Kiwanis Park Opens New Softball Field

Five years in the planning, fund raising and construction have resulted in a brand new softball field at the Kiwanis Park in Nunda. For many years, the girls had been playing on a "baseball" style field but not getting the full effects of a dirt infield which is what is used for modern softball games. Through designing and excavation last summer and grooming this spring, the field was transformed into a regulation "skinned" infield for the girls.

Lawson Sand and Gravel donated and brought in 5 truckloads of sand for the base. After a lot of grooming, raking and leveling, the field was ready for play beginning this April.

Kiwanis also has 2 other fields that are set up for baseball. Work continues on both of these fields for Machine Pitch and T-Ball Games as well as 10 and under and 12 and under teams. Thanks to all the coaches for the daily maintenance of these fields.





Rabies Positive Bat in Lakeville

According to the Livingston County Public Health Director, Jennifer Rodriguez, the New York State Health Department laboratory has confirmed that a bat in the Hamlet of Lakeville tested positive for rabies on July 30, 2019. A person exposed to the rabid bat is seeking treatment.

Rabies is a deadly virus that attacks the central nervous system in mammals. It is most frequently found in raccoons, skunks, and bats. All mammals, including unvaccinated dogs, cats, and farm animals, are at risk for getting rabies.

It is important to note that there is no way to tell if an animal is rabid just by looking at it. Wild and feral animals should always be avoided. Signs of rabies in wildlife include: inability to walk, appearance of "drunkenness," unwillingness to drink water or eat, drooling, aggressive behavior, or any significant change in temperament. All potential rabies exposures should be reported to the Livingston County Department of Health.

Below are important steps to prevent rabies.

- Stay away from unfamiliar animals, either wild or domestic, even if they appear friendly.
- Thoroughly wash any wound from an animal with soap and water and seek immediate medical attention.
- Avoid wild and feral animals, especially if the animal is showing any sign of rabies.
- Be a responsible pet owner by keeping your pet's vaccinations current. Getting your pets vaccinated can help stop the spread of rabies from wild animals to humans.

New York State Law requires that all dogs, cats and ferrets have current rabies vaccinations, beginning at 4 months of age. An unvaccinated pet that comes into contact with a rabid animal must be kept in strict confinement for six months or be euthanized. Free rabies clinics are offered for dogs, cats, and ferrets every year in Livingston County.

The next rabies clinic is on August 6, 2019 in Livonia. Pre-registration is available on the Environmental Health website listed below.

It is important to be aware of the facts and use caution to protect your family and your pets. 




