator. Since then, he has implemented programs such as Project Imagine, which is a training and employment program designed to give youths with a gang connection a future off the streets by providing them with a paid work experience and mentoring while on the job.

Before coming to Danville, he served as a juvenile court counselor with the N.C. Department of Public Safety, a community gang liaison in Rockingham, N.C., and a probation officer in California.

David also is a life and recovery coach and motivational speaker and has been a drug-free Mr. Universe bodybuilder and four-time world champion powerlifter.

It's Not Too Late to Start Moving

If we've been inactive for many years, it's easy to just assume that there's nothing we can do at our age to increase our health and longevity. Not so, according to a new study.

A large University of Cambridge study of 14,000 participants over nearly 13 years assessed diet, alcohol consumption, body mass index, occupation — and physical activity levels - and compared those with mortality risk from any condition.

Here's what researchers discovered: Those who were sedentary and remained sedentary had a higher risk of mortality. However, those who started with low activity levels but increased them had additional longevity benefits. Specifically, the risk of death decreased 24% for a low increase in activity, 38% for a medium increase, and 42% for a high increase in activity.

In other words, even if we've been very sedentary, becoming more active now lowers our mortality risk.


Many researchers (and the World Health Organization) still say that 150 minutes per week of moderate-intensity exercise is what we all need. They even break it down into minutes of activities like dog walking or gardening, all the way up to running and playing tennis.


But that doesn't mean we should all do 150 minutes of cycling or jogging per week, especially without medical advice. Yes, we can gain longevity if we become more active, but it shouldn't be at the risk of our current health.

Get your doctor's opinion. Ask for a plan to gradually increase your activity level. How many minutes of which activity should you do each week? If you're going to walk, where will you do that? If you want at-home exercise equipment, what kind? If your doctor's office has a sports medicine department, ask about being assessed on its equipment.

Seriously consider upping your activity level, but do it safely.



With its telegenic cast of singing, dancing and emoting performers who would soon become the most popular and envied kids in America, The Mickey Mouse Club show captivated up to 10 million viewers a day during the 1950s. It remains today one of the most iconic television series ever.

The Mickey Mouse Club was an ABC-TV variety show with a revolutionary concept for its time—a show for kids that featured kids as the performers. The hundreds of enthusiastic youngsters auditioning for the series included future actors Paul Petersen and Candice Bergen and future songwriter/singer Paul Williams. Growing up in an era much simpler than our current one, the 28 original Mouseketeers chosen tended to be normal youngsters whose biggest problems were overbearing stage mothers and niggling intra-cast jealousies.

The Mickey Mouse Club, whose target audience was age 12 but also included many parents, was hosted by "Mooseketeer" Jimmie Dodd, a banjoist/actor/songwriter who composed the show's iconic "The Mickey Mouse March" (you remember..."M-I-C...K-E-Y," etc.) and occasionally offered little morality lessons called "Doddisms."

Roy Williams, a Disney artist and the second "Mooseketeer," suggested the wearing of Mouseketeer ears by each performer, an idea disdained by some. Lonnie Burr, for example, grumbled that the stiff appendages messed up his "cool" pompadour hairstyle. He would later donate his stage ears to the Smithsonian.

Each weekday's show featured a special theme. Monday was Fun with Music Day, Tuesday was Guest Star Day, Wednesday was Anything Can Happen Day, Thursday was Circus Day and Friday was Talent Round-up Day. Each afternoon's events were divided into 15-minute segments and were rife with commercials and product placement. They featured newsreels, Mouseketeer performances, a Mickey Mouse cartoon (voiced by Disney himself as the world's best-known rodent) and such serial dramas as The Adventures of Spin and Marty and The Hardy Boys. Several cast members became well-known, but none more so than Annette Joanne Funicello. The only Mouseketeer hand-picked by Disney after he had spied her at a local dance-school recital, the already-developed girl turned 13 in October of 1955, the same month that The Mickey Mouse Club made its debut. Funicello quickly established herself as the show's superstar—and the object of desire for millions of hormone-fueled boys. In time, she would cut five Top 40 hit singles on her boss's Disneyland/Buena Vista label and co-star with fellow teen idol Frankie Avalon in several vacuous but popular Beach Party movies. (At Disney's request, she always kept her navel covered.) Funicello died in 2013 at age 70 after battling multiple sclerosis for 26 years.



Why People Hoard

The reasons most people hoard is because they have an extreme sentimental attachment to their possessions, or they believe they might need their items at a later date. Hoarding can also be a sign that an older person is depressed or showing early symptoms of dementia.

Common problems for seniors who live in excessive clutter are tripping, falling and breaking a bone; overlooking bills and missing medications that are hidden in the clutter; and suffering from the environmental effects of mold, mildew and dust, and even living among insects and rodents.

What to Do

To get a handle on your mom's problem, the Institute for Challenging Disorganization offers a free "Clutter Hoarding Scale" that you can download off their website at ChallengingDisorganization.org.

If you find that your mom has a moderate cluttering problem, there are a number of things you can do to help.

Start by having a talk with her, respectfully expressing your concern for her health and safety, and offering your assistance to help her declutter.

If she takes you up on it, most professional organizers recommend decluttering in

You will also need to help her set up a system for organizing the kept items and new possessions.

Find Help

If you need some help with the decluttering and organizing, consider hiring a professional organizer who can come to your mom's home to help you prioritize, organize and remove the clutter. The nonprofit group National Association of Productivity and Organizing Professionals has a directory on the website at NAPO. net to help you locate a professional in your area.

If your mom has a bigger, more serious hoarding problem (if her daily functioning is impaired, or if she is having financial difficulties, health problems, or other issues because of her hoarding) you'll need to seek professional help. Antidepressants and/or talk therapy can help address control issues, anxiety, depression, and other feelings that may underline hoarding tendencies, and make it easier for her to confront her disorder.

To learn more and find professional help see the International OCD Foundation which provides a hoarding center on their website (Hoarding.iocdf.org) that offers information, resources, treatments, self-help groups, and more. Also see HoardingCleanup.com, a site that has a national database of qualified including resources cleaning companies and therapists that can help.




